

Codebook: United Jewish Communities Survey

A note on negative values and "NAP": Throughout this data set, negative punch codes have been used to indicate missing cases and not-applicable cases. Where appropriate, these codes have been documented in the **Punch** column of the variable description (e.g., for **AgeSp**, -3 = NAP, R not married). However, many variables have a "NAP" section at the bottom of the variable description. The text in this NAP section represents screens/skips as specified in the questionnaires. Thus cases *meeting* the specifications in the NAP sections will be represented as a -1 in the data set. Unless otherwise noted, all cases from communities which did not administer that item will also be coded -1. Also, missing cases not attributable to screens/skips have also been coded as -1.
