Survey Methodology

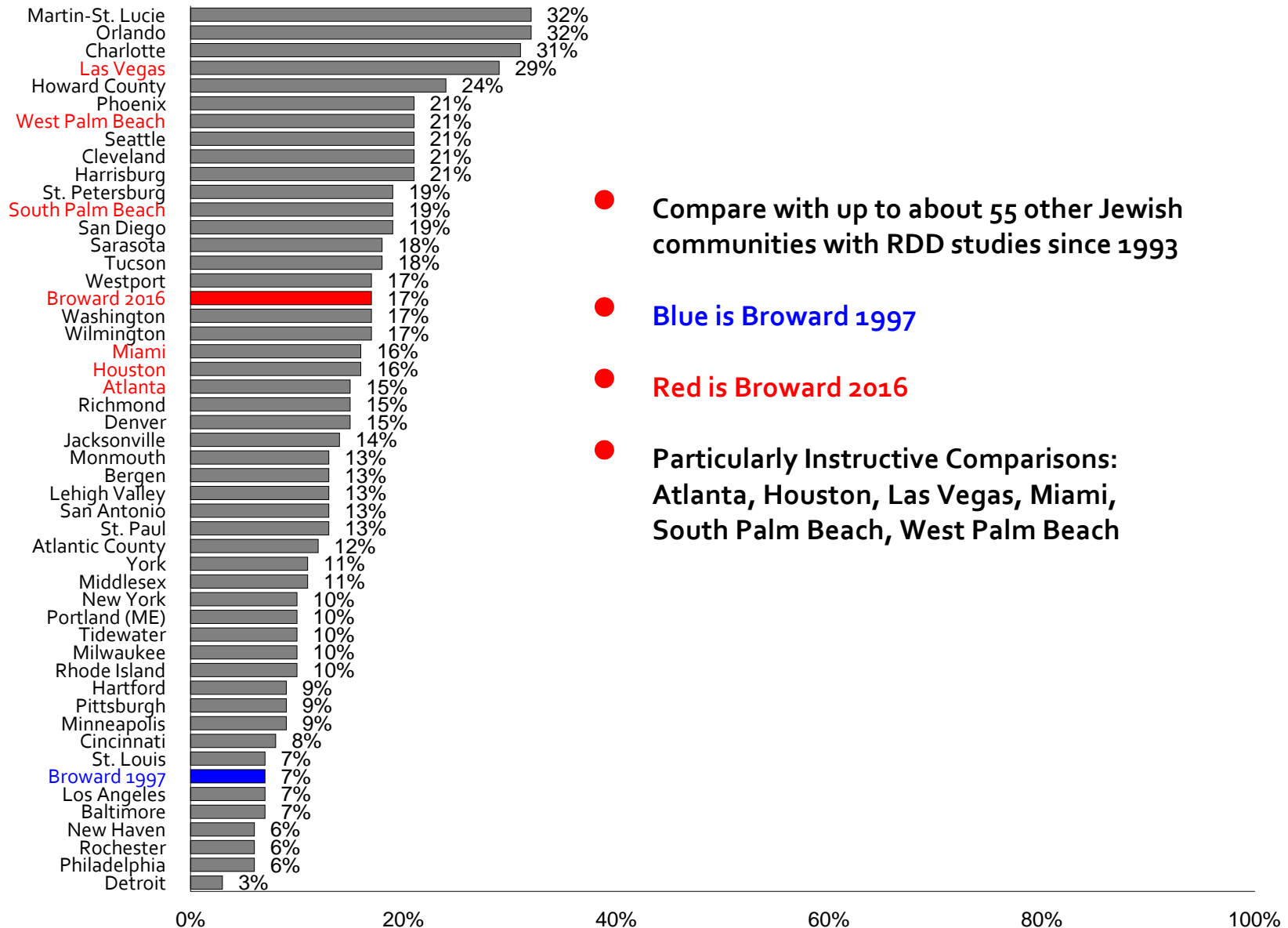
- Random Digit Dialing (RDD) Telephone Survey methodology provides scientific validity
 - Population estimate
 - Produces the “purest” random sample
- (954) 435 - _____
- RDD Telephone Survey(300 surveys)
- List Telephone Survey (900 surveys)
- Cell Phone Households with non-local area codes with DJNs based on billing zip codes
- 1,200interviews
- Response Rate (AAPOR RR₃) is 39%and cooperation rate is 83%
- Weighting factors are used to combine the samples
- Interviews averaged about 22 minutes each
- Phones were dialed 121,477 times
- Interviewing April to June 2016

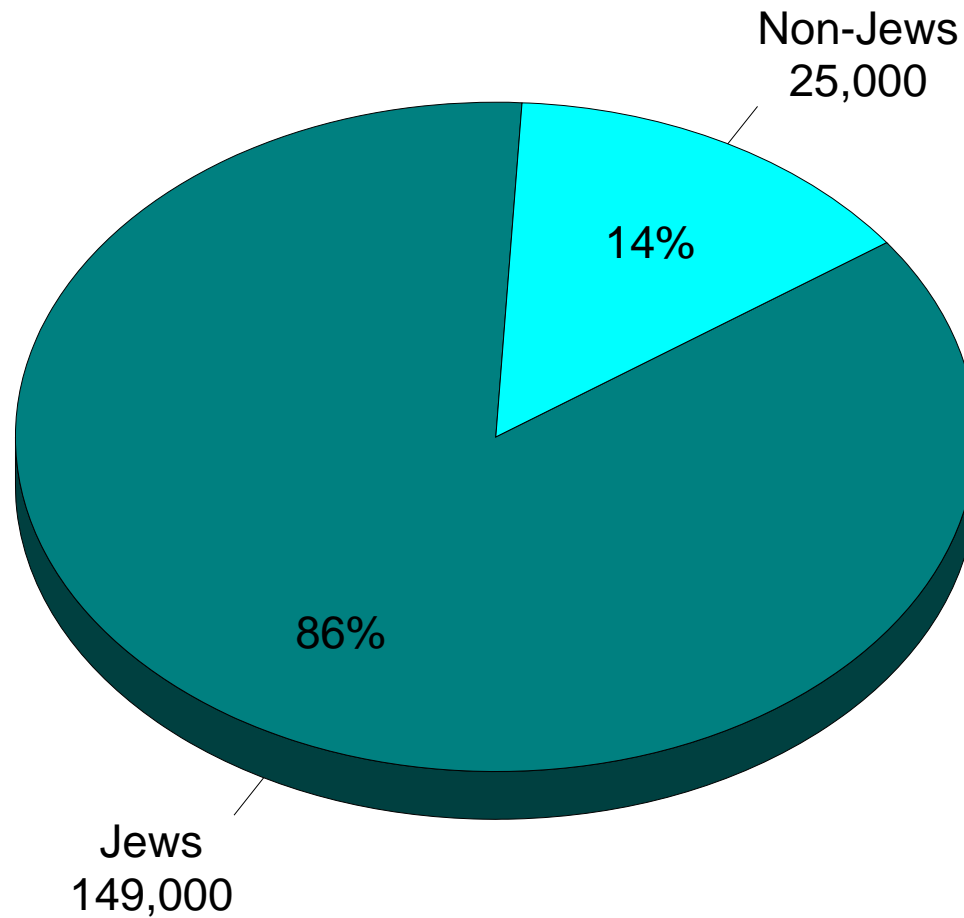
Comparison Bar Chart

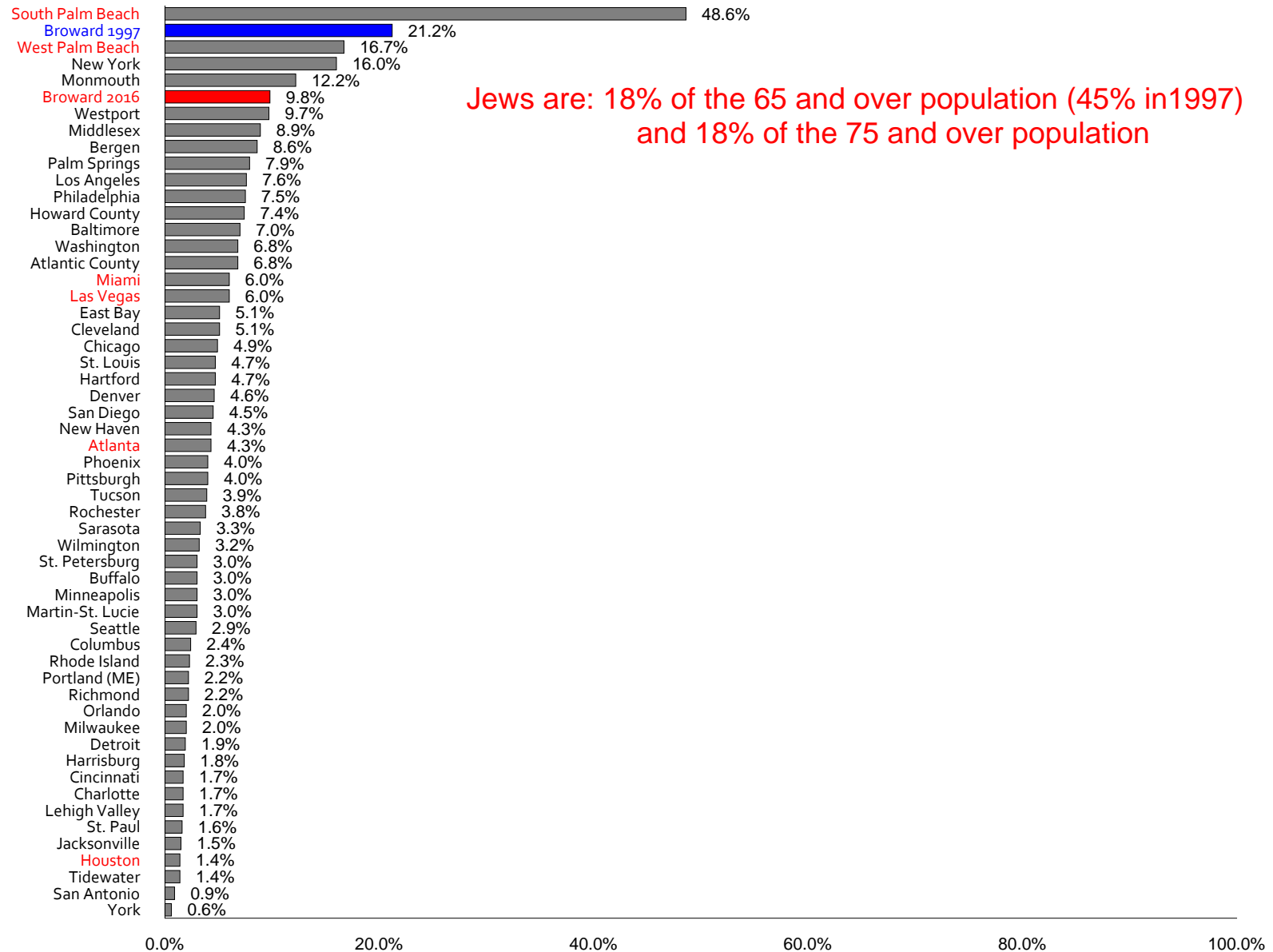

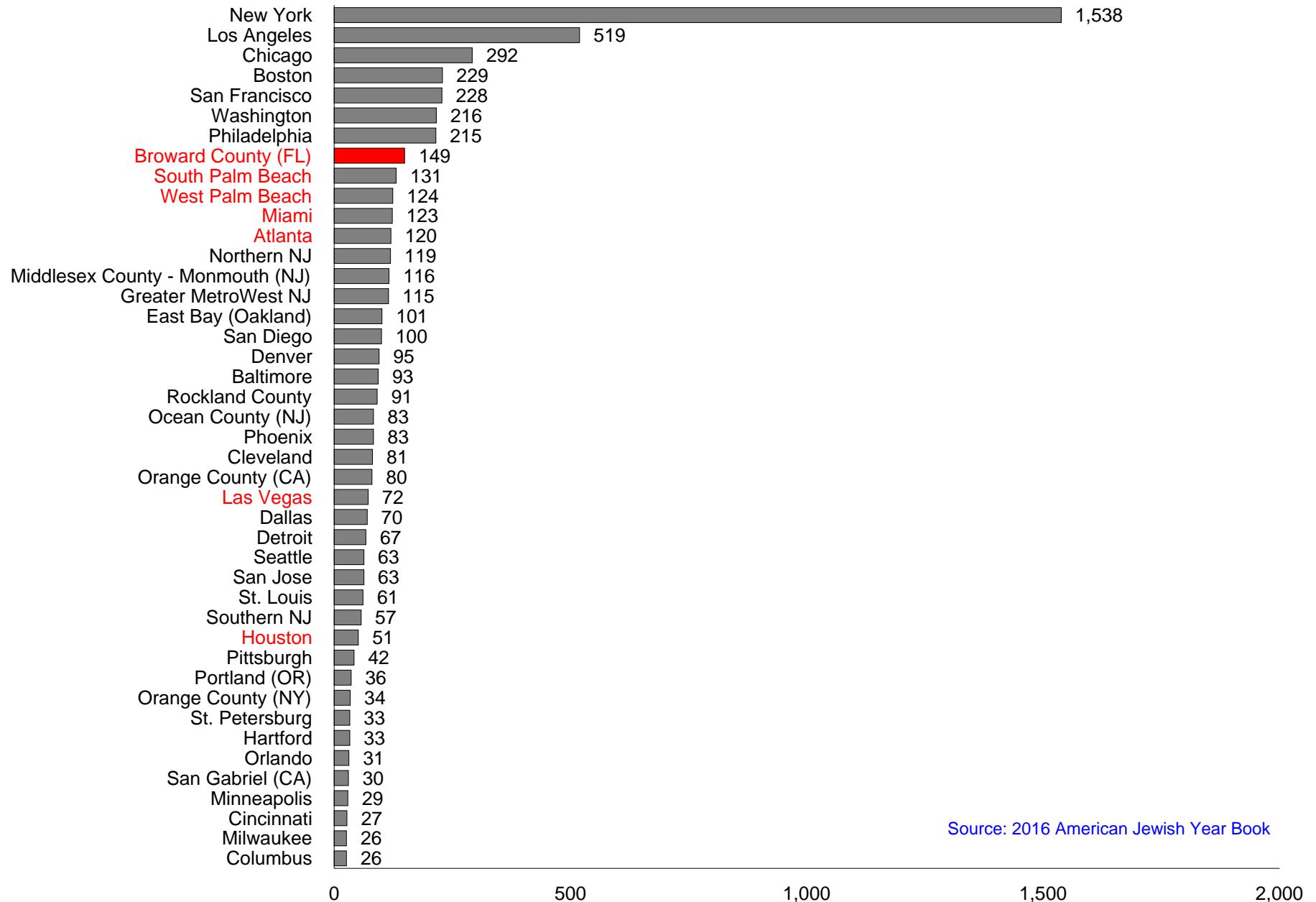
Percentage of Households in the Community Who Are Jewish Households

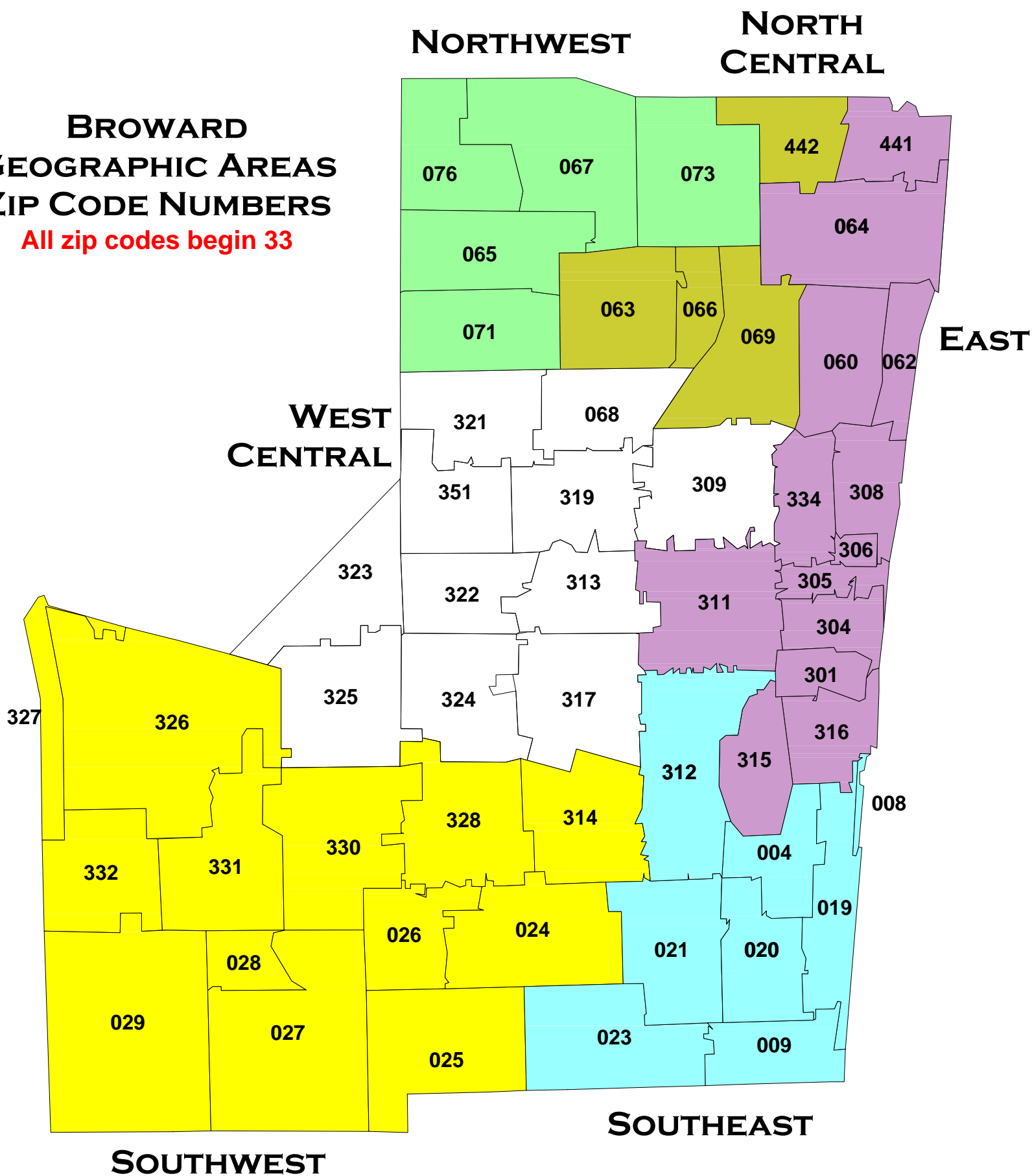

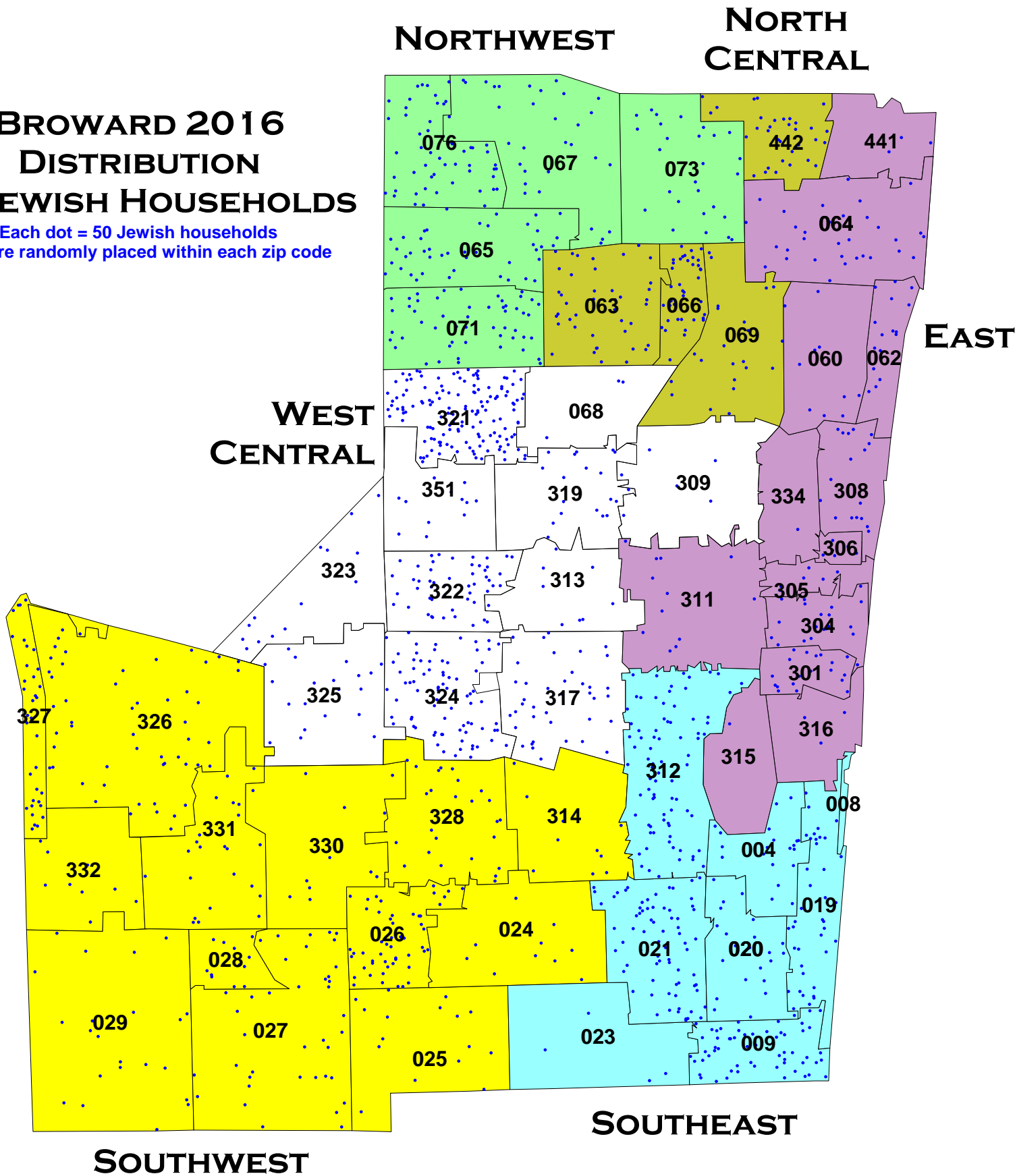

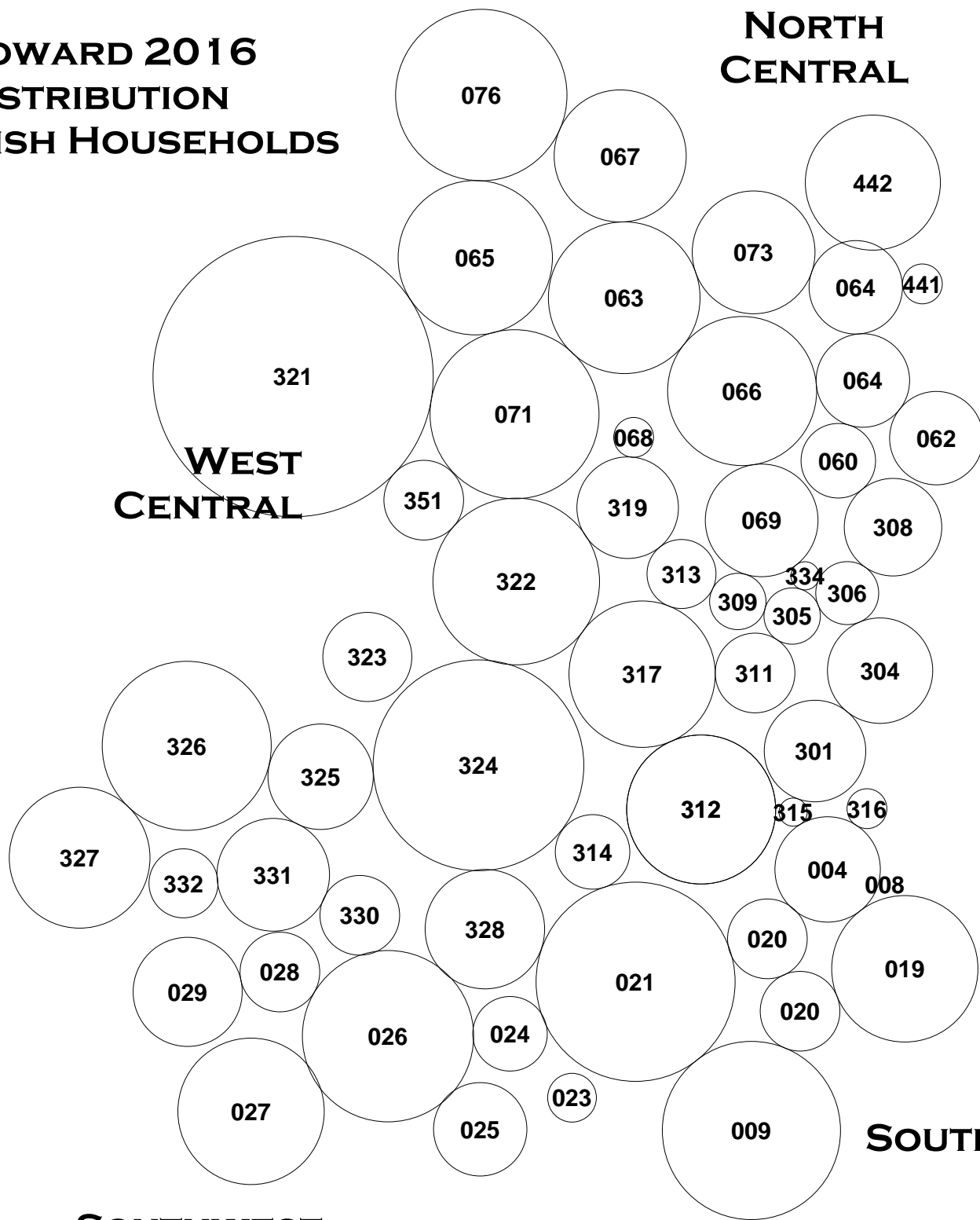


BROWARD 2016 DISTRIBUTION OF JEWISH HOUSEHOLDS

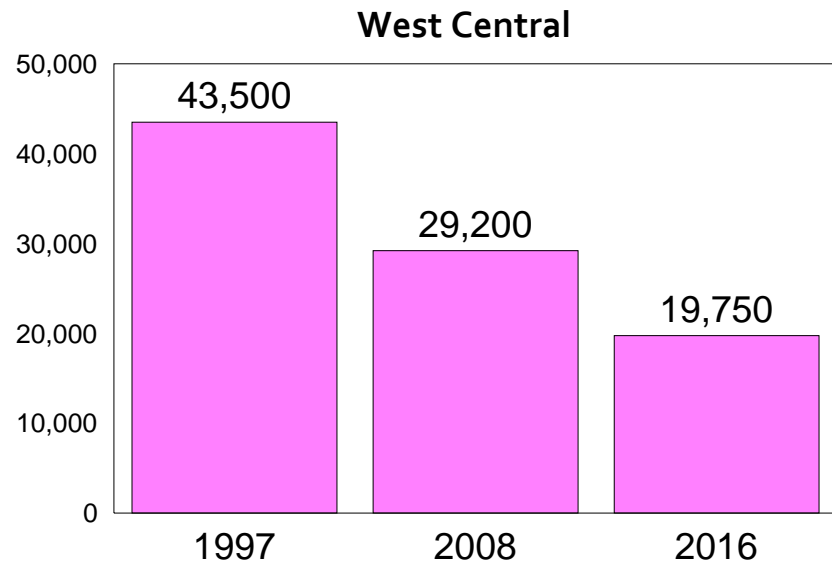
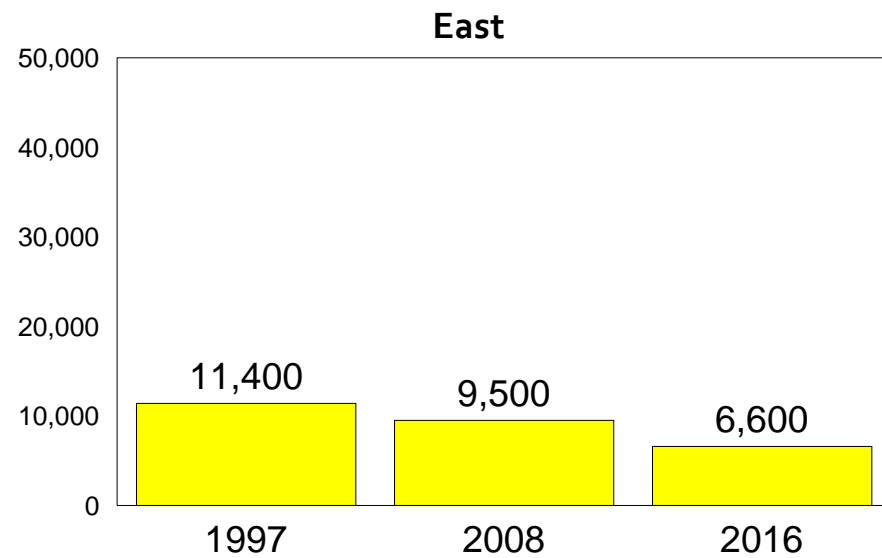
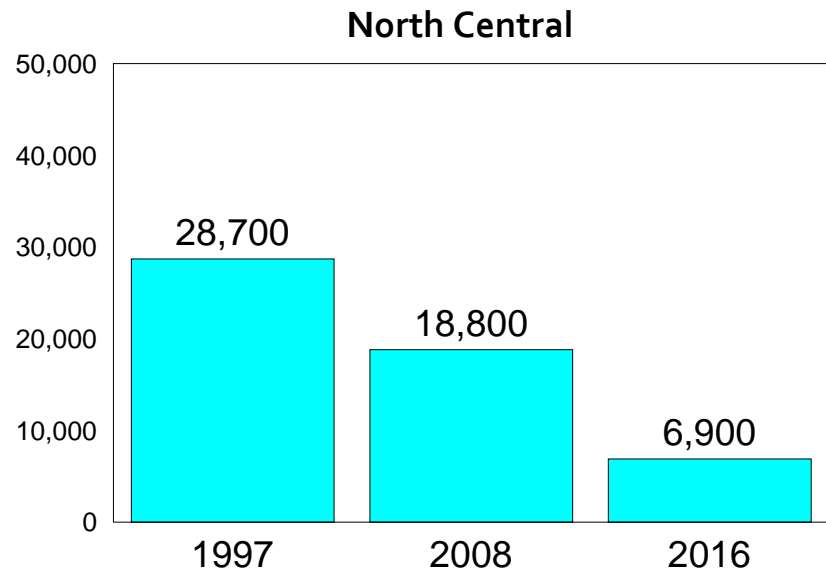
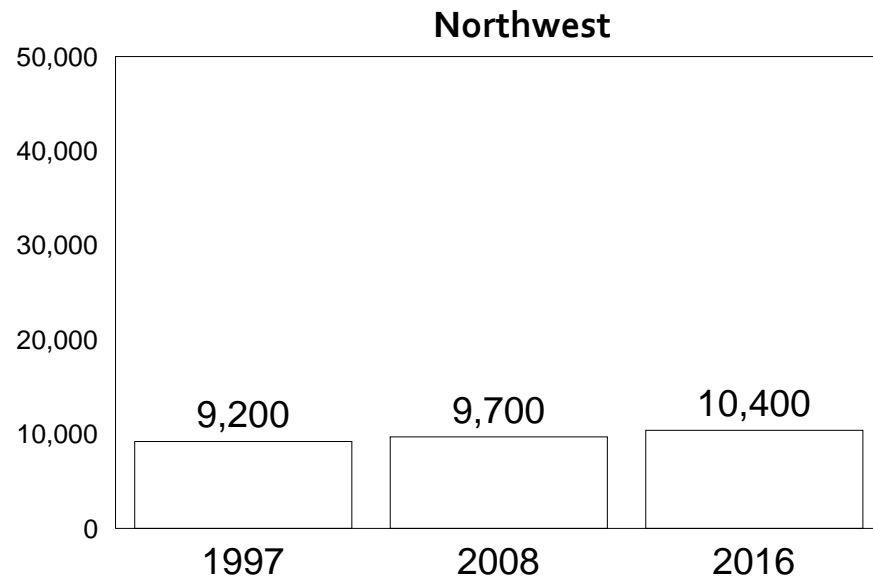

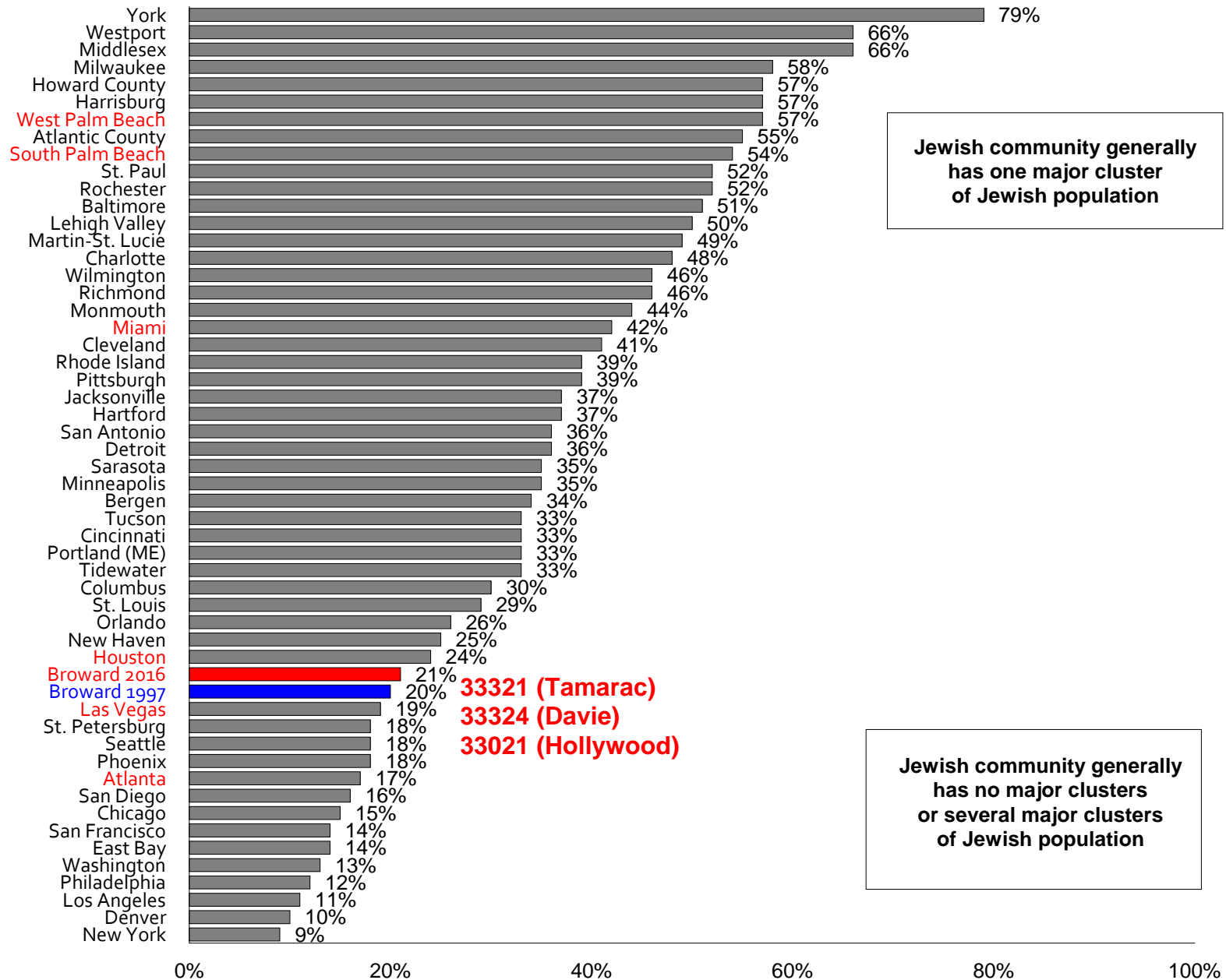


Distribution of Jewish Households

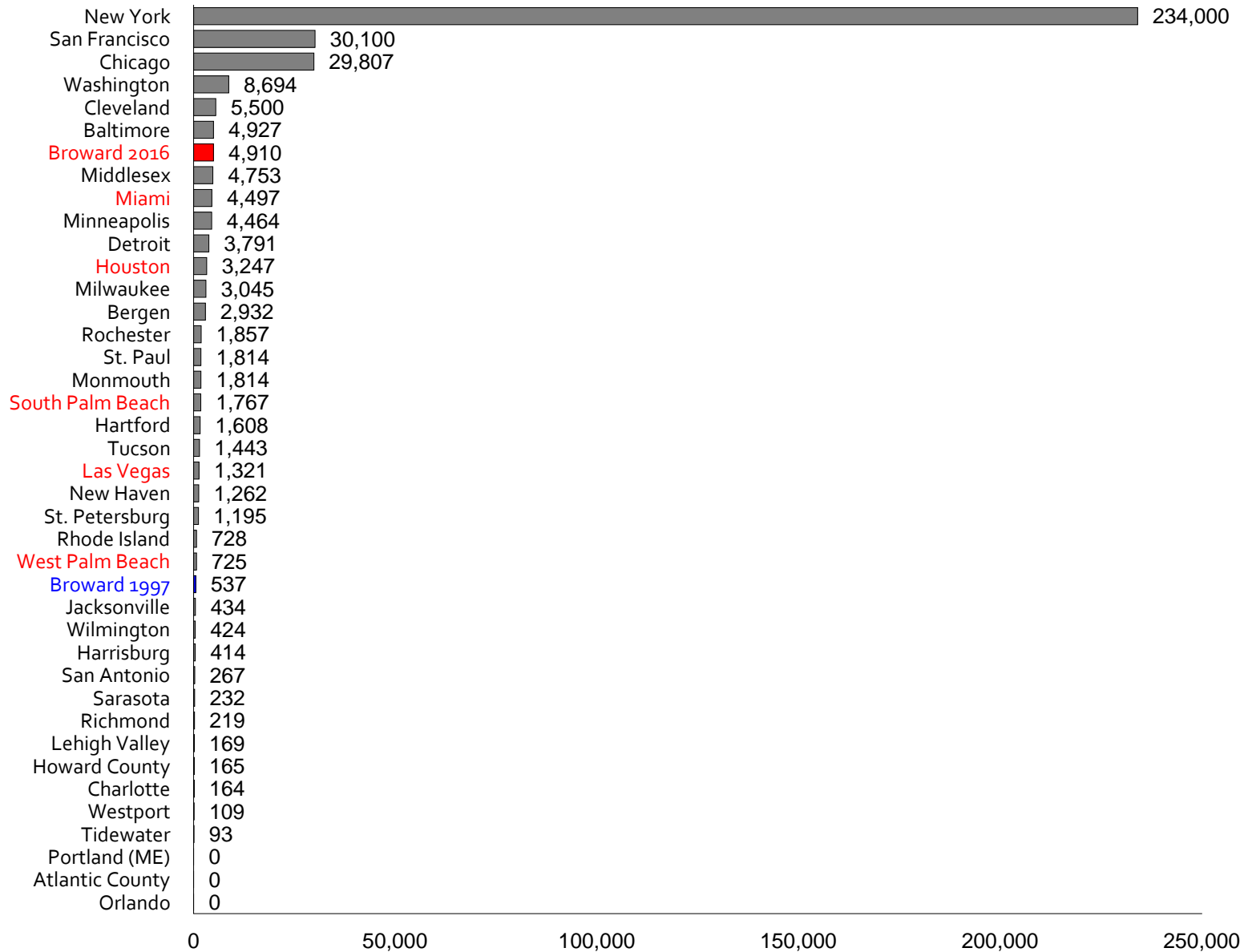

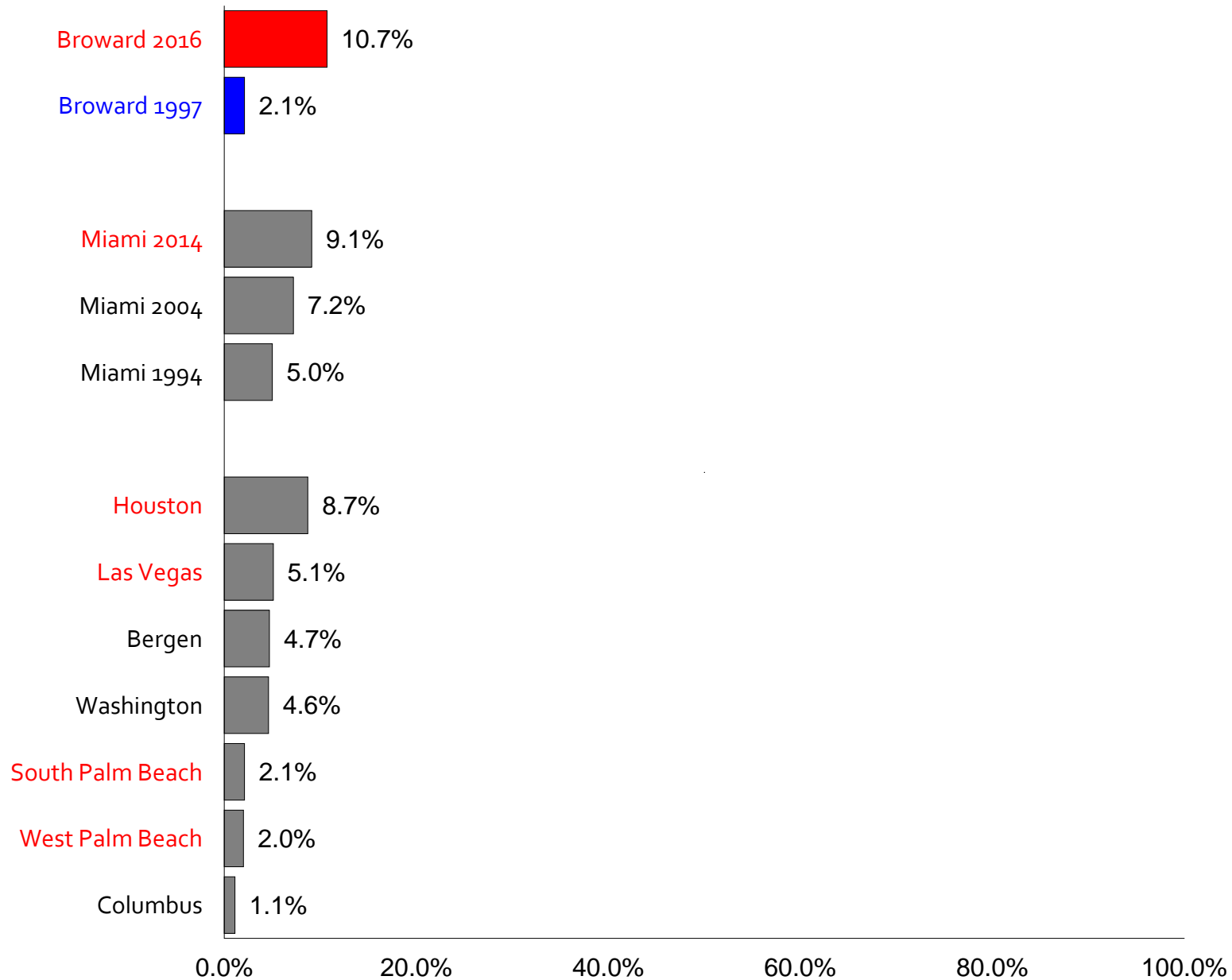

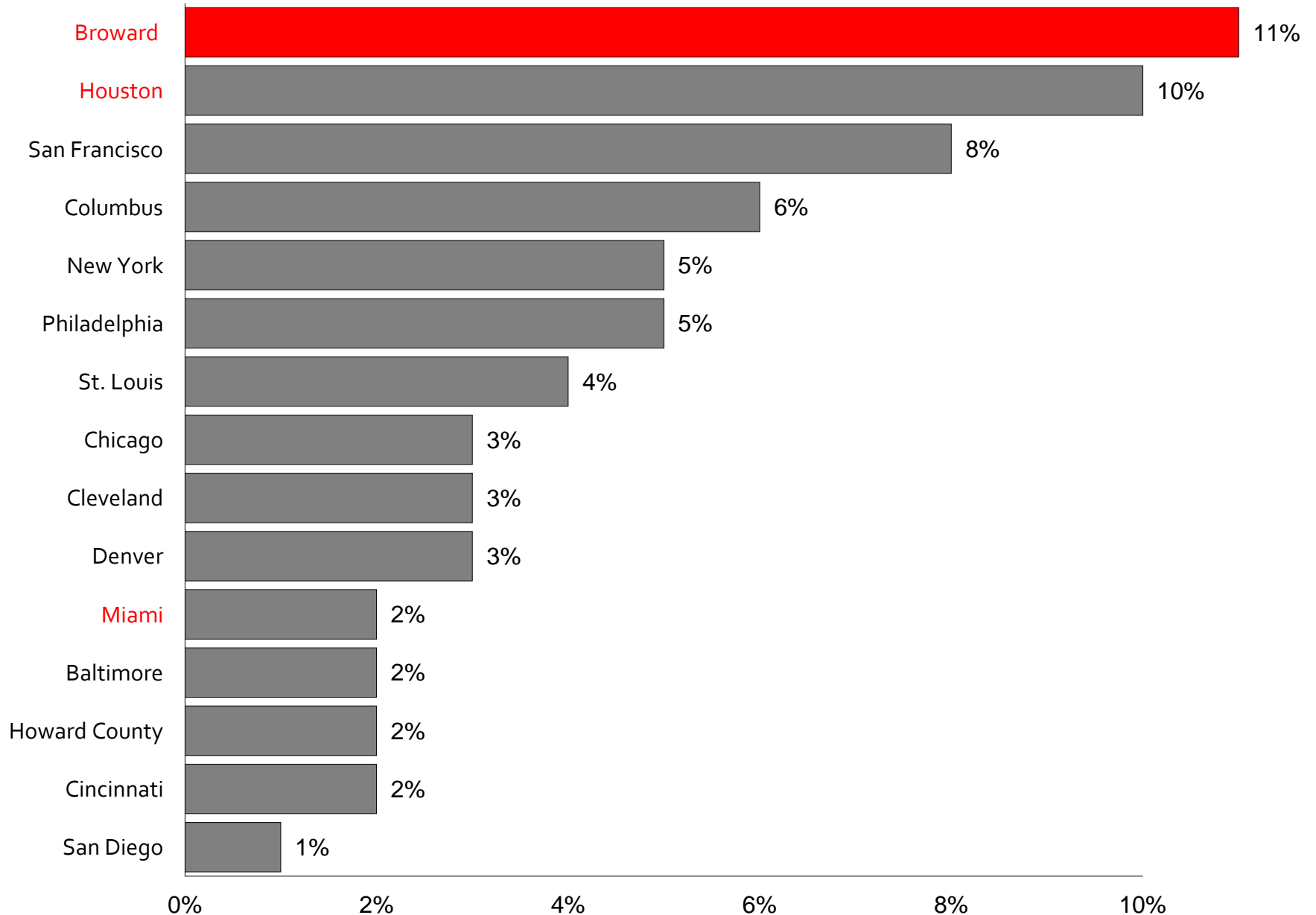

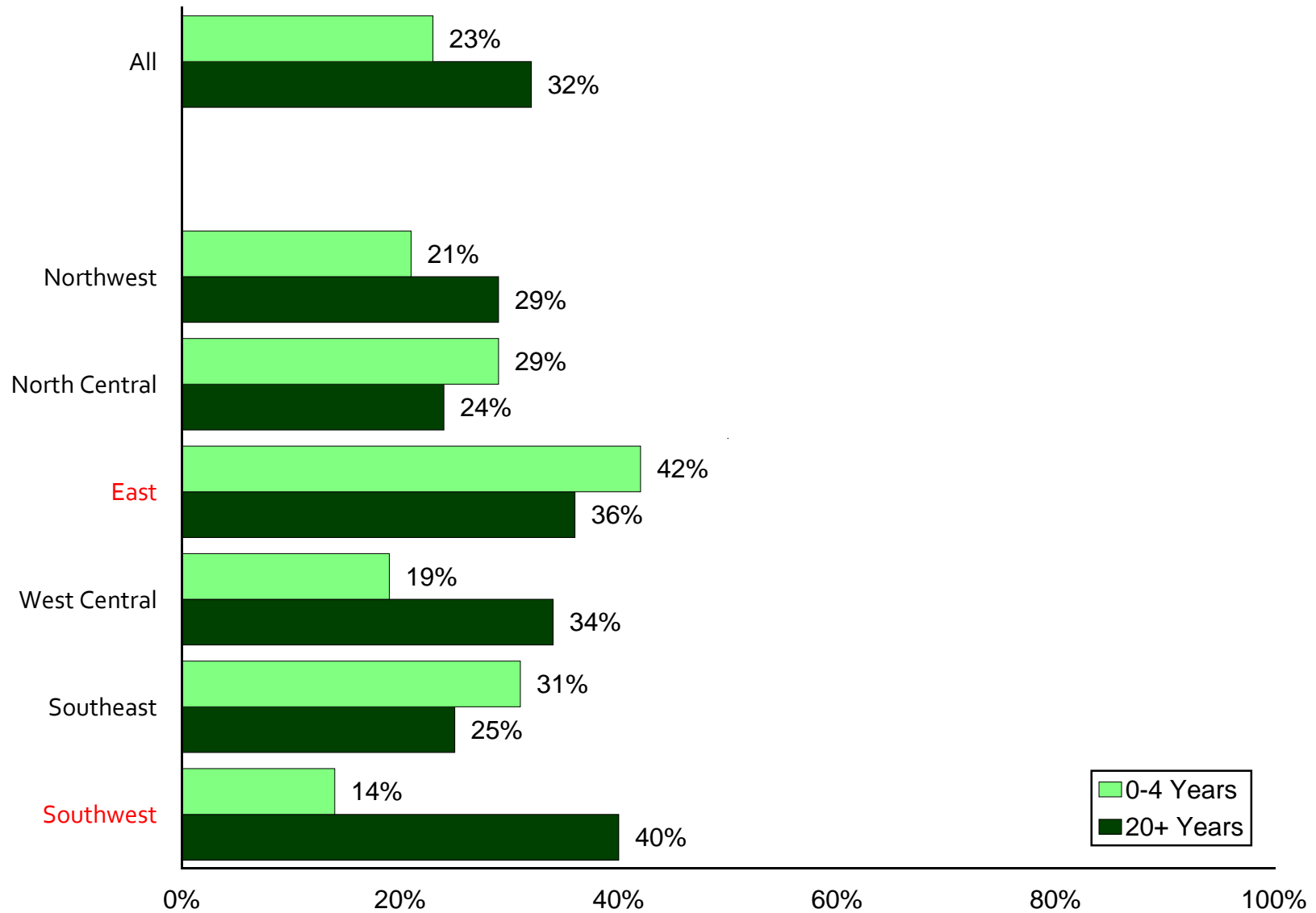


Someone in Household Considers Themselves to Be LGBT (Jewish Households)



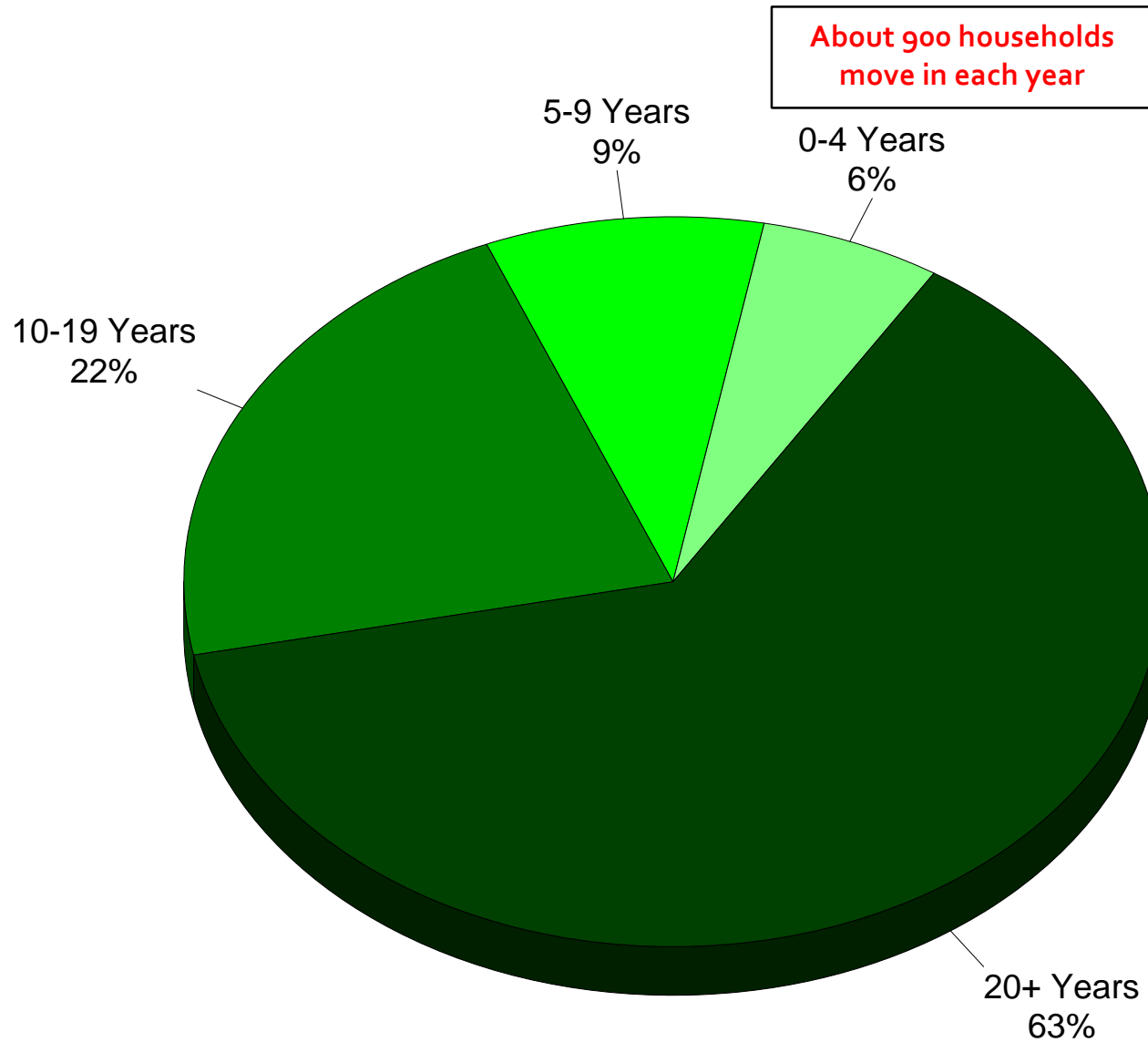
Years at Current Address by Geographic Area

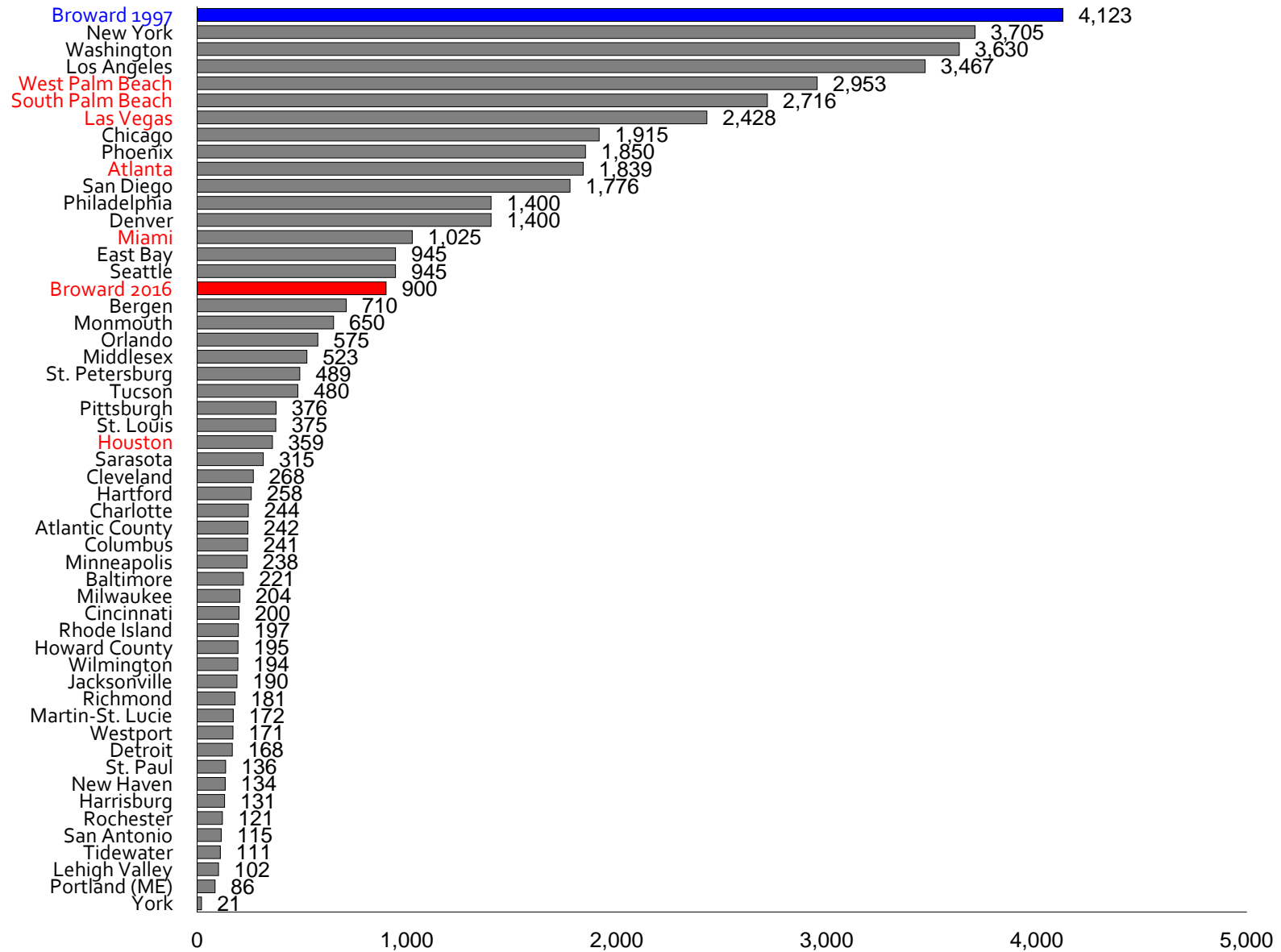


Length of Residence in Broward

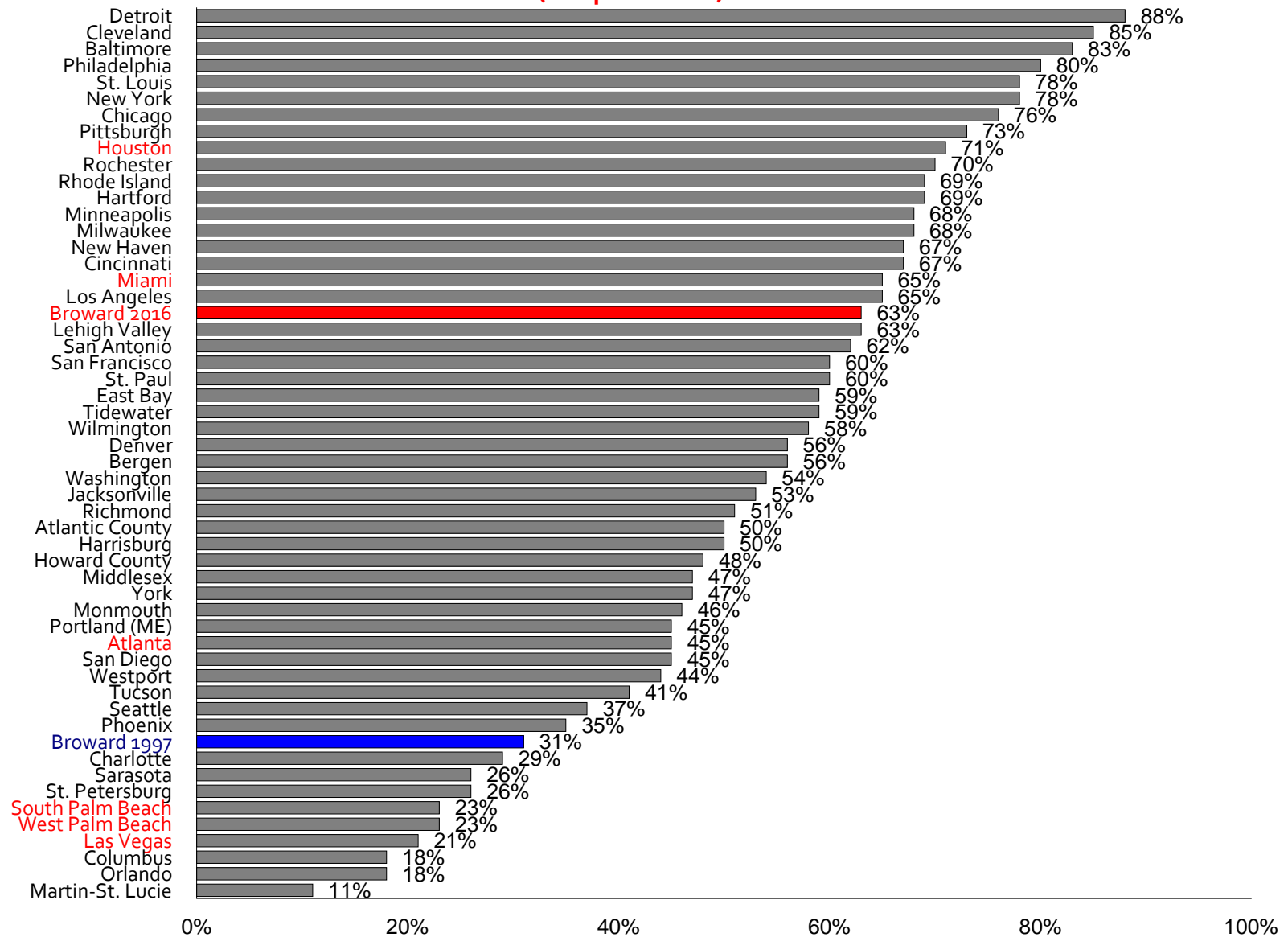


Average Number of New Households Per Year During the Past Five Years (Jewish Households)



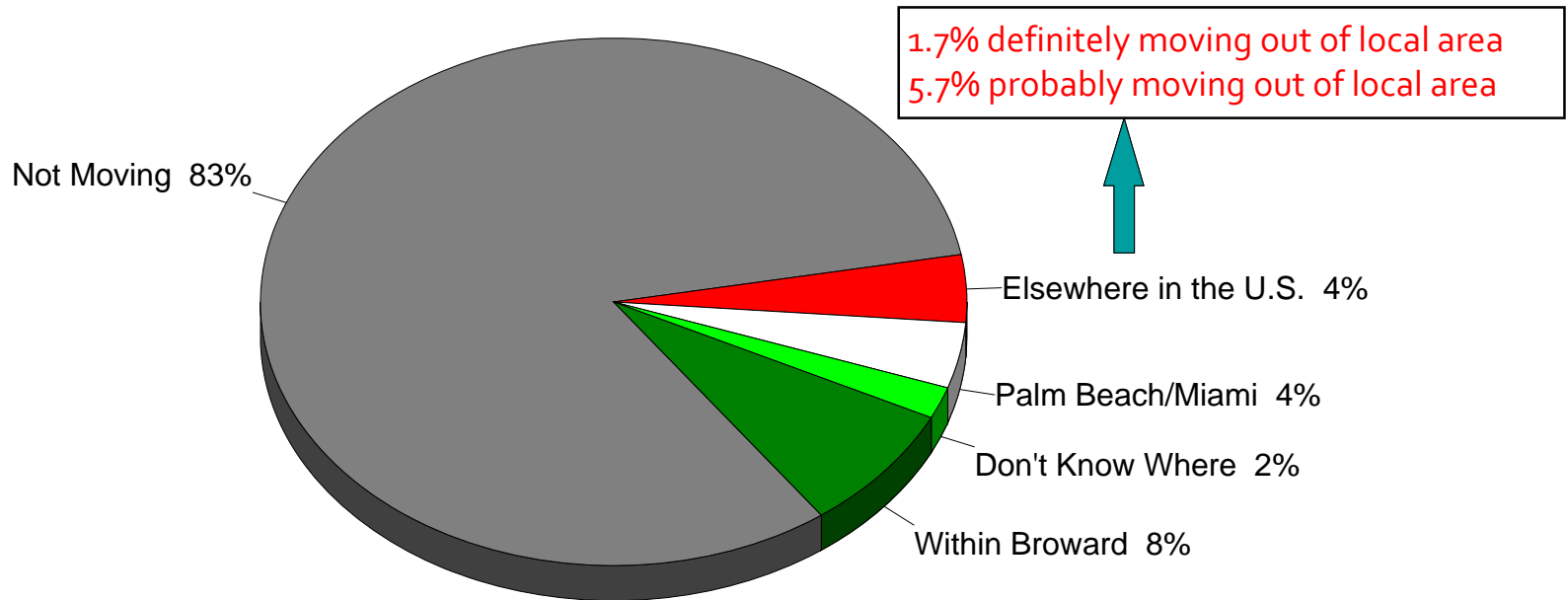

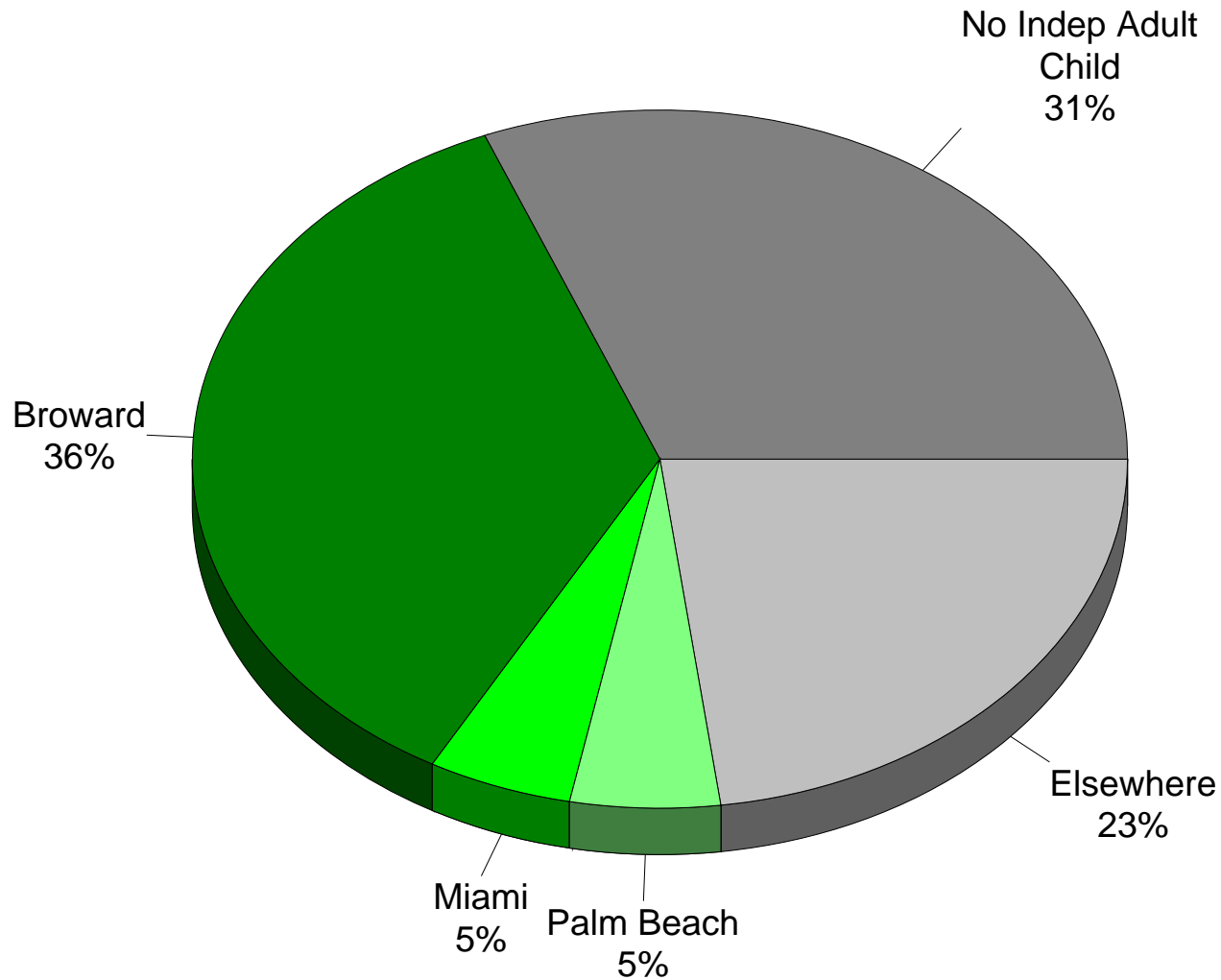


Migration of Full-Year Households

- Average Annual In-Migration
 - 900 full-year households moved in each year during the past five years
- Projected Average Annual Out-Migration
 - 400 full-year households definitely moving out of Broward each year during the next three years
 - 1,300 full-year households probably moving out of Broward each year during the next three years
- Projected Change
 - the Jewish population should continue to decrease in the next few years as a result of migration

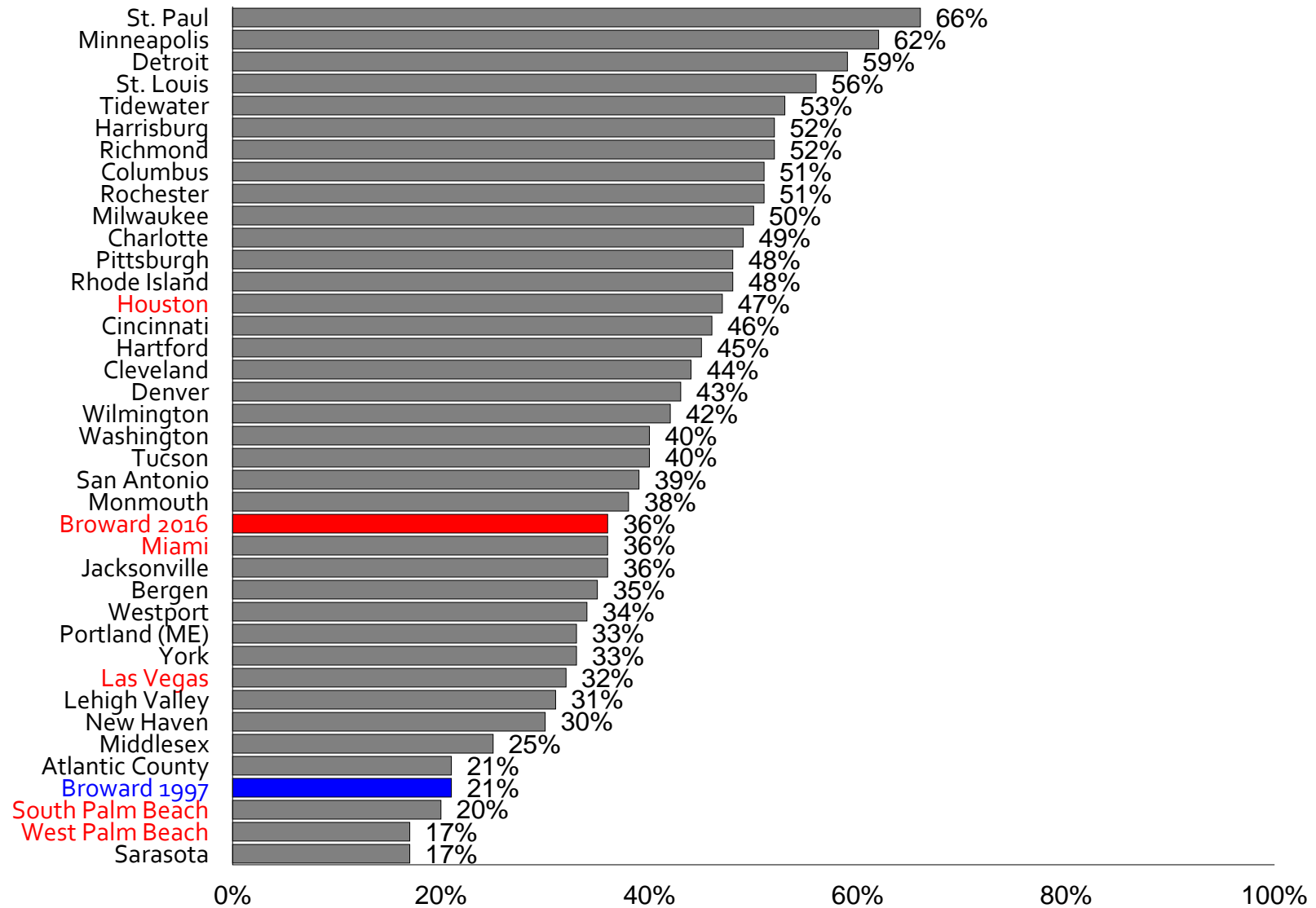
Location of Adult Children Who Have Established Their Own Homes

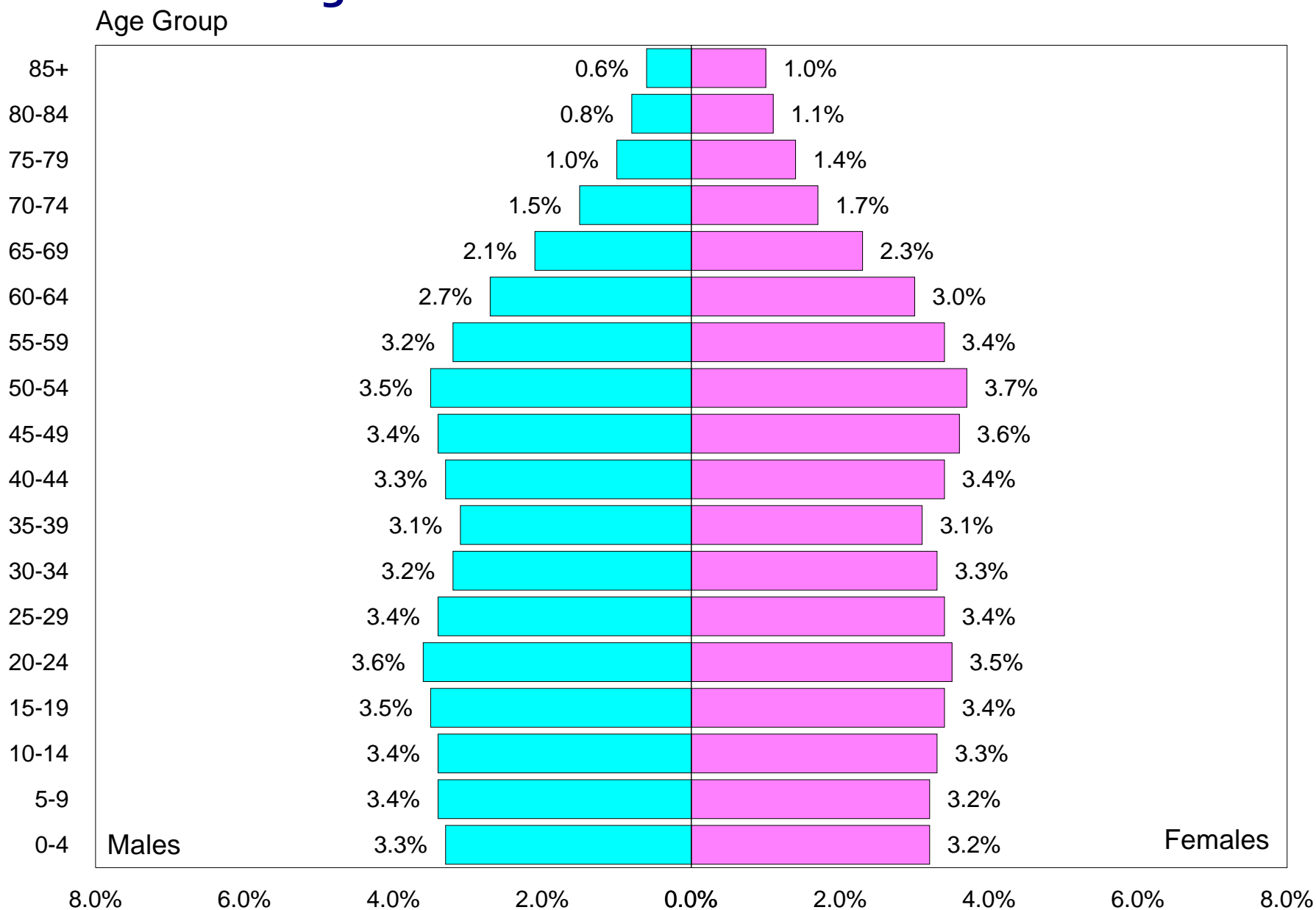

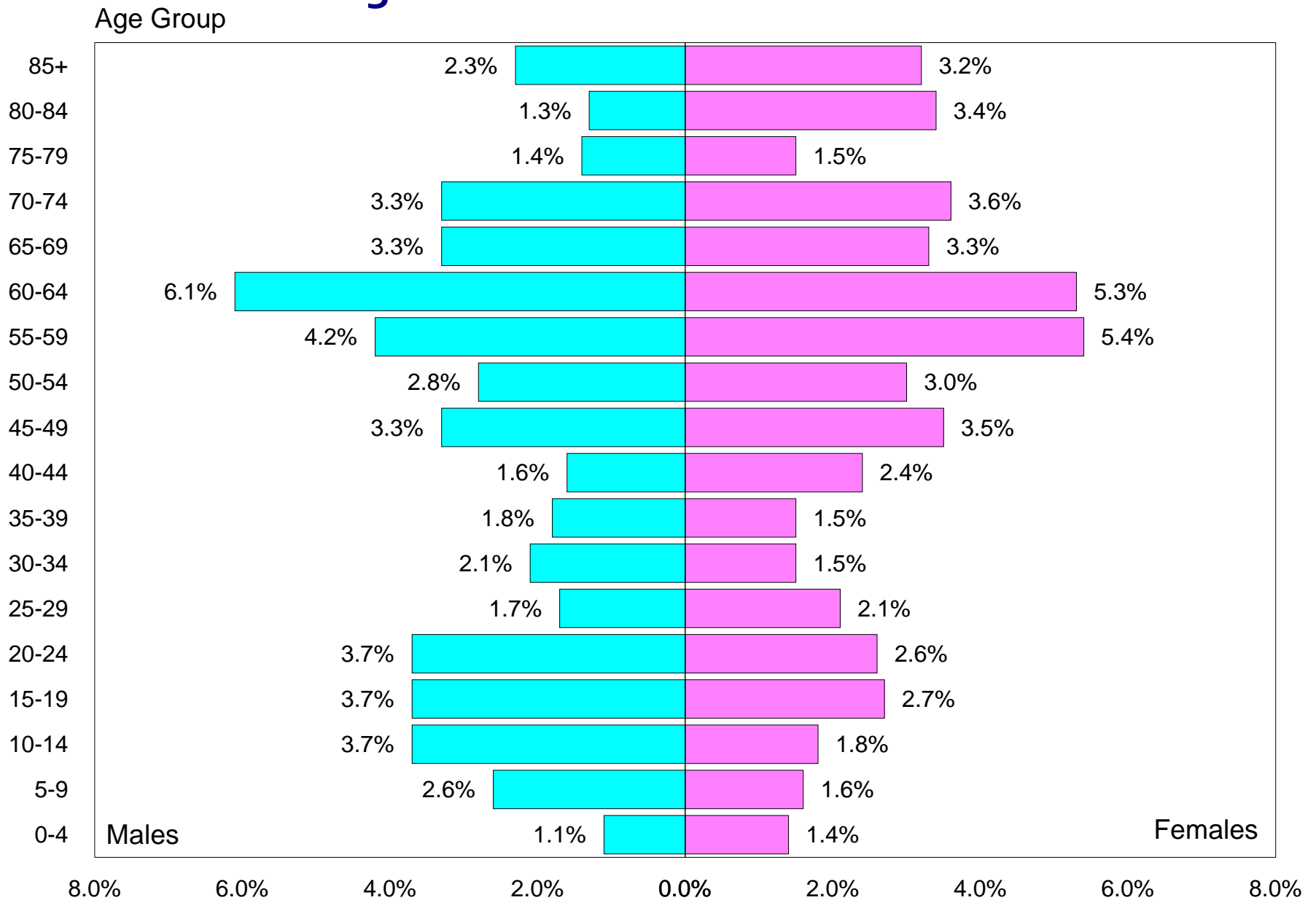

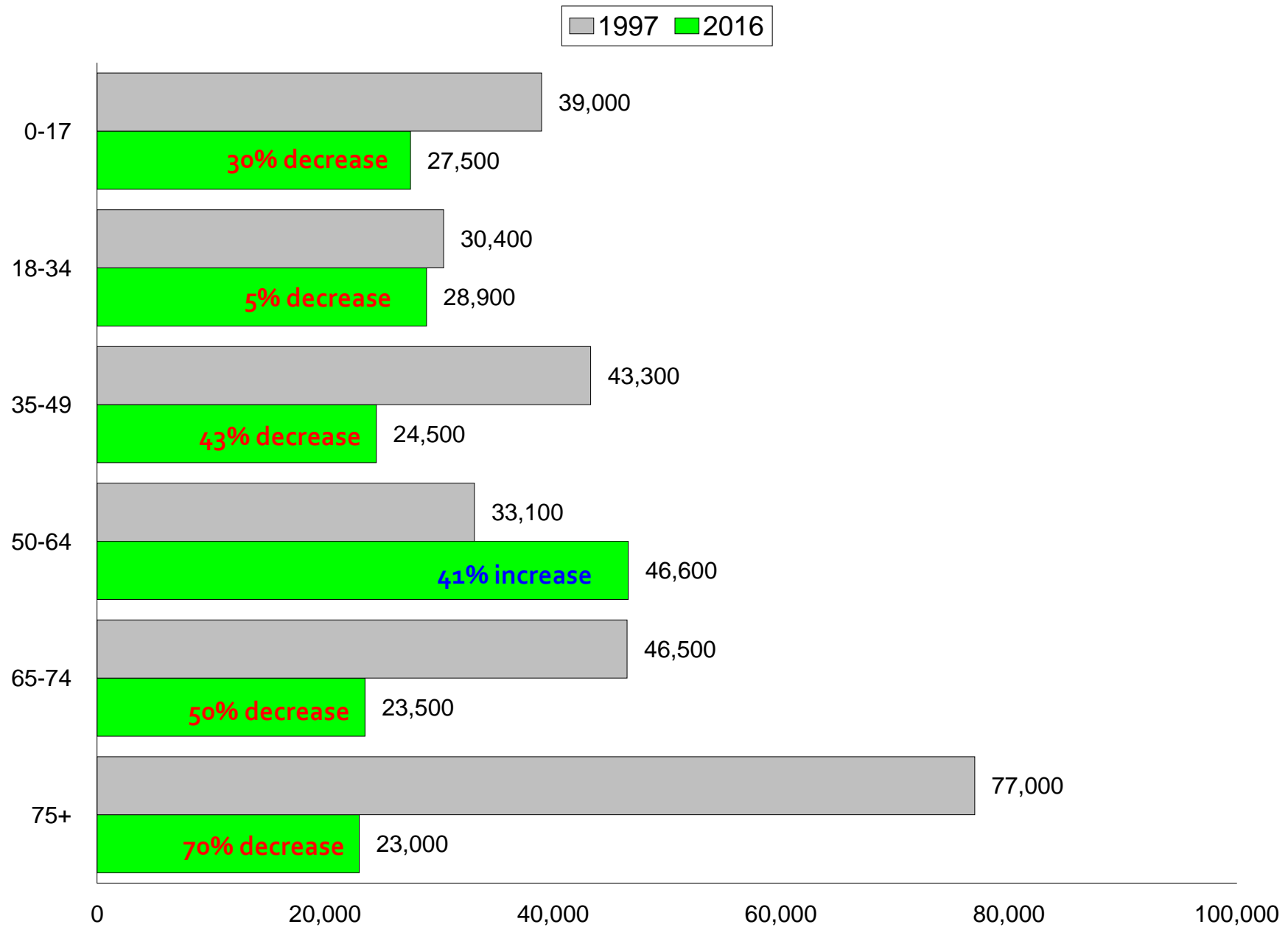
Age Distribution-Broward - 2016

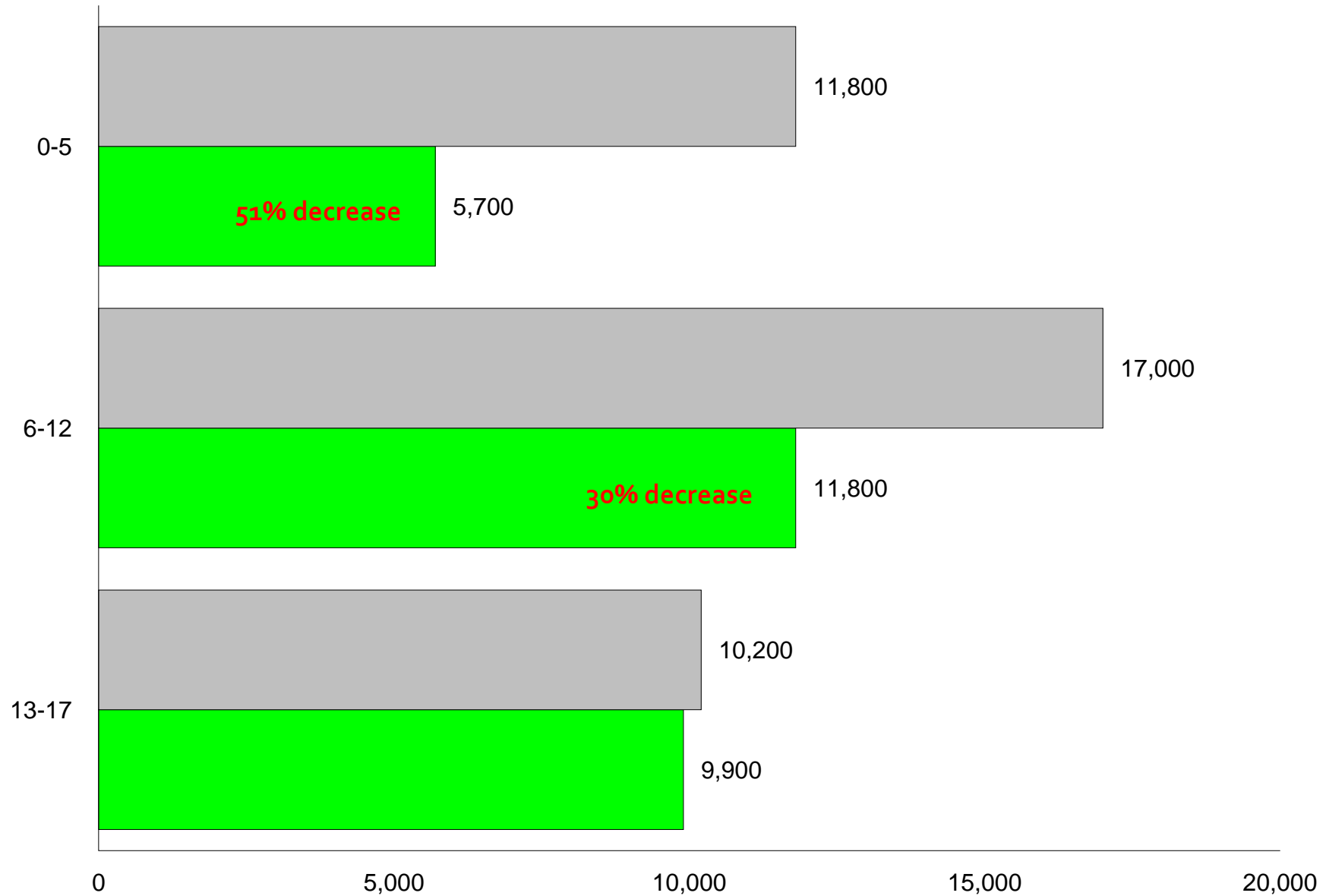

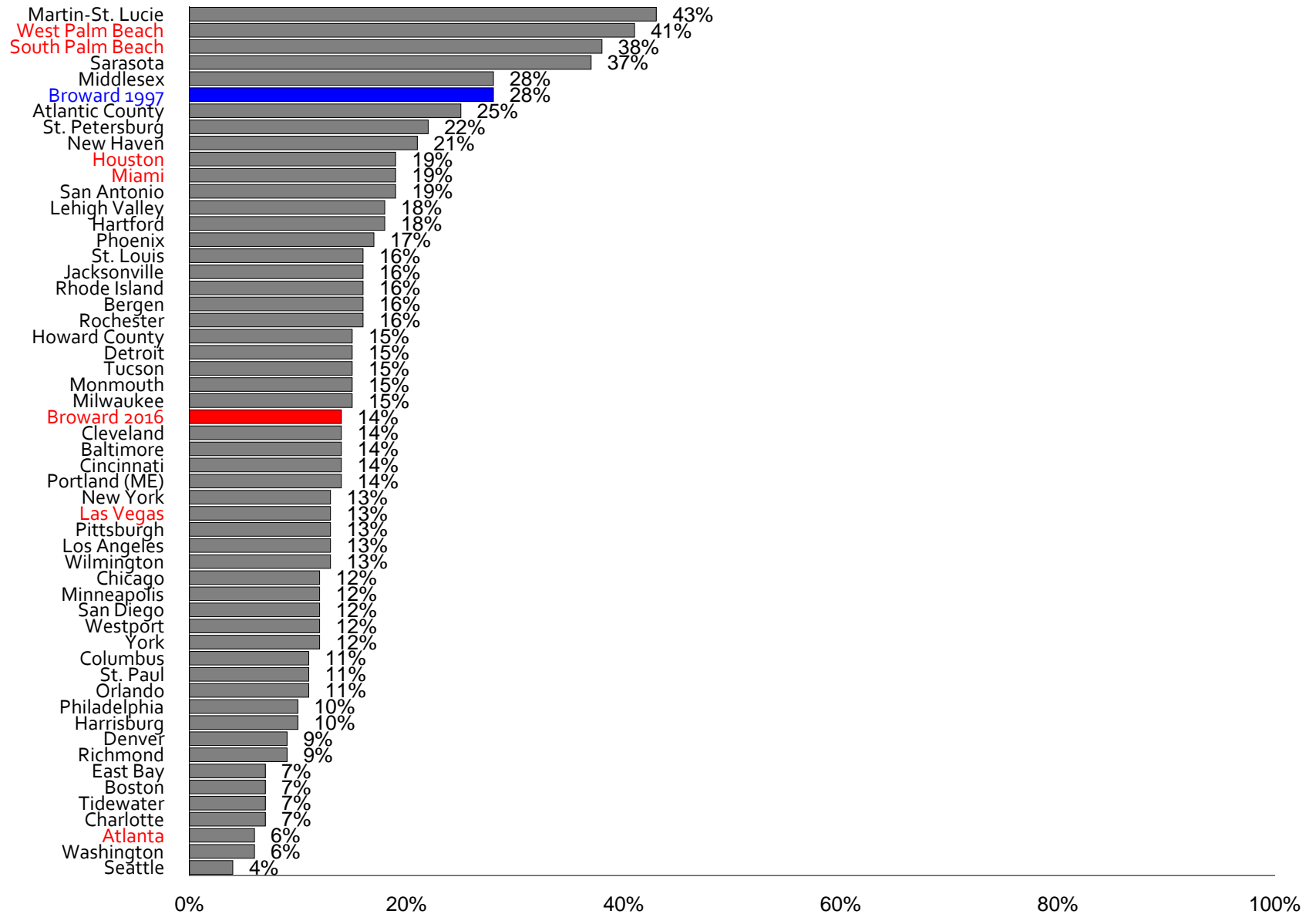


Married Households with No Children at Home (Jewish Households)



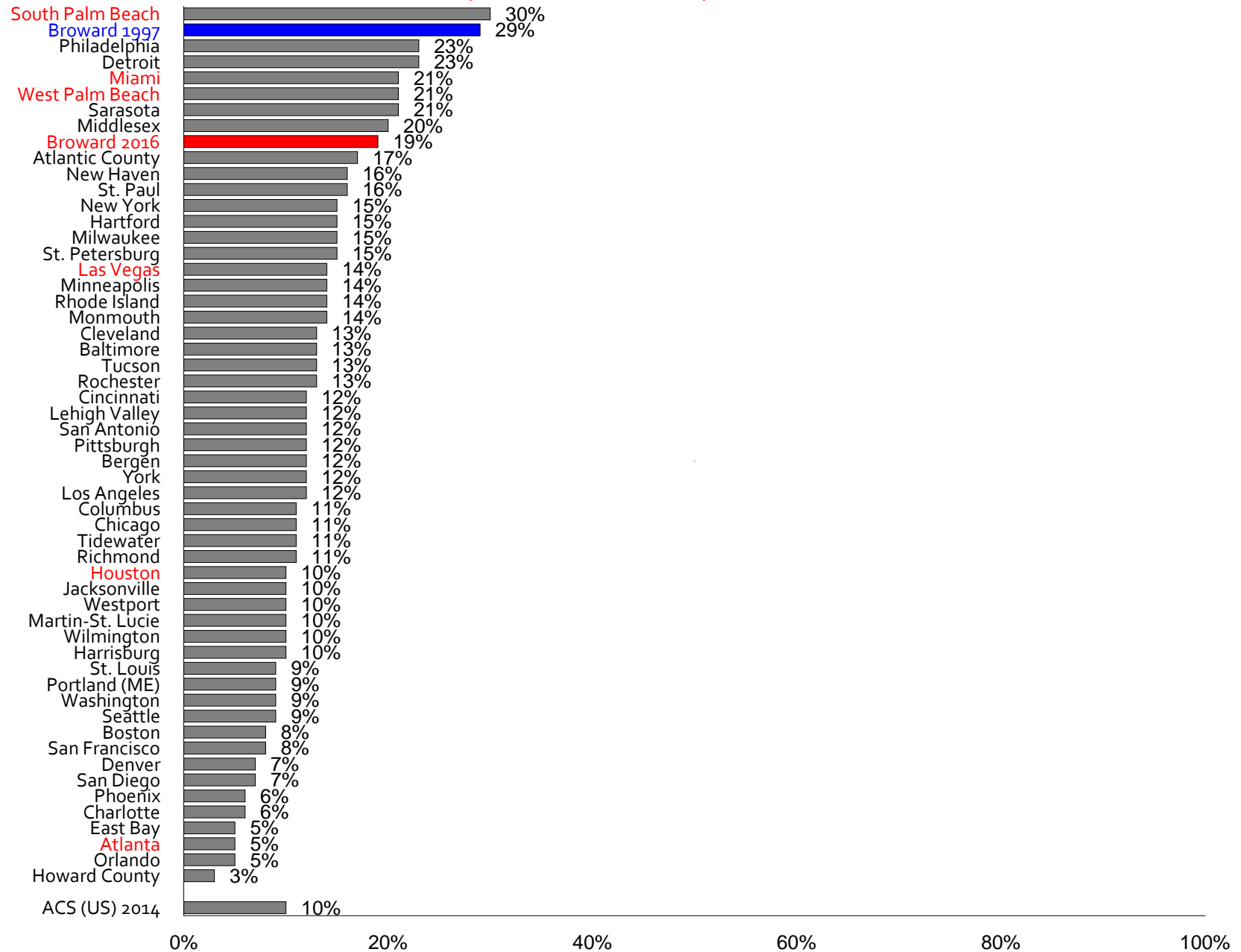

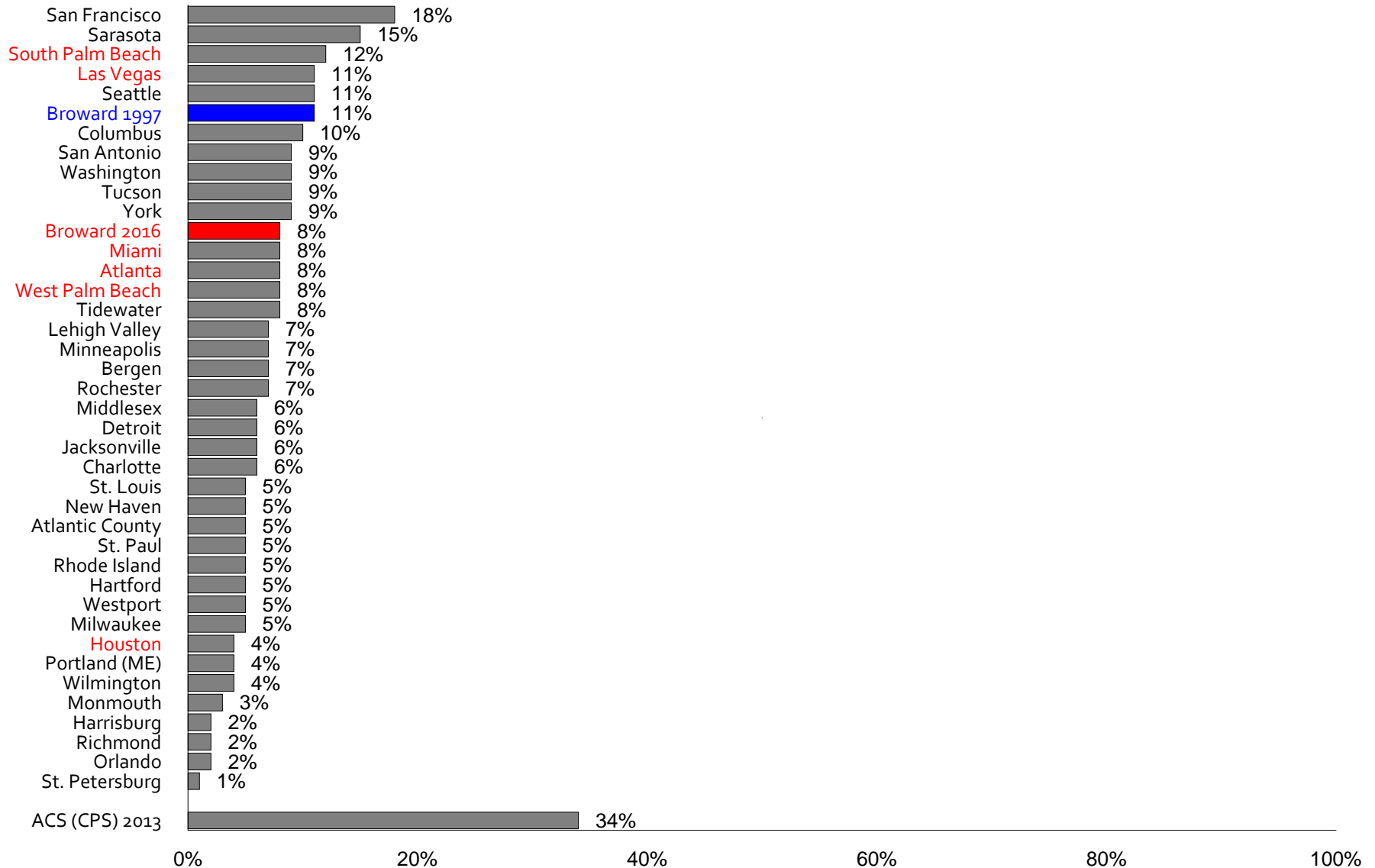

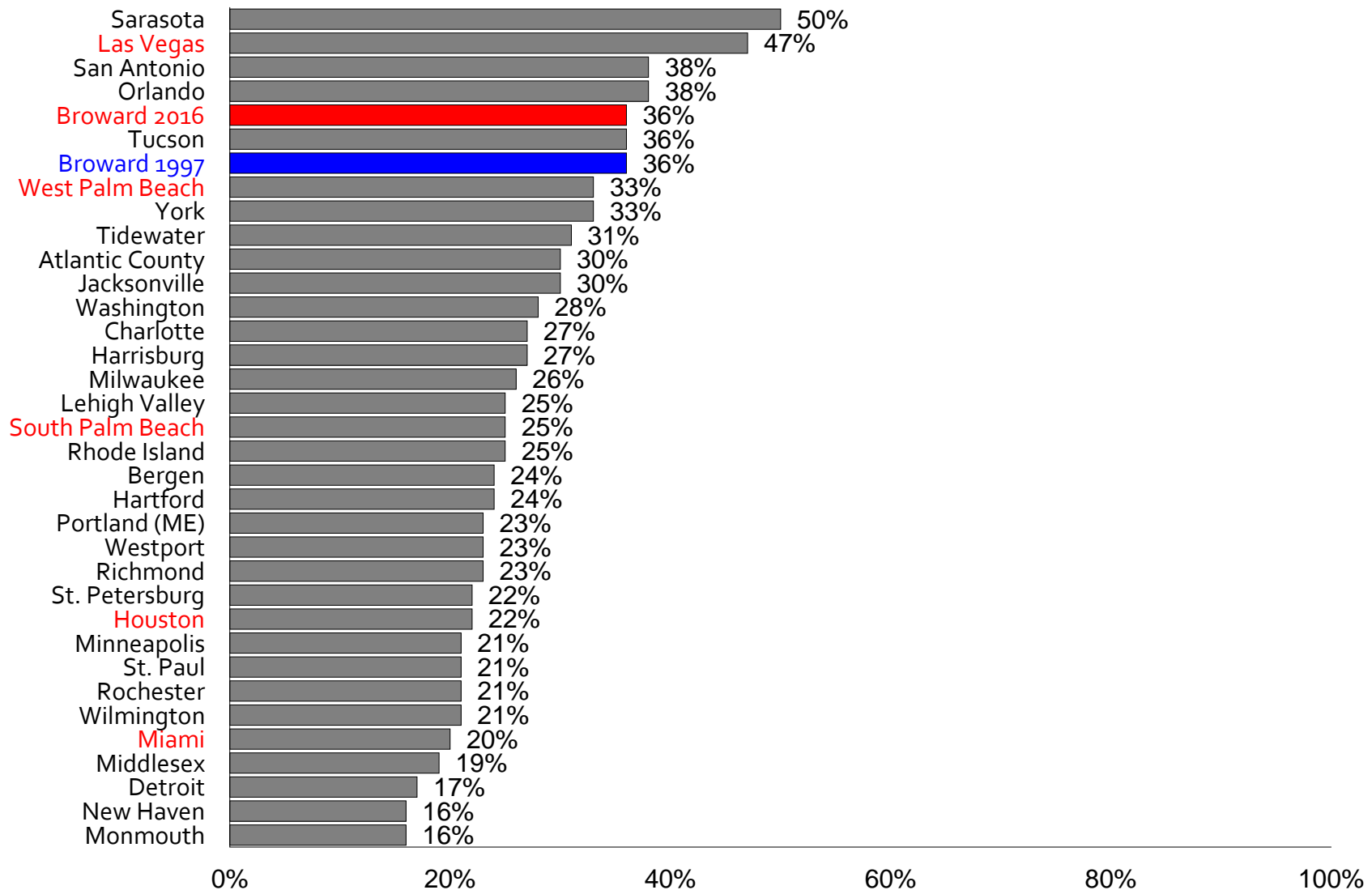

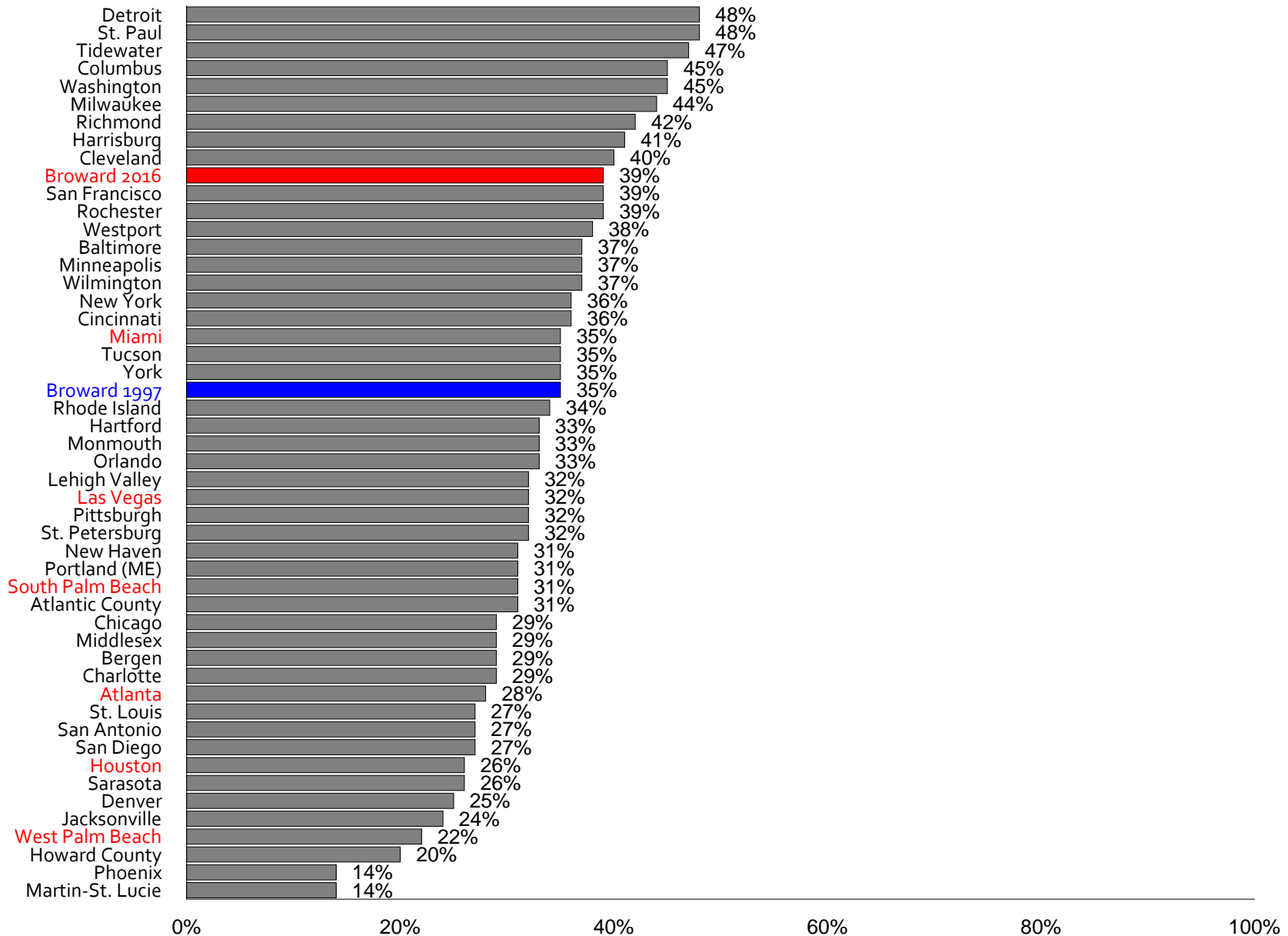

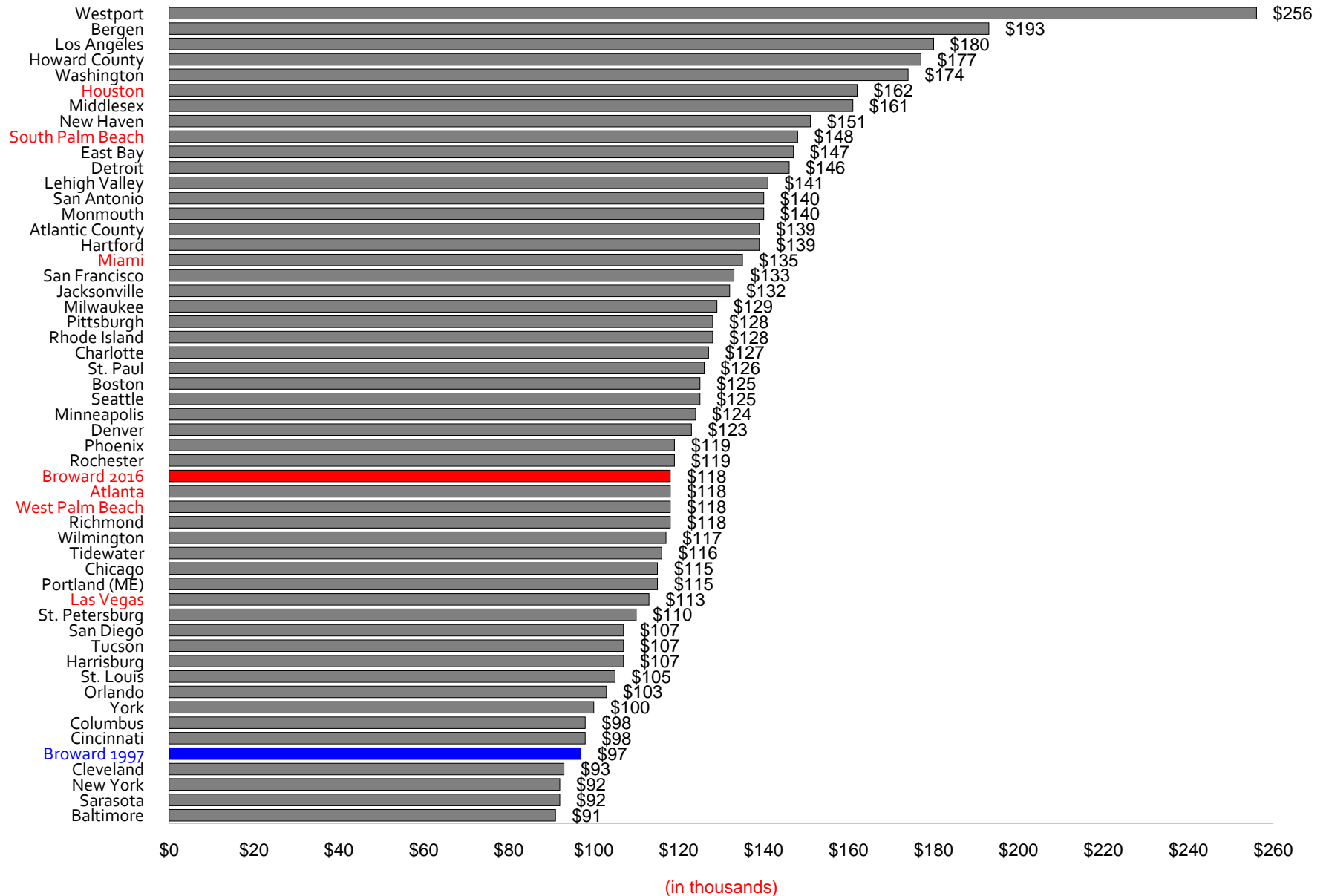
Household Income of Households with Children

(In thousands)



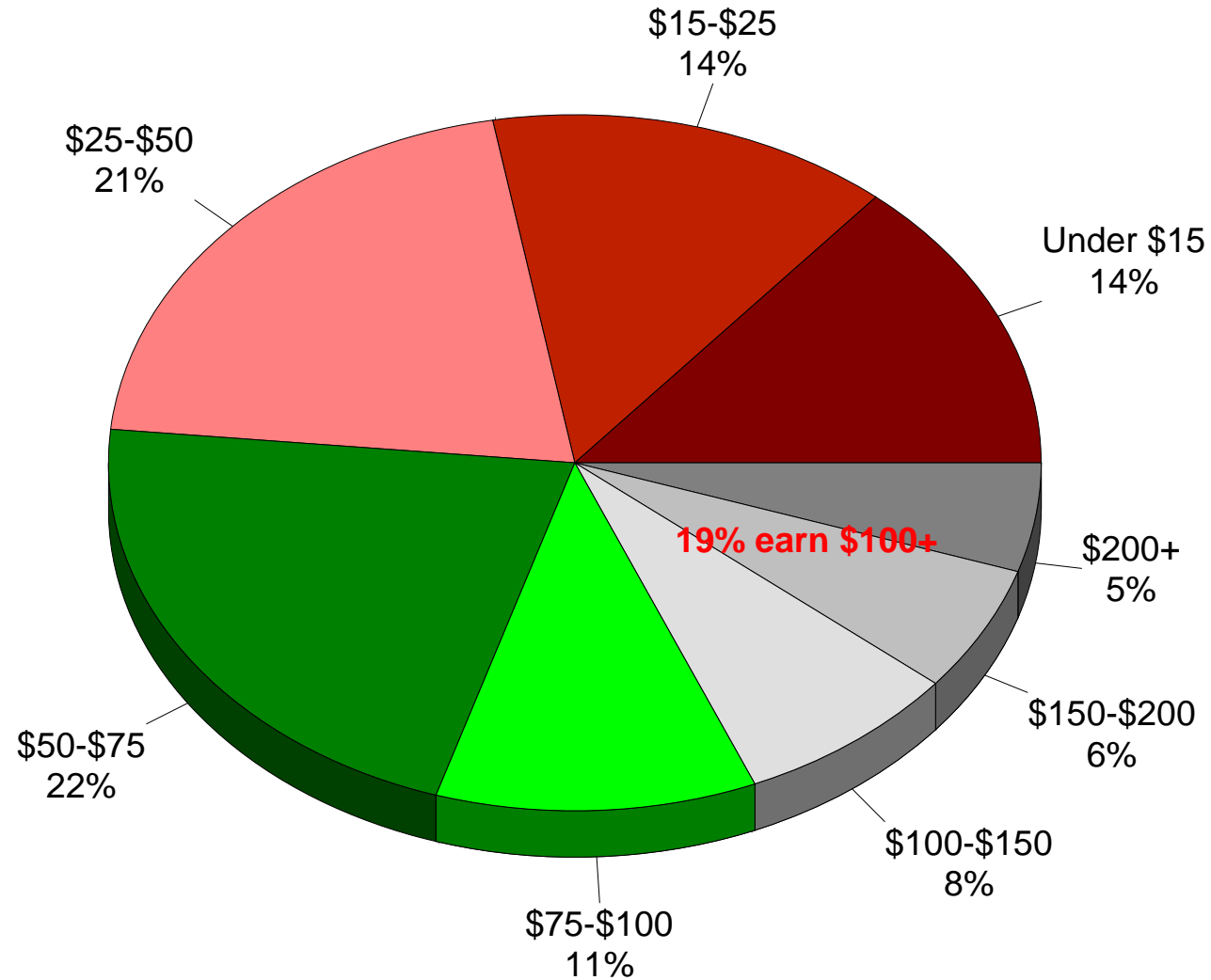

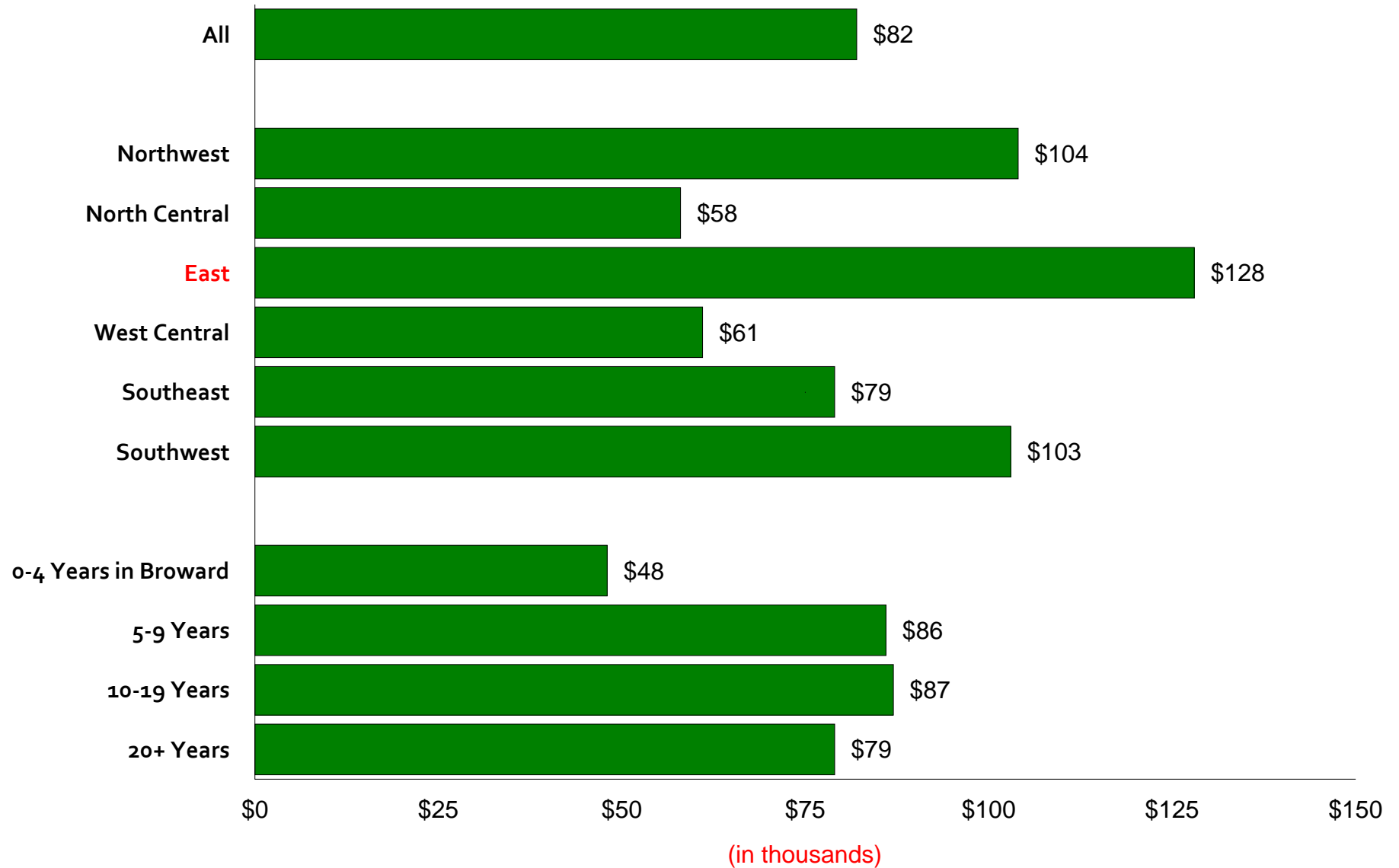

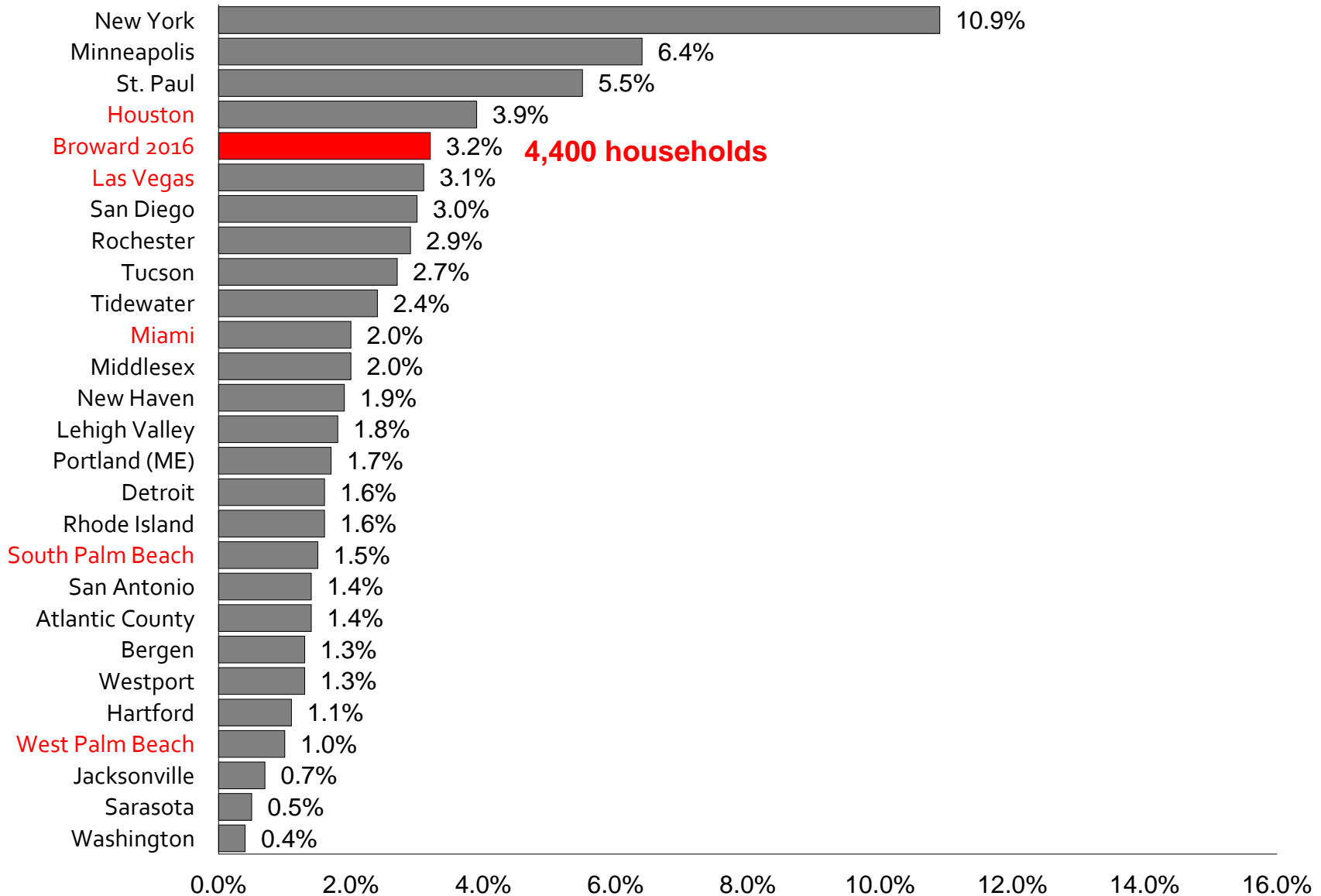
Profile of Low Income Households

- 14% are synagogue members; 8% are JCC members

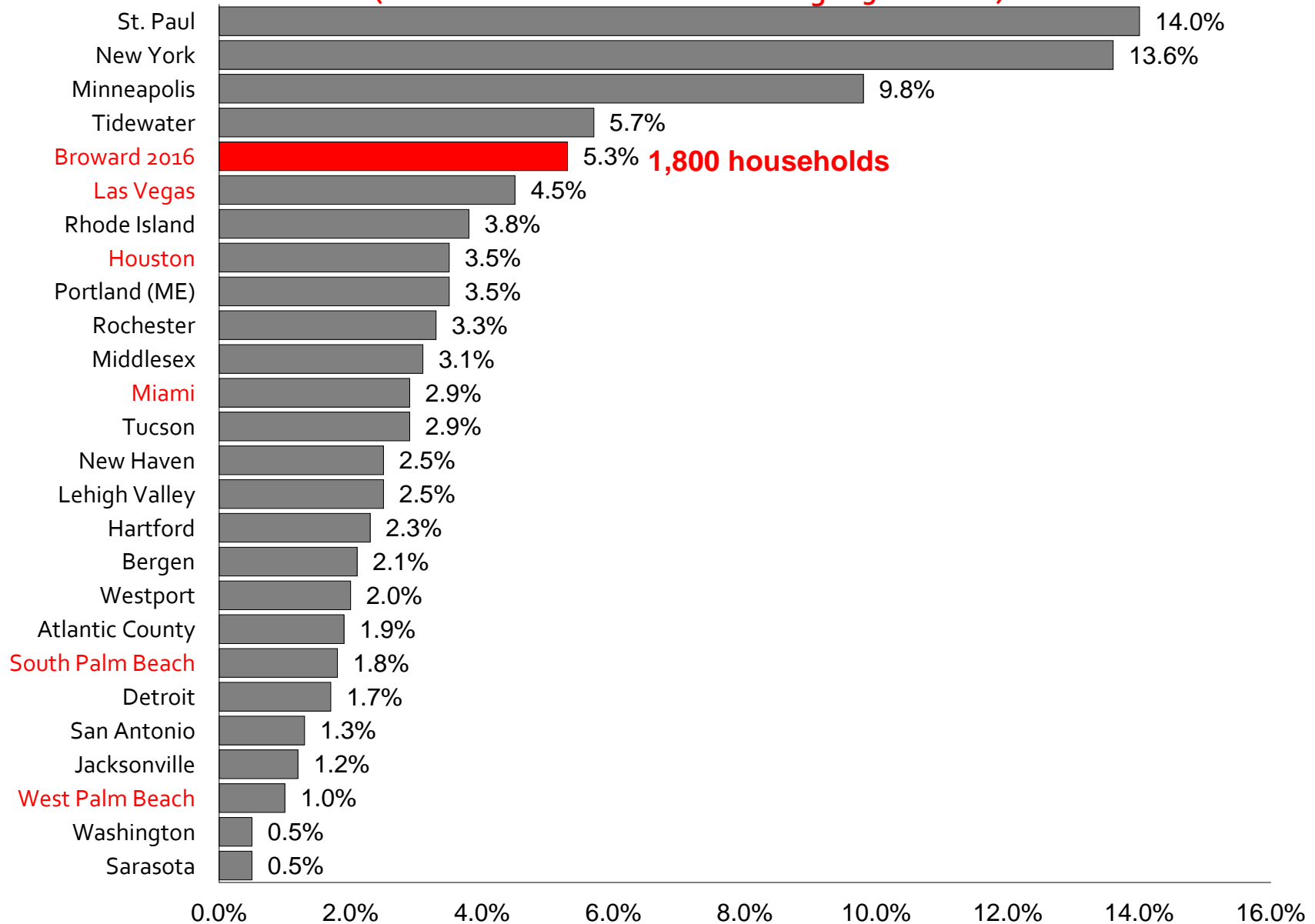
Households Living Below the Federal Poverty Levels

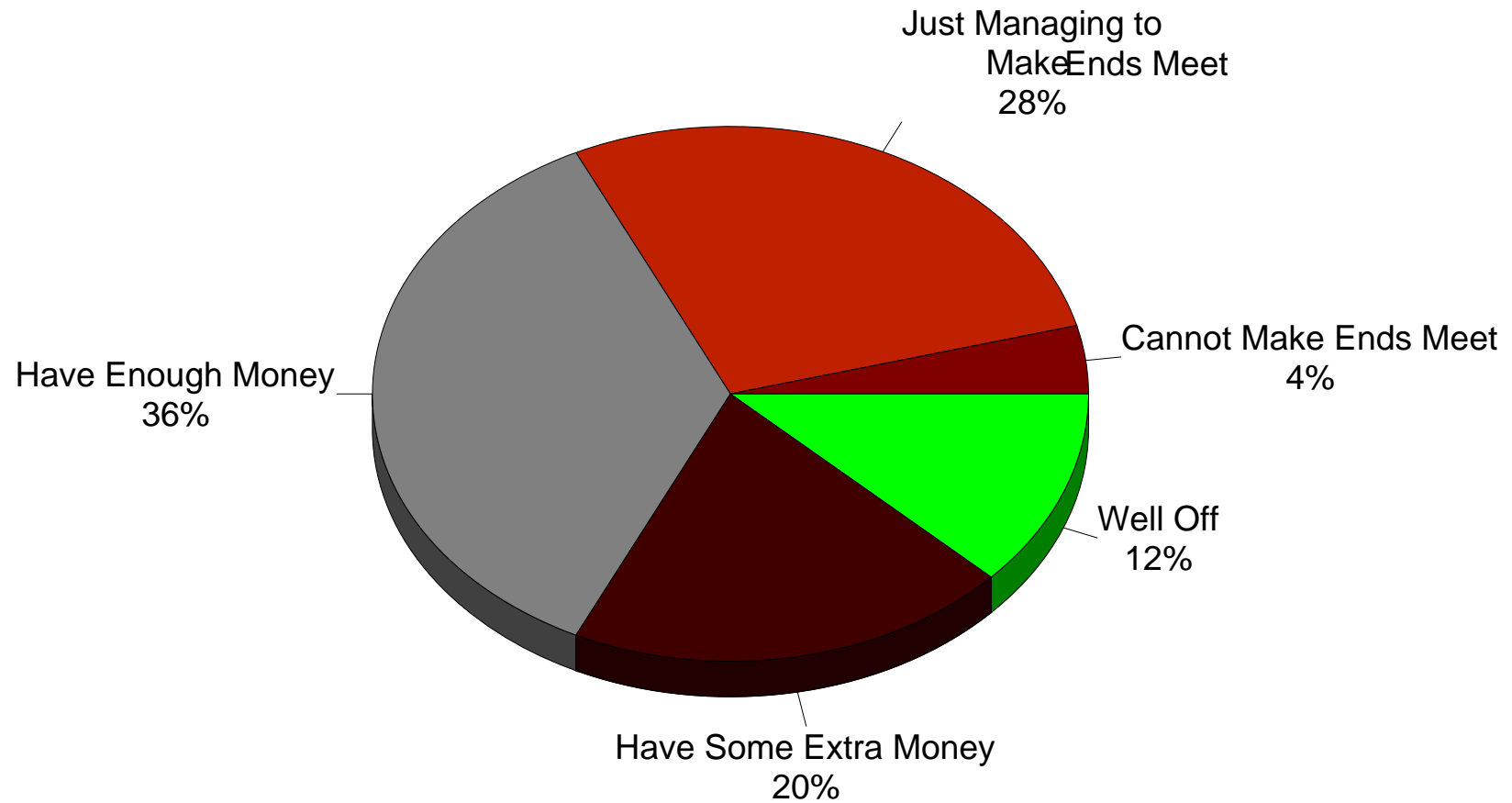
Households with Elderly Persons Living Below the Federal Poverty Levels

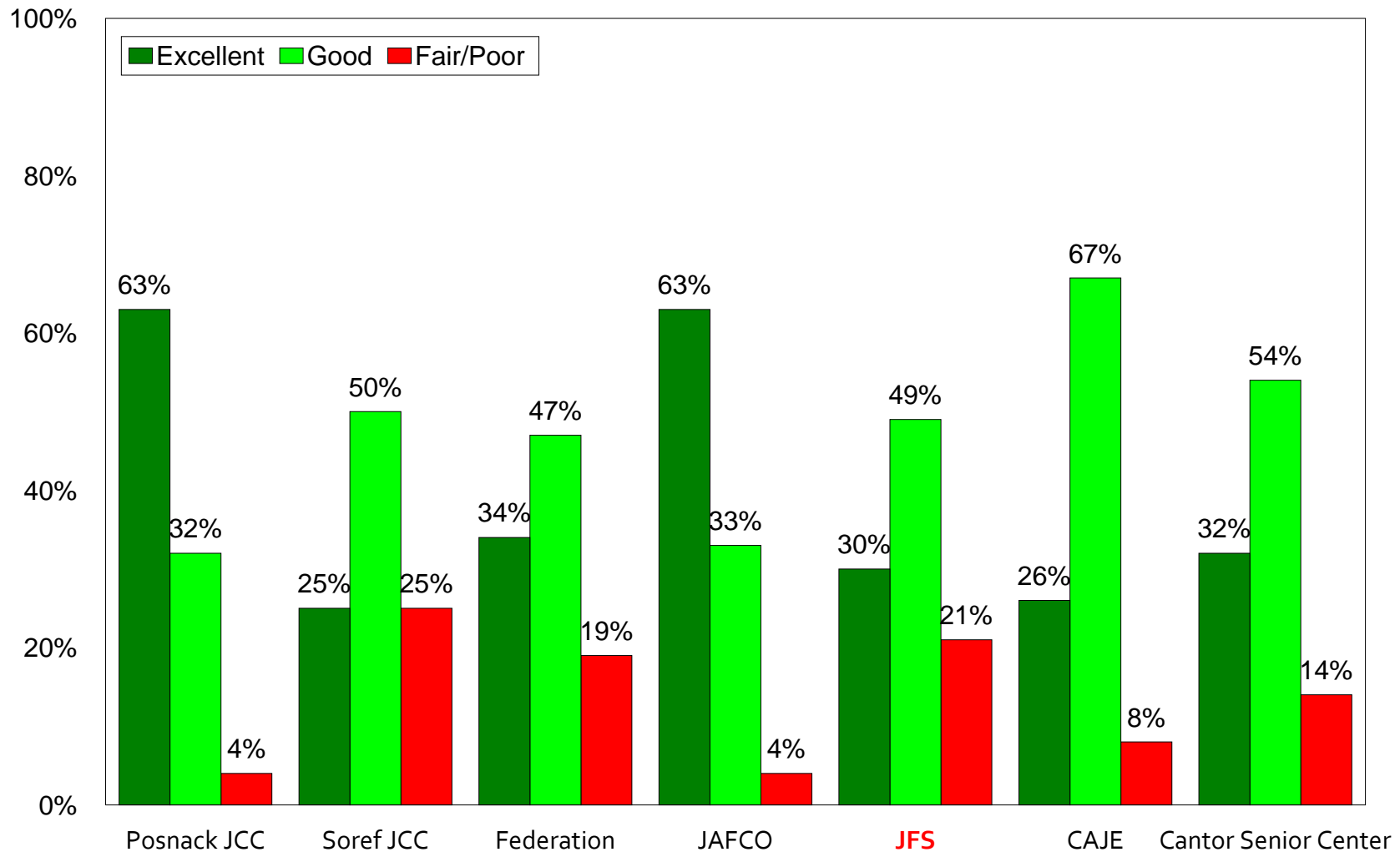

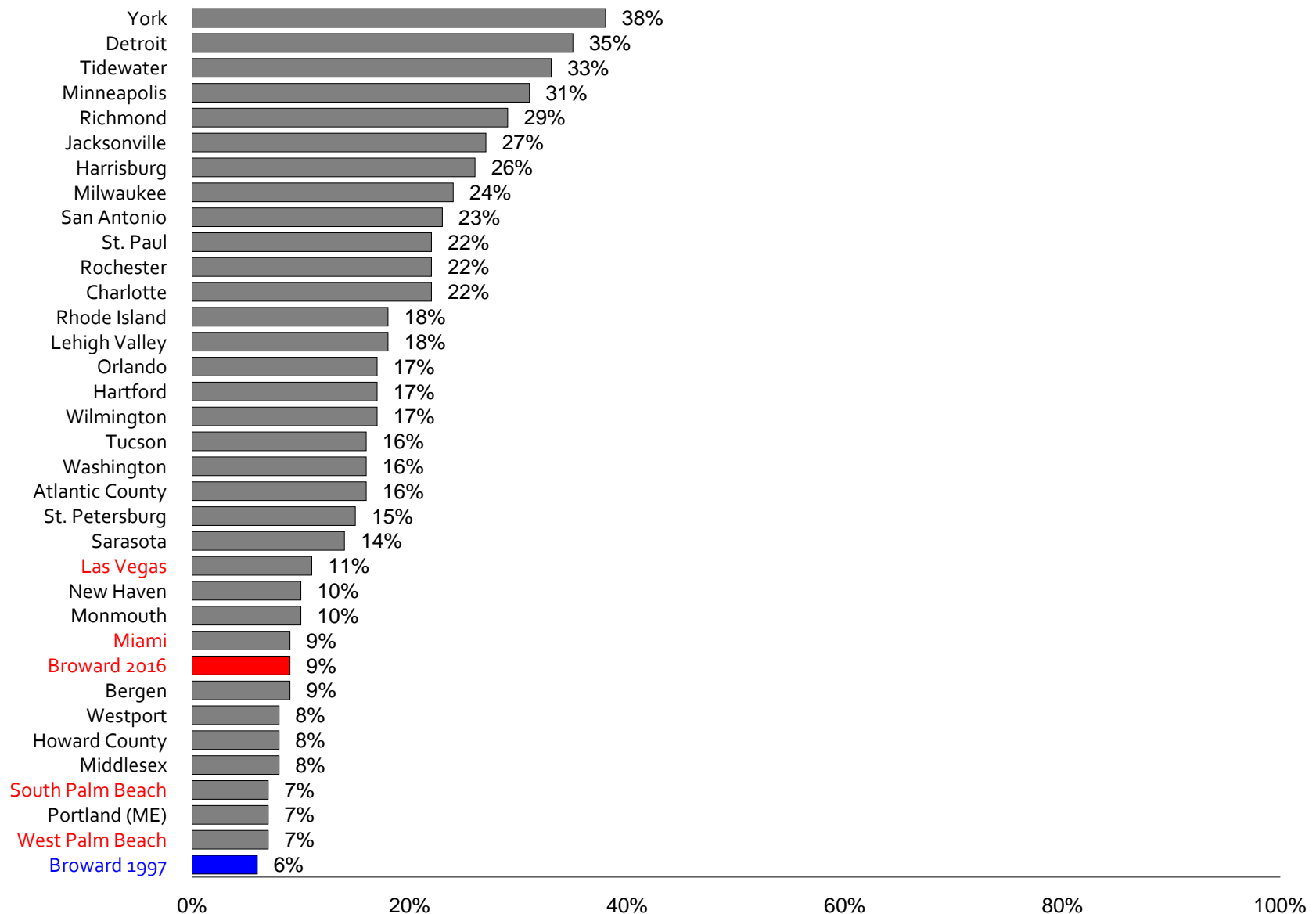
Perception of Jewish Agencies

(Respondents Who Are Very/Somewhat Familiar)



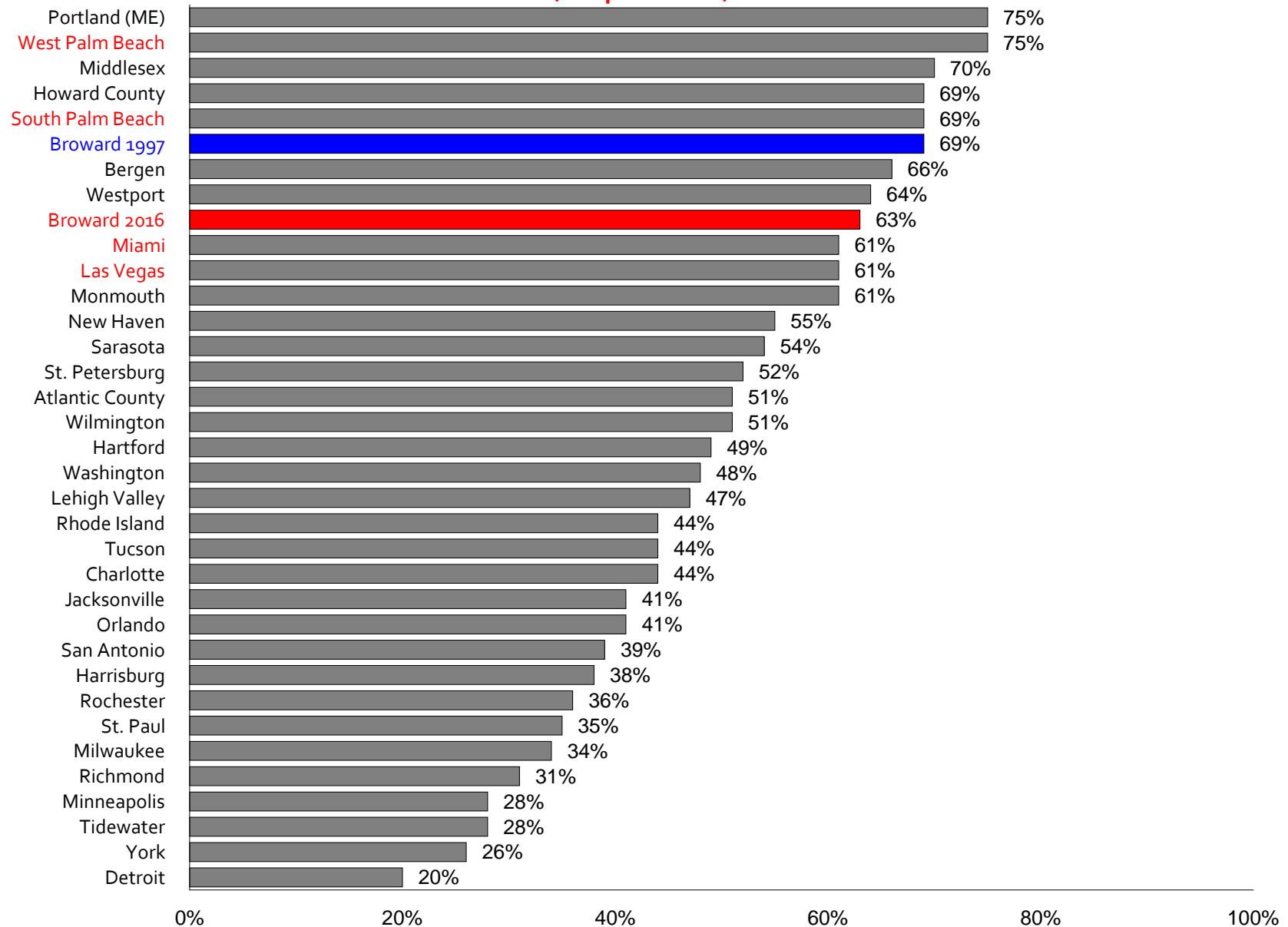

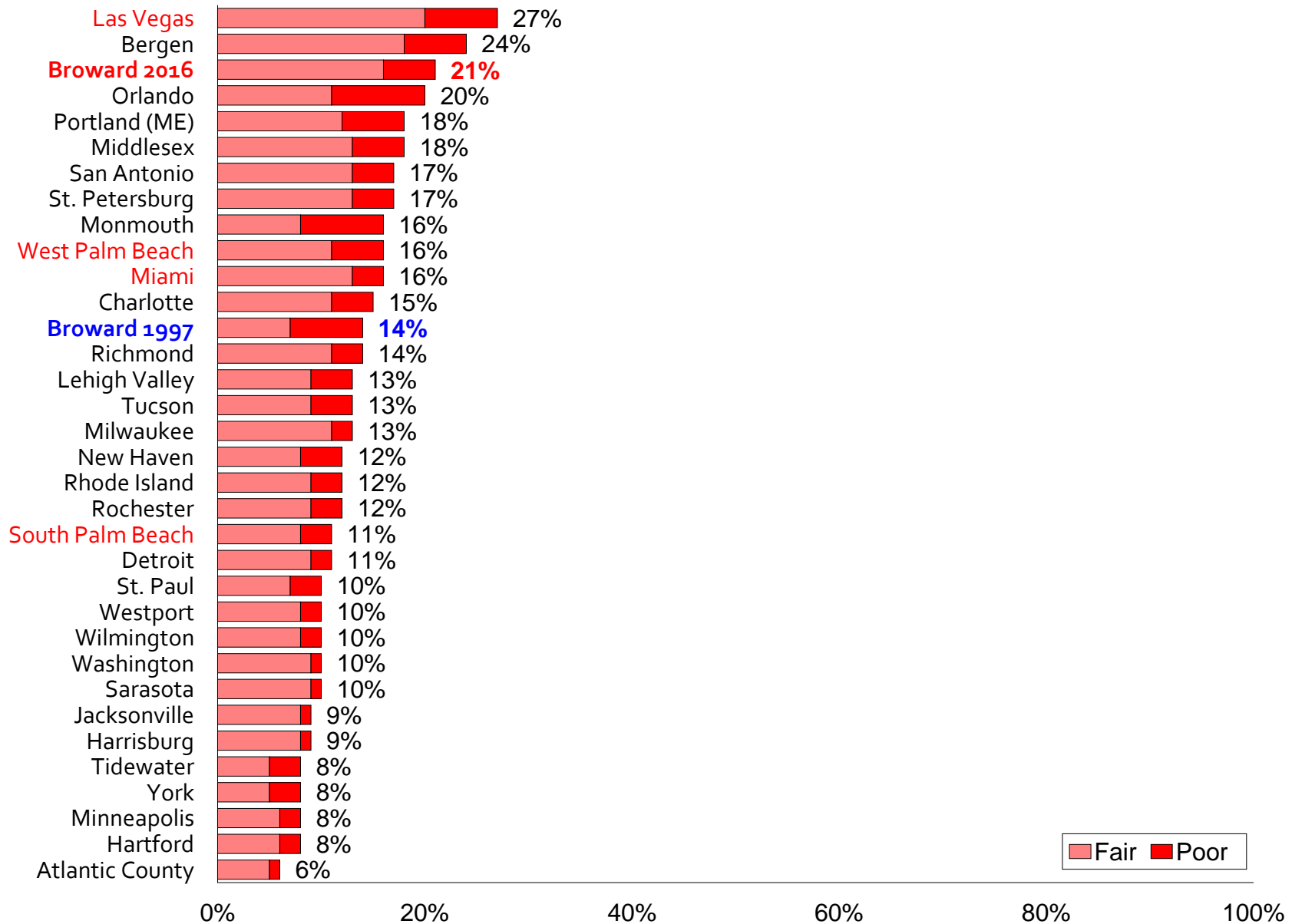
Excellent Perceptions of the Local Jewish Family Service

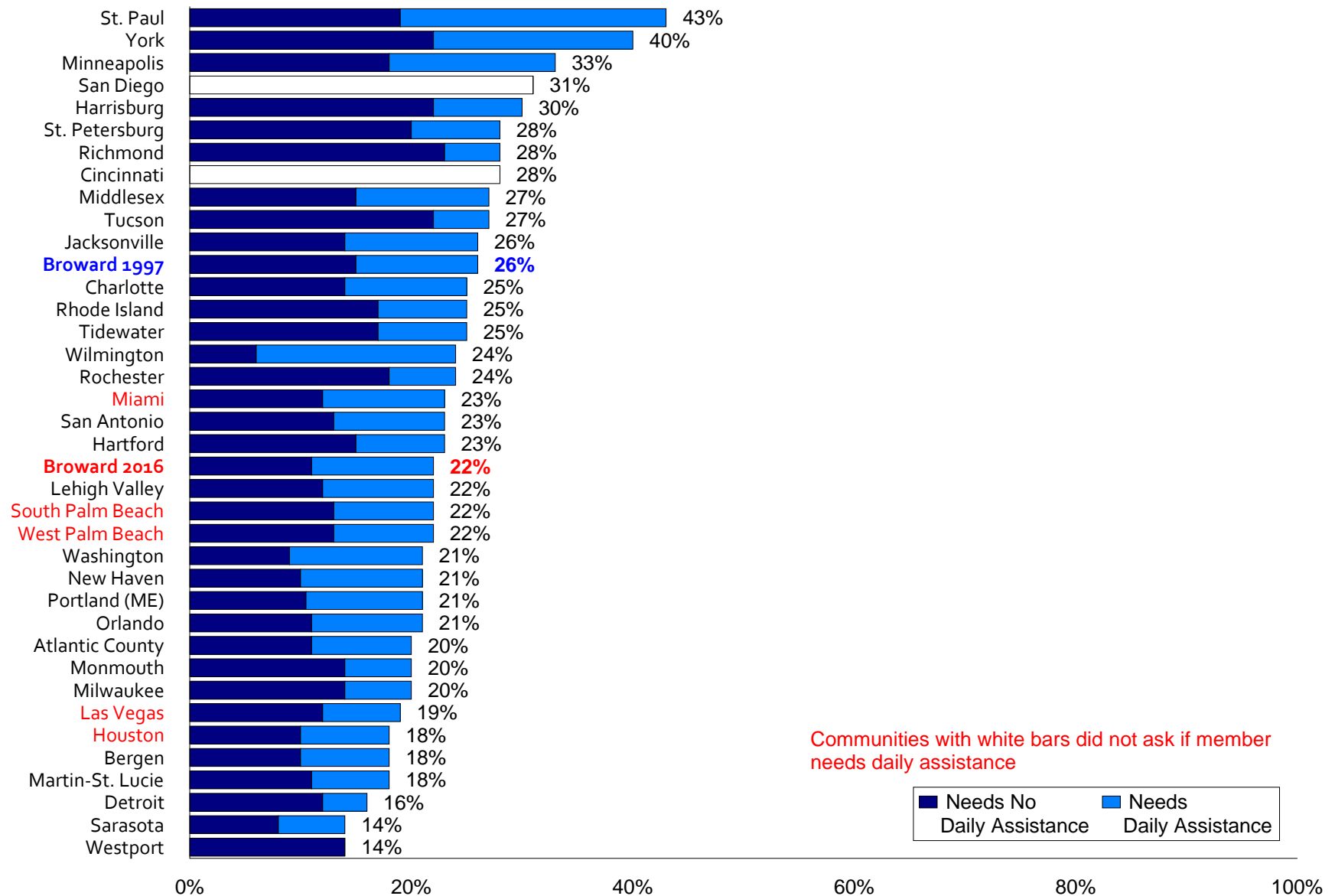

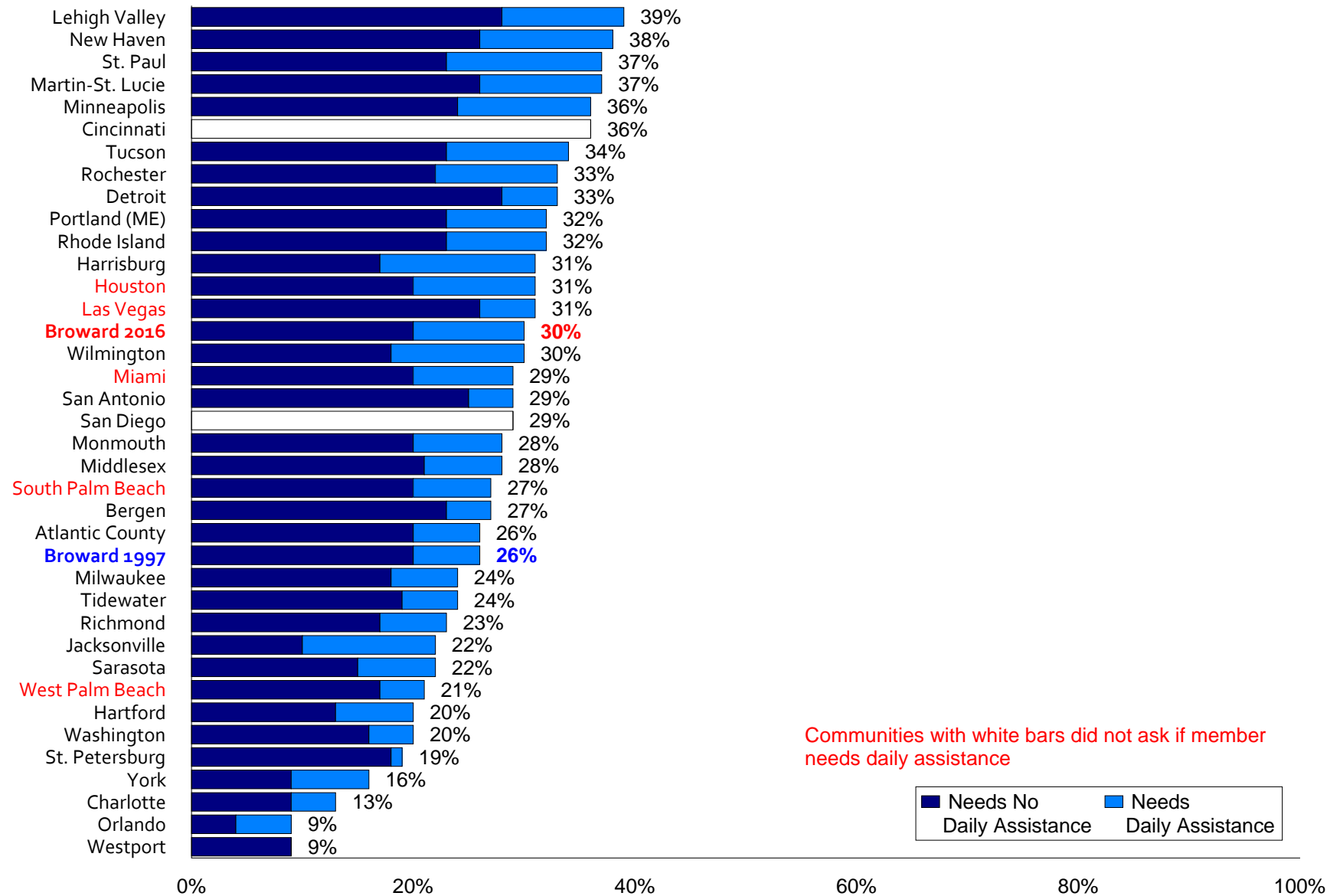

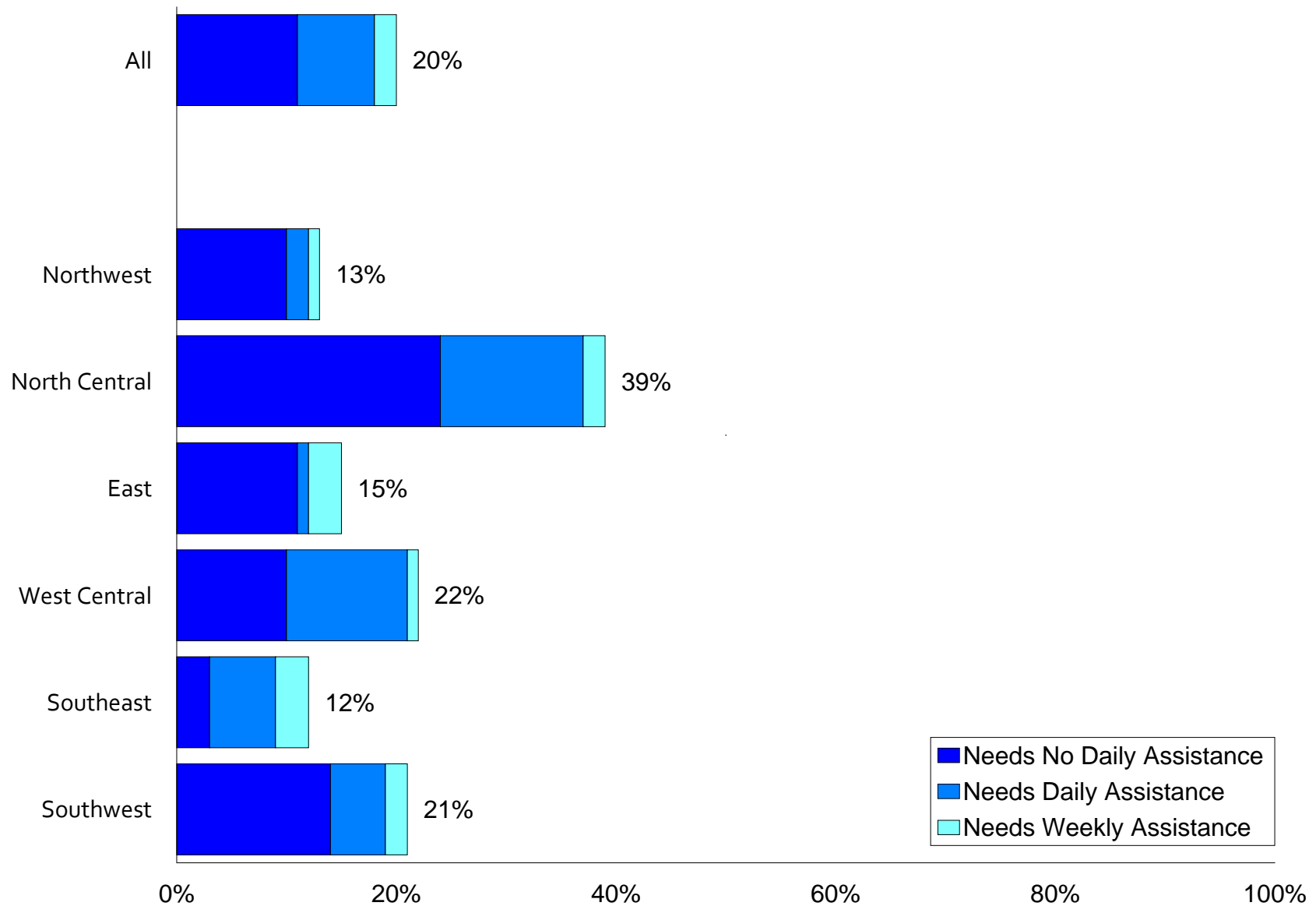
Elderly Couple Households in Which a Member Is Health Limited



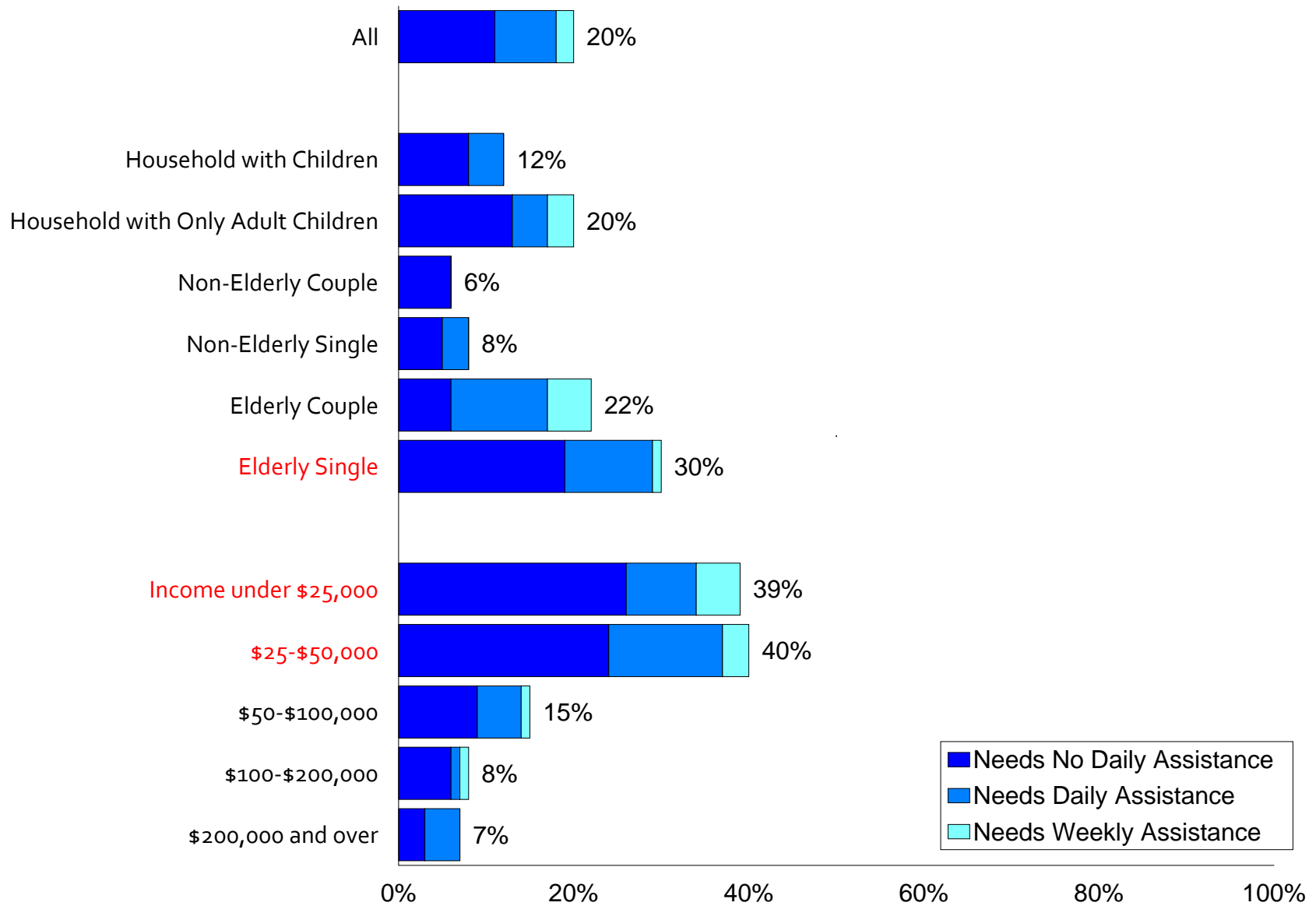
Elderly Single Households Who Are Health Limited

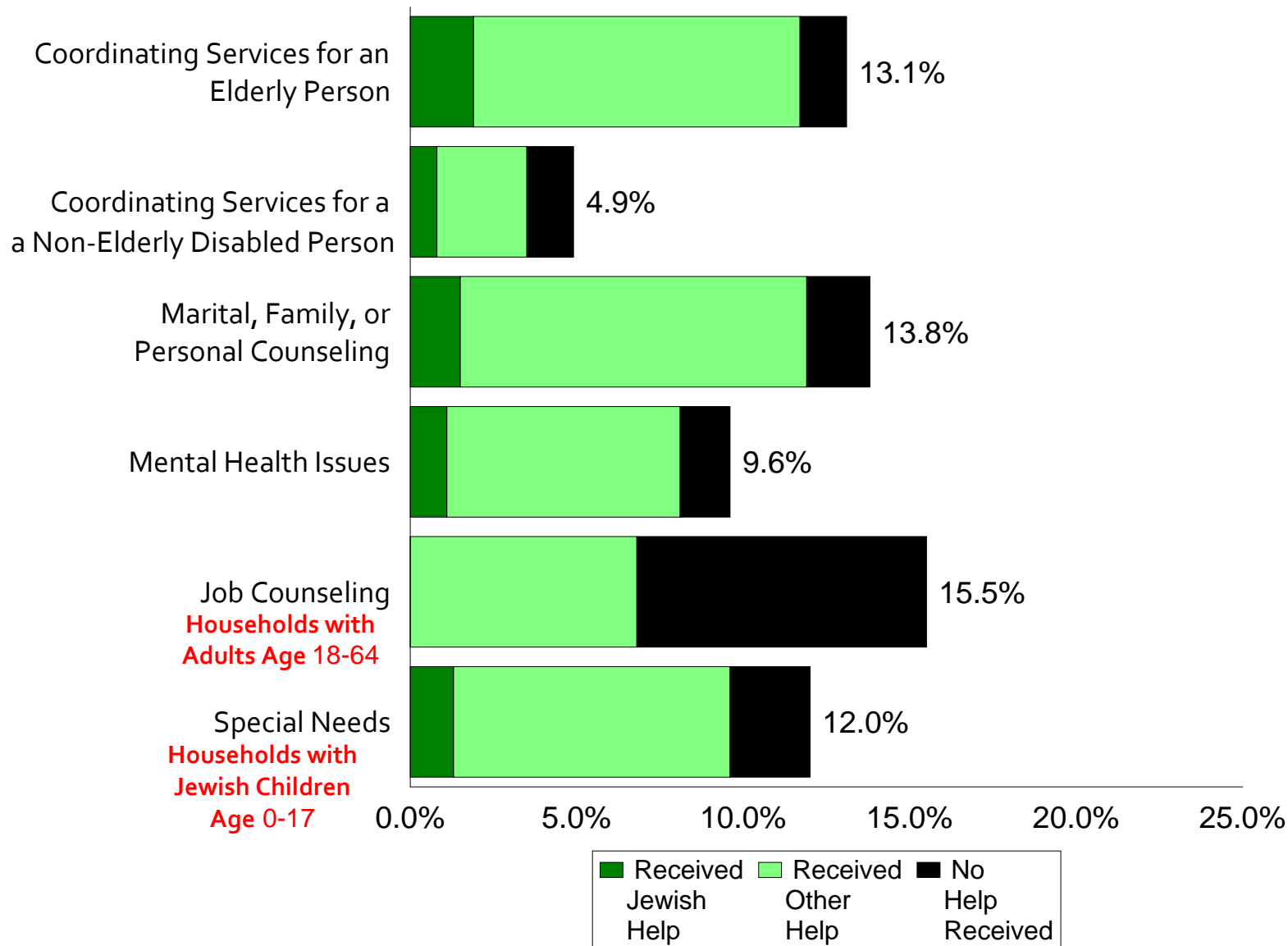
Disabilities

- **0.5% (360 households) of Jewish households contain a disabled adult child (age 18 and over) who is unable to work and lives at home with his/her parents or other adults**

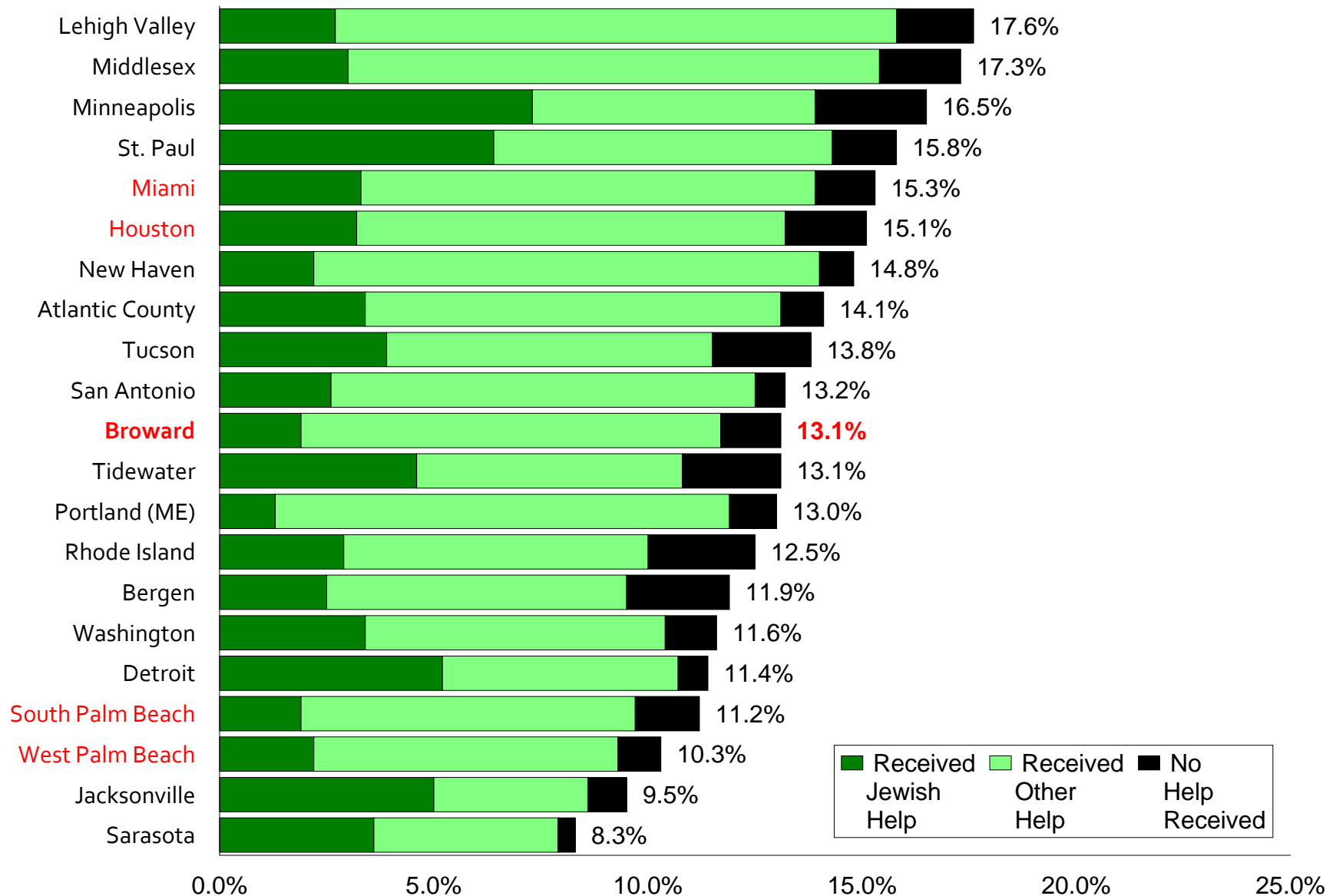

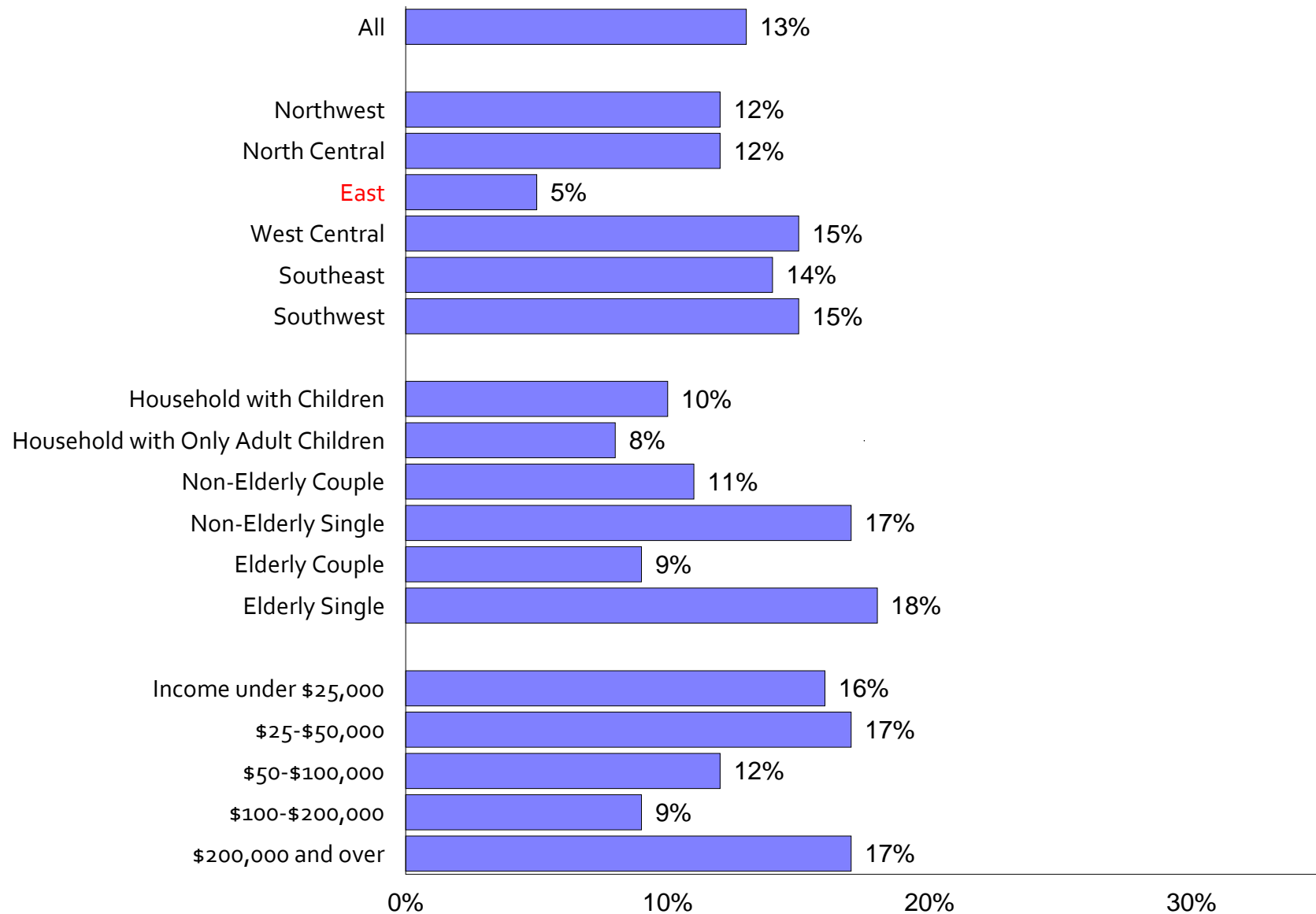


Need for Help in Coordinating Services for an Elderly or Disabled Person in the Past Year (Jewish Households)

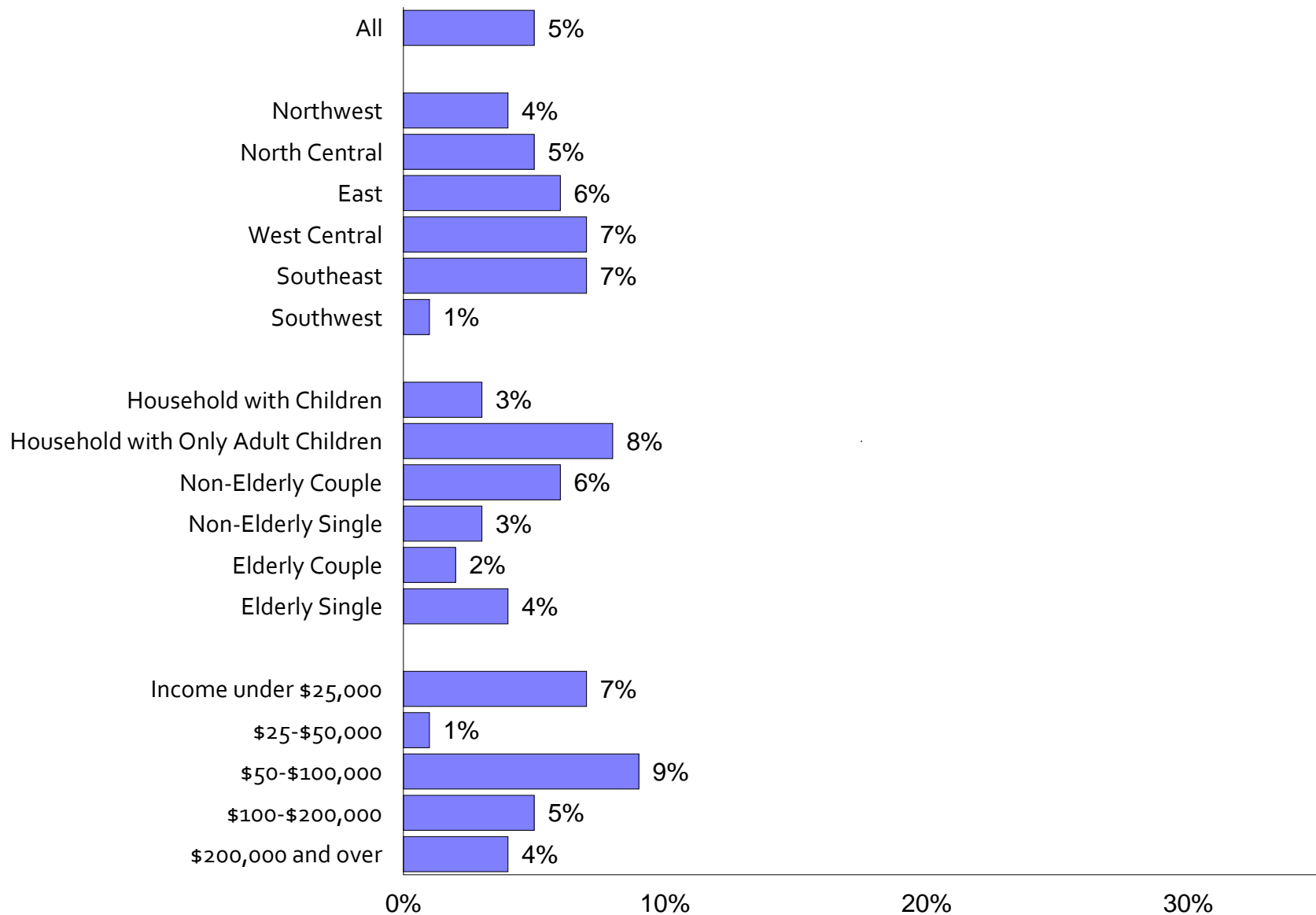

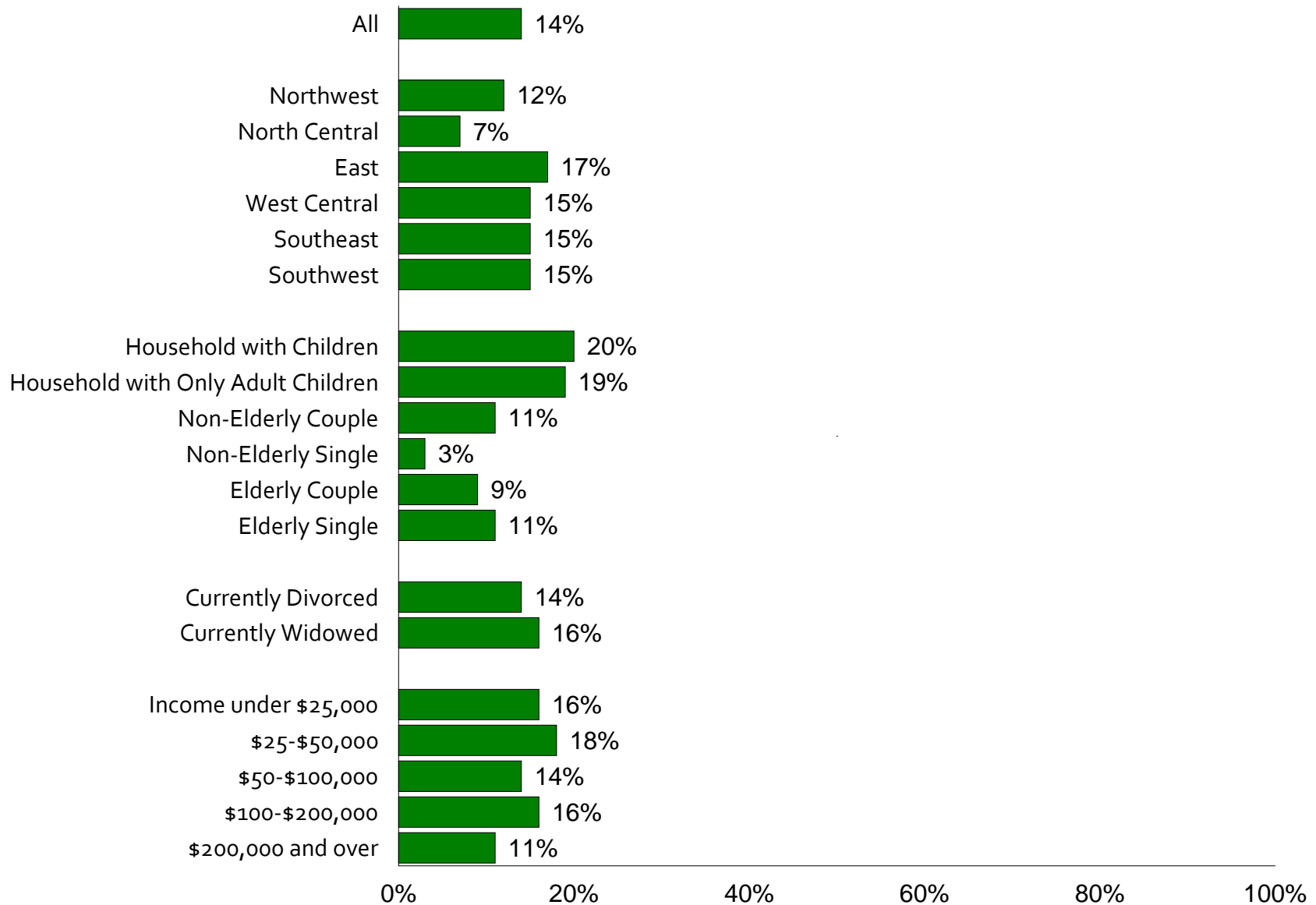

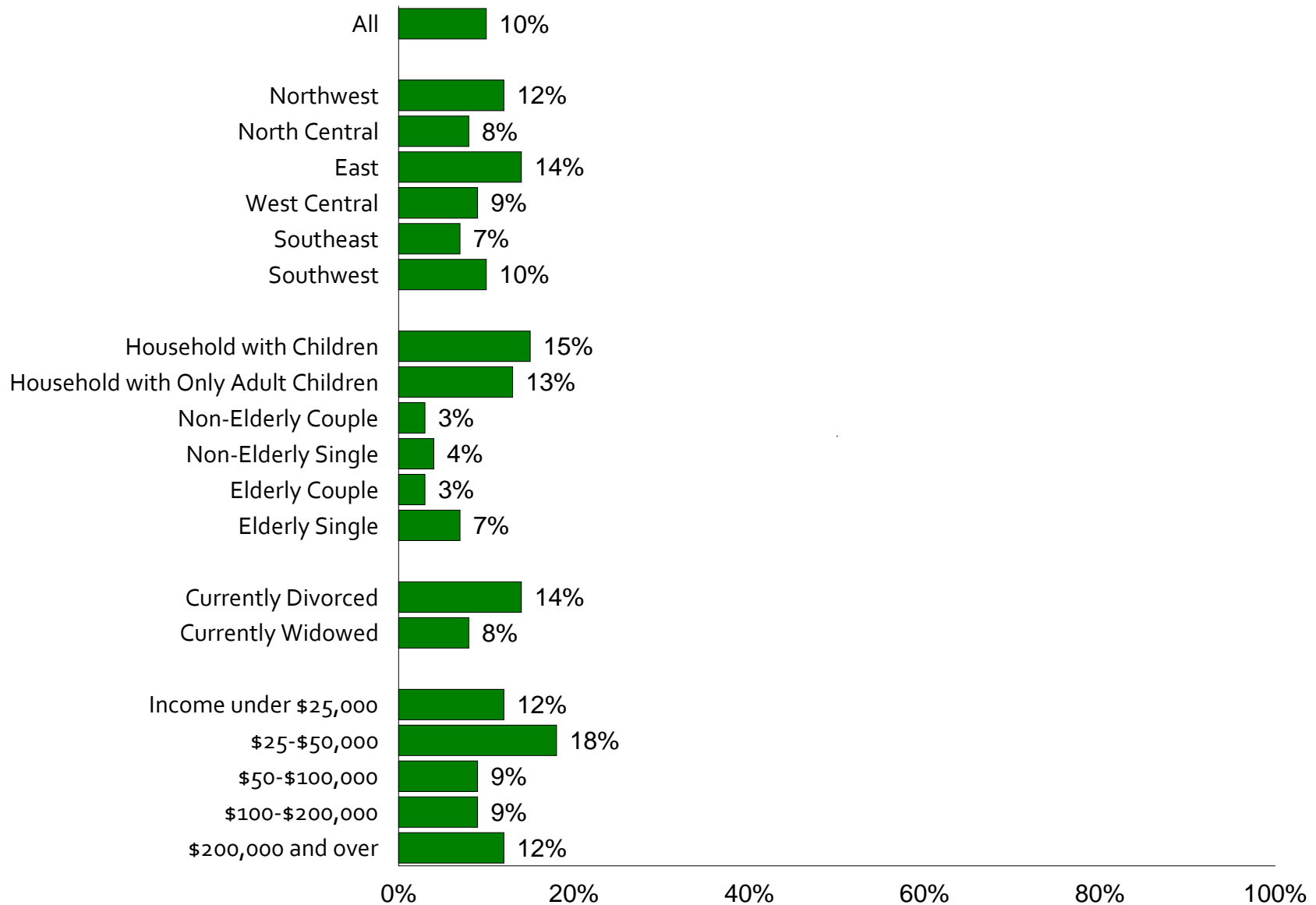

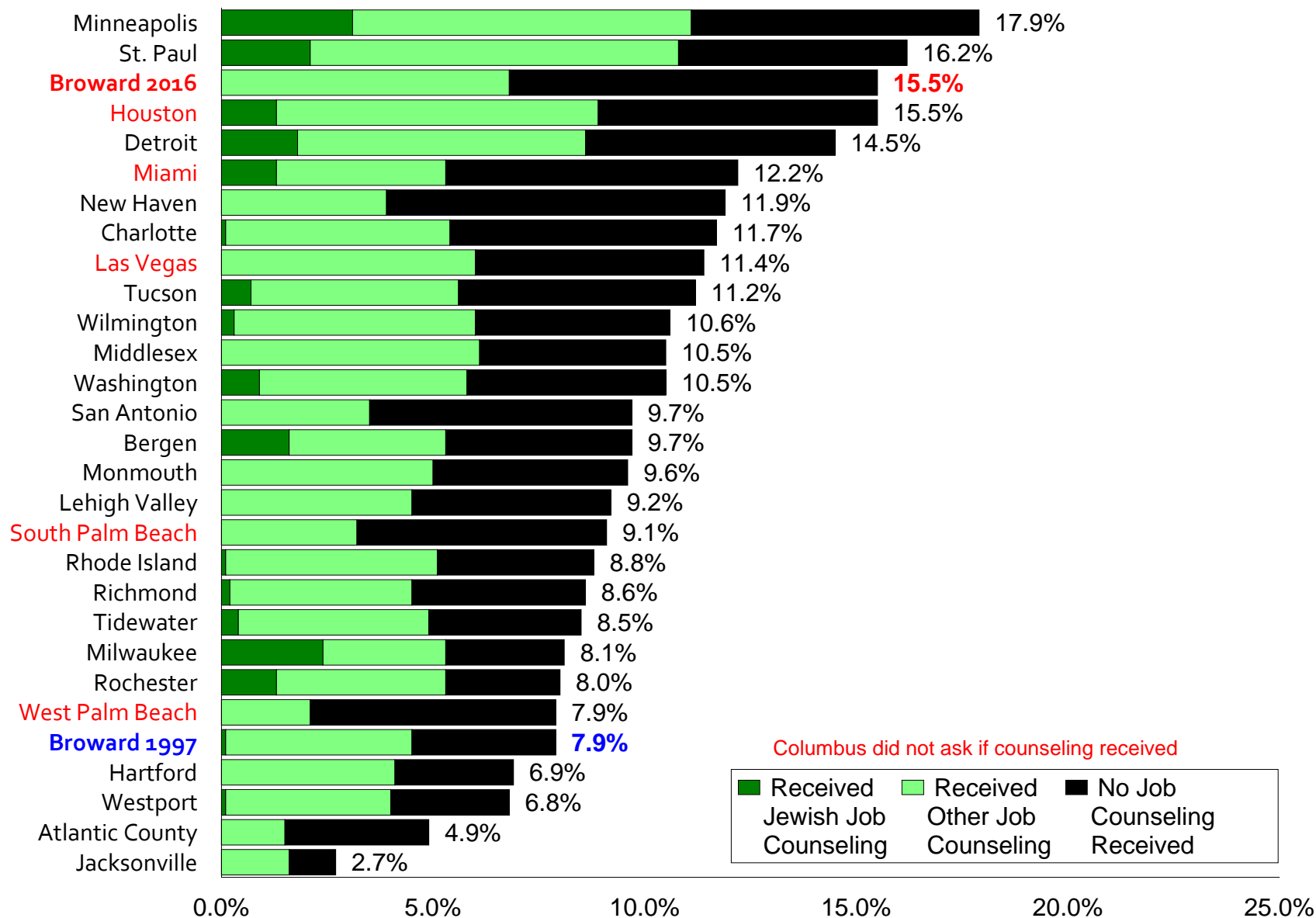

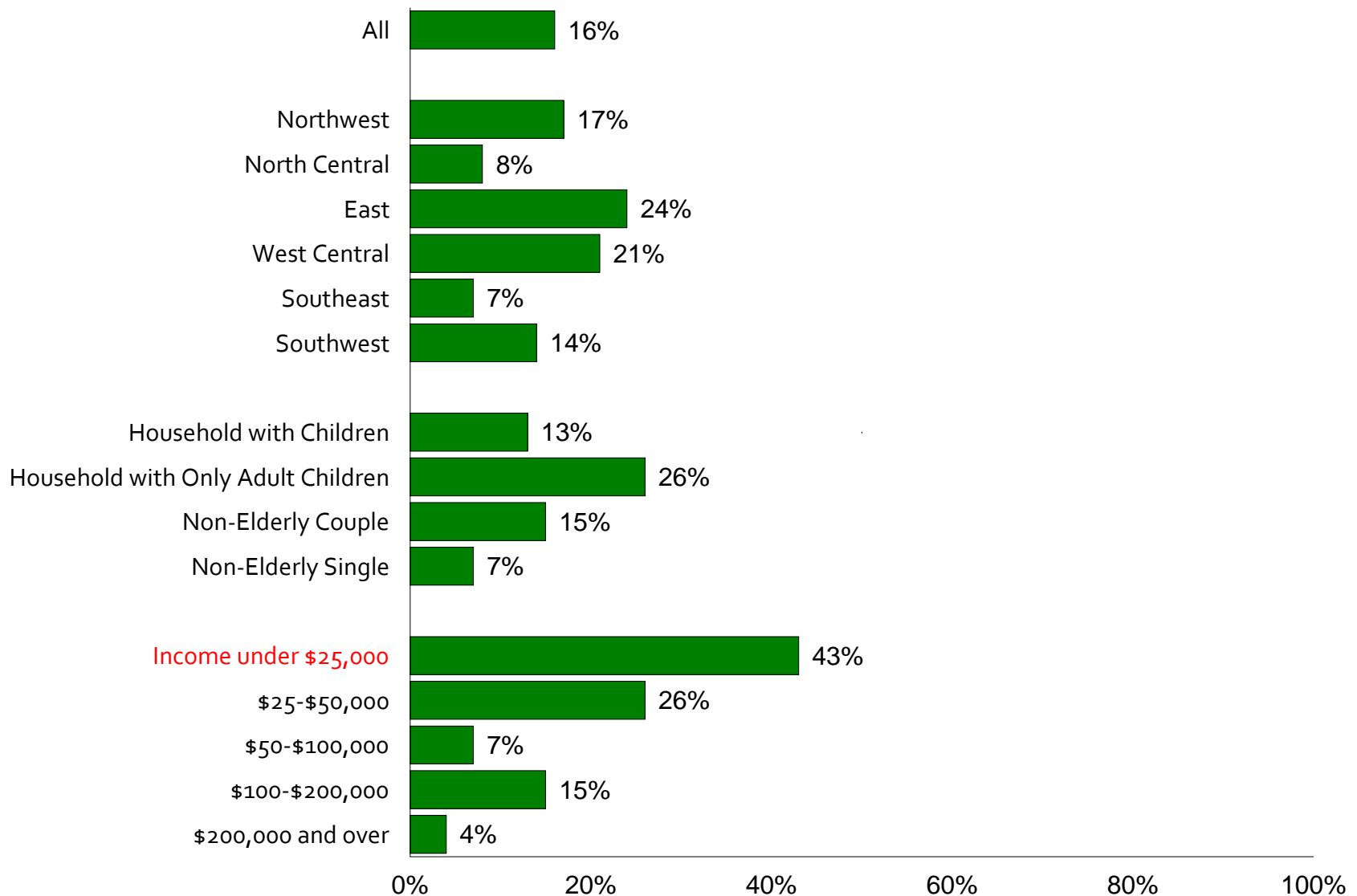

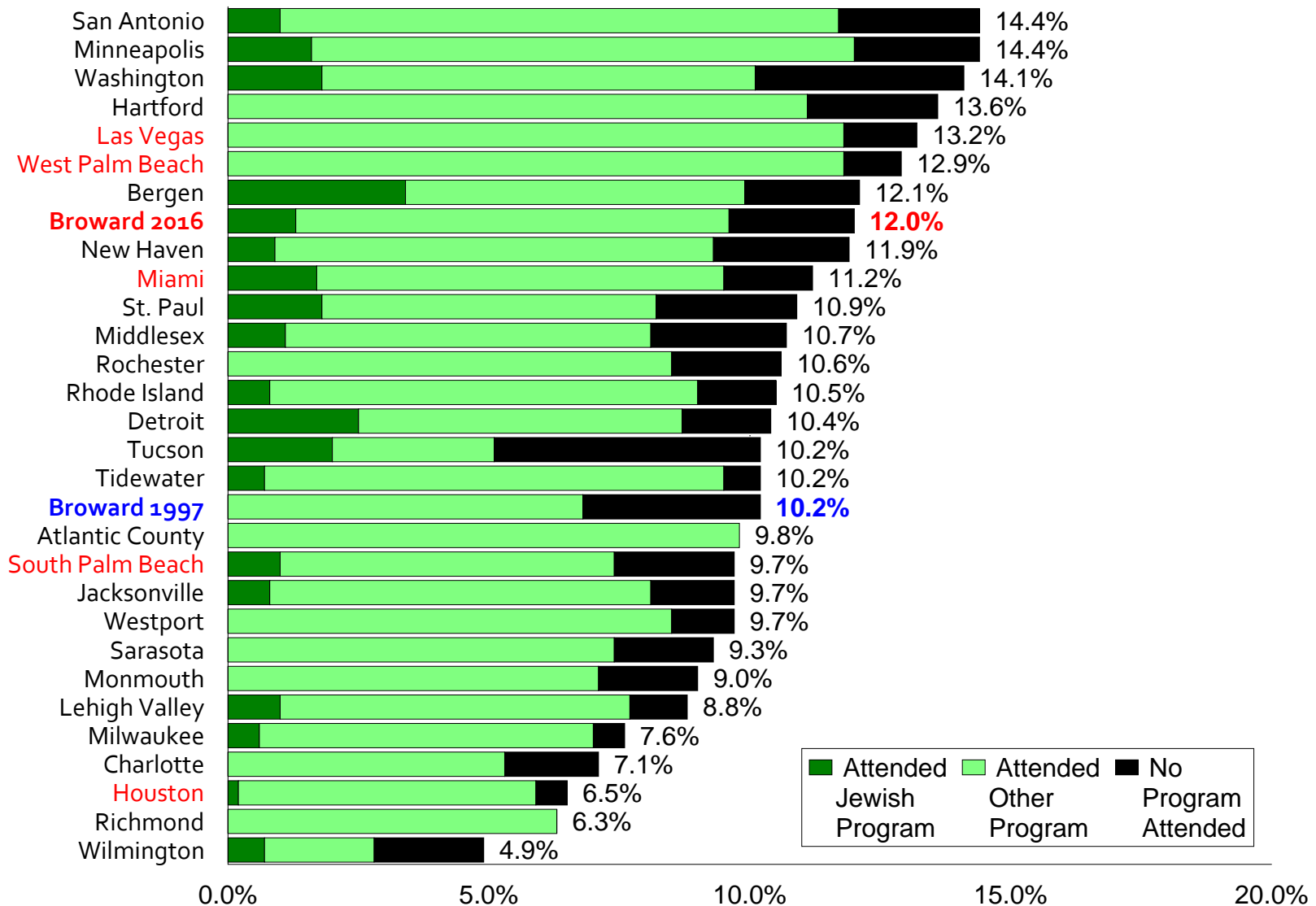

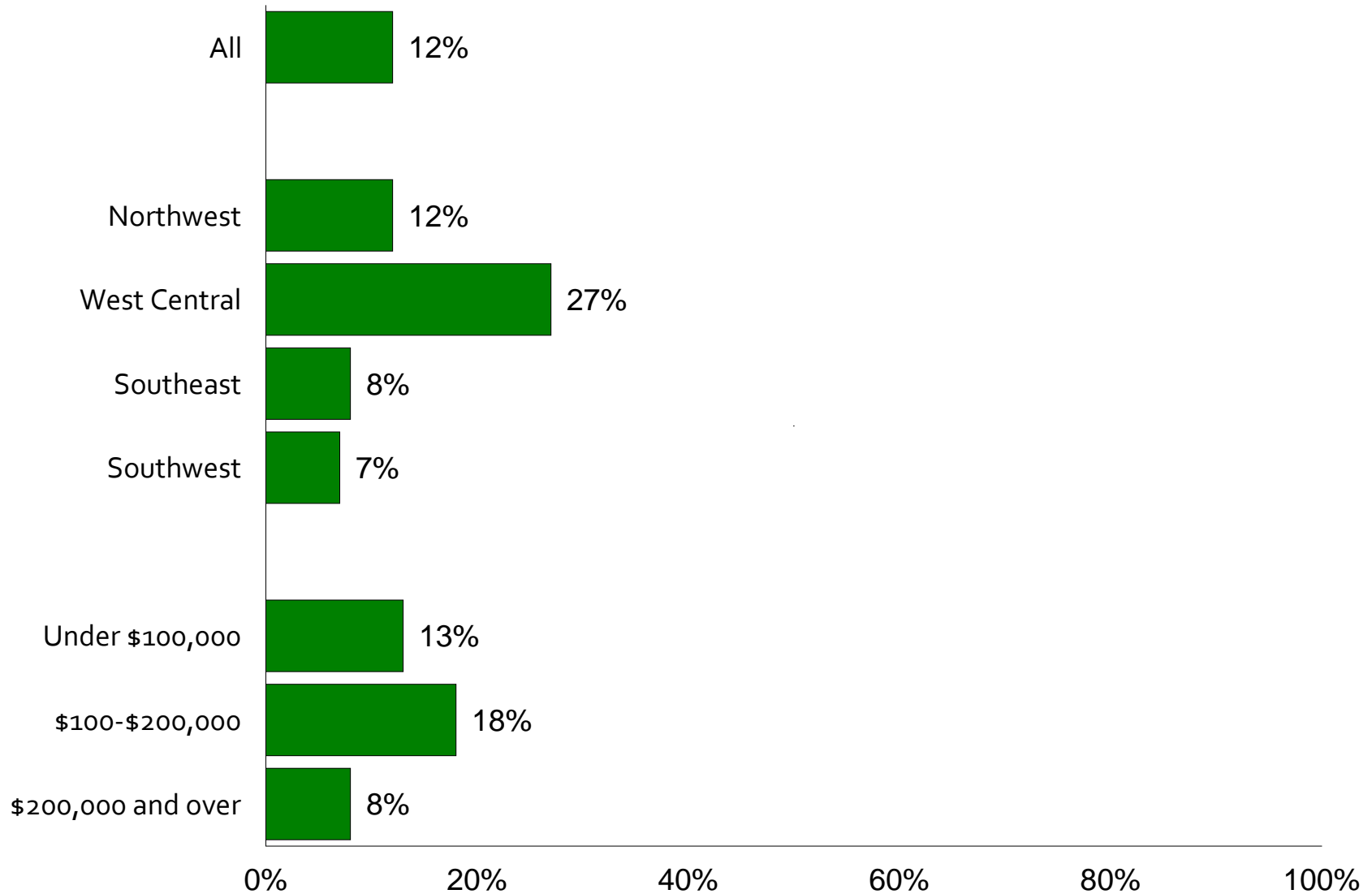

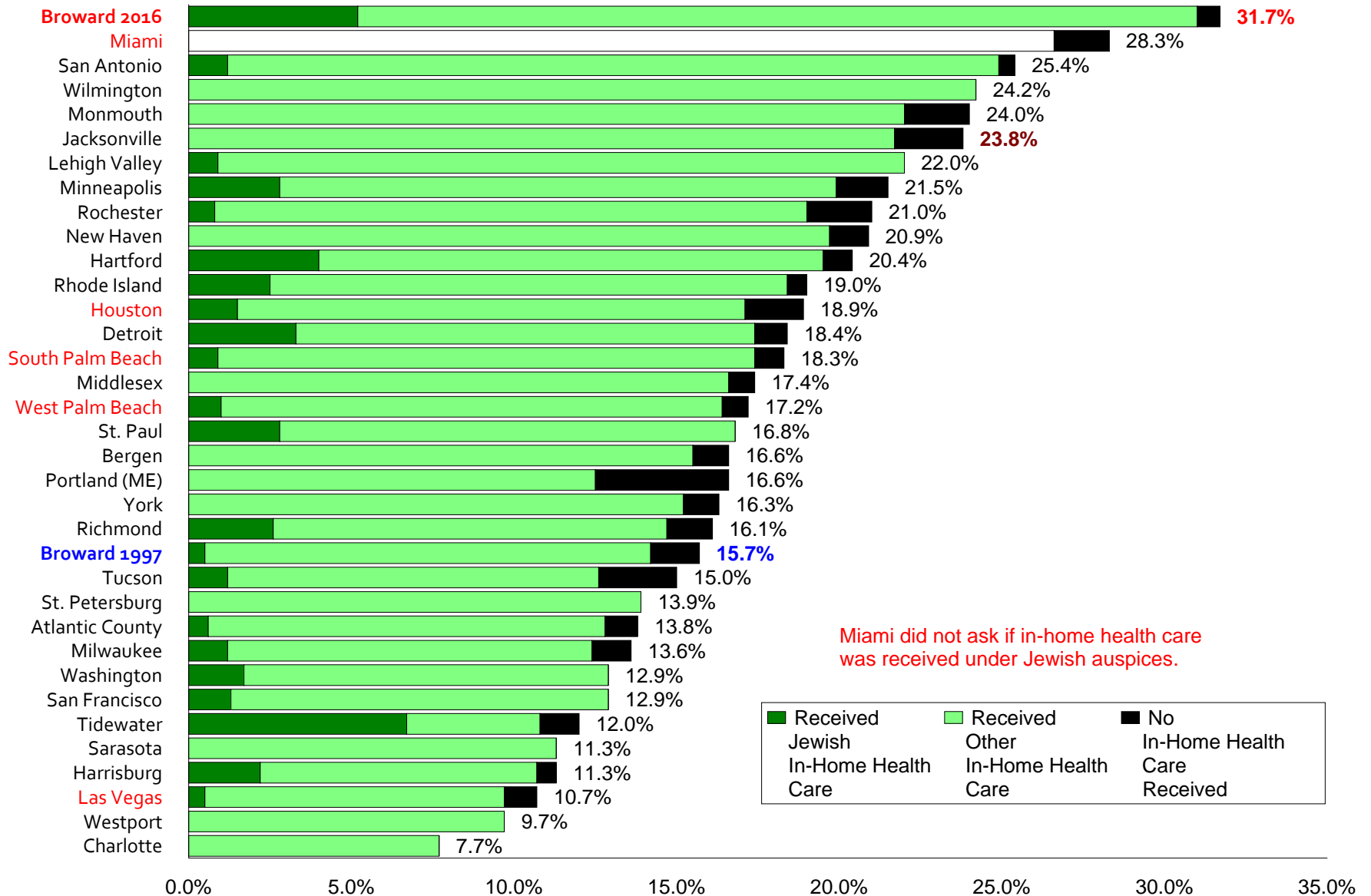

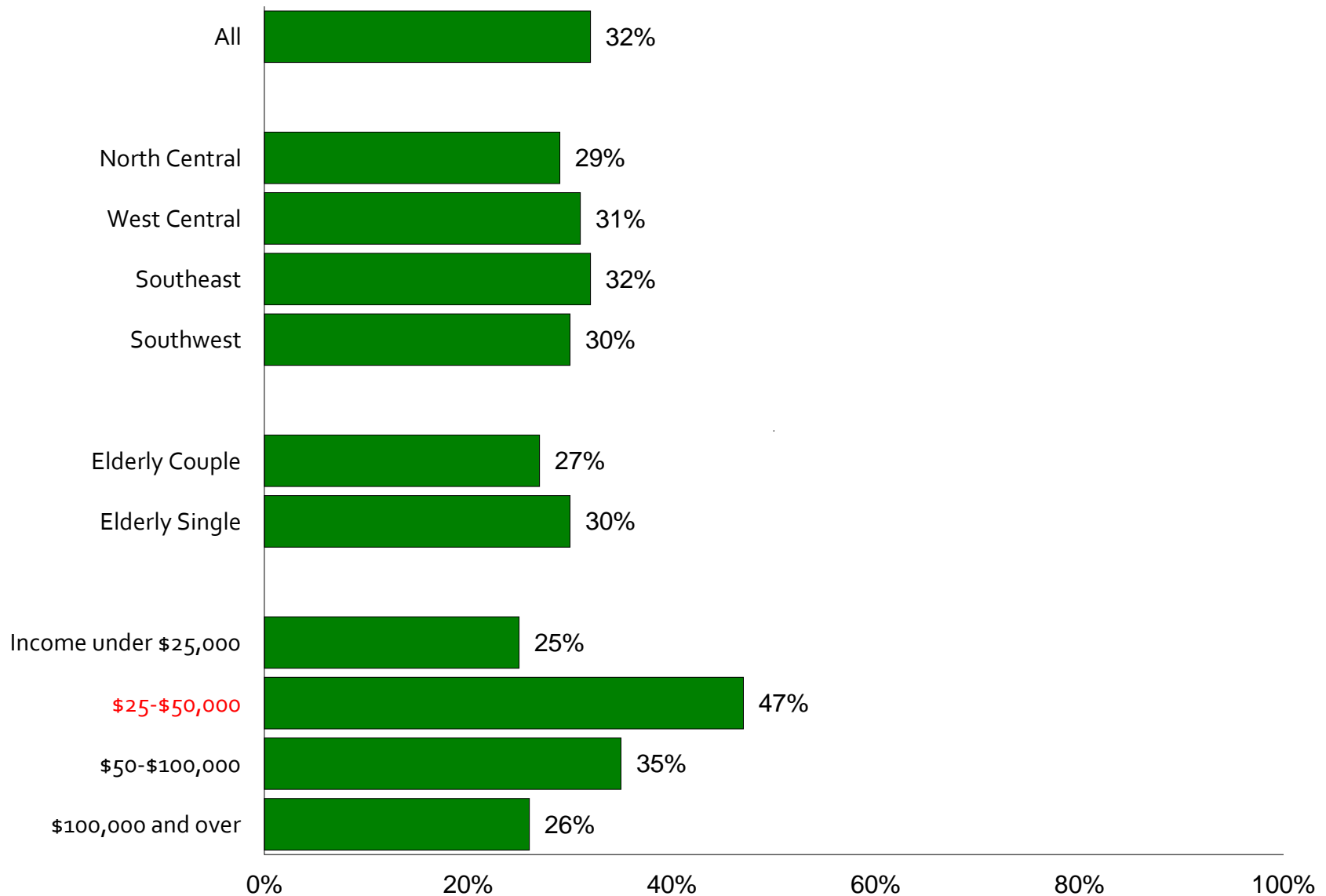

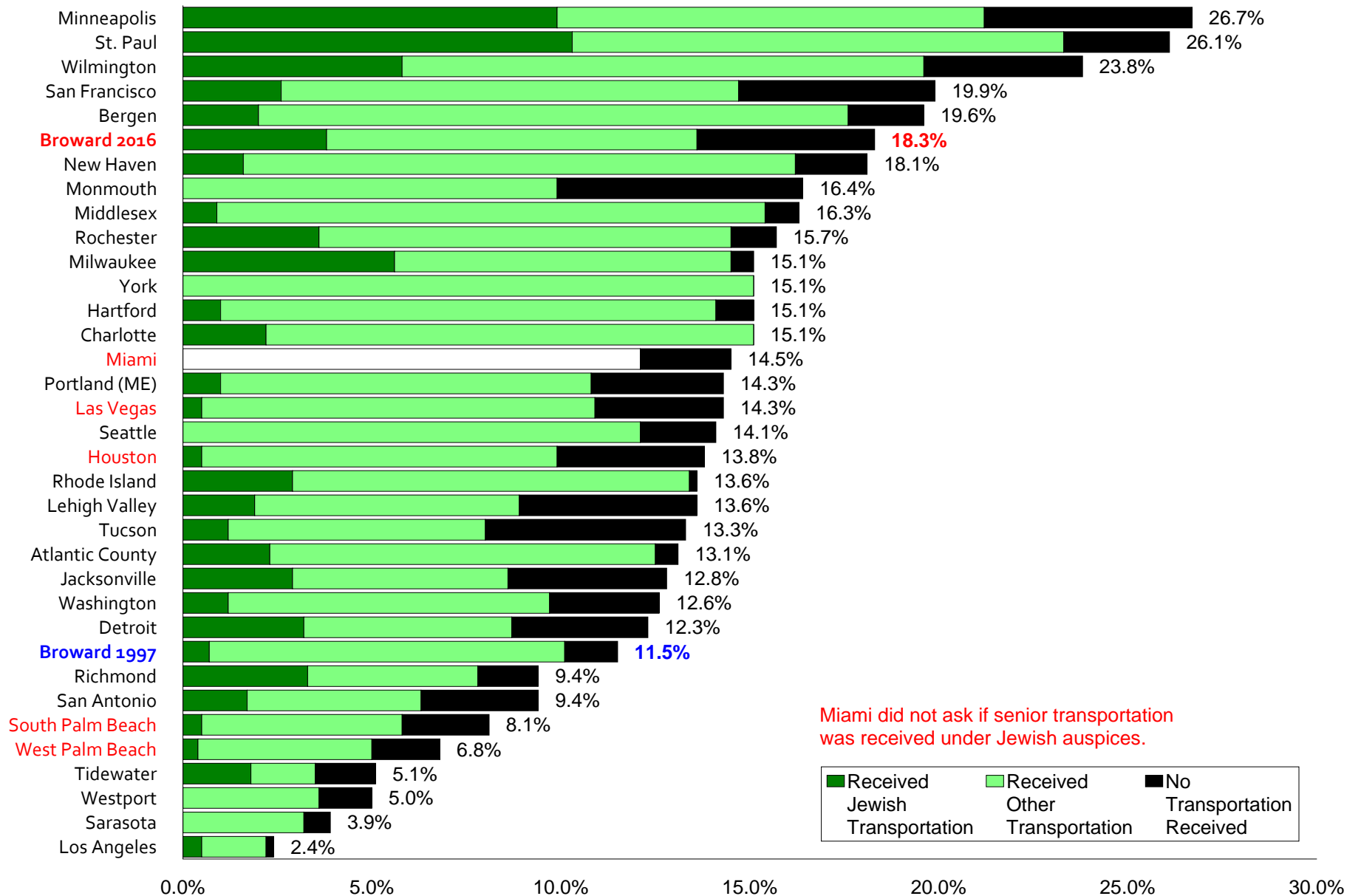

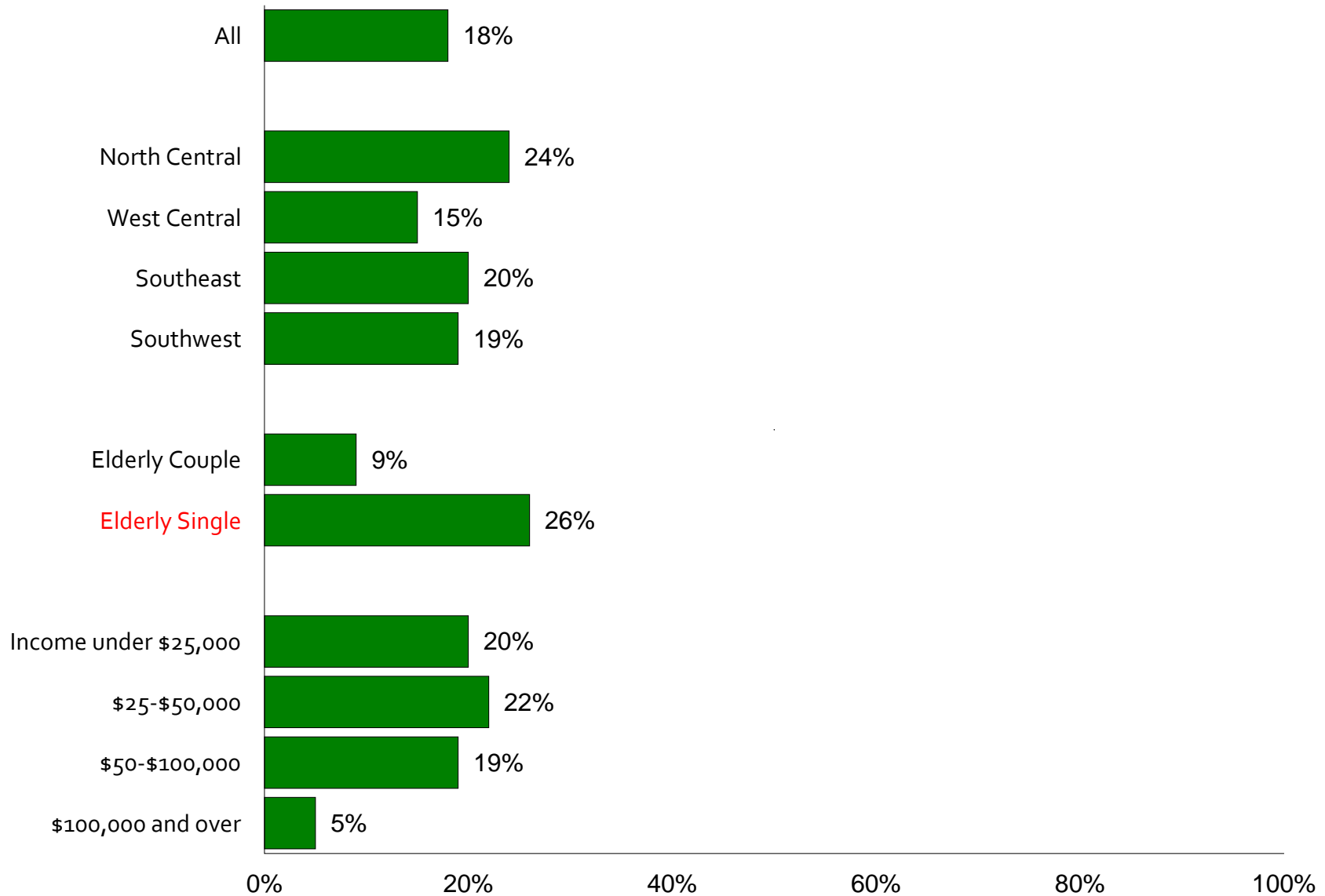

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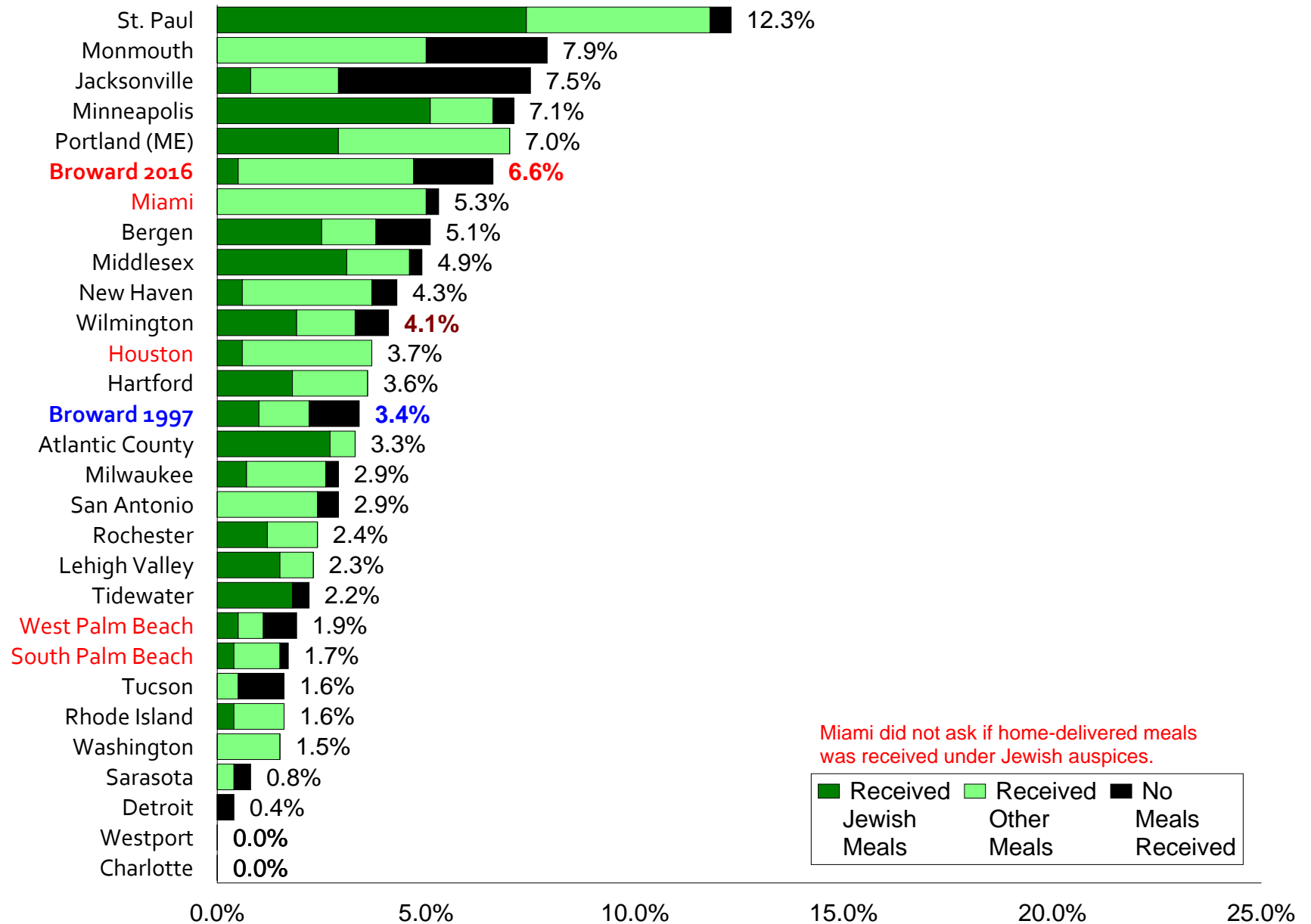

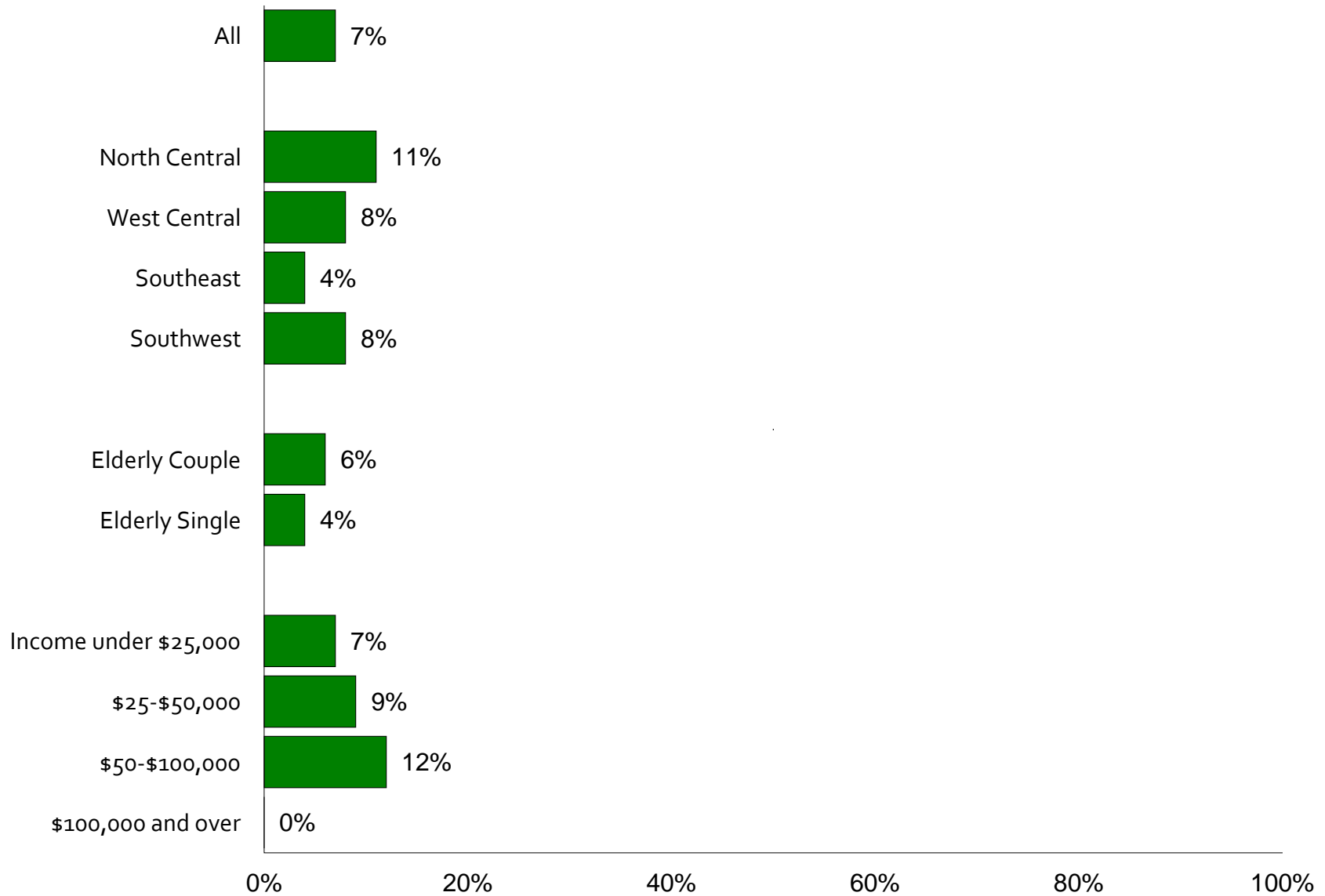

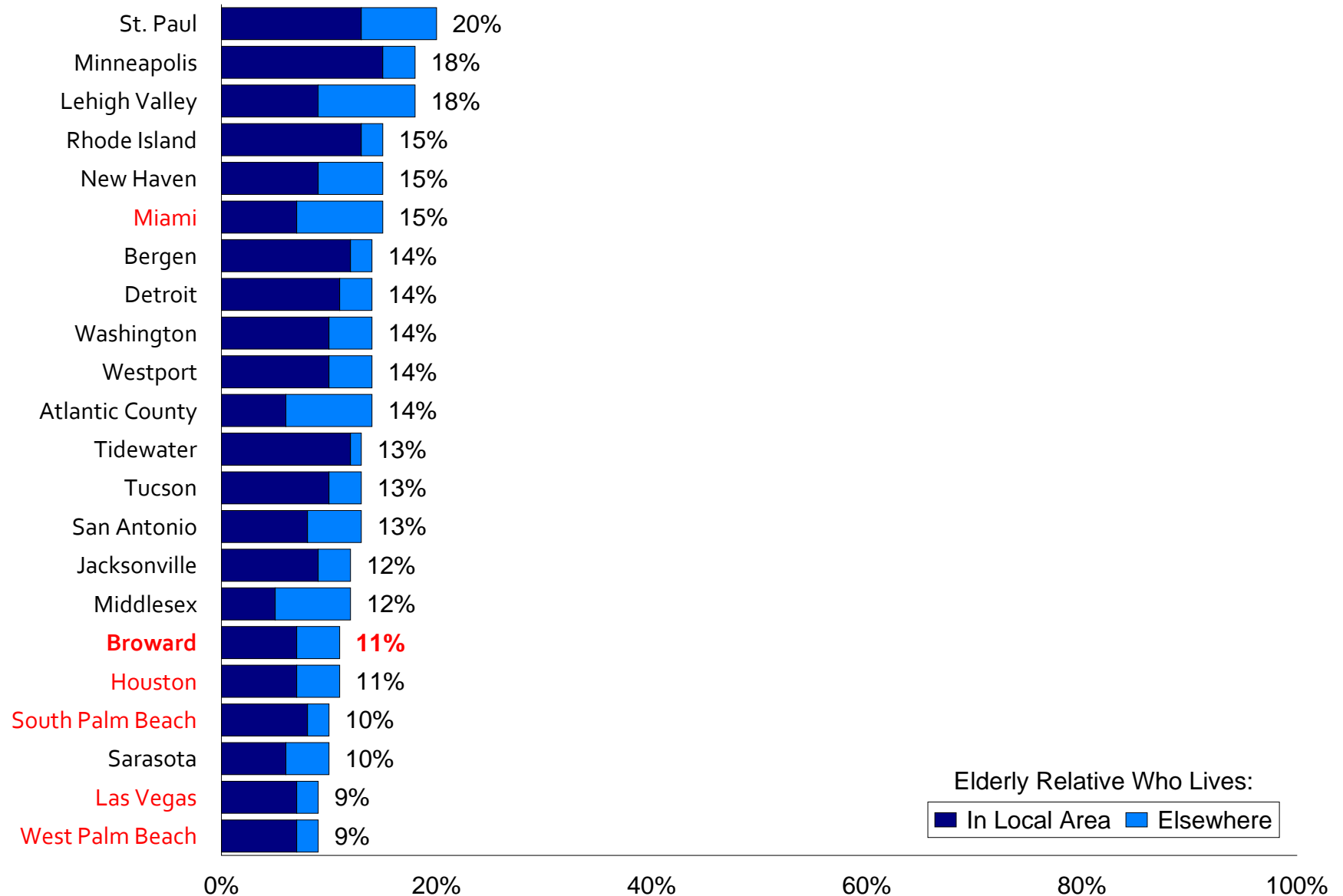

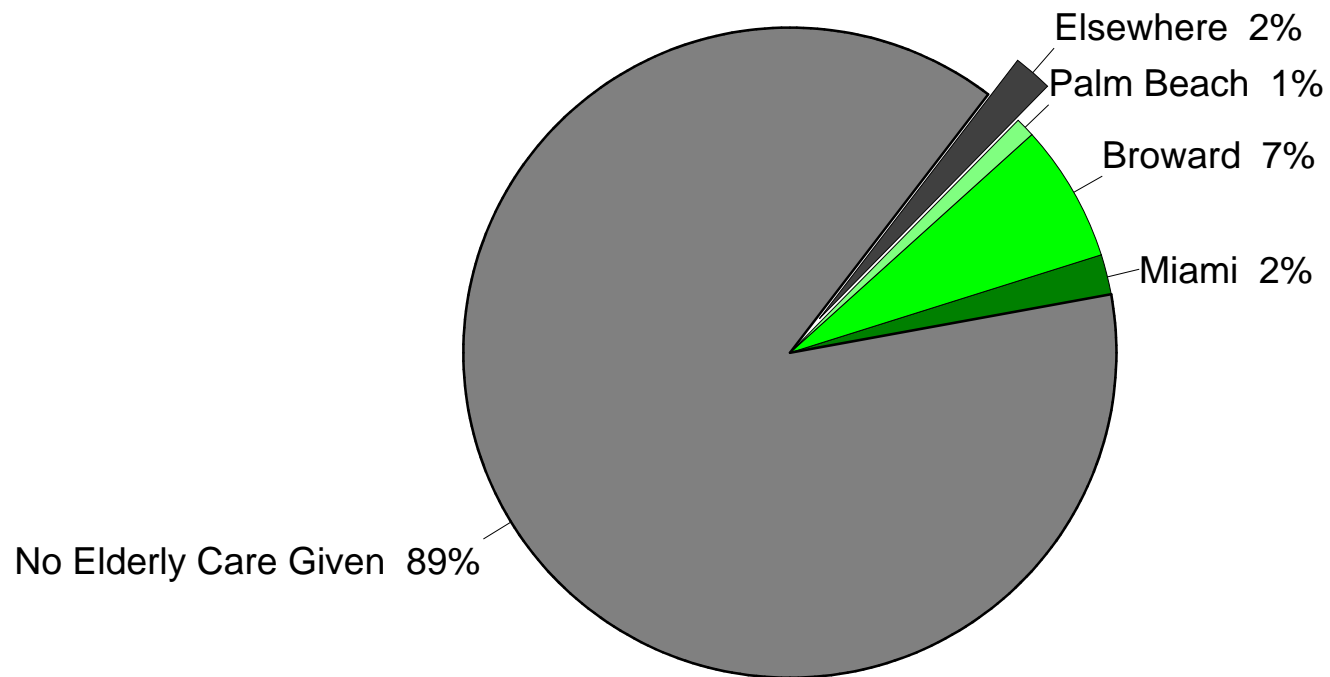

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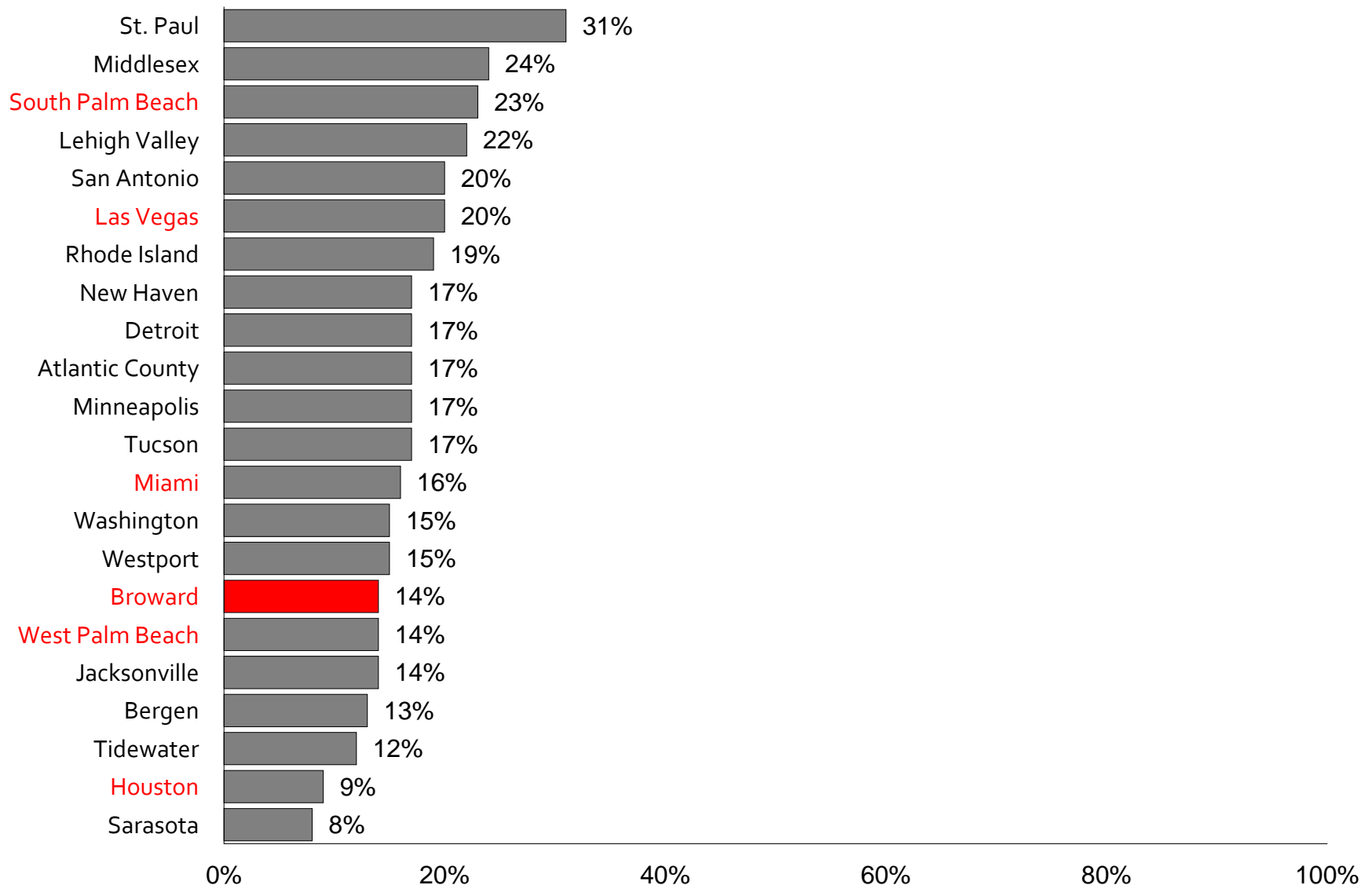
Where Elderly Person Needing Care Lives

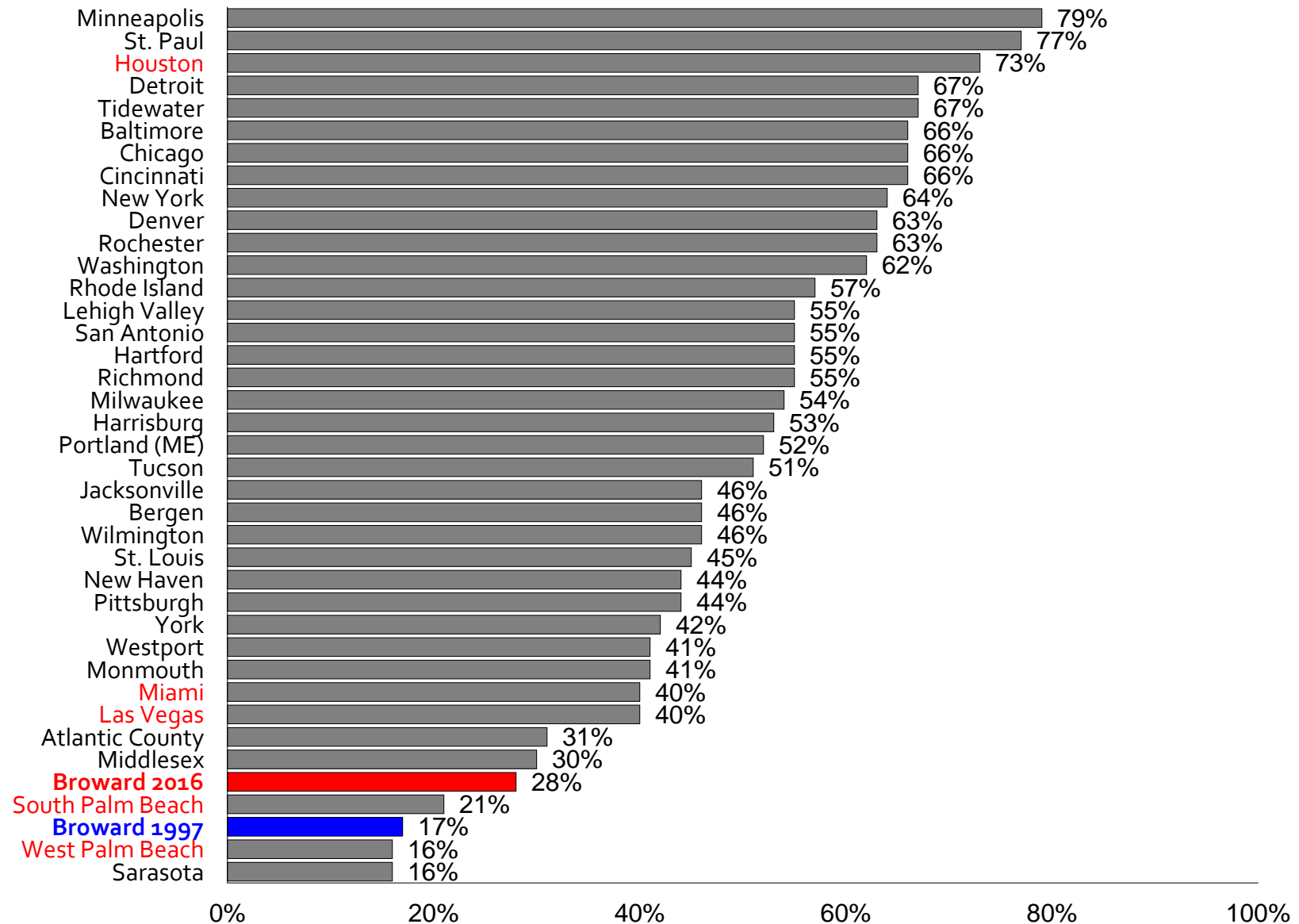


Households with Children Who Care for an Elderly Relative

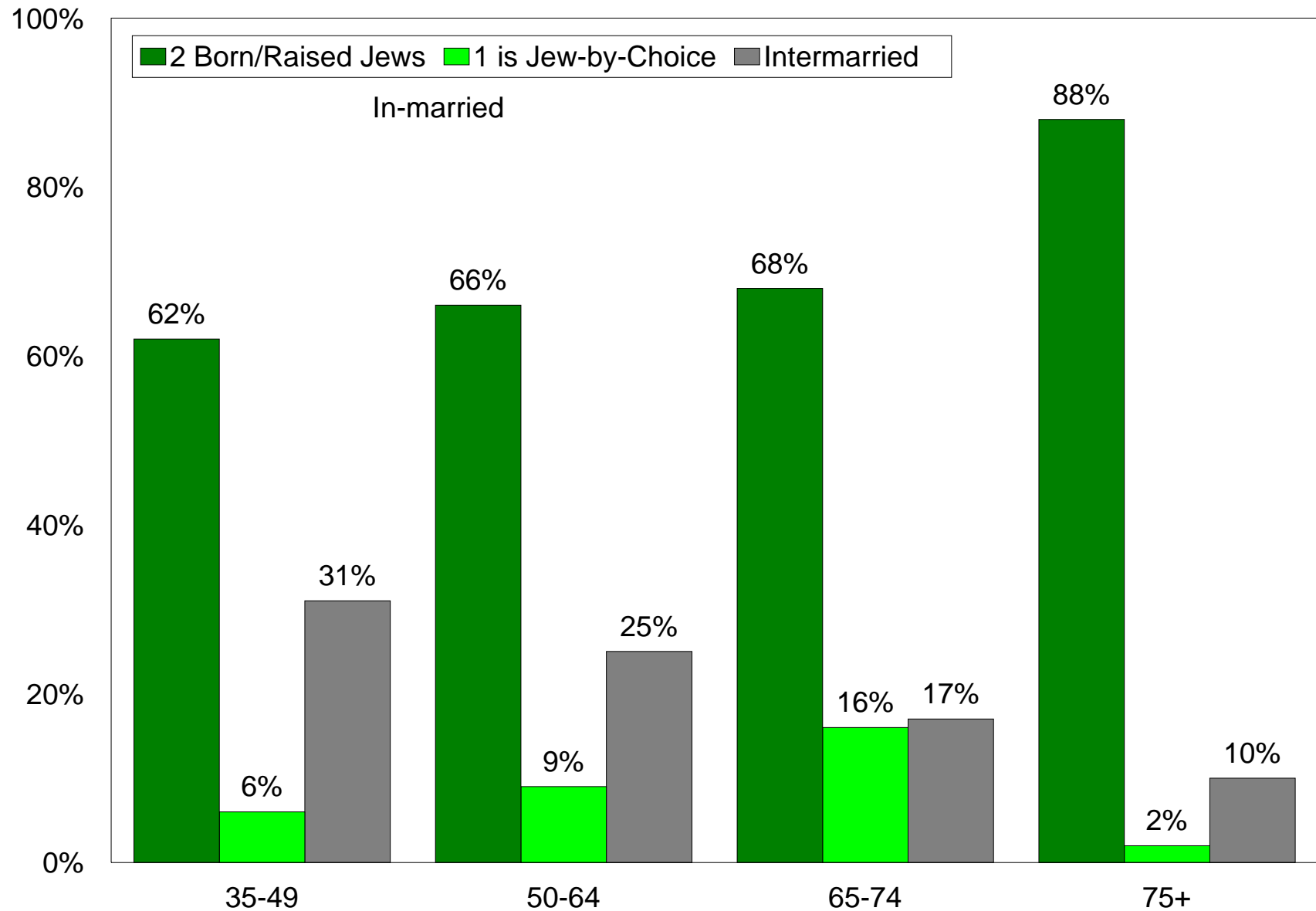


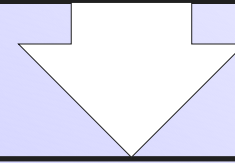
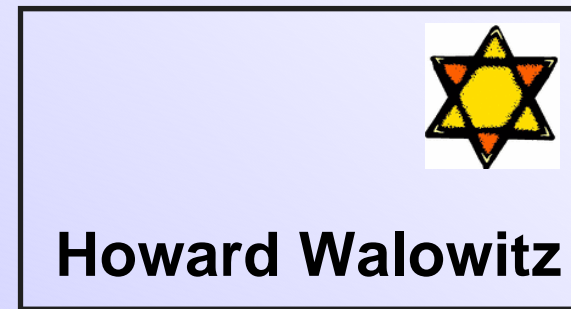
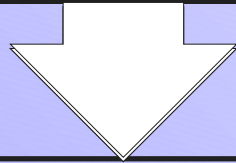
Intermarriage (Couples Intermarriage Rate)



Types of Marriage by Age of Head of Household

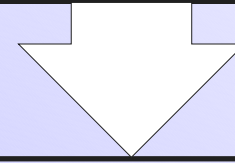
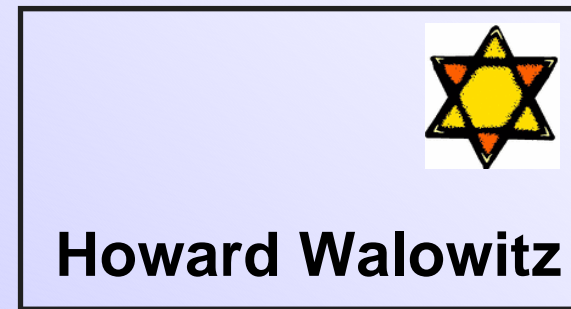
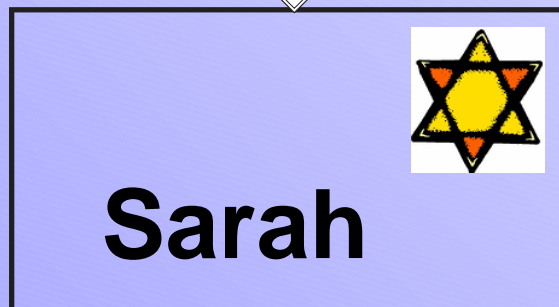
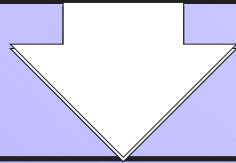

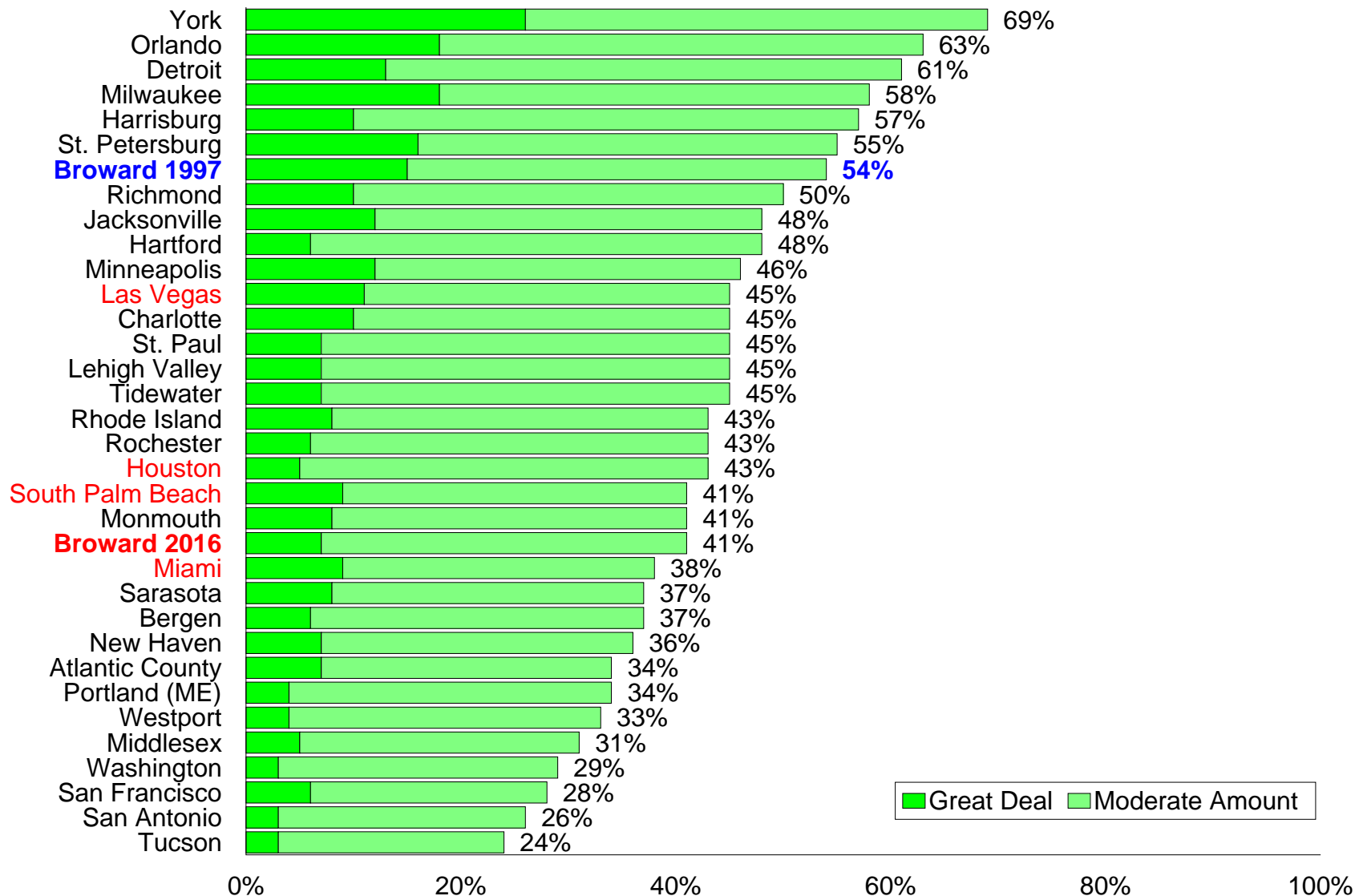
Personally Experienced Anti-Semitism in Local Community in the Past Year

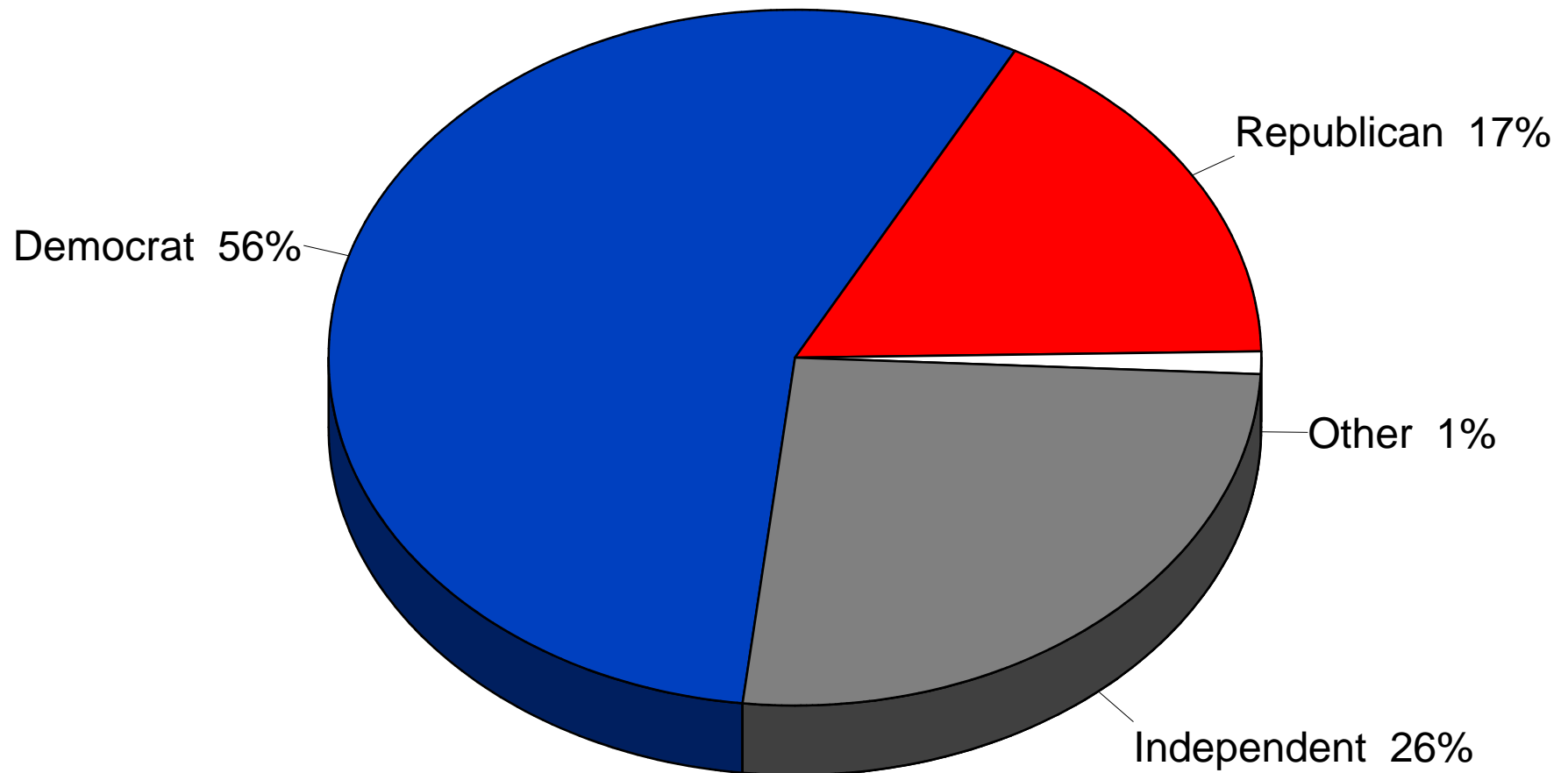
