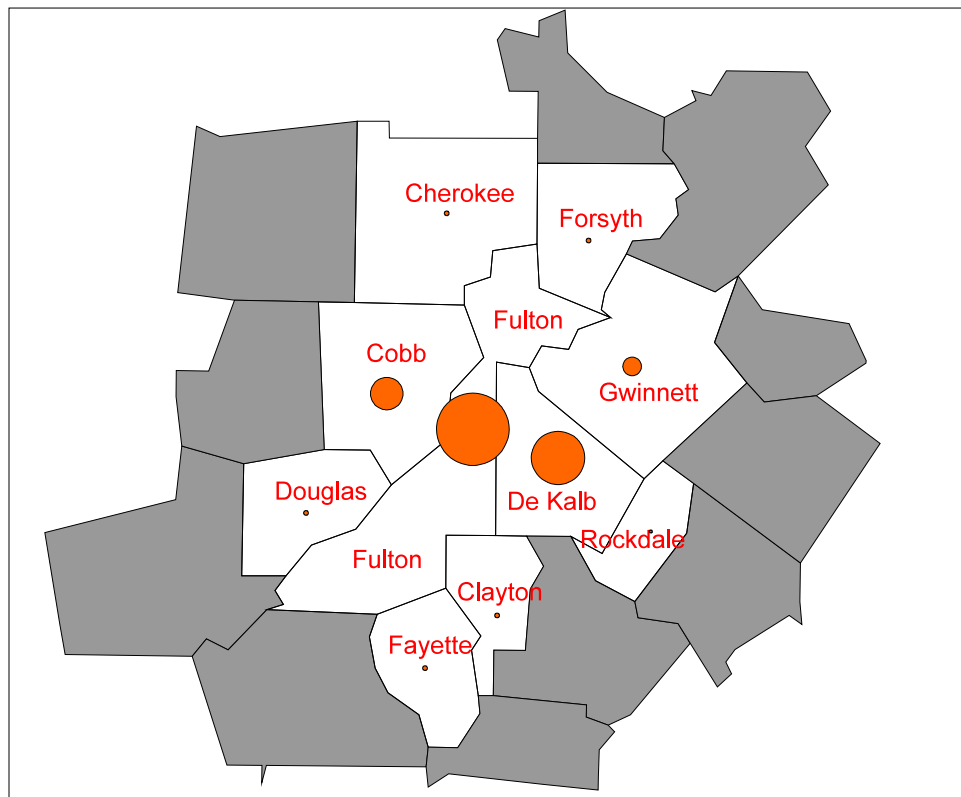


# Geographic Distribution of the Jewish Population of Greater Atlanta Recent Trends

## Section I

### Geographic Distribution of Jewish Households

A question that has arisen since the completion of the 1996 demographic study concerned whether a significant shift in the Jewish population of Greater Atlanta had occurred. The 1996 study estimated the Jewish population in only four counties: Fulton, De Kalb, Cobb, and Gwinnett. The feeling on the part of some in the Jewish community was that a significant number of households had now moved outside this four-county area. Table 1 shows that 95% of Jewish households continue to live in the four-county area. The map on the following page shows the relative number of households in each County.

## Section II Analysis of Changes in the Jewish Households in Selected Zip Codes

Table 2 shows changes in the number of households with one of 31 DJNs listed in the CD-ROM telephone directory for seven zip codes for 1994 and 2000. This area, shown in the map on the following page, shows a decline in the number of Jewish households by about 16%.

While the greatest percentage decline is in 30326, this zip code had a very small Jewish population in 1994. One should really not compare the “percentage change” in a zip code that starts with 22 households in 1994 with zip codes that start with more than 100 households in 1994.

In my judgement, changes of less than 10% should not be viewed as significant. They could easily be due to chance. The largest decreases are in 30309 and 30305.

According to Table 4 on page 12 on *The 1996 Jewish Population Study of Atlanta, Summary Report*, 30305 (Buckhead) showed a decrease of 149 households from 1984 to 1996. 30306 (Midtown) had shown an increase of 549 households during this period. 30309 (Peachtree Place) showed an increase of 247 households. 30324 (Morningside) showed an increase of 471 households, and 30327 (Mt. Paran, Howell Mill) showed an increase of 543 households. Thus, to some extent, Table 2 implies a change in this area from growth to decline.

## **Section III**

### **Distribution of Jewish Households in 1996**

The map on the following page shows the distribution of Jewish households in 1996 and may be viewed as simply a superior production of the map on page 13 of *The 1996 Jewish Population Study of Atlanta, Summary Report*.
