# Survey Methodology

- Random Digit Dialing (RDD) Telephone Survey methodology provides scientific validity
  - Population estimate
  - Produces the “purest” random sample
- (954) 435 - \_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_
- RDD Telephone Survey(300 surveys)
- List Telephone Survey (900 surveys)
- Cell Phone Households with non-local area codes with DJNs based on billing zip codes
- 1,200interviews
- Response Rate (AAPOR RR<sub>3</sub>) is 39%and cooperation rate is 83%
- Weighting factors are used to combine the samples
- Interviews averaged about 22 minutes each
- Phones were dialed 121,477 times
- Interviewing April to June 2016

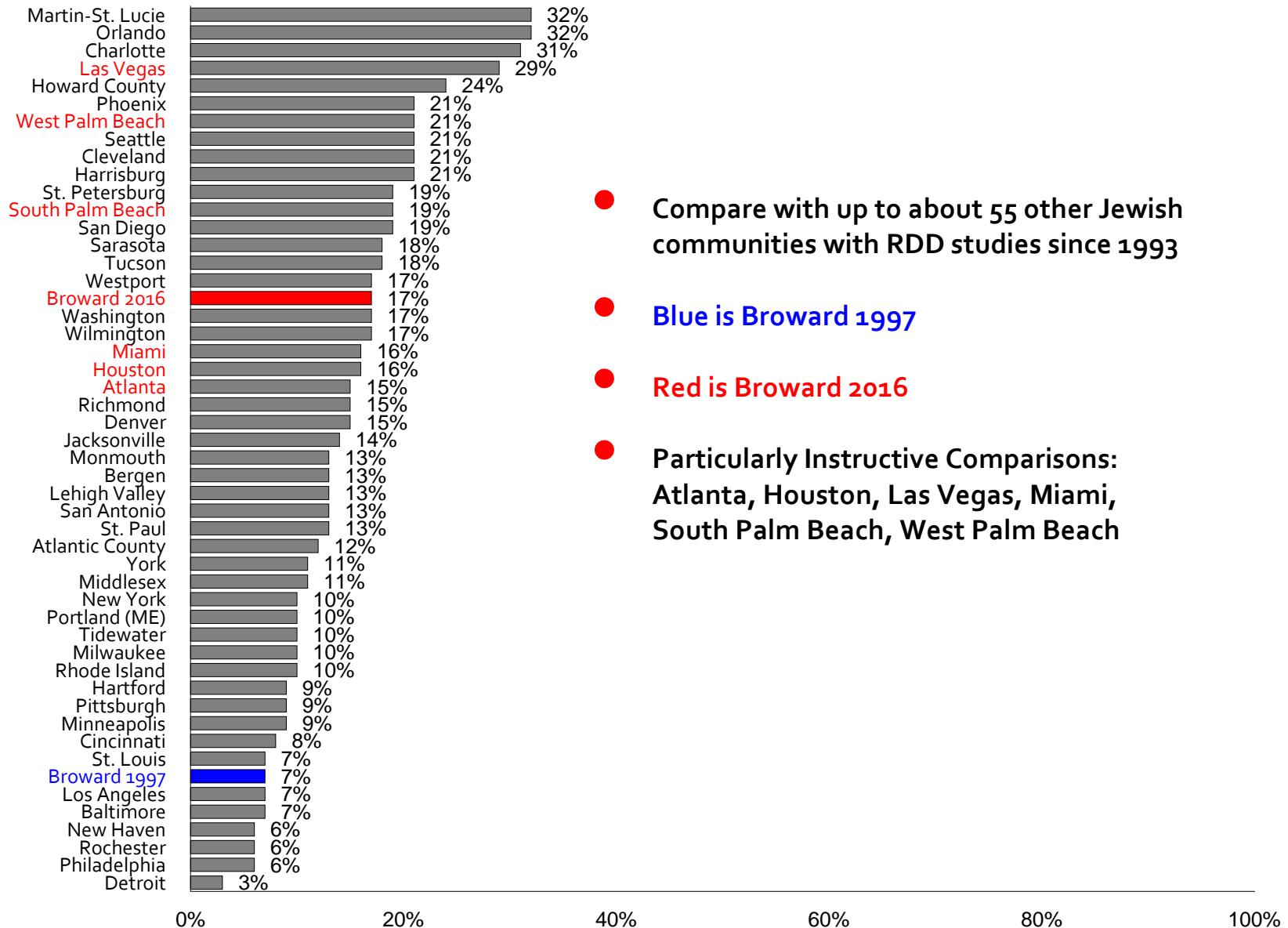

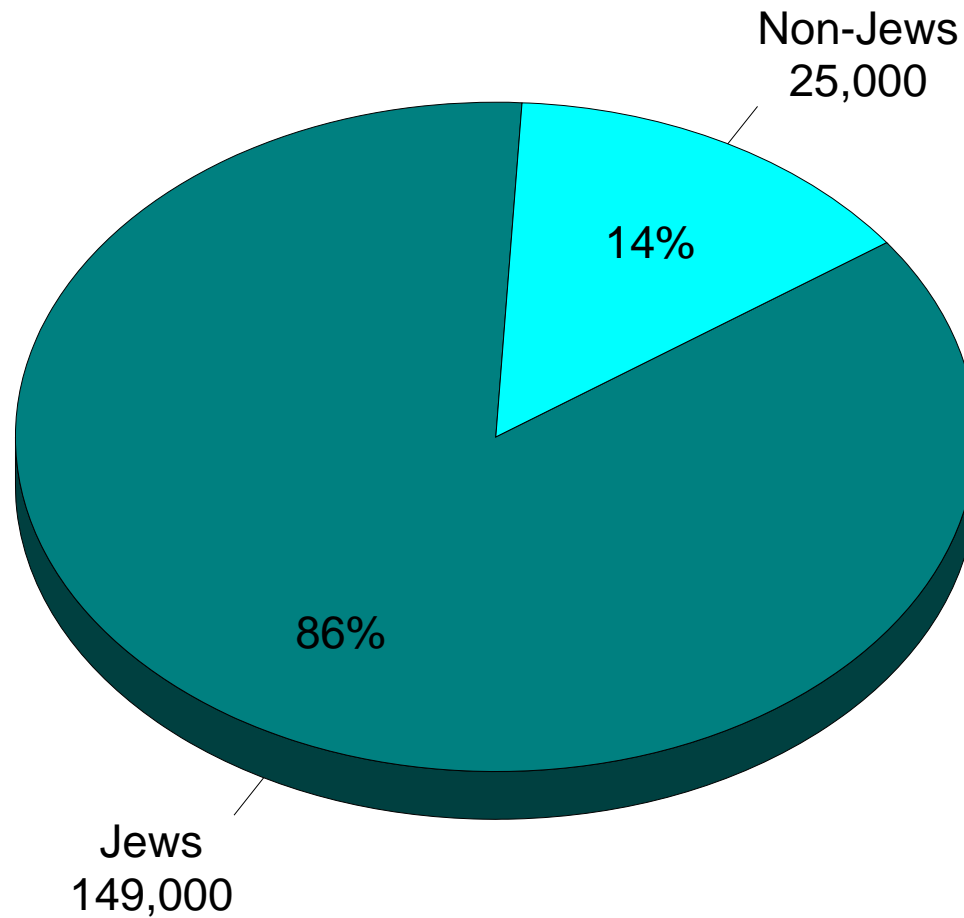


## **Jewish Population Size and Geography**



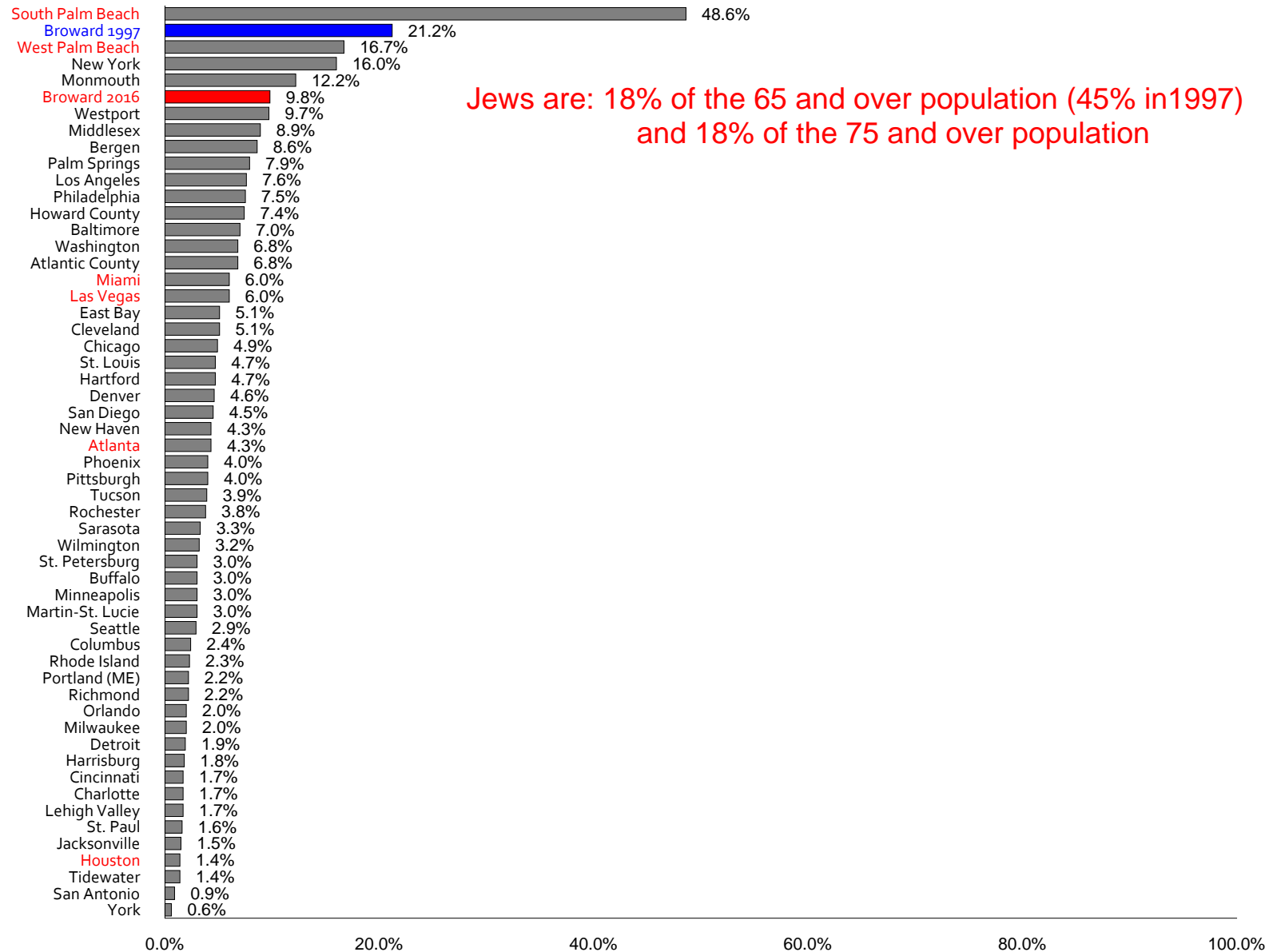

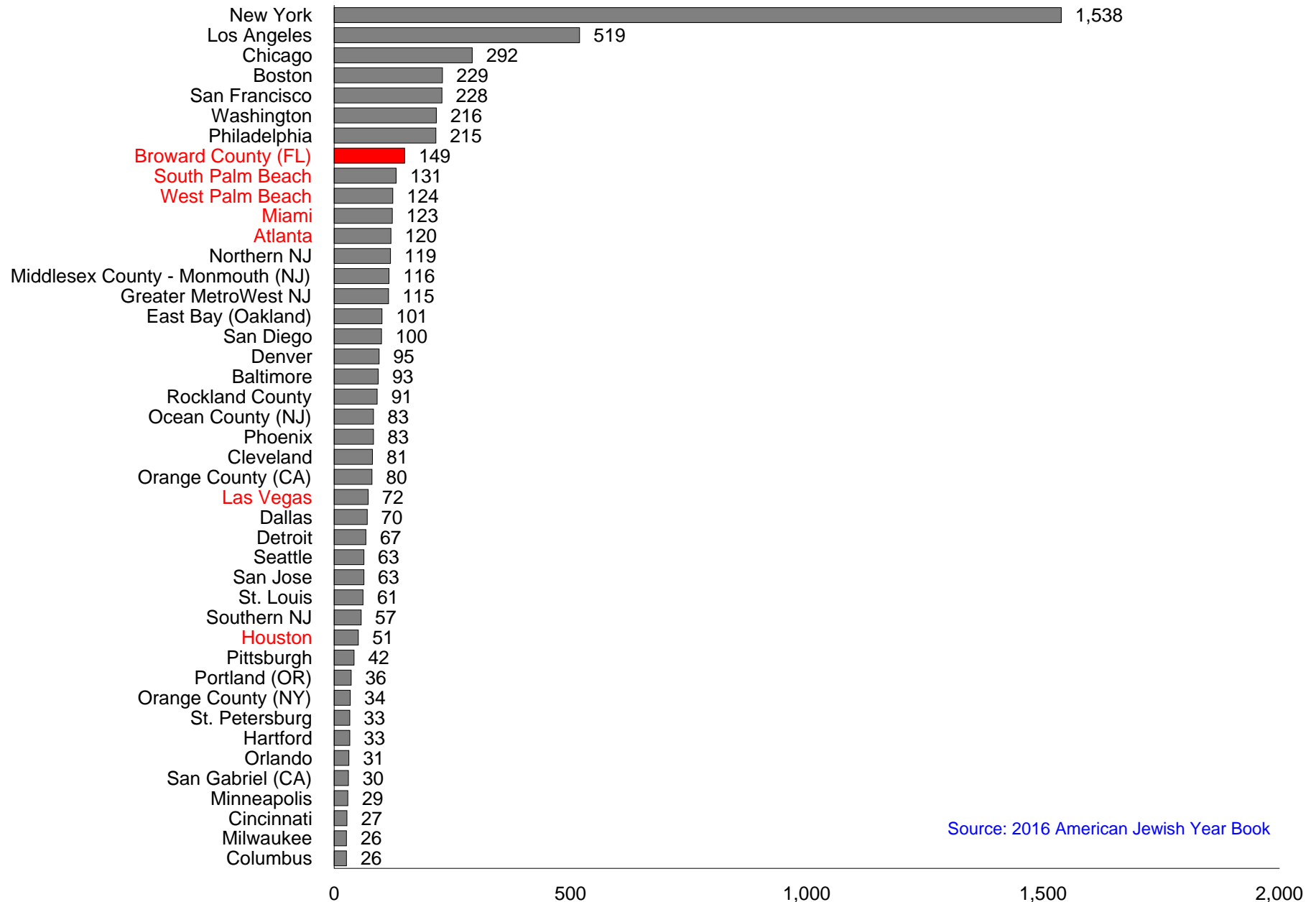
# Percentage of Households in the Community Who Are Jewish Households

# American Jewish Communities of 50,000+: 2016

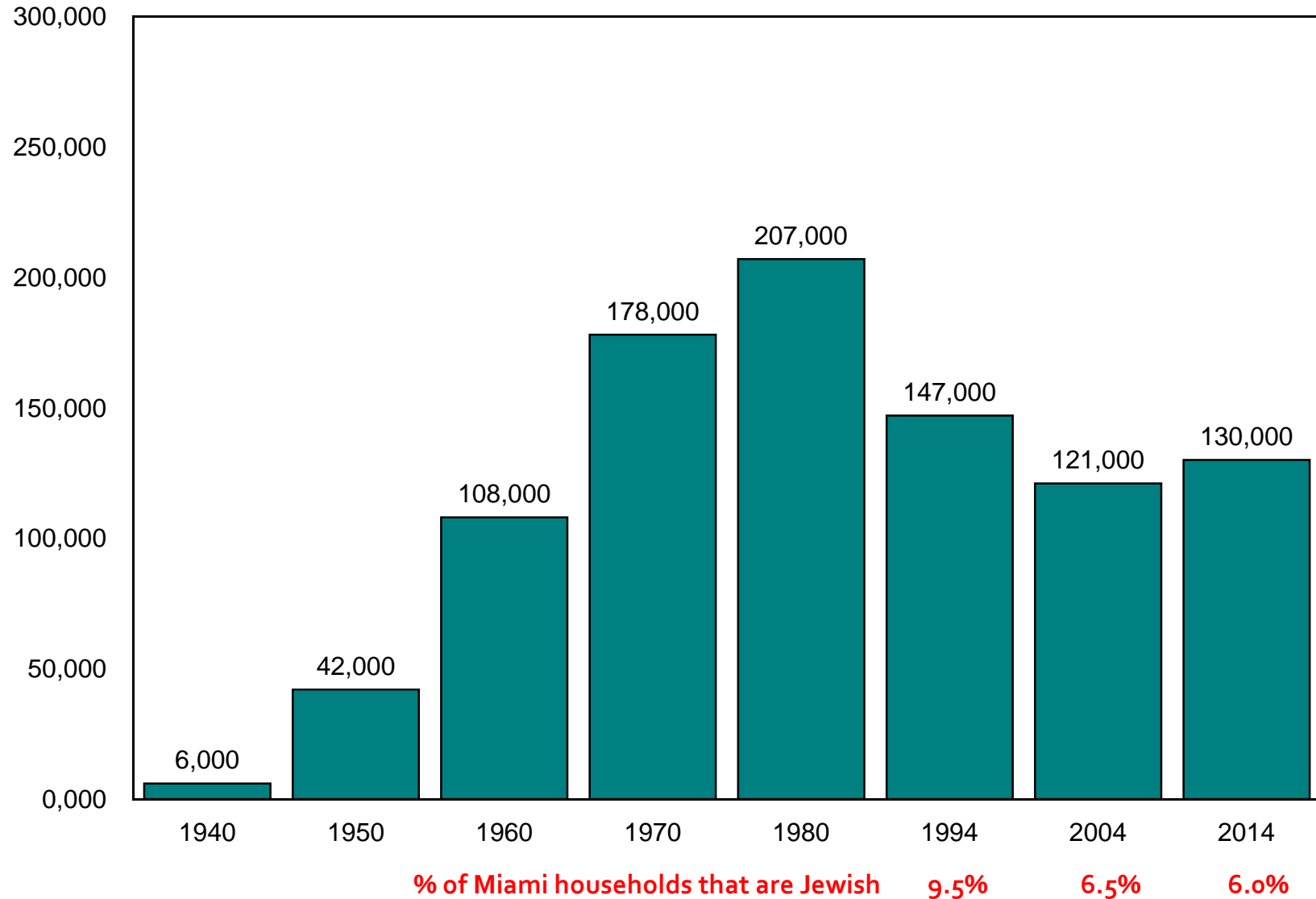

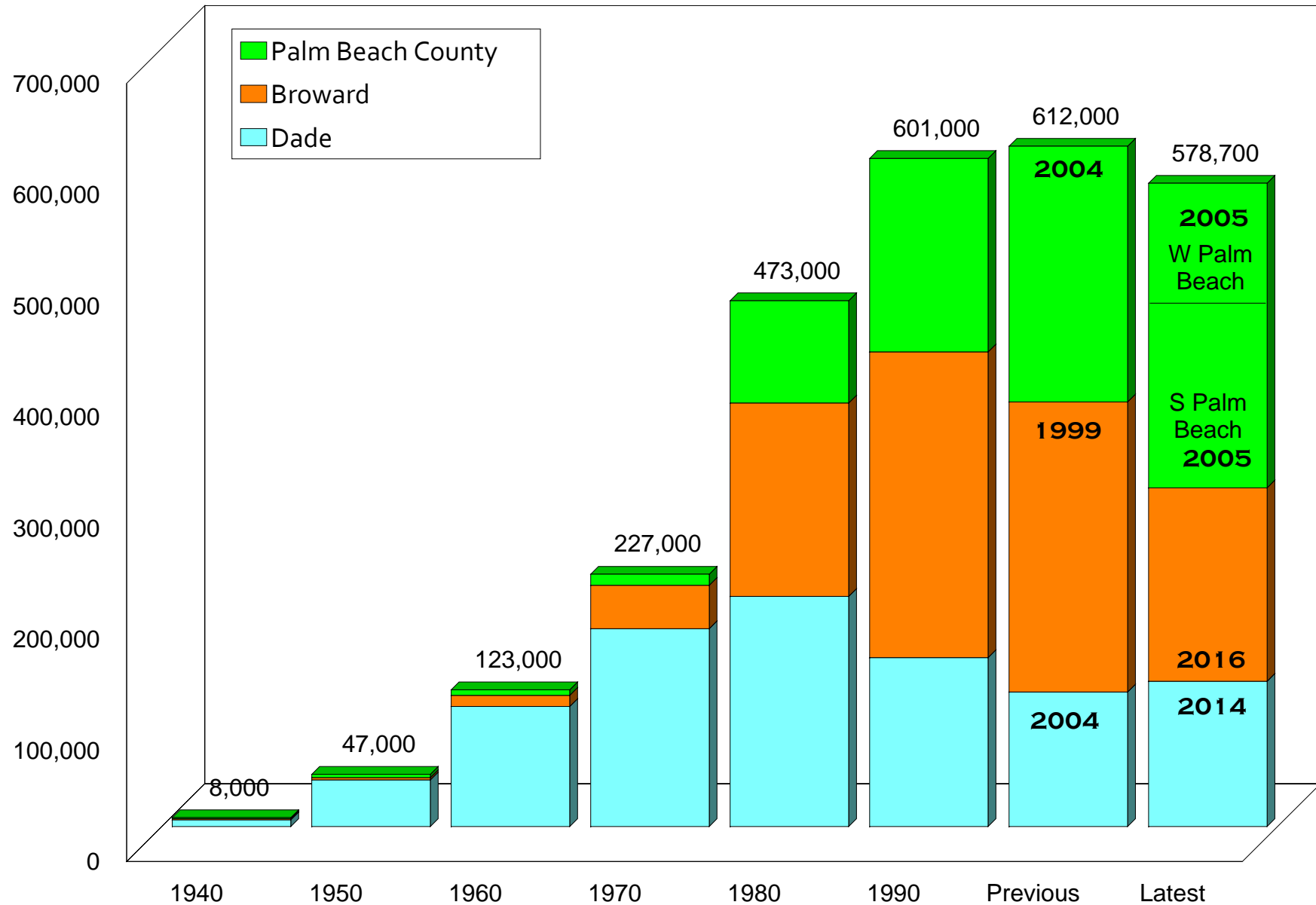

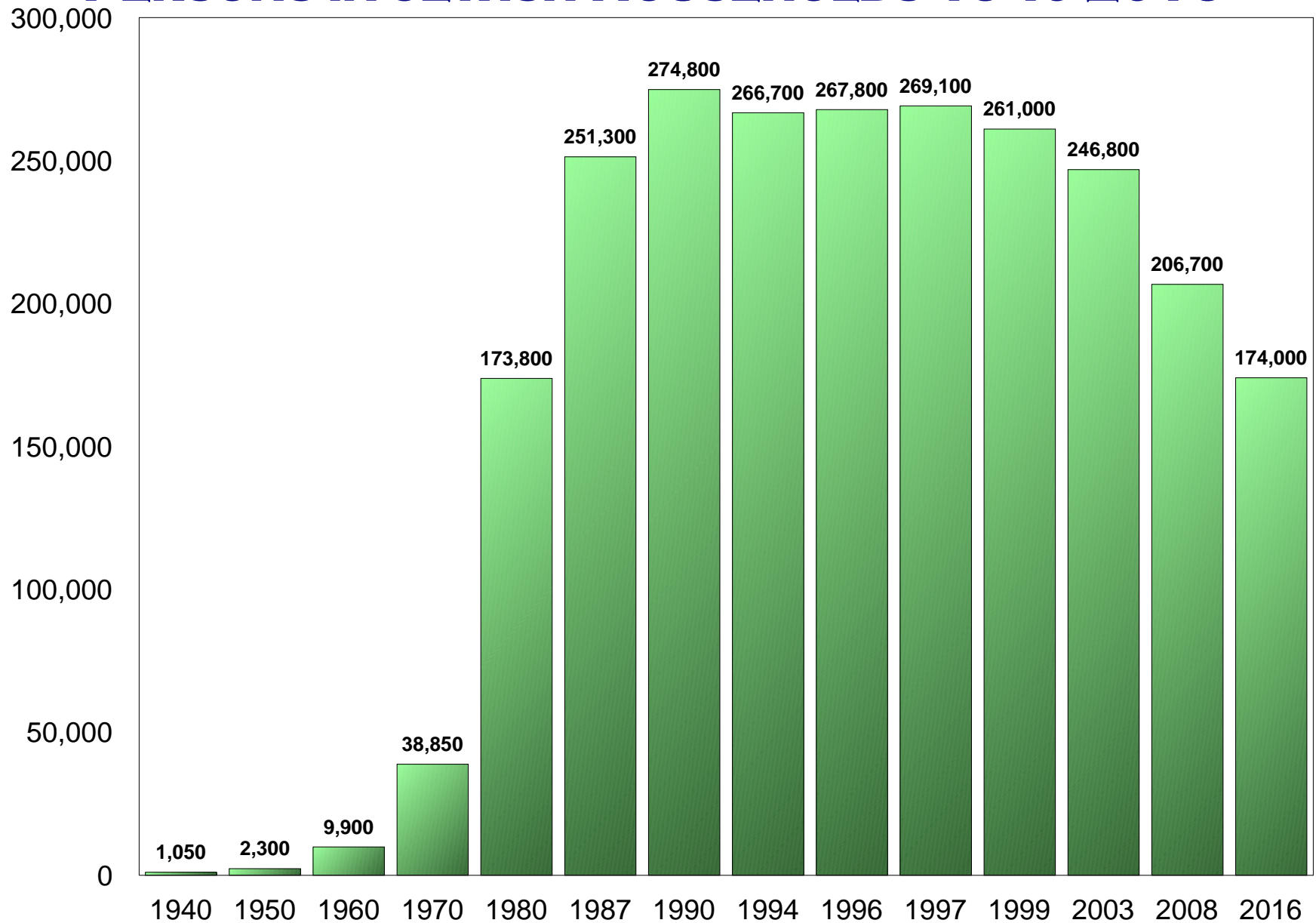

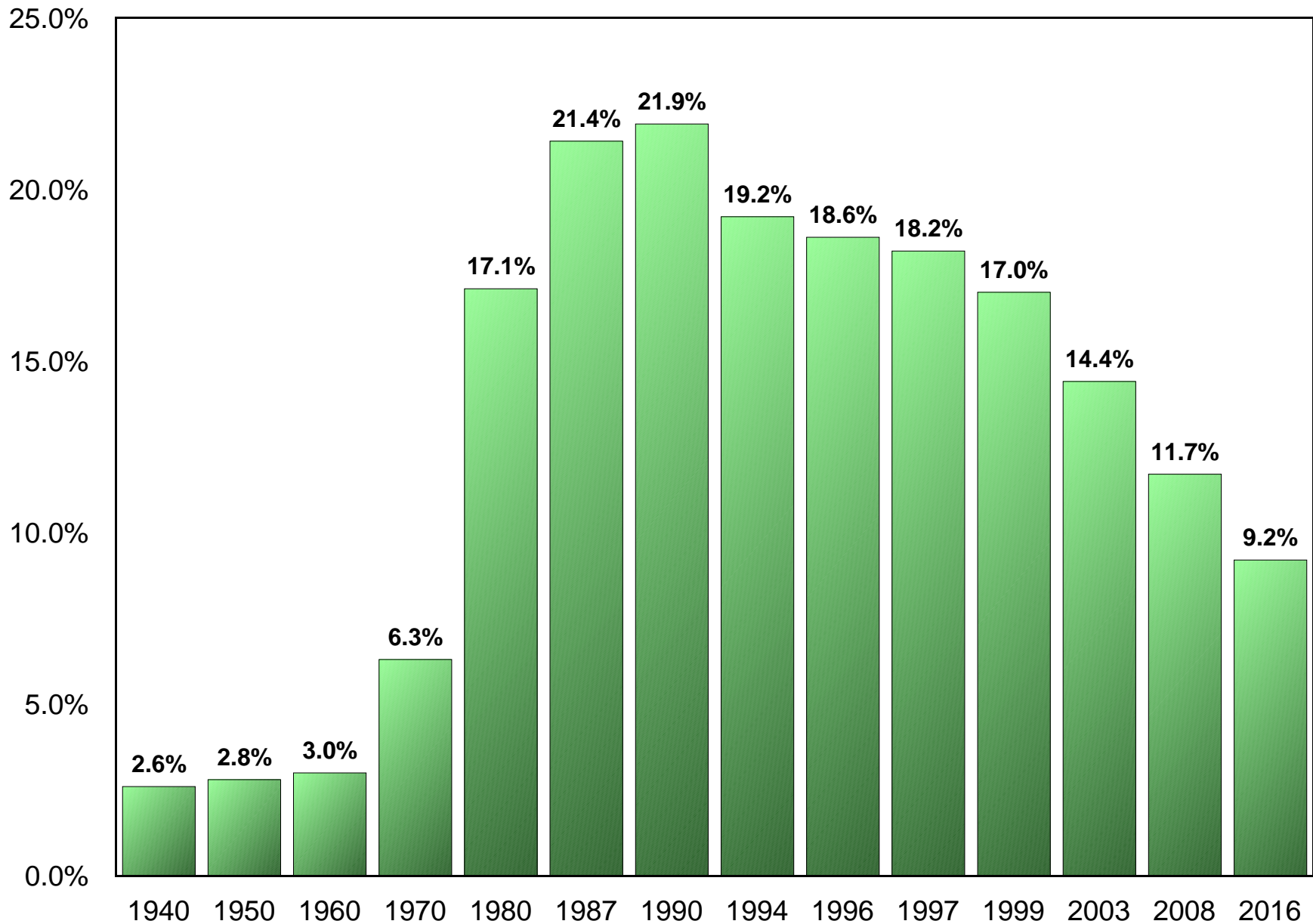

### PERSONS IN JEWISH HOUSEHOLDS 1940-2016

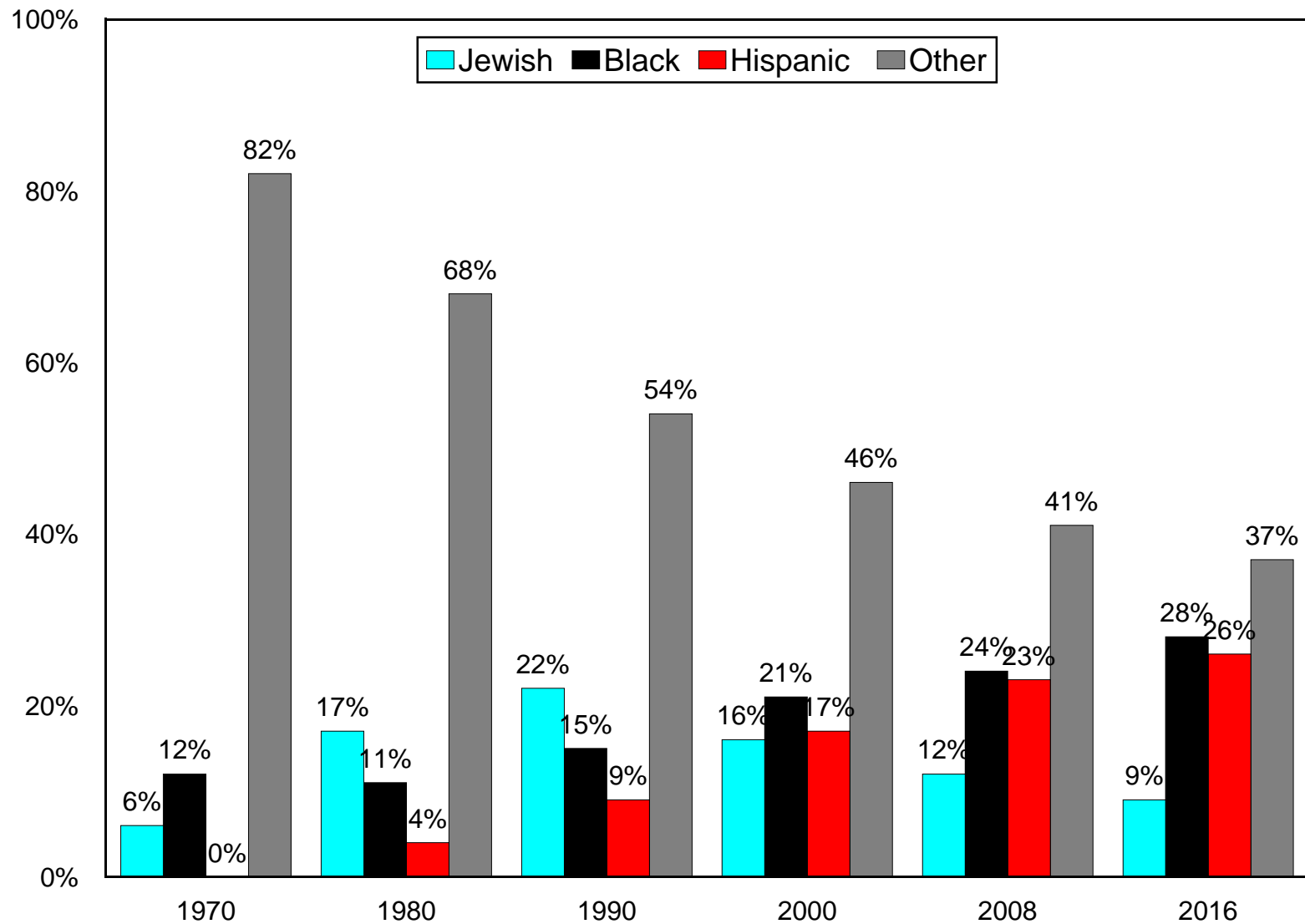

## Ethnic Change in Broward 1970-2016

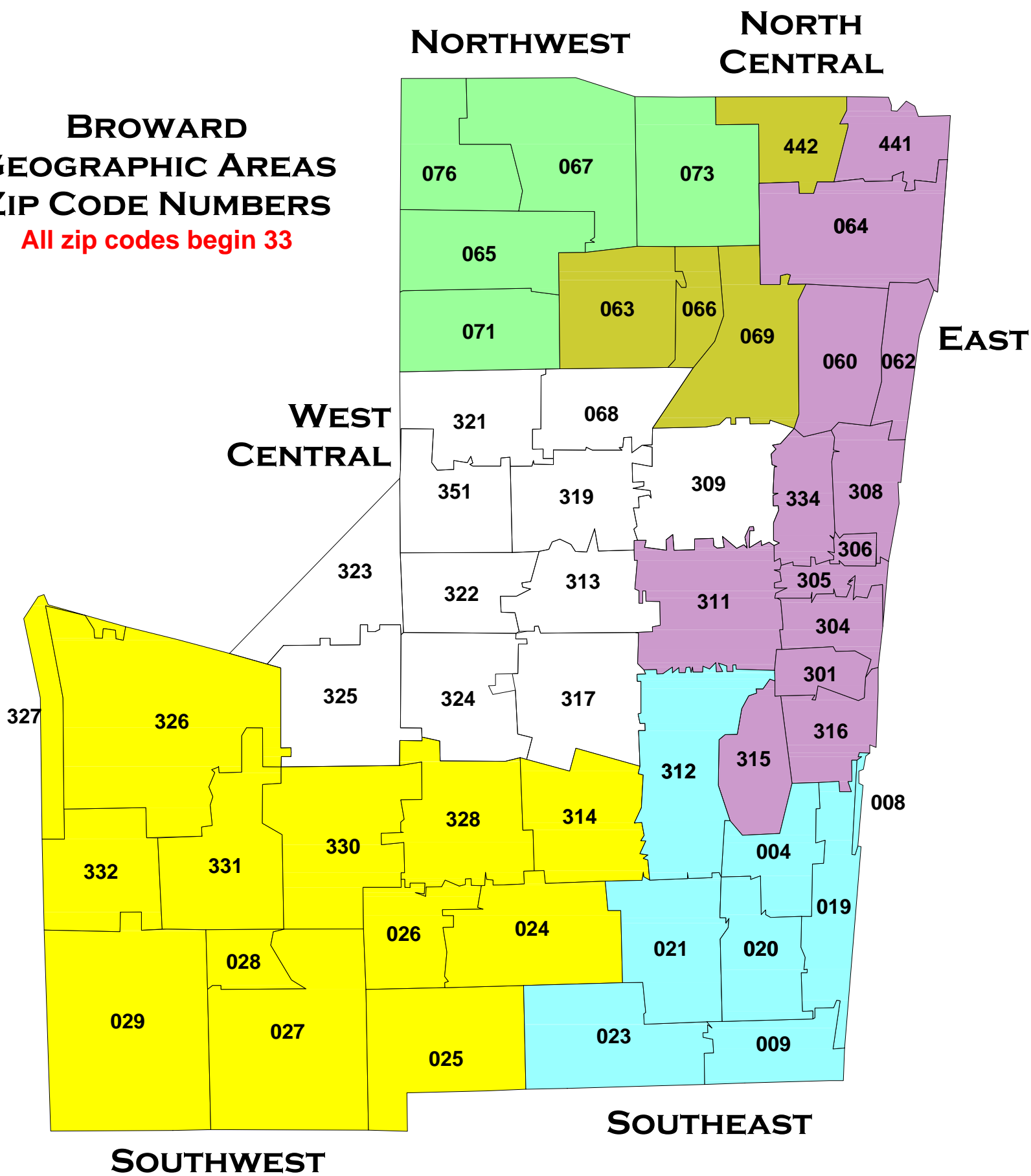

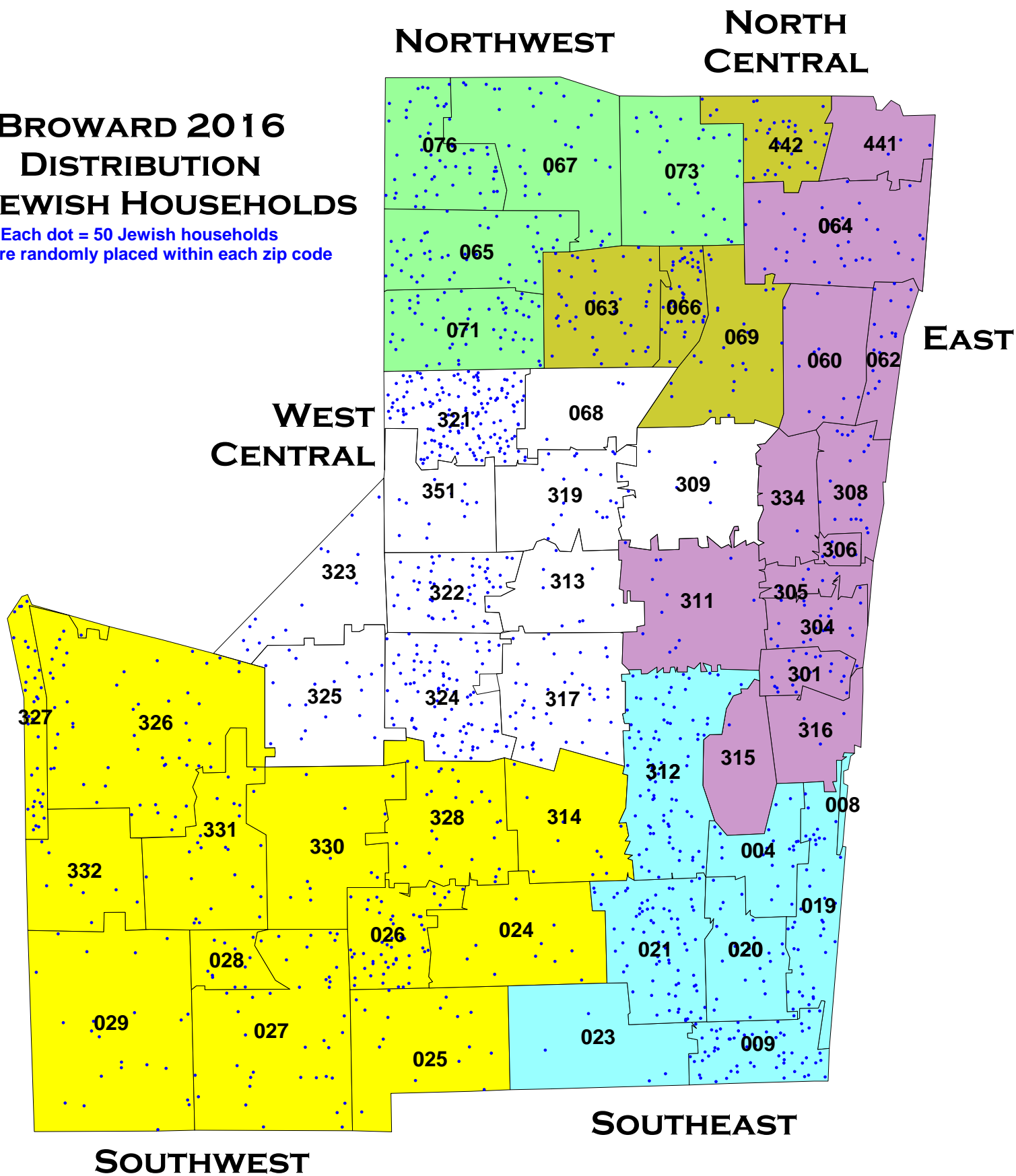

Dots are randomly placed within each zip code

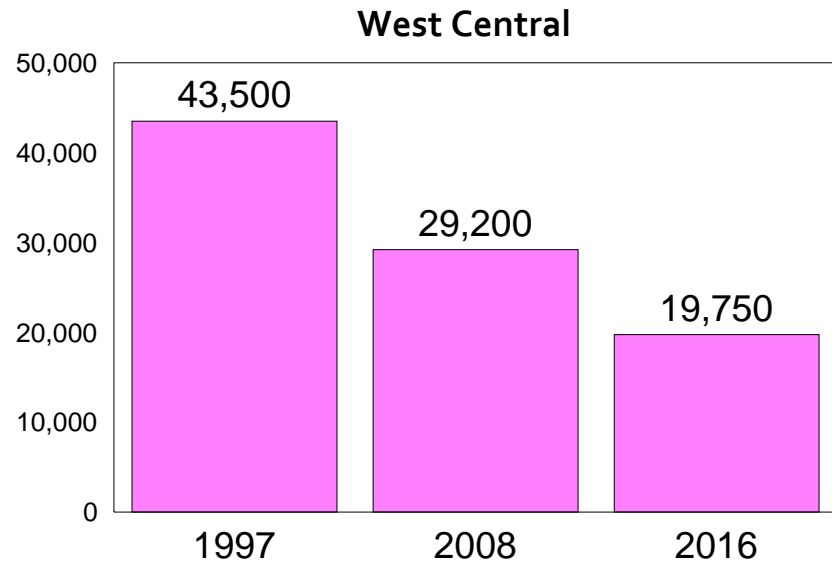
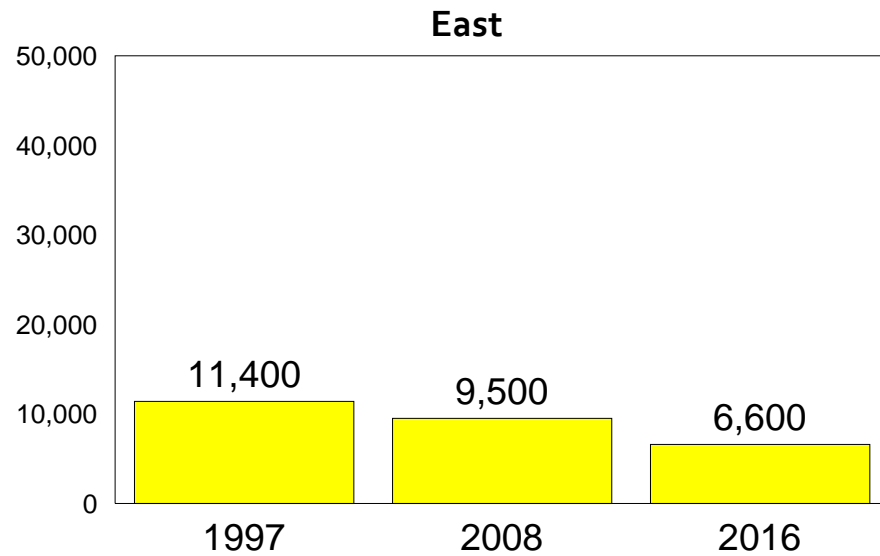
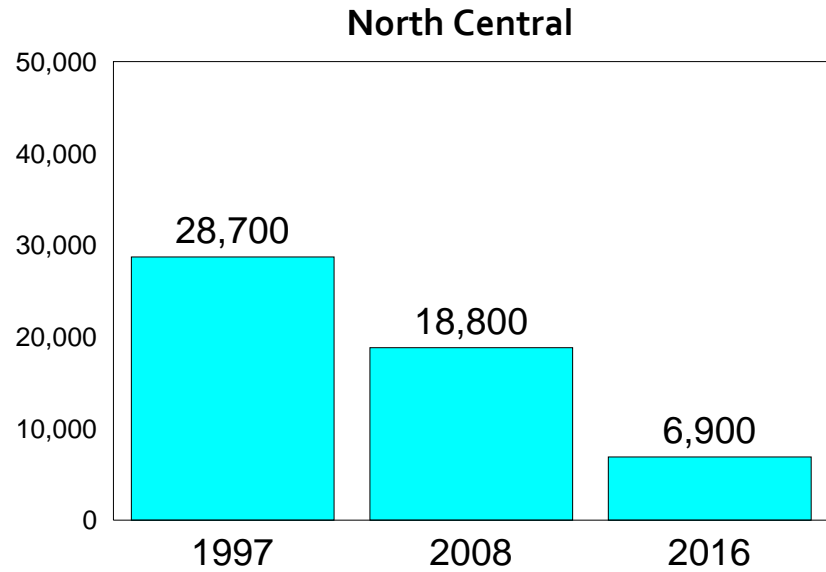
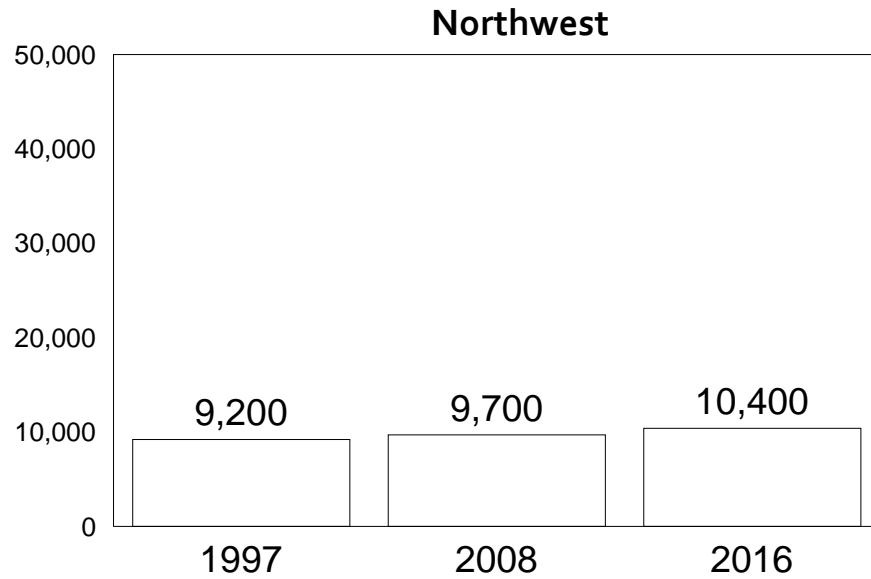

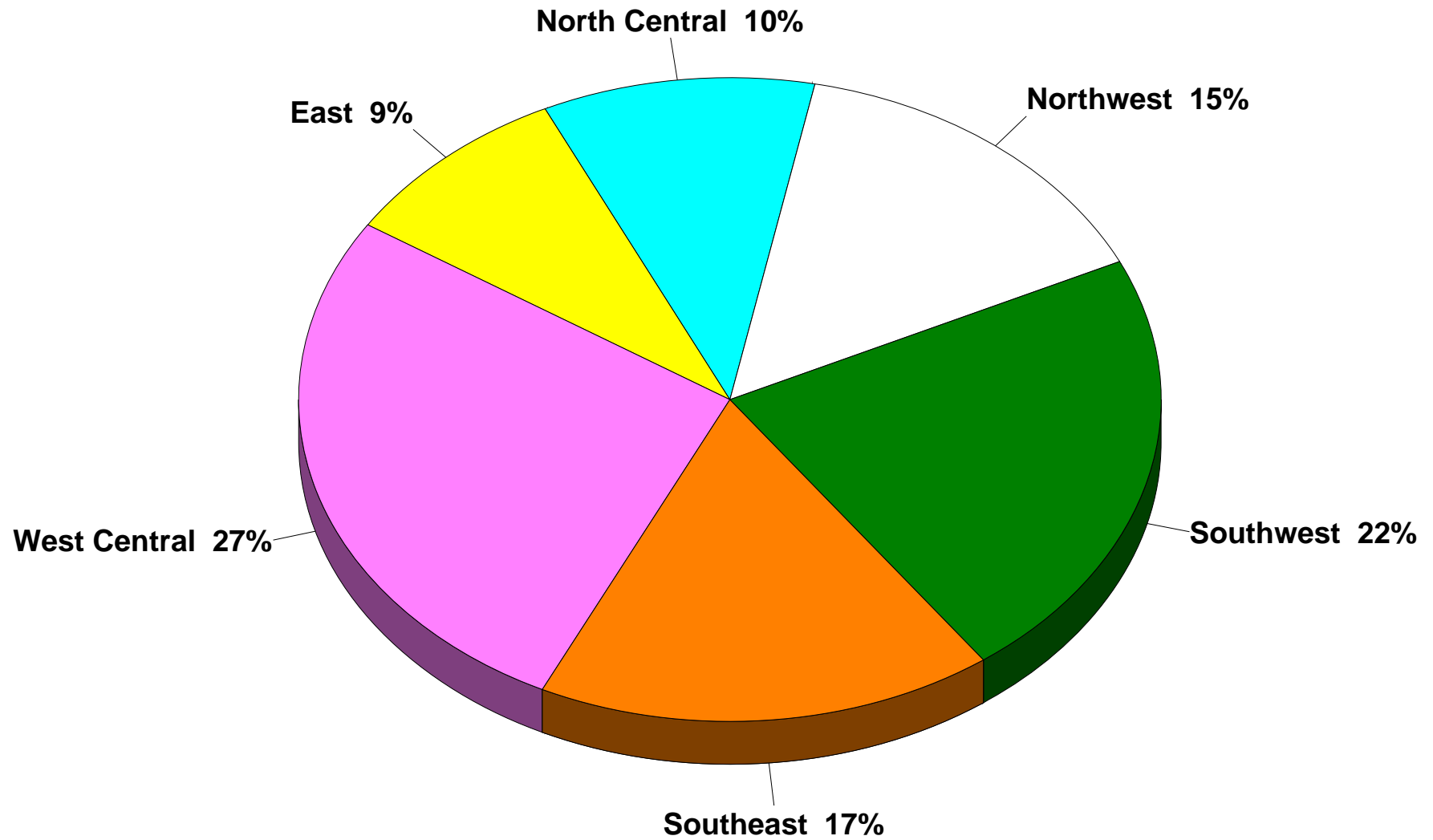

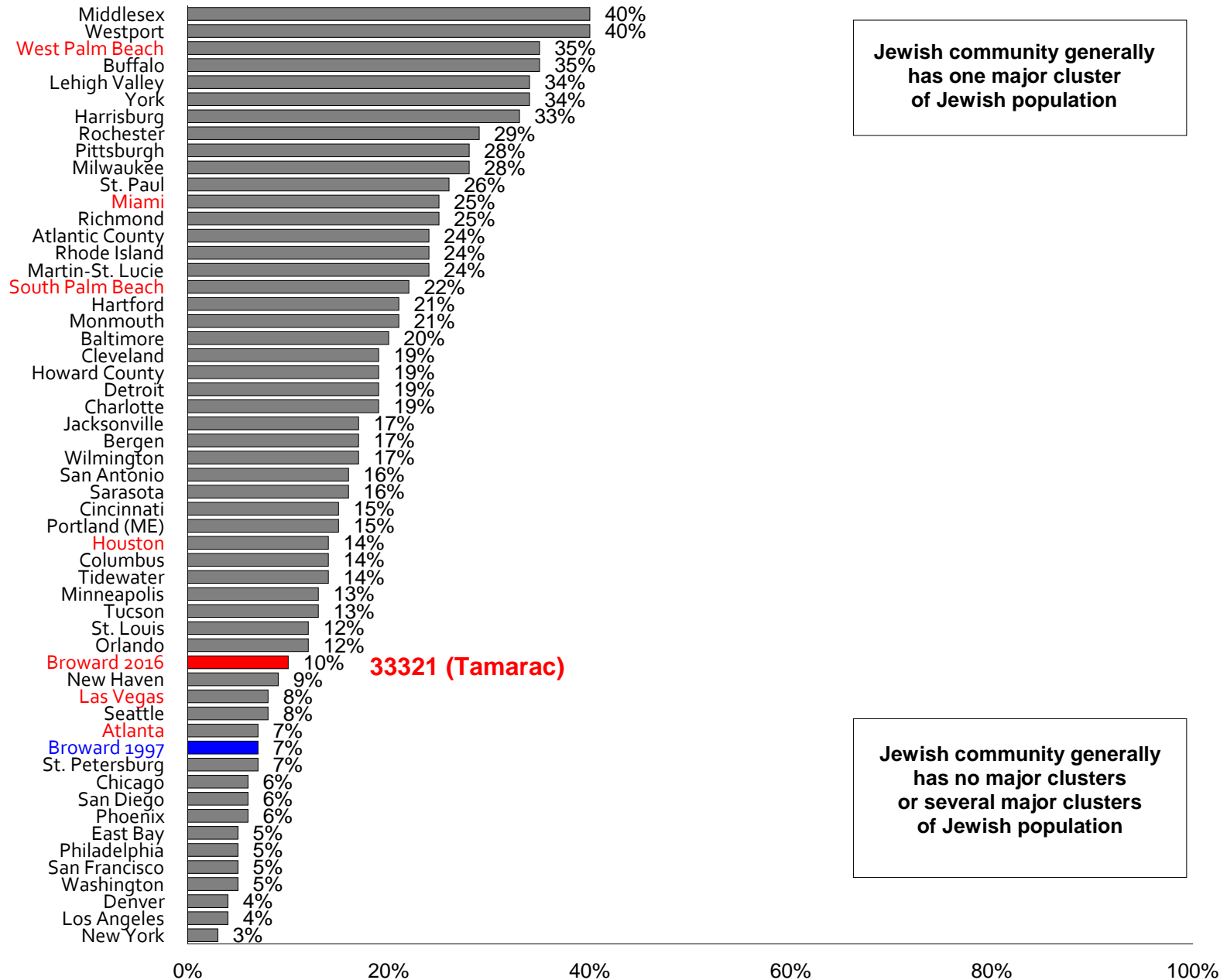


# Distribution of Jewish Households



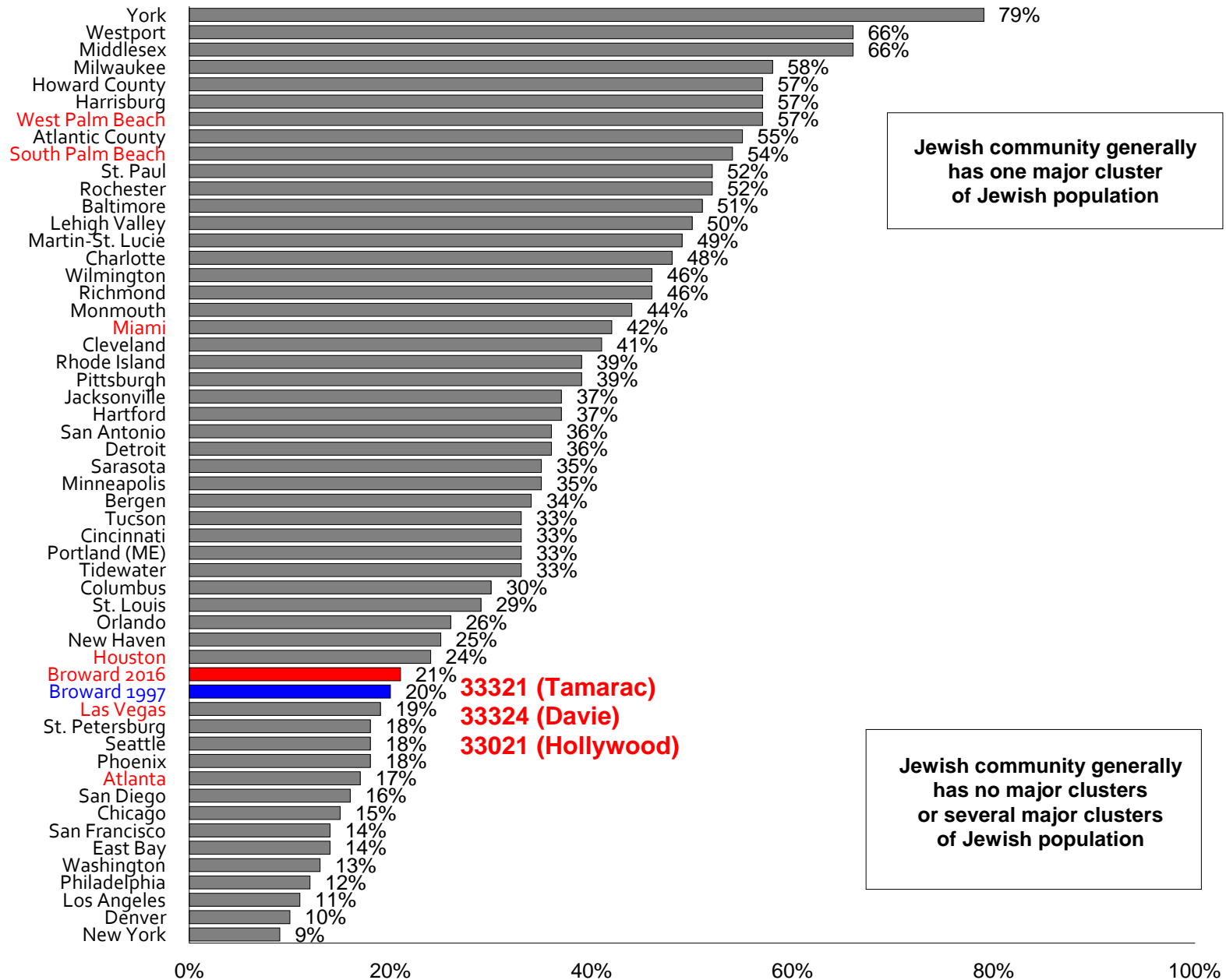
# Households in Top Zip Code Area

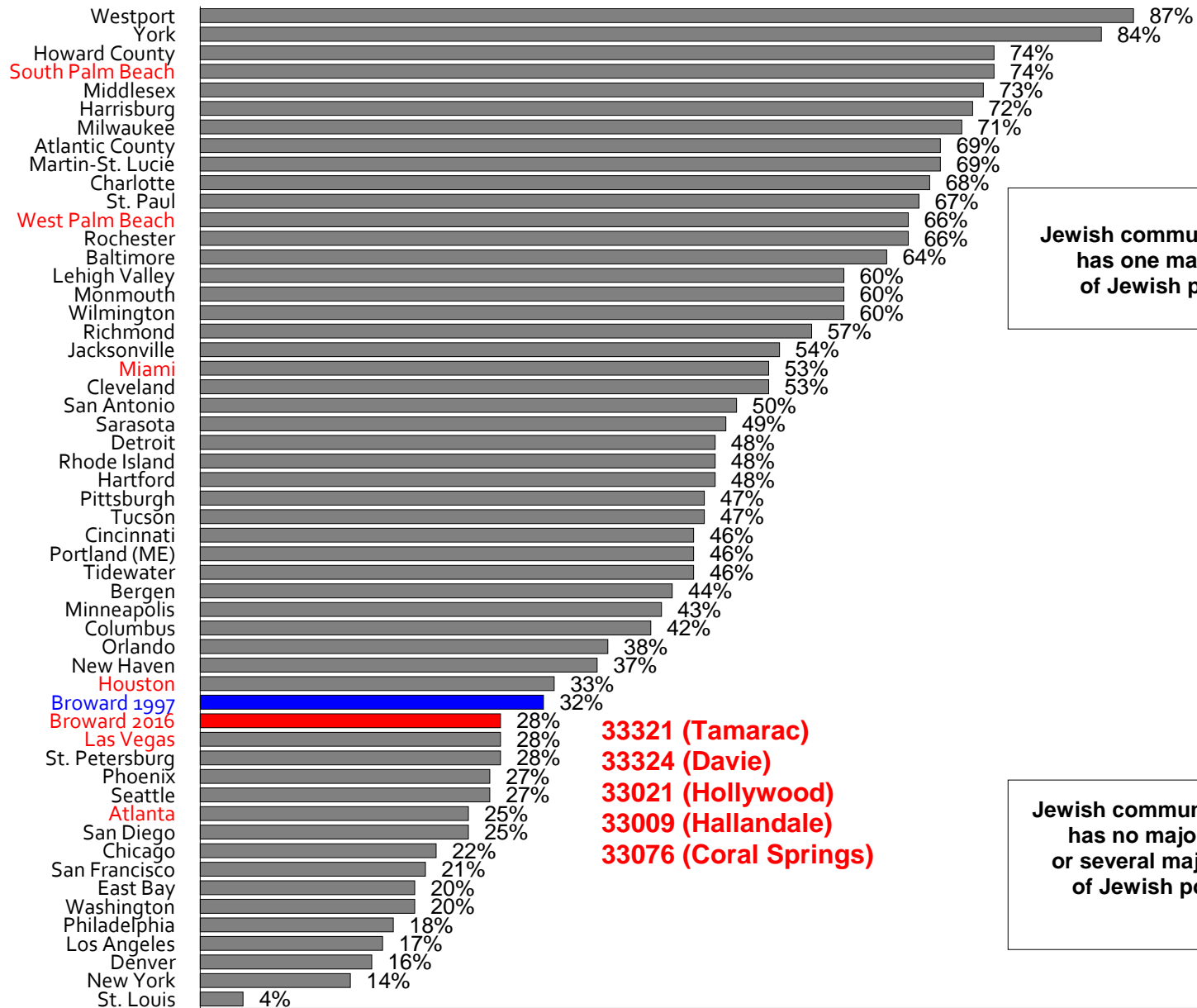
# Households in Top Three Zip Code Areas

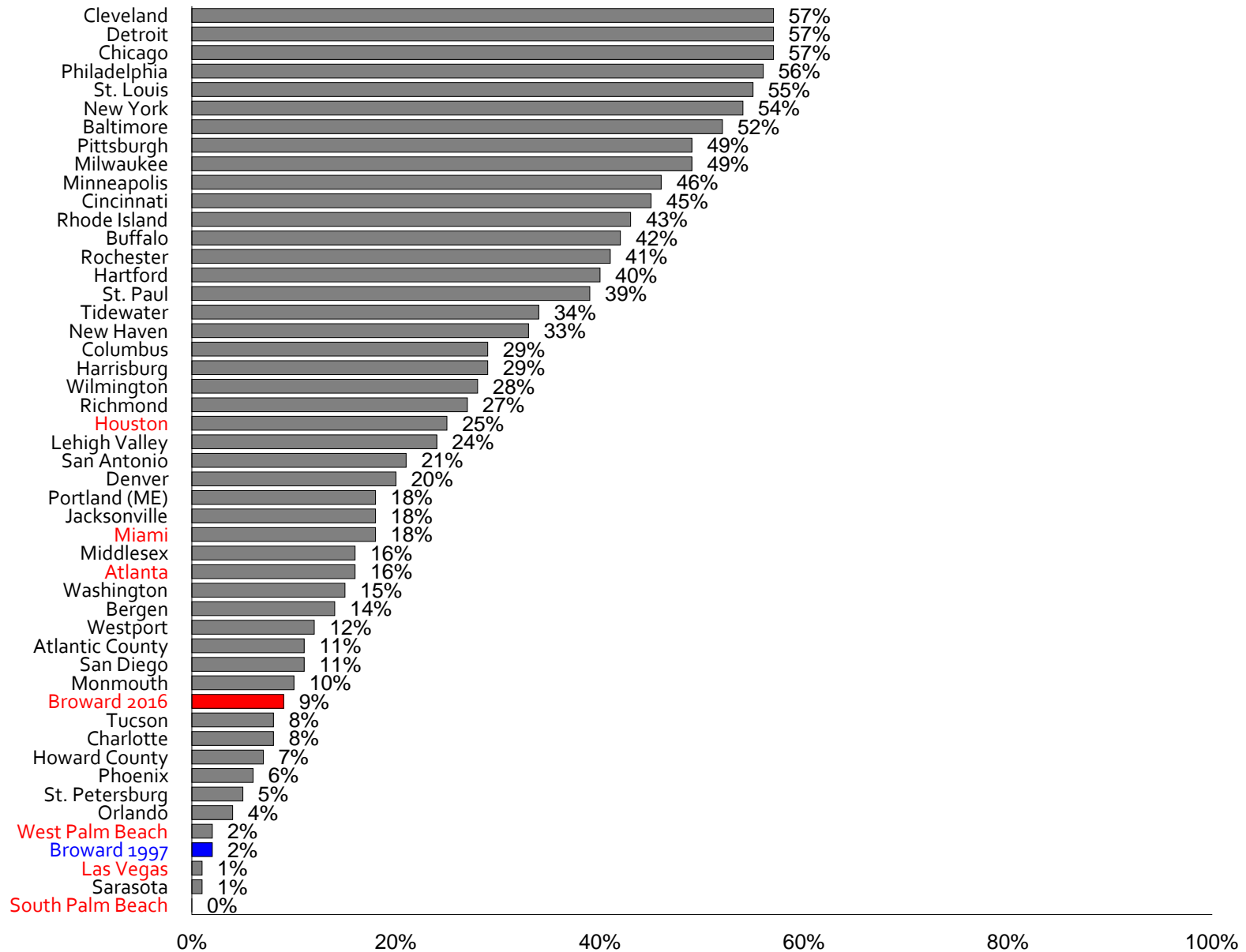

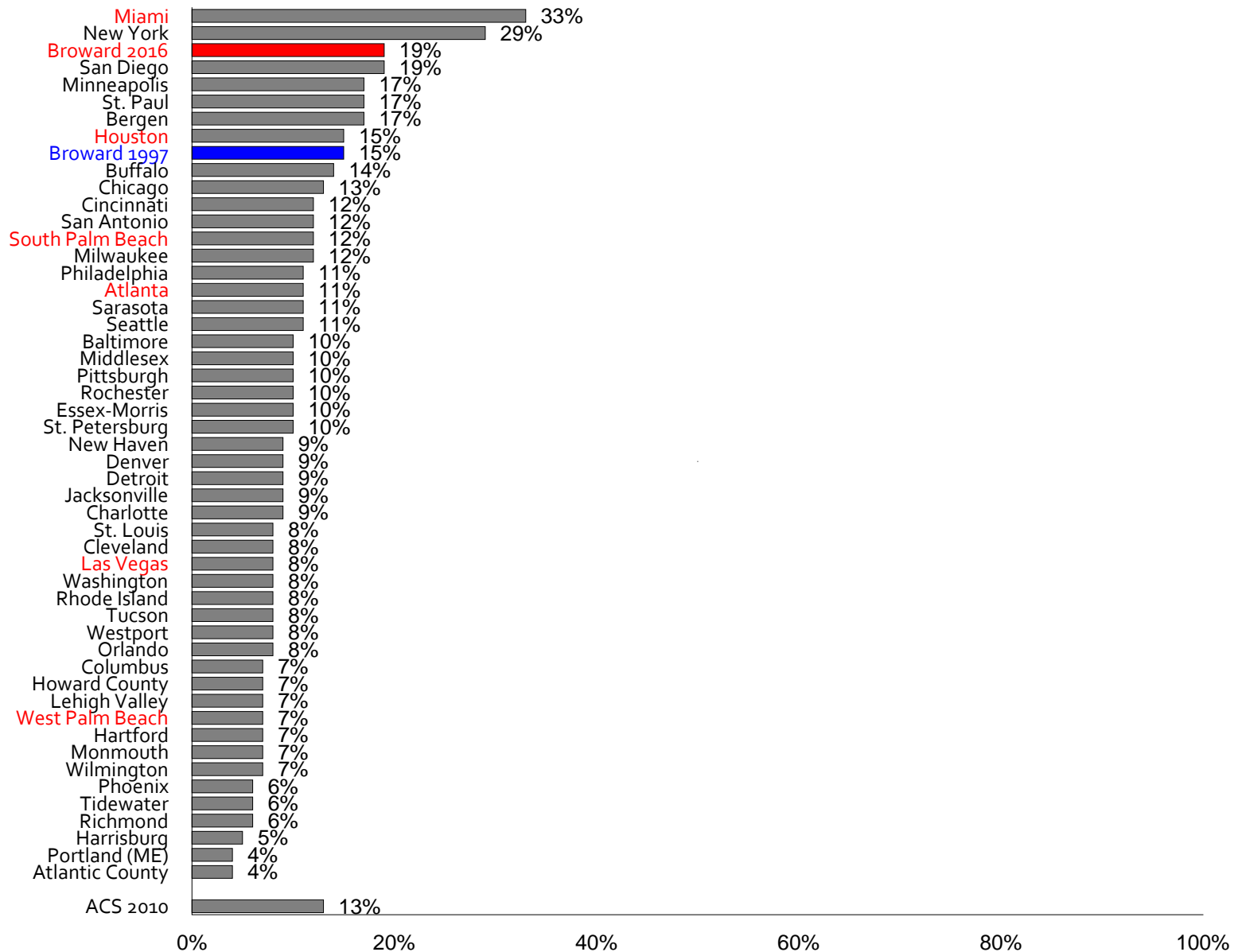

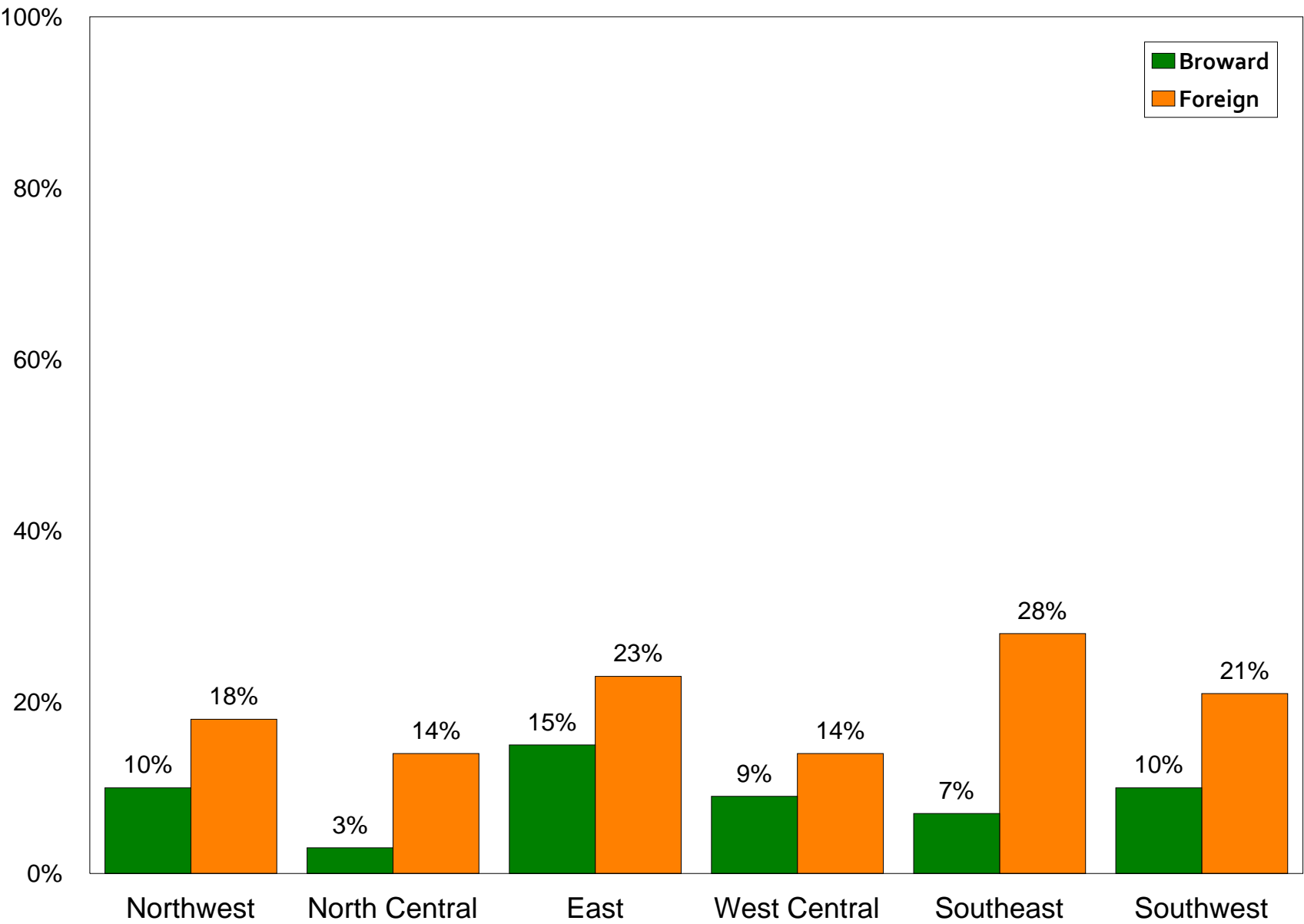

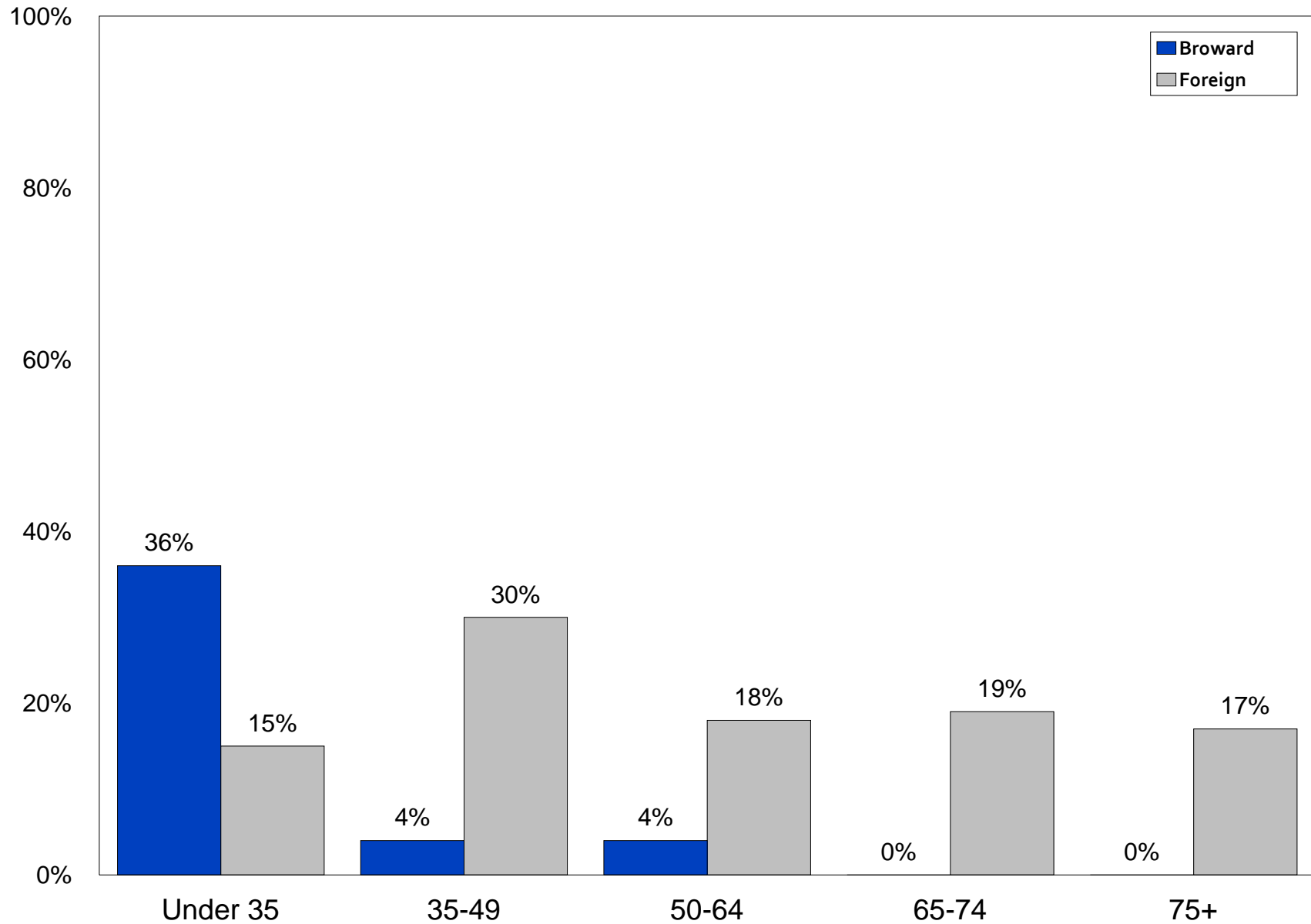

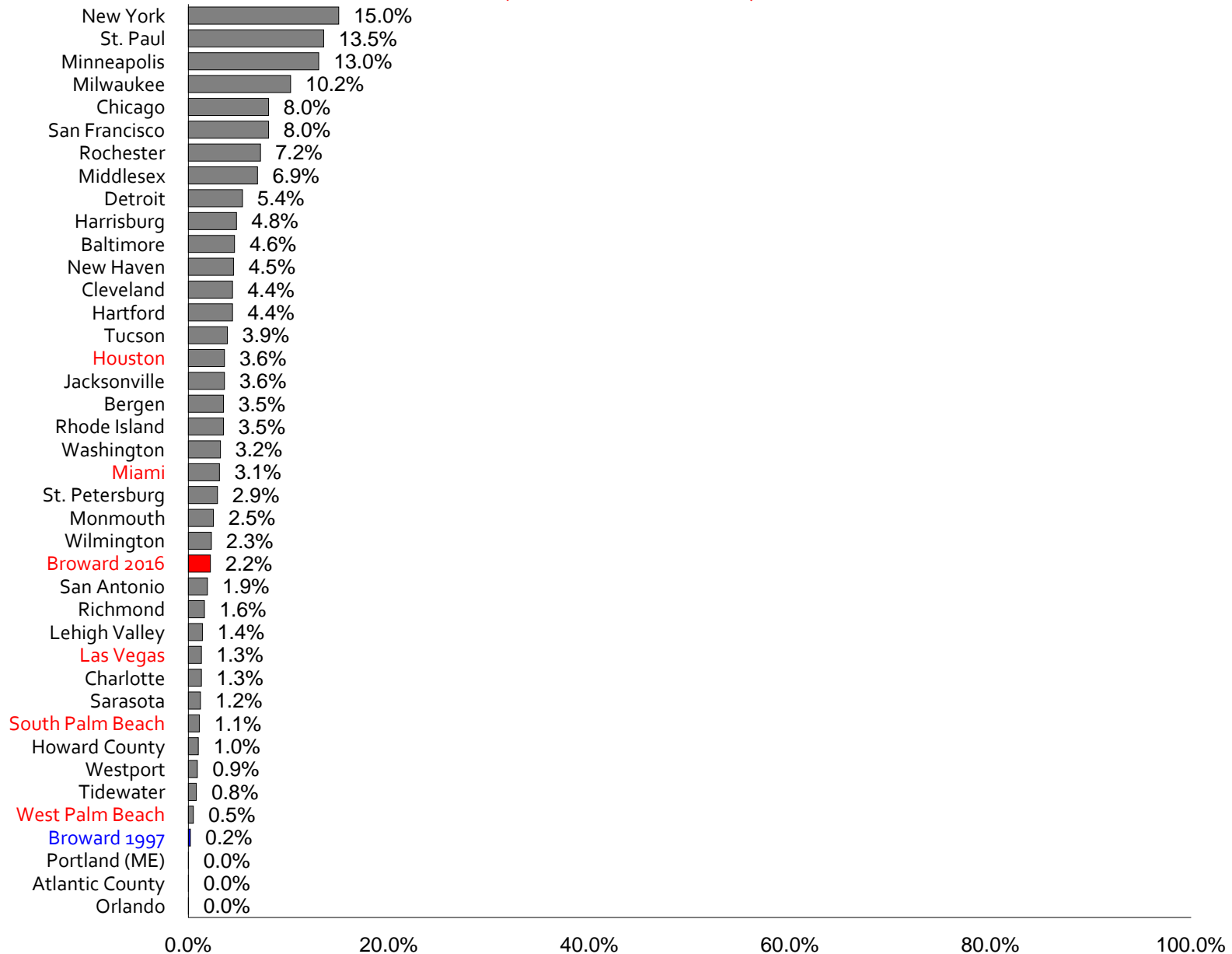
## Place of Birth by Age of Adults

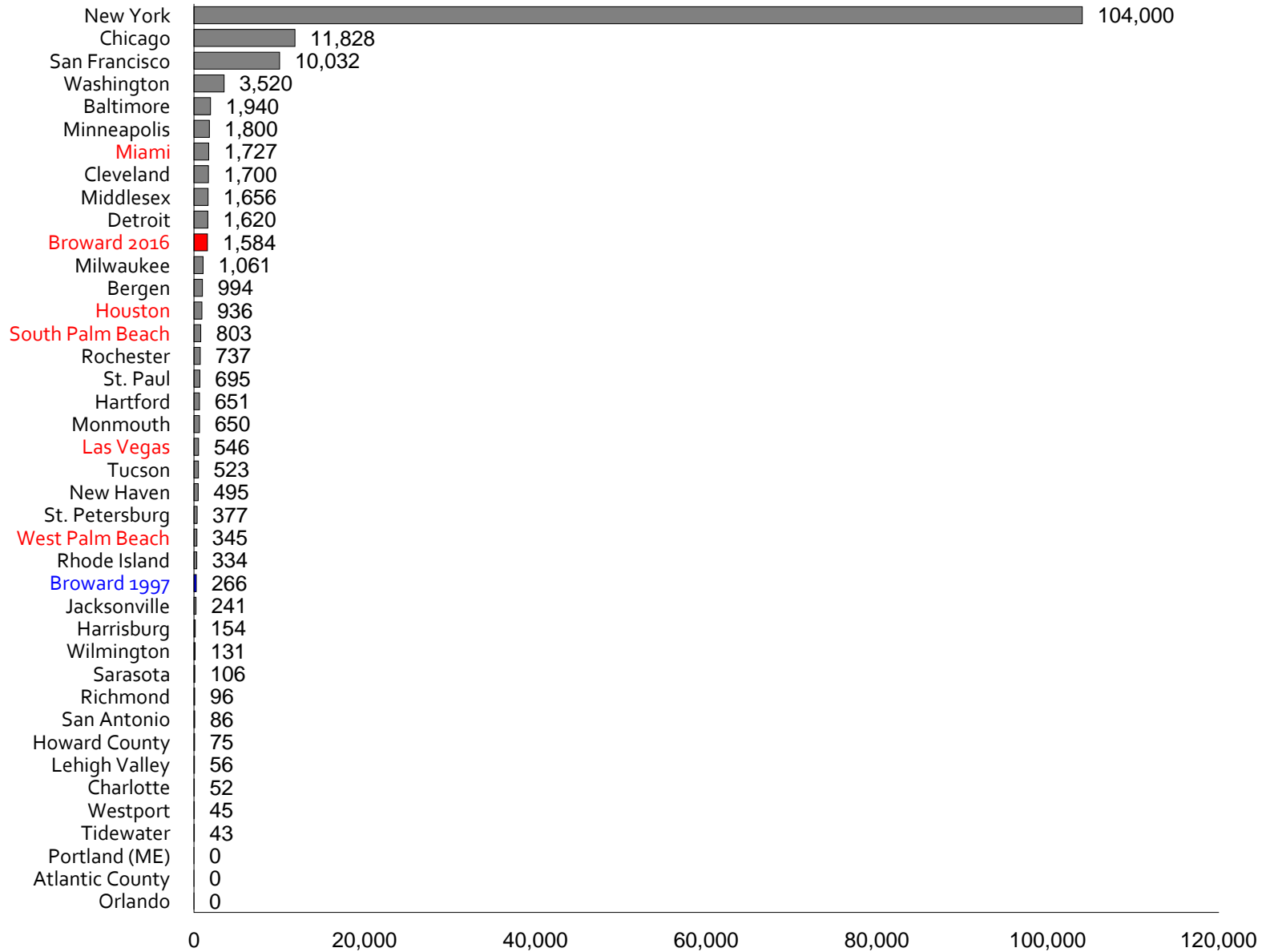

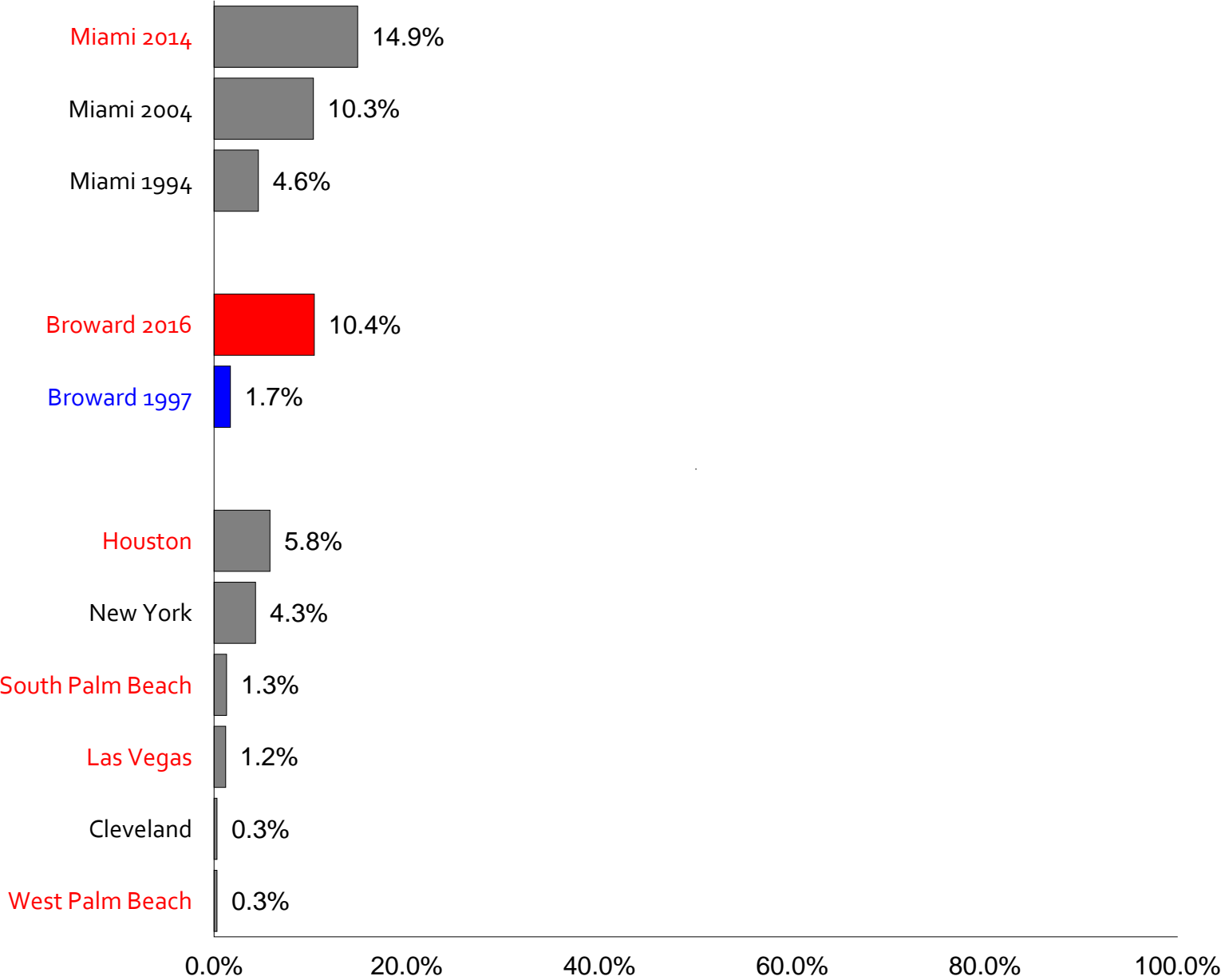

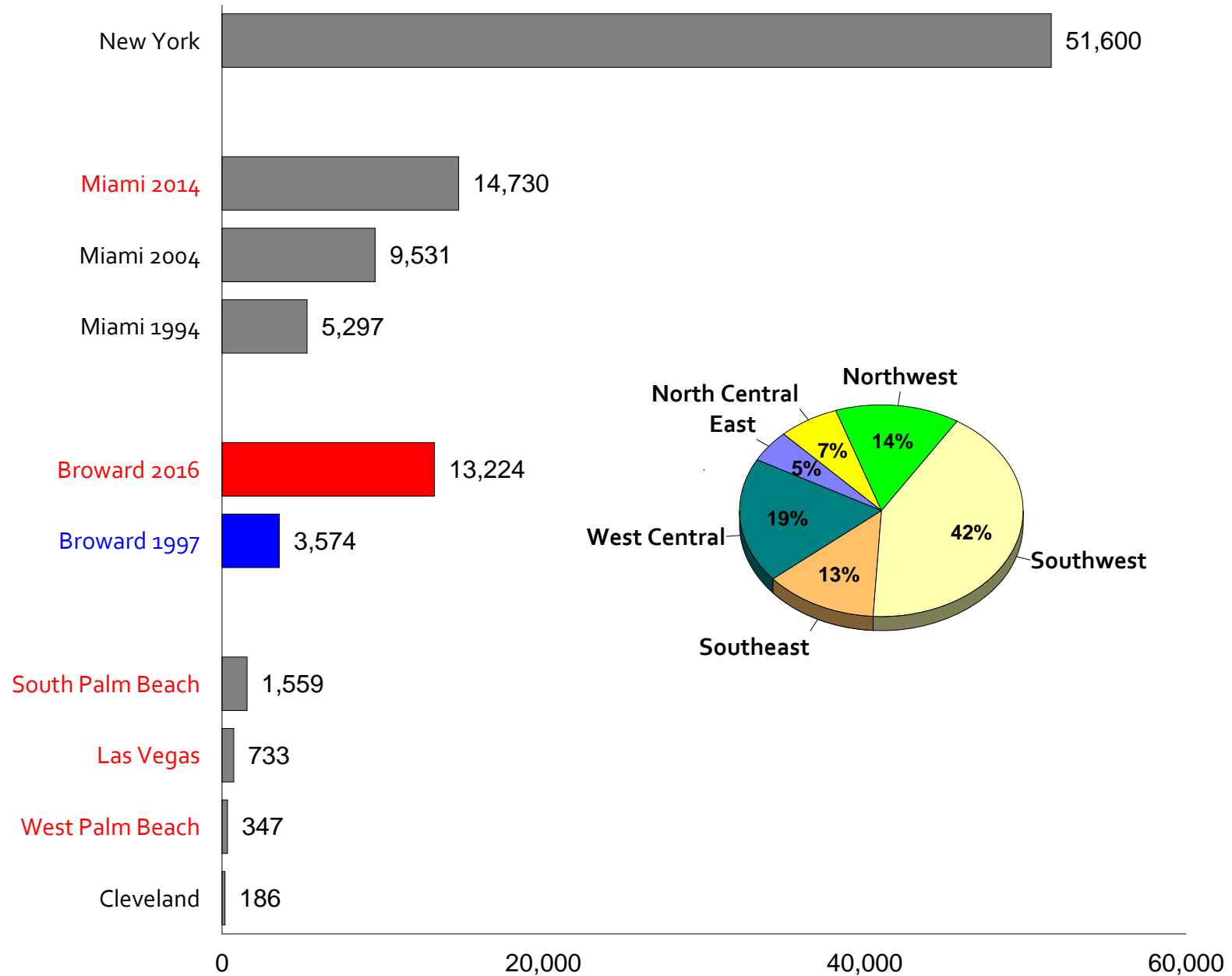

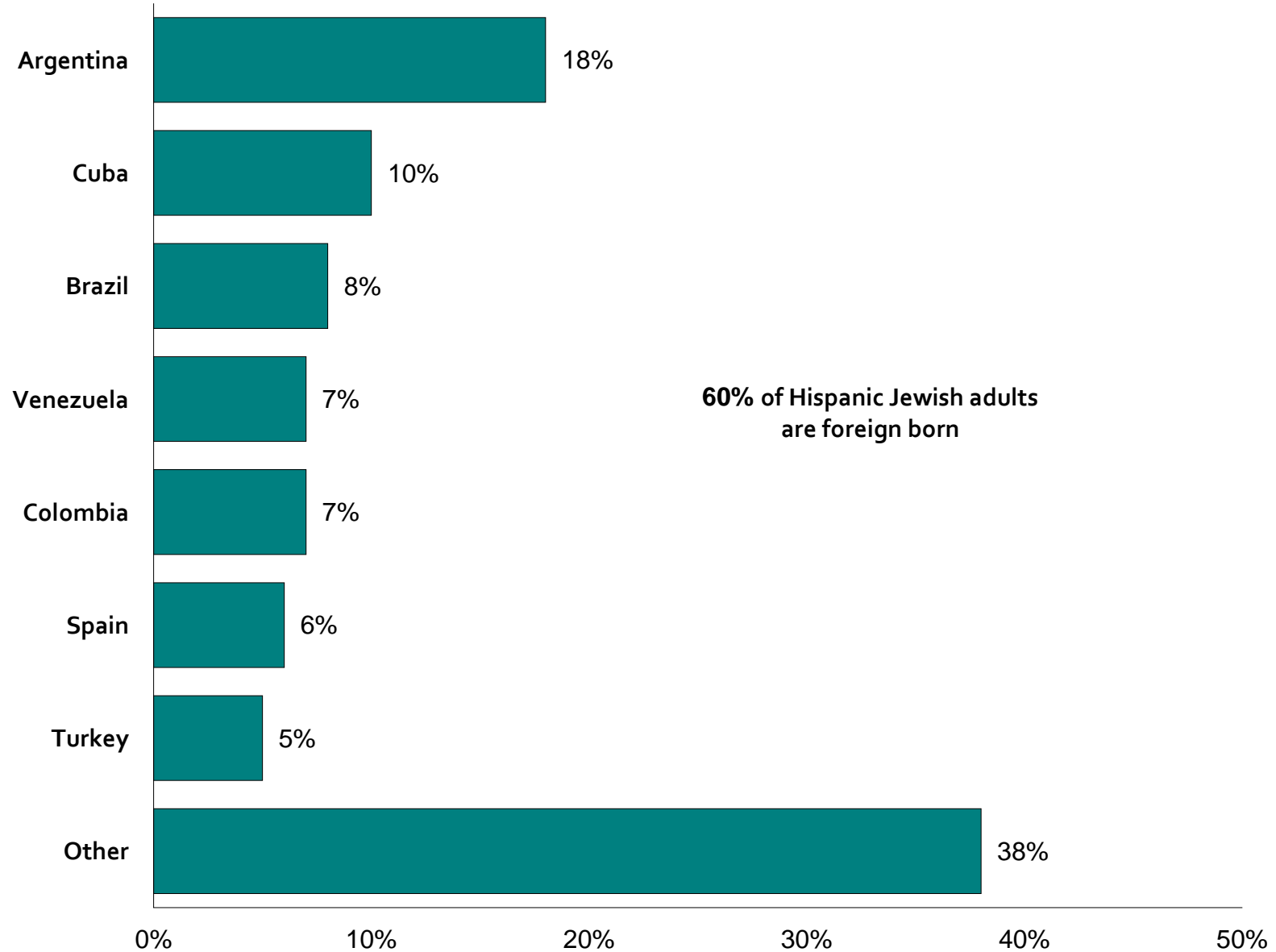


## Number of Hispanic Jewish Adults

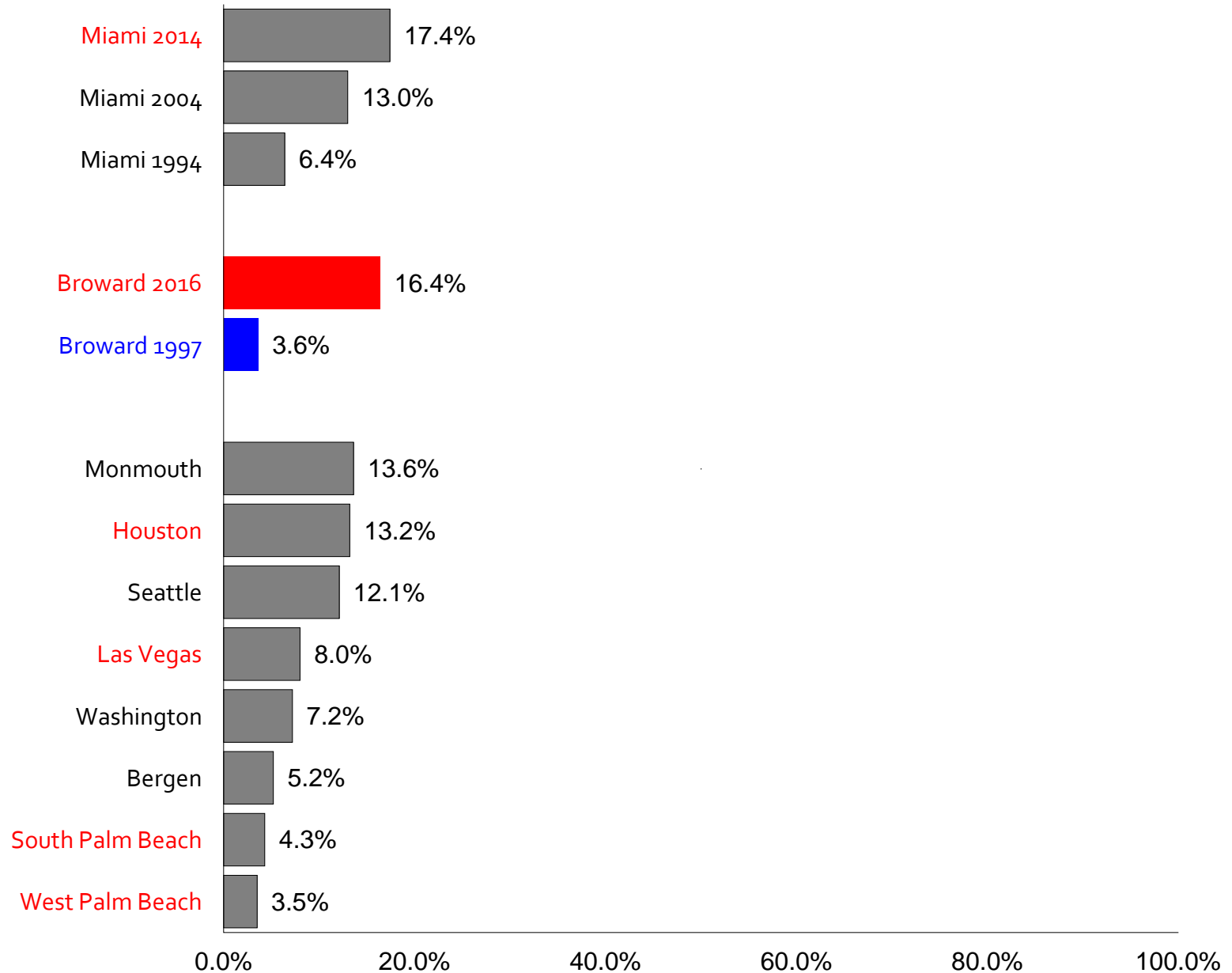
## Country From Which Hispanic Jewish Adults Come





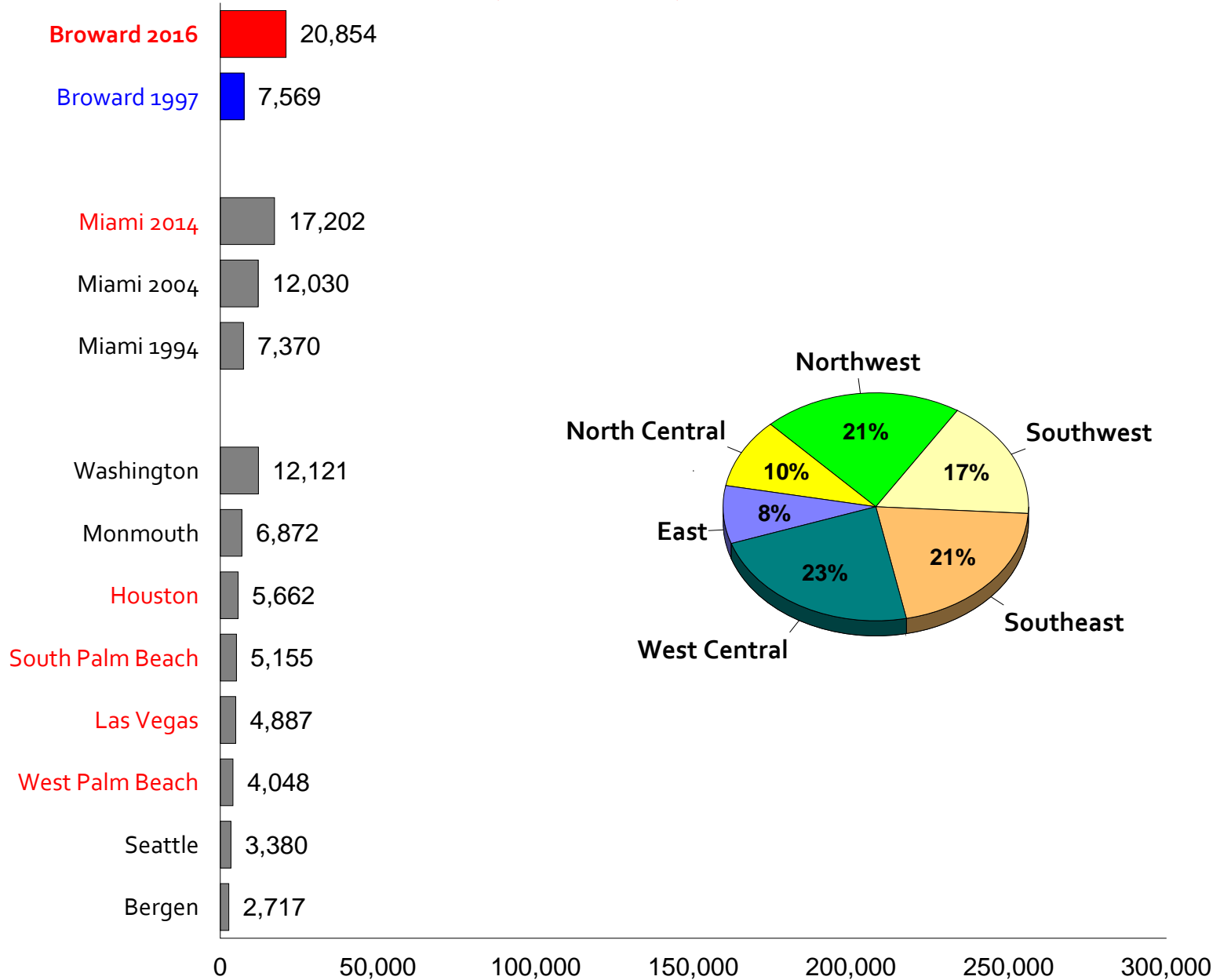

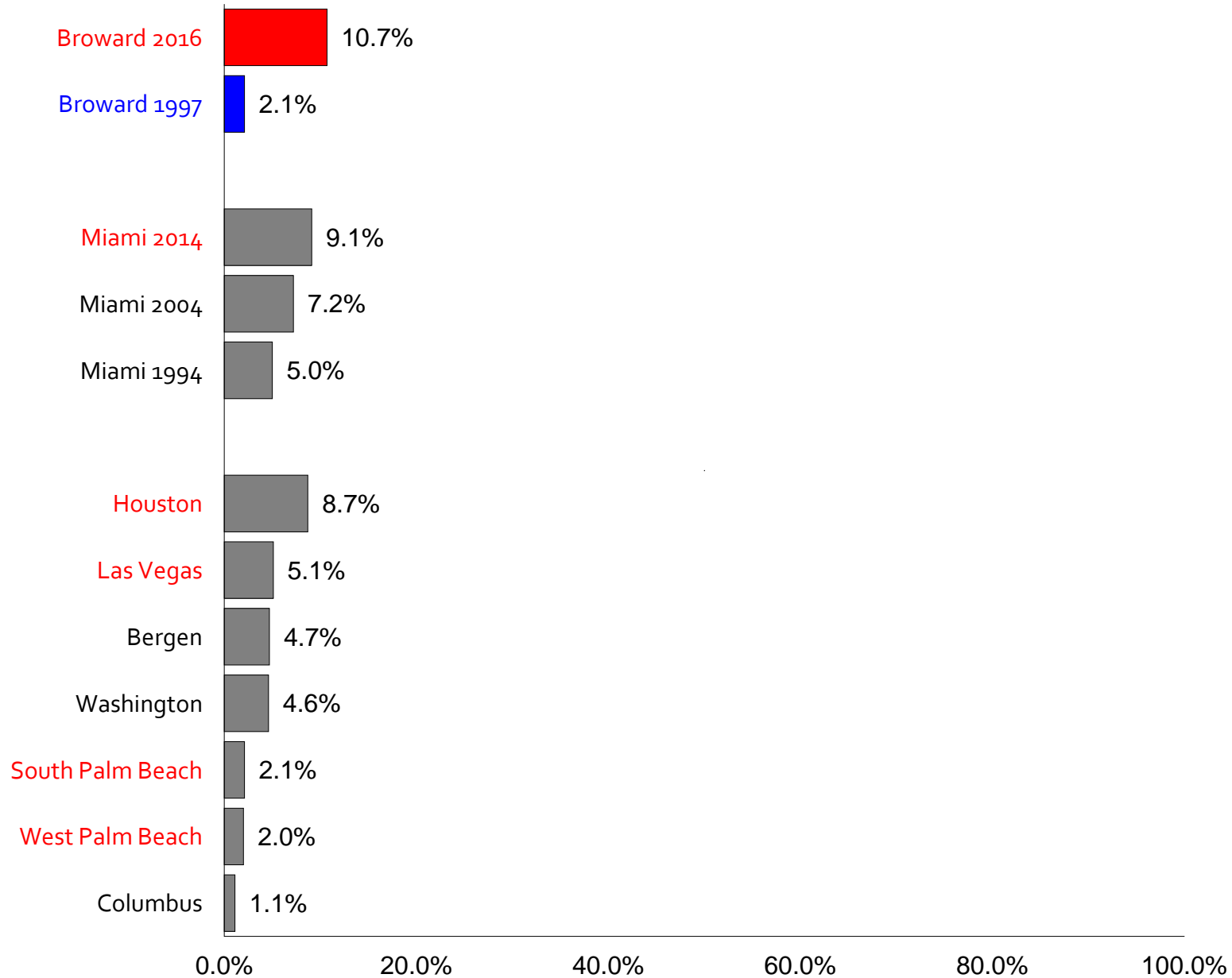

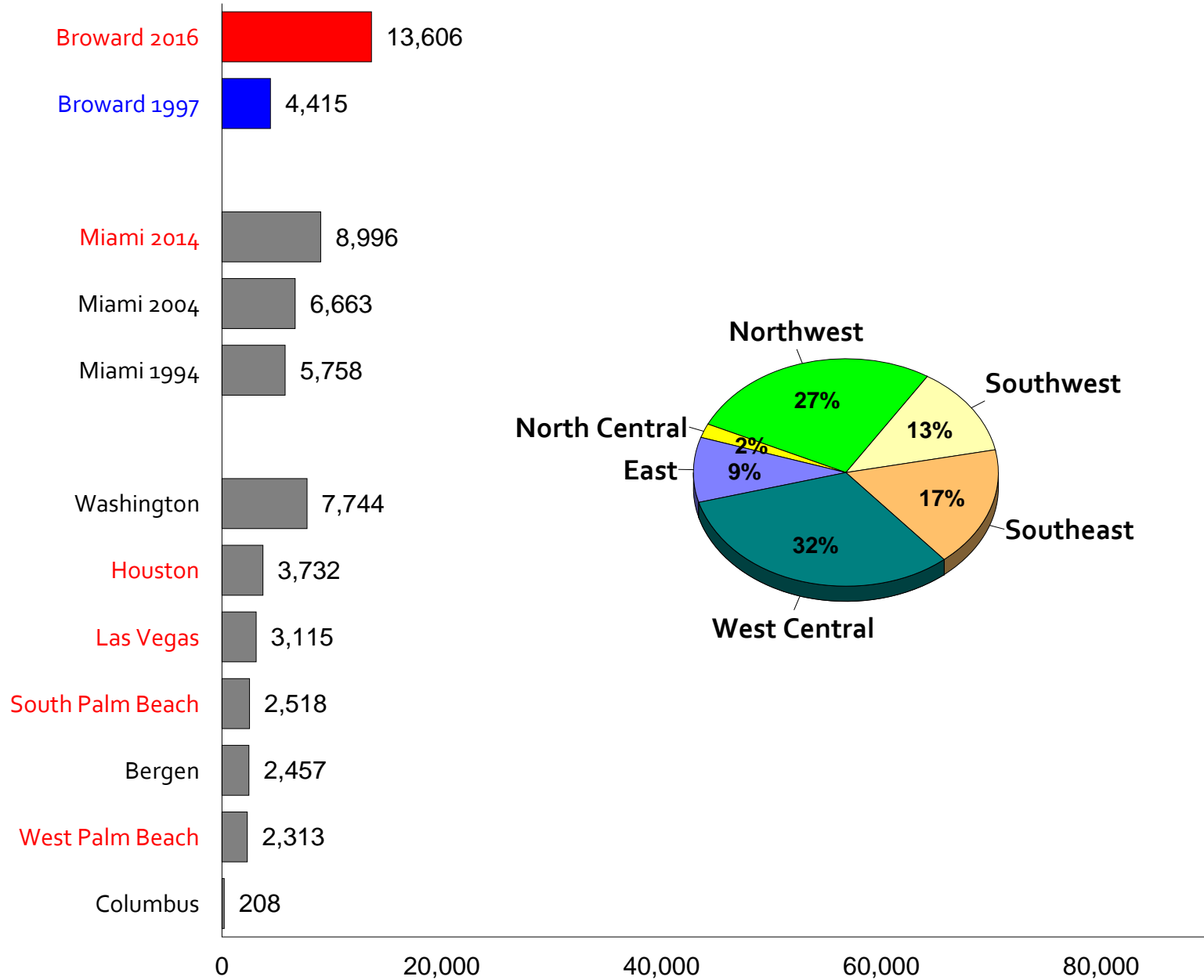

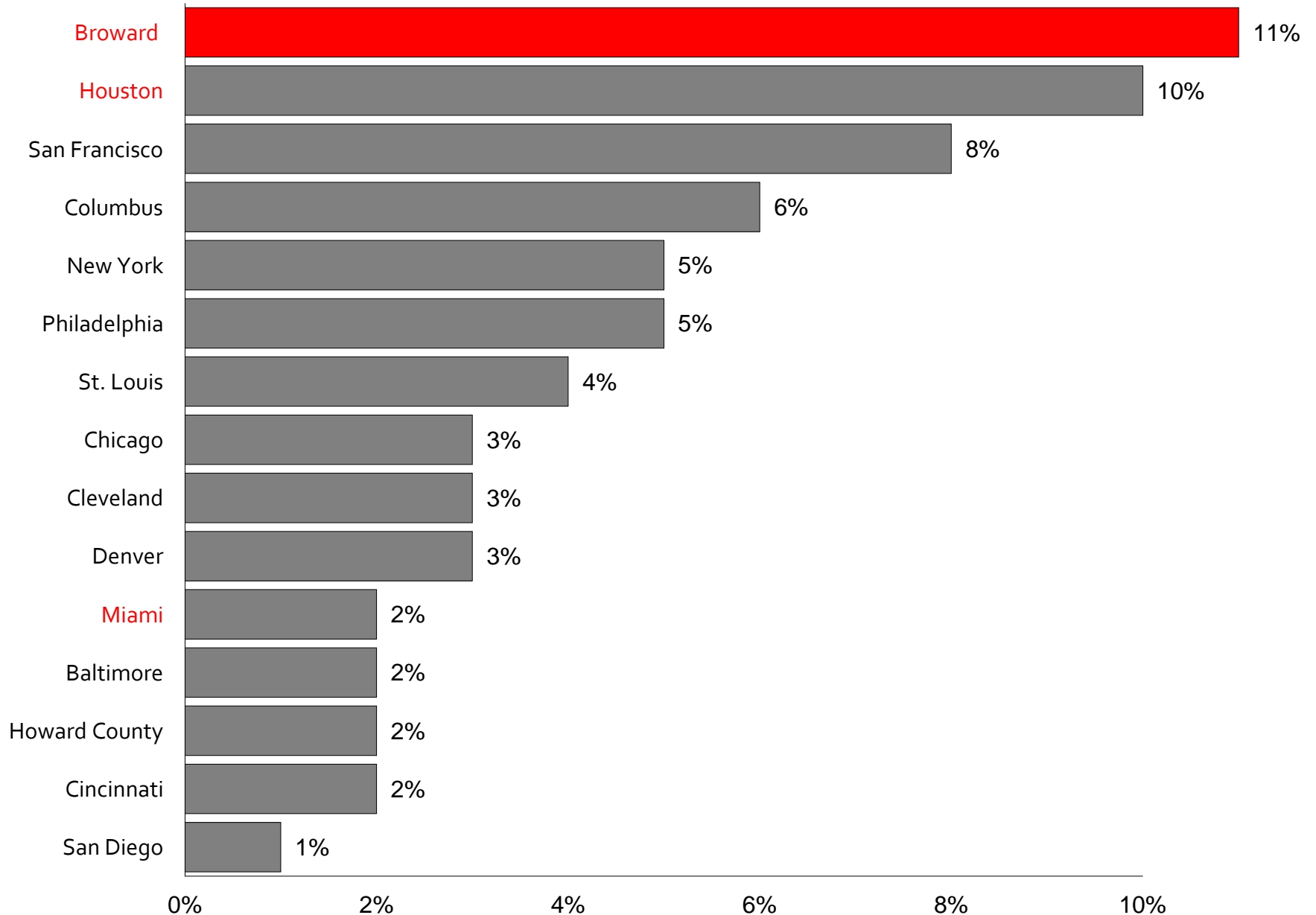

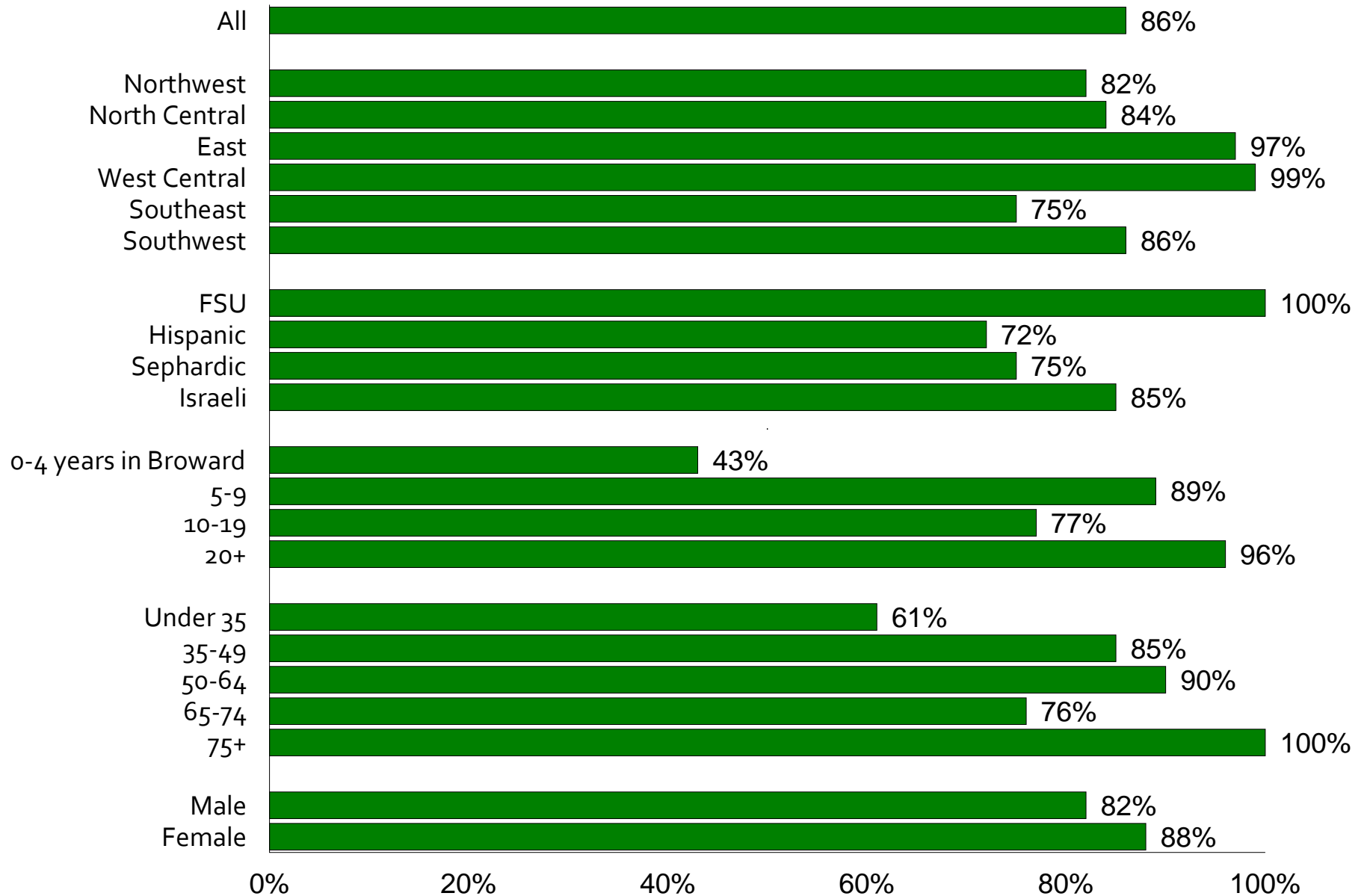


## Someone in Household Considers Themselves to Be LGBT (Jewish Households)



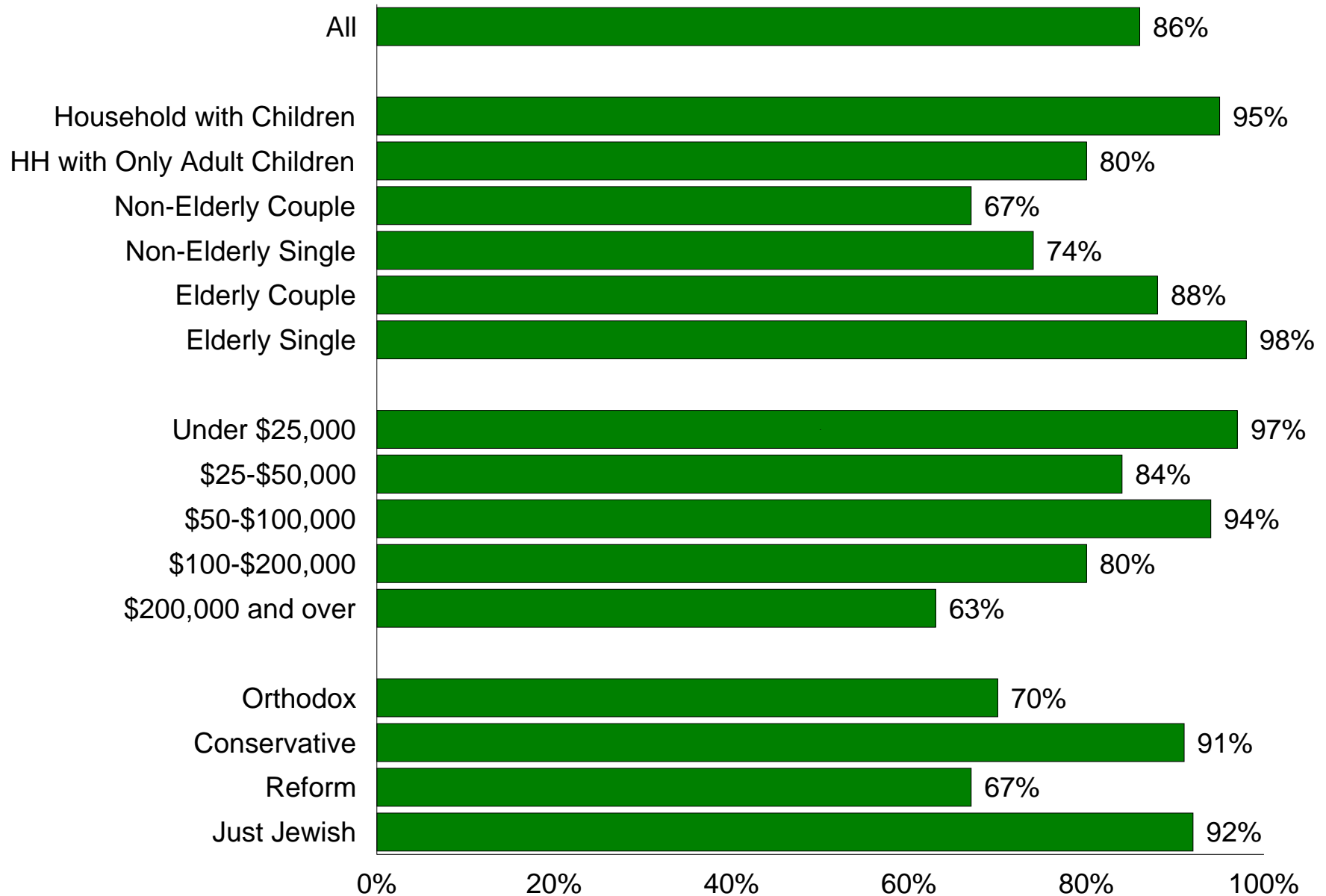

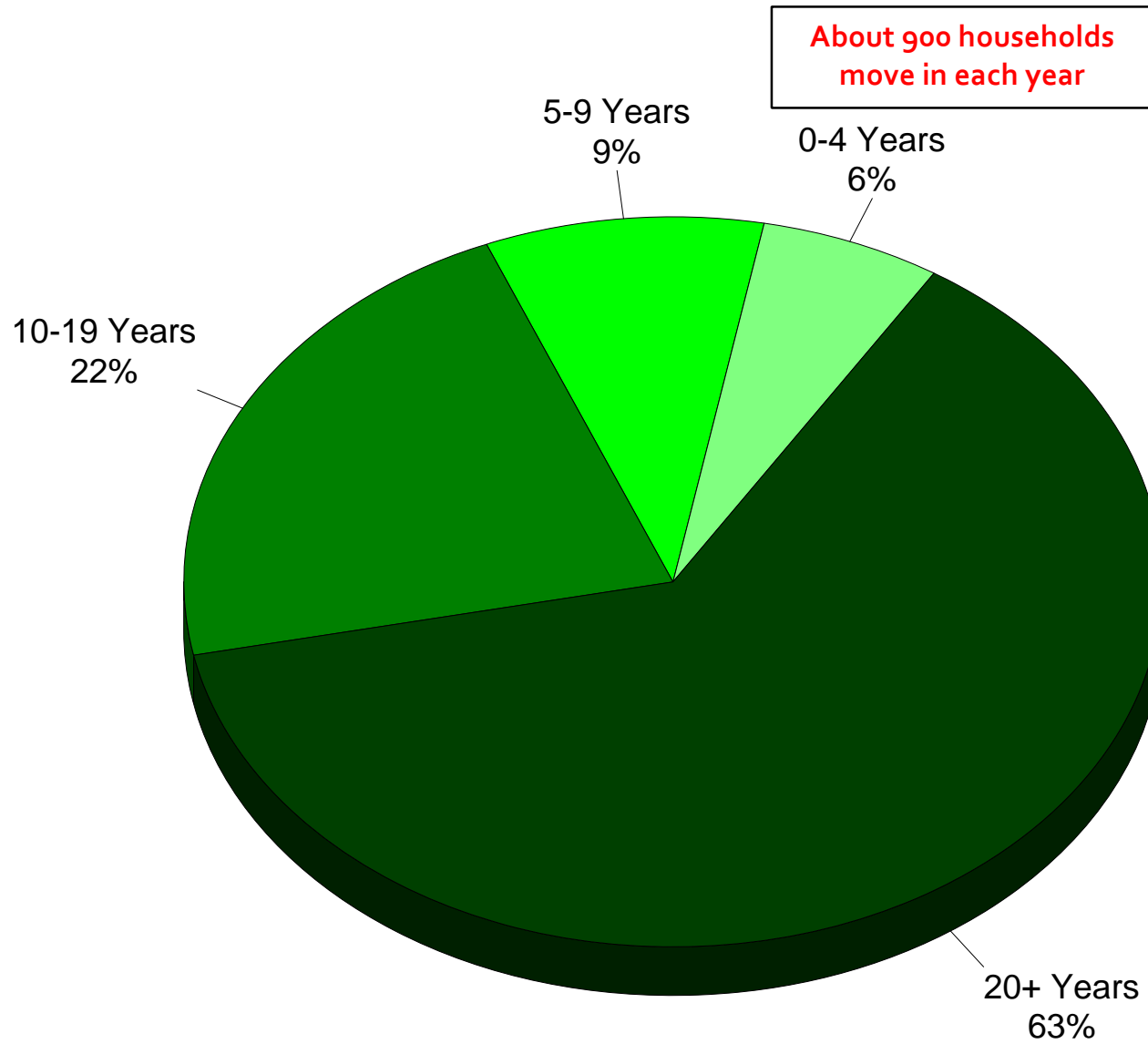
## Location of Residence Prior to Broward

(Respondents in Jewish Full-Year Households)



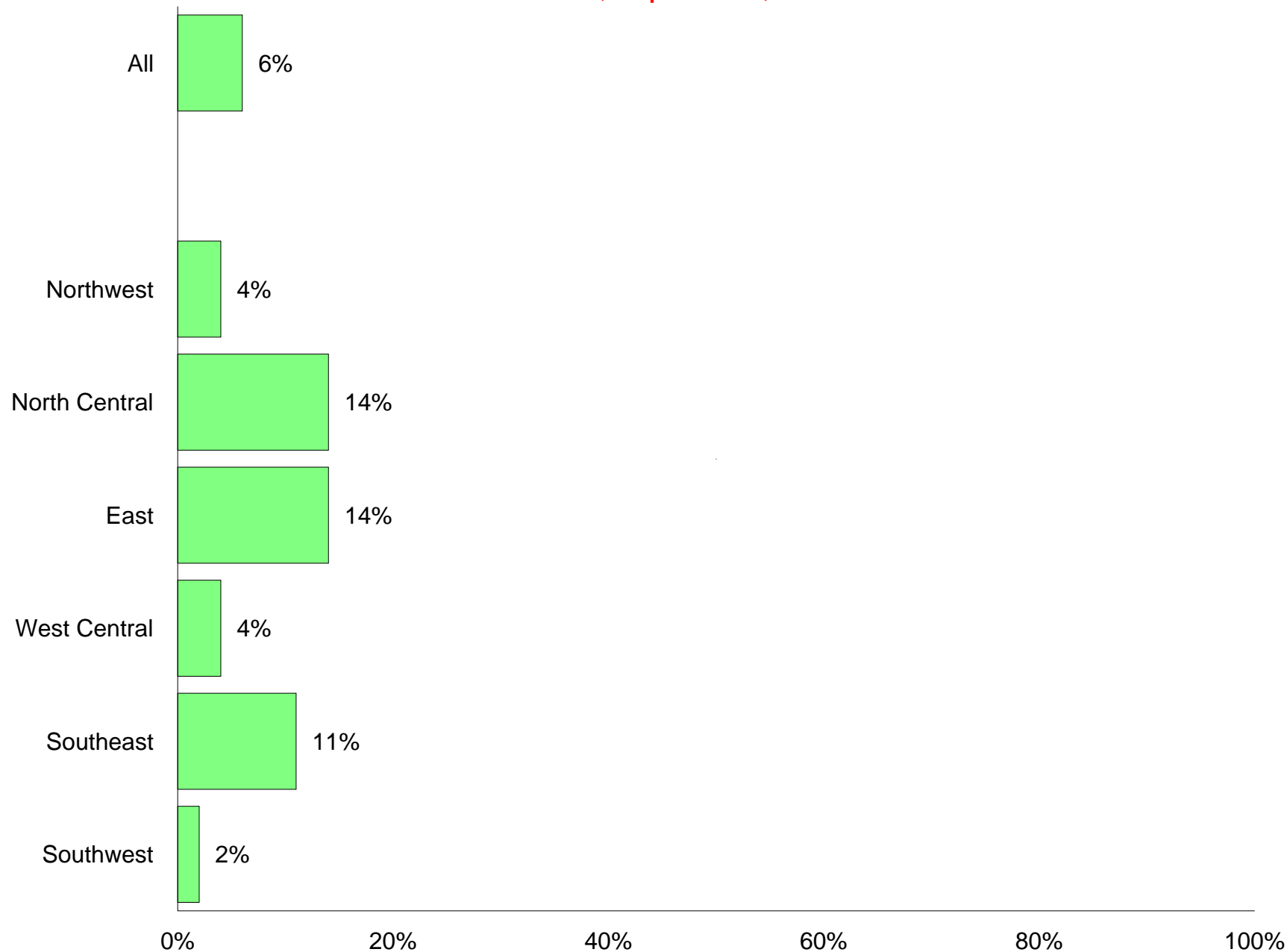

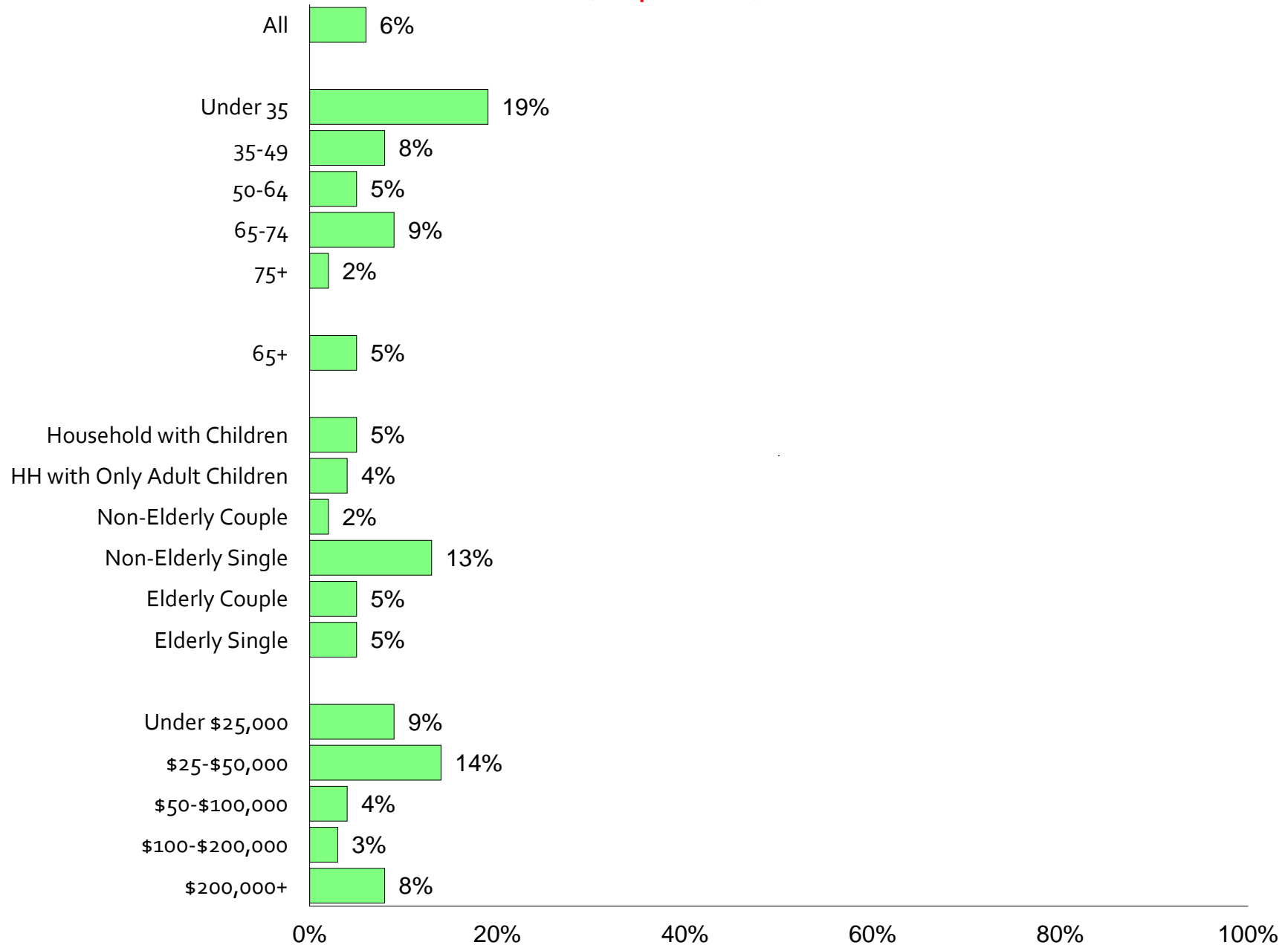

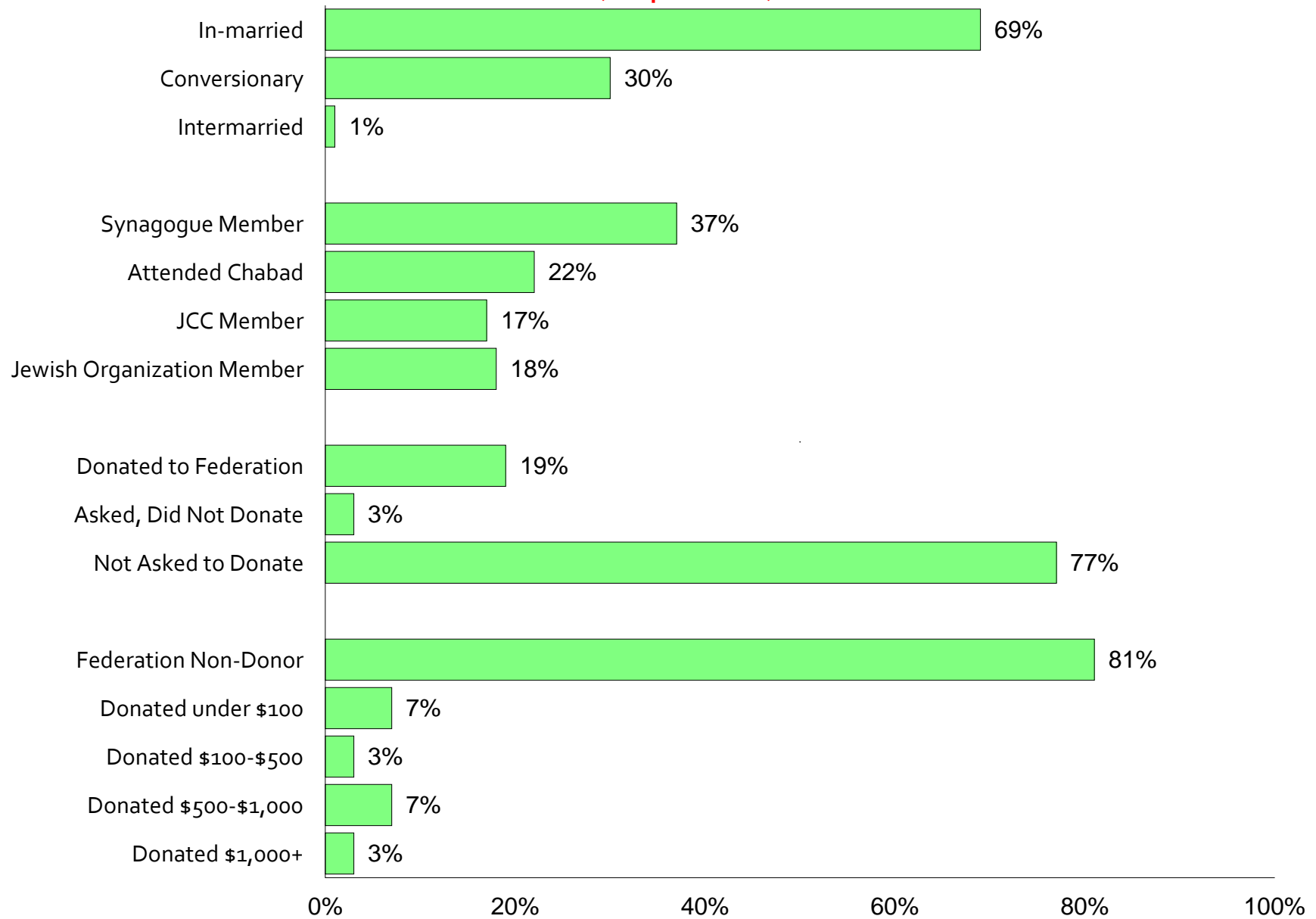

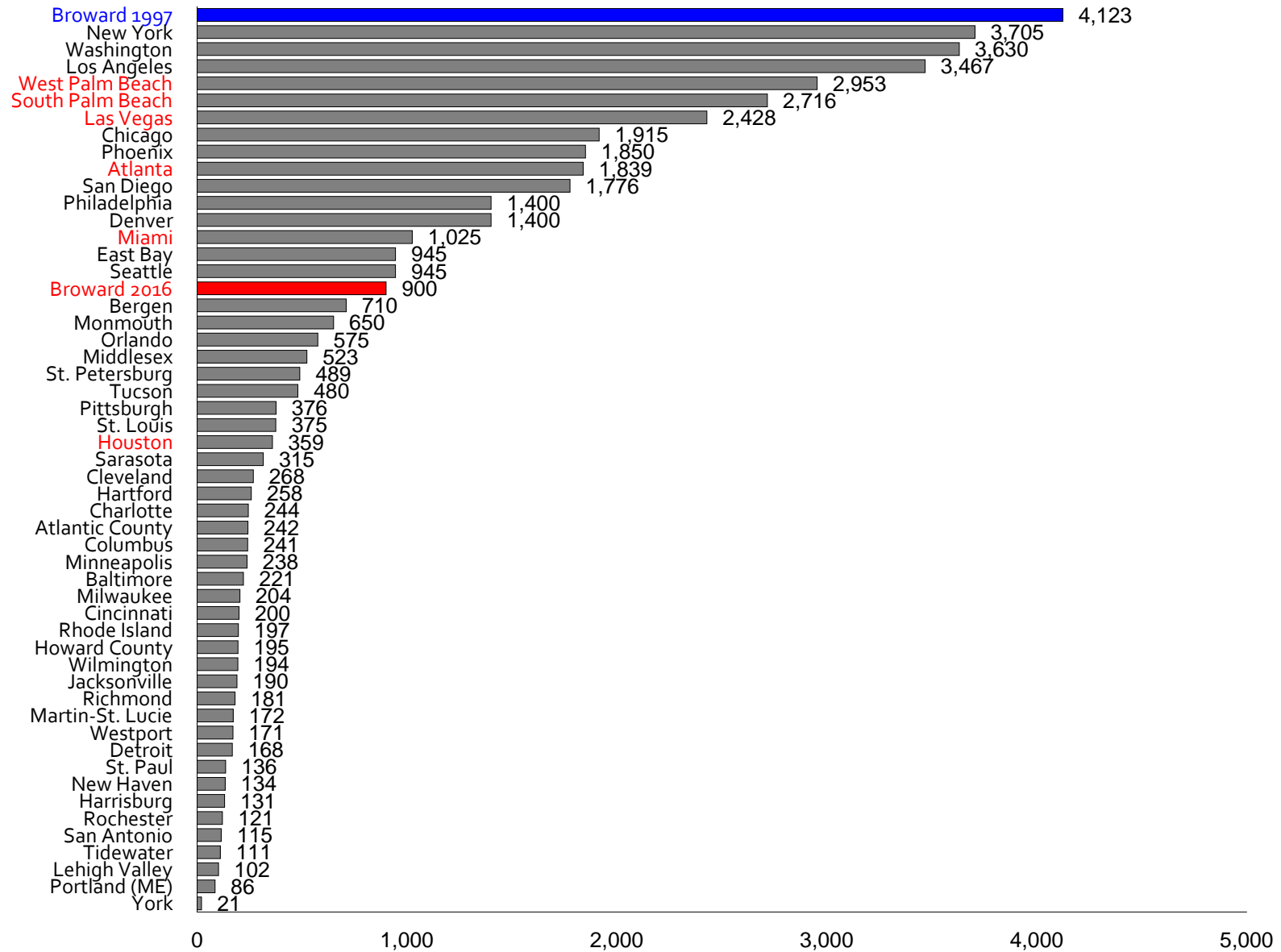

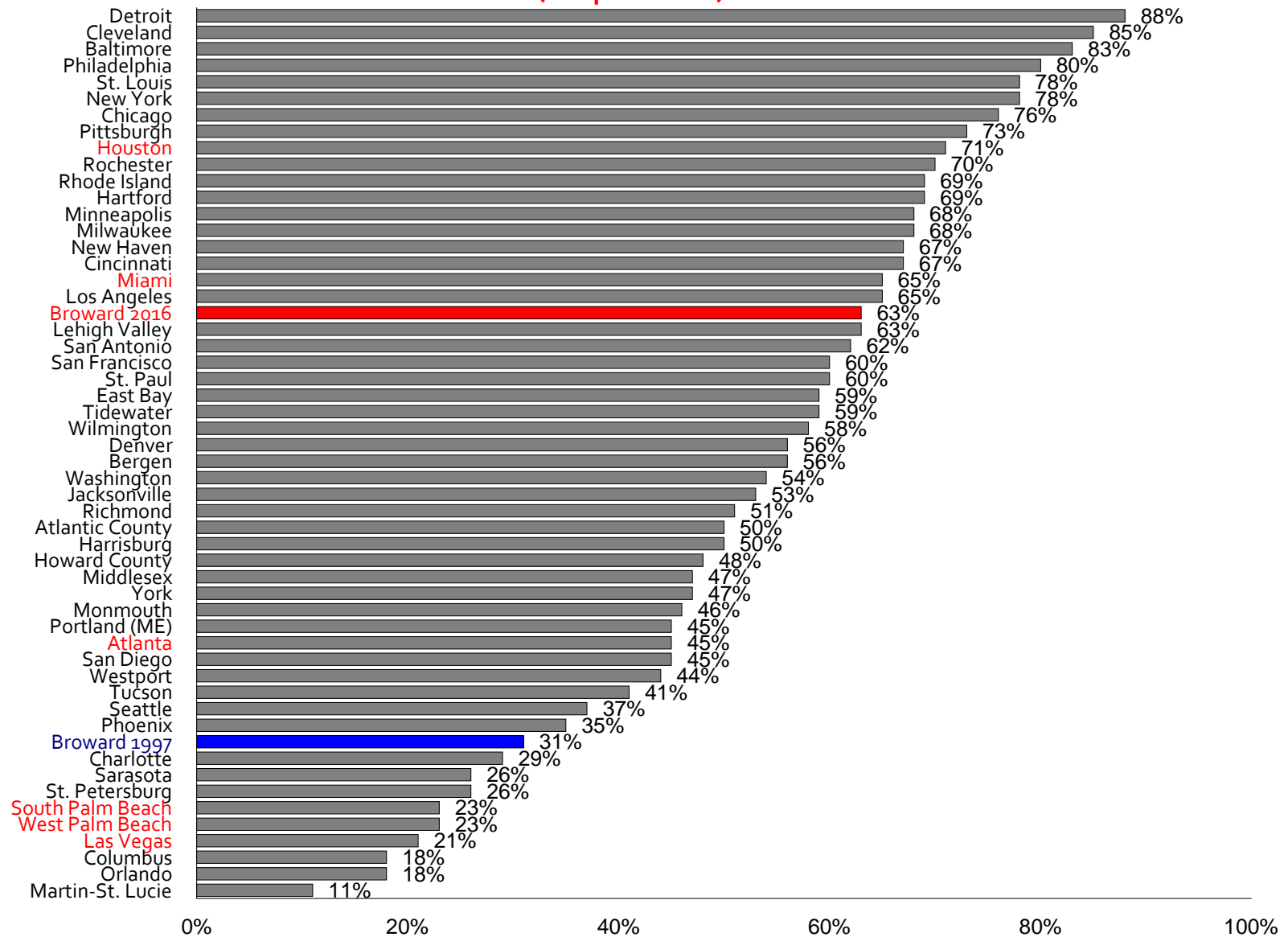
## Average Number of New Households Per Year During the Past Five Years (Jewish Households)





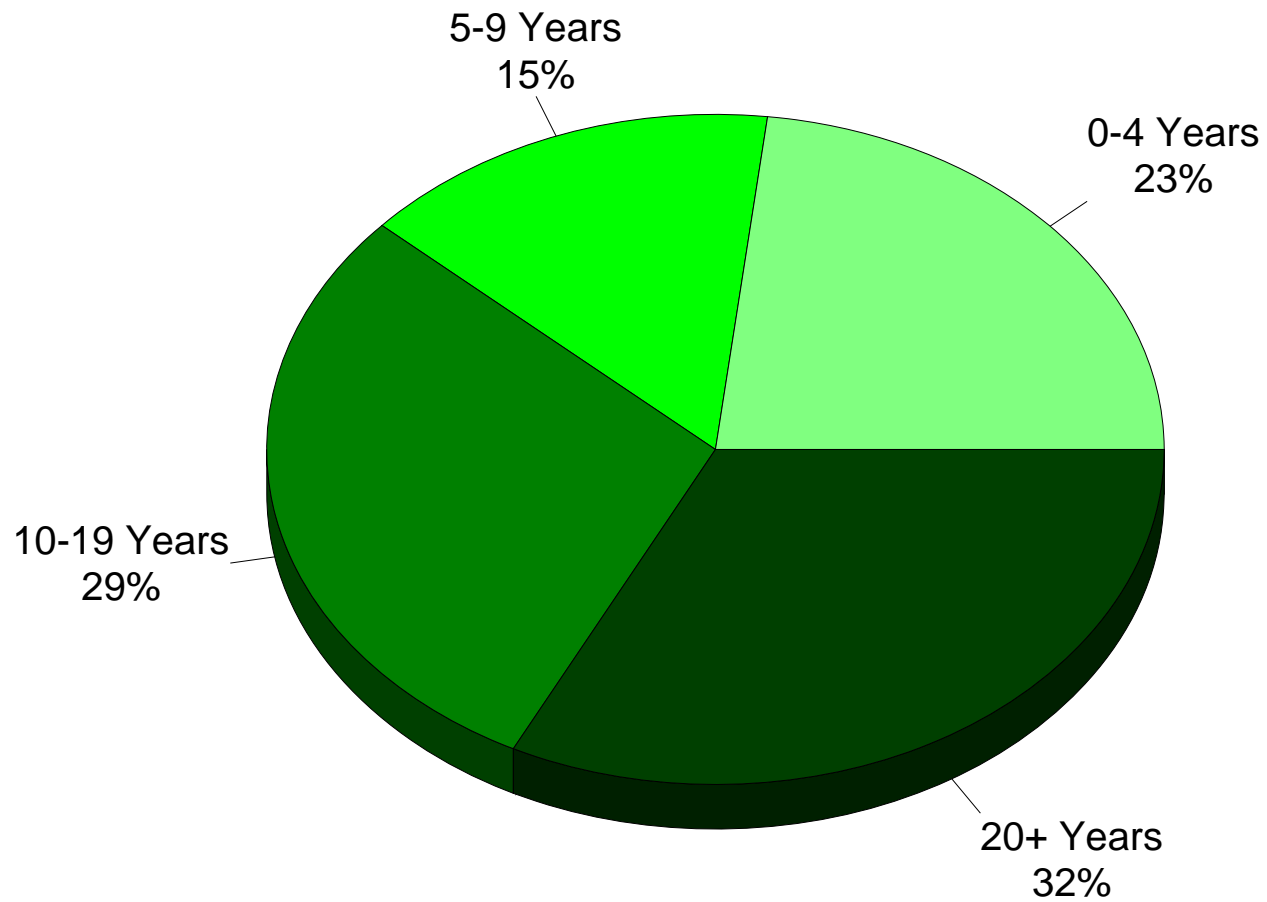

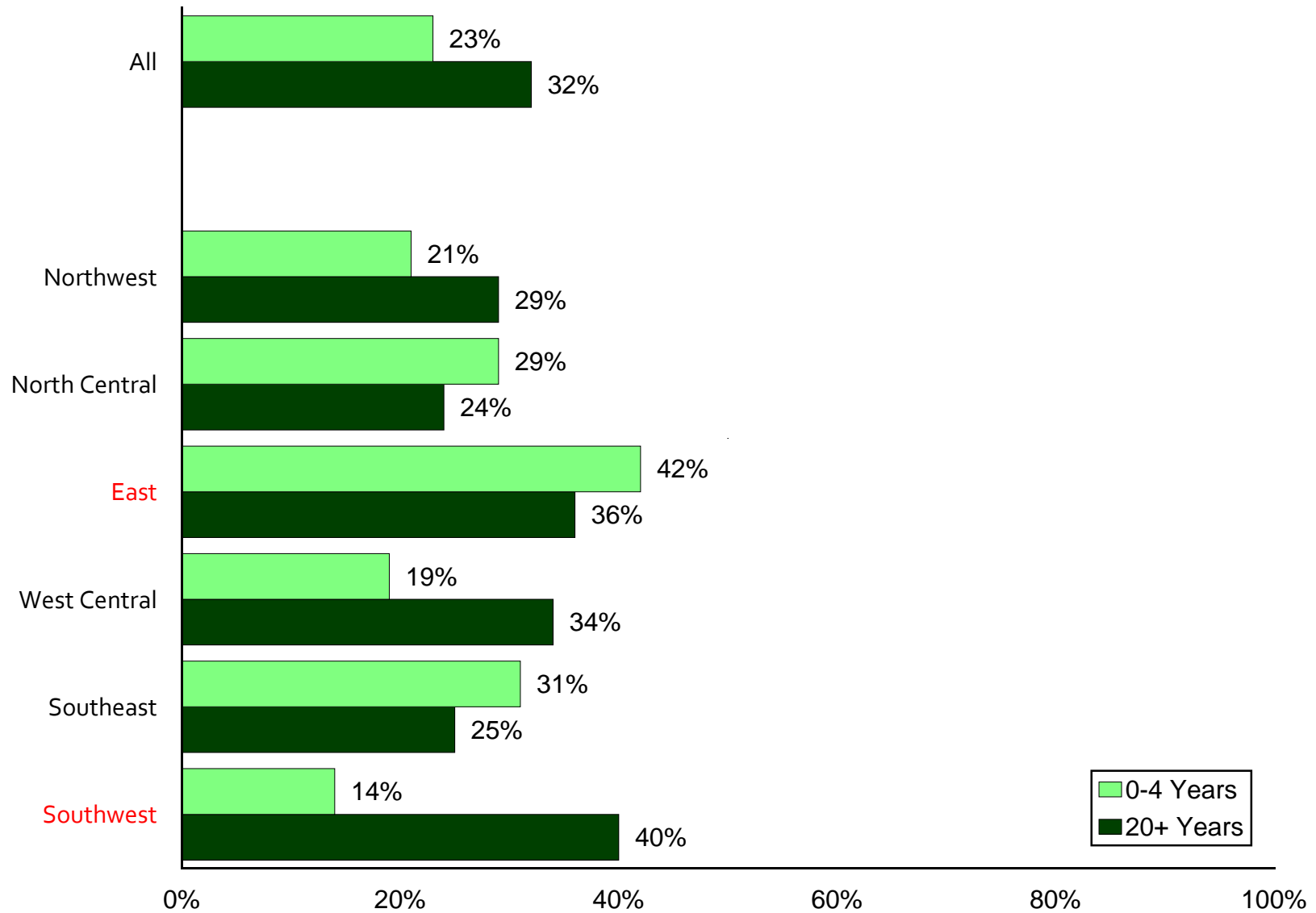
## Length of Residence at Current Address

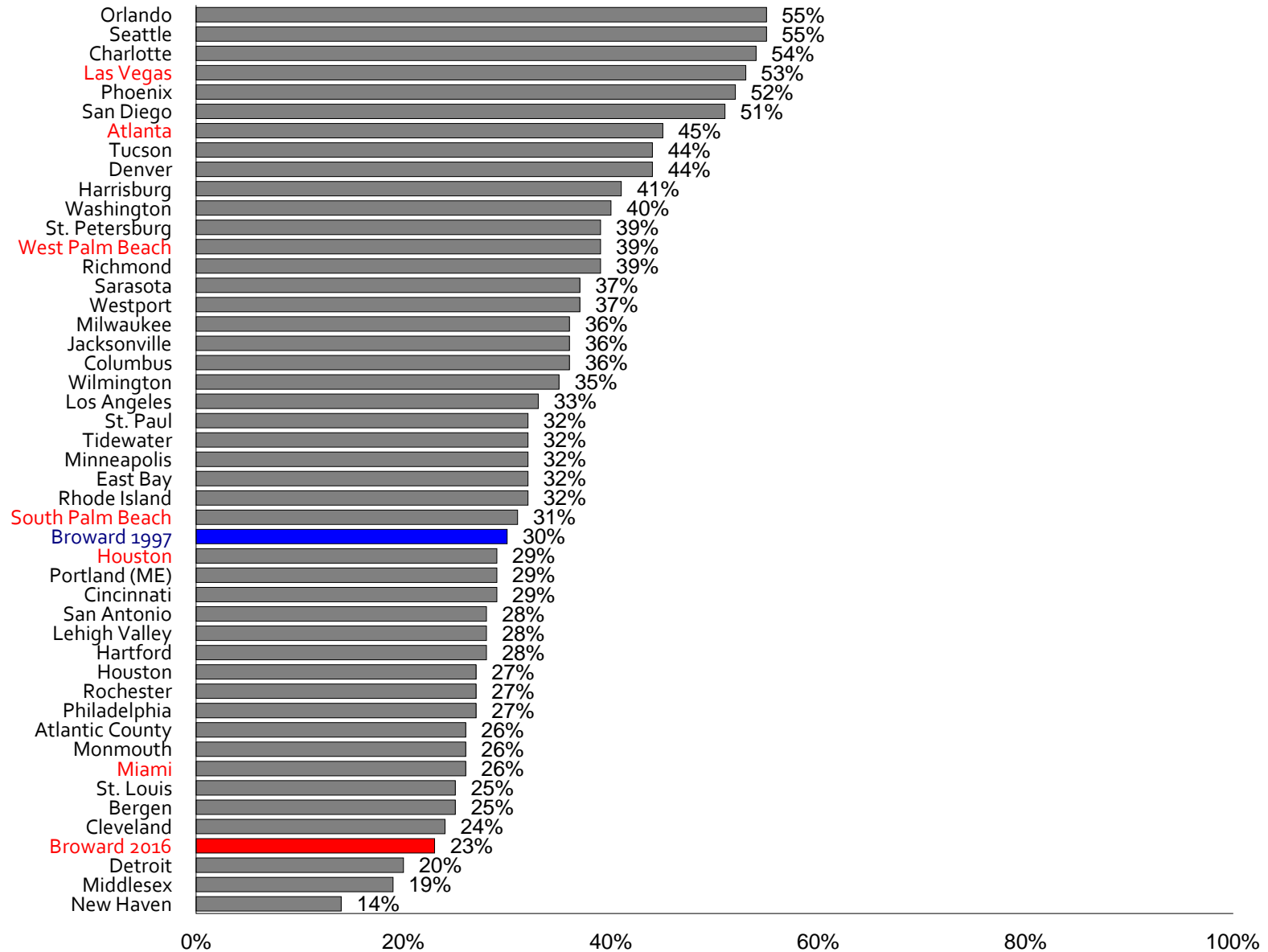
## Years at Current Address by Geographic Area

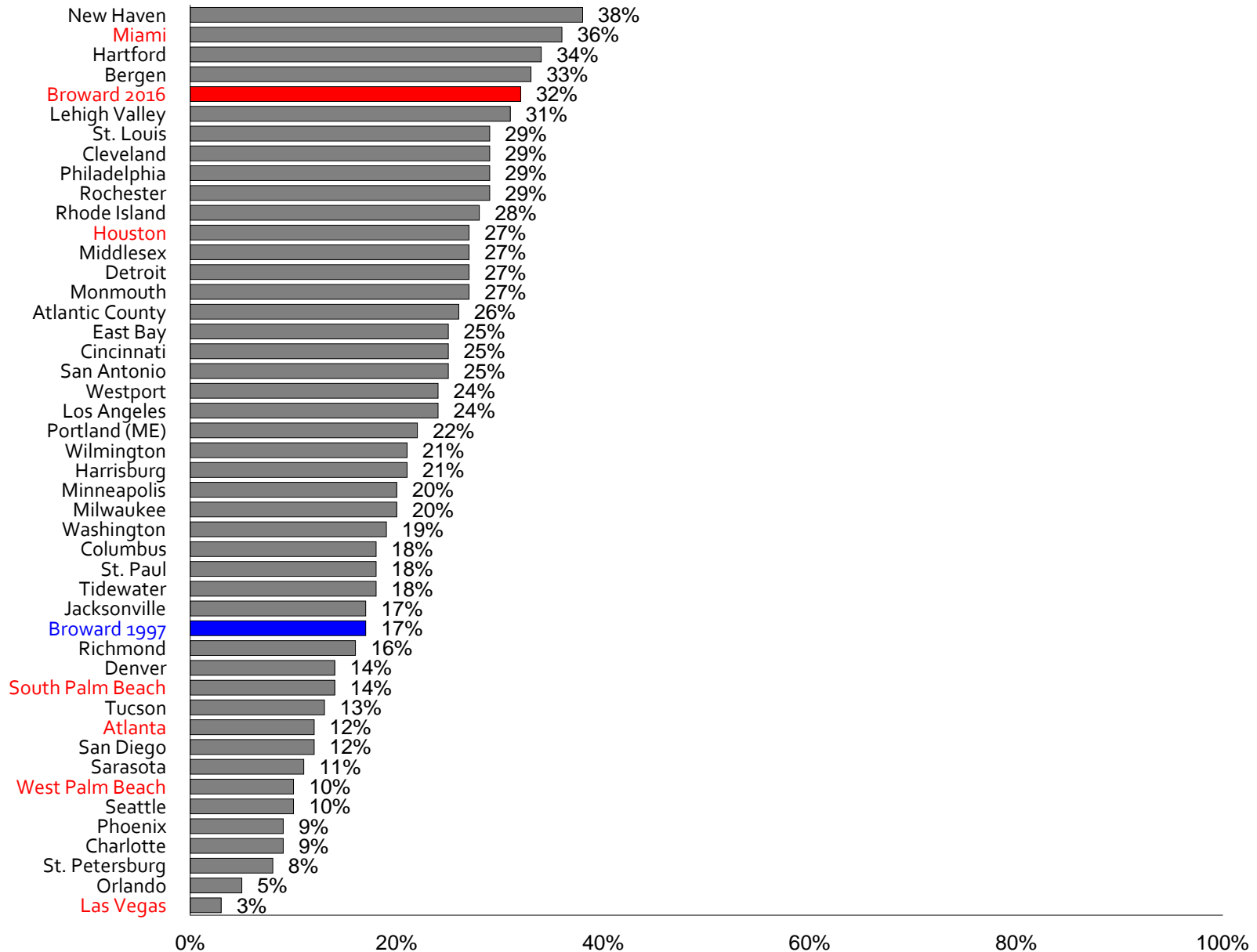

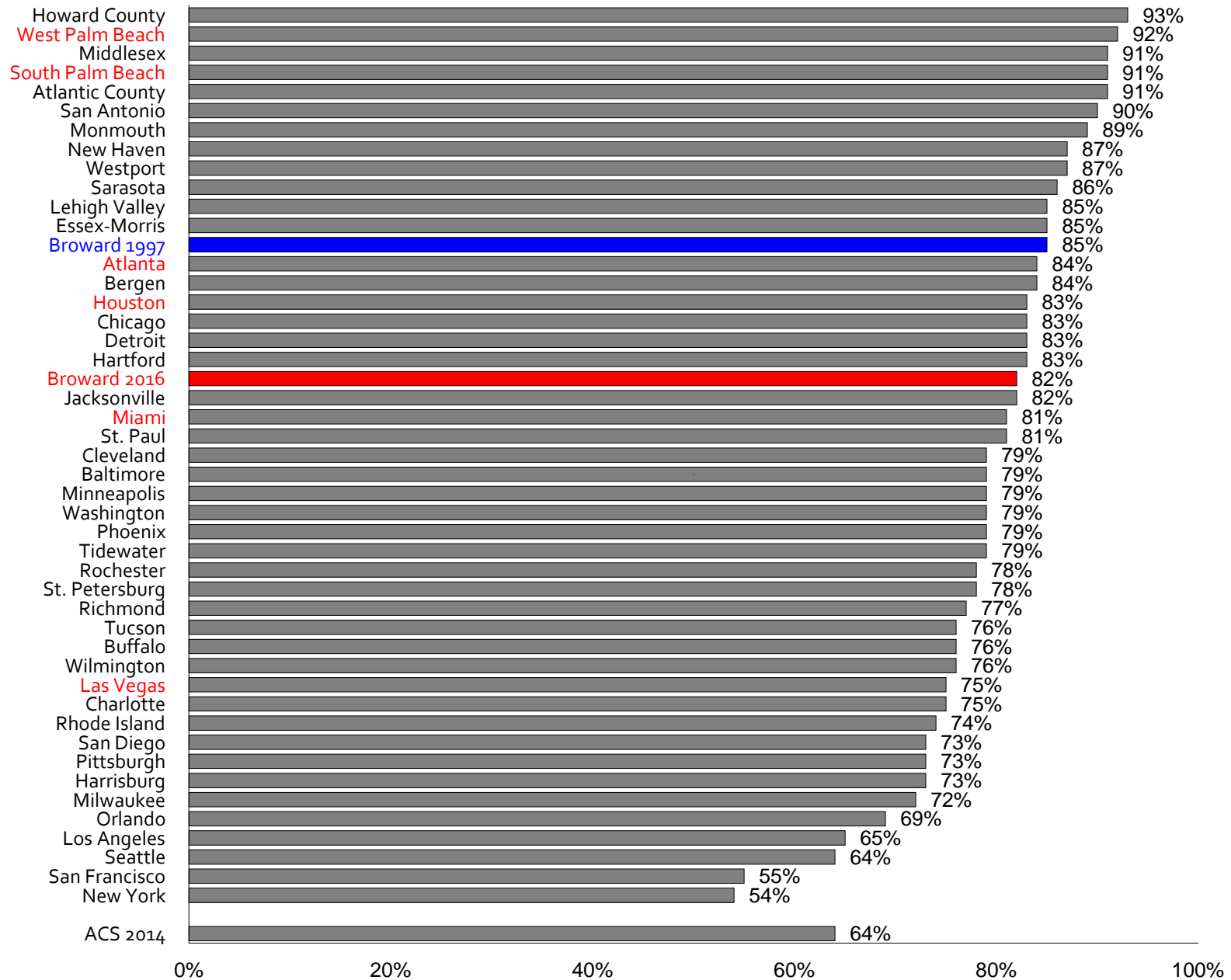

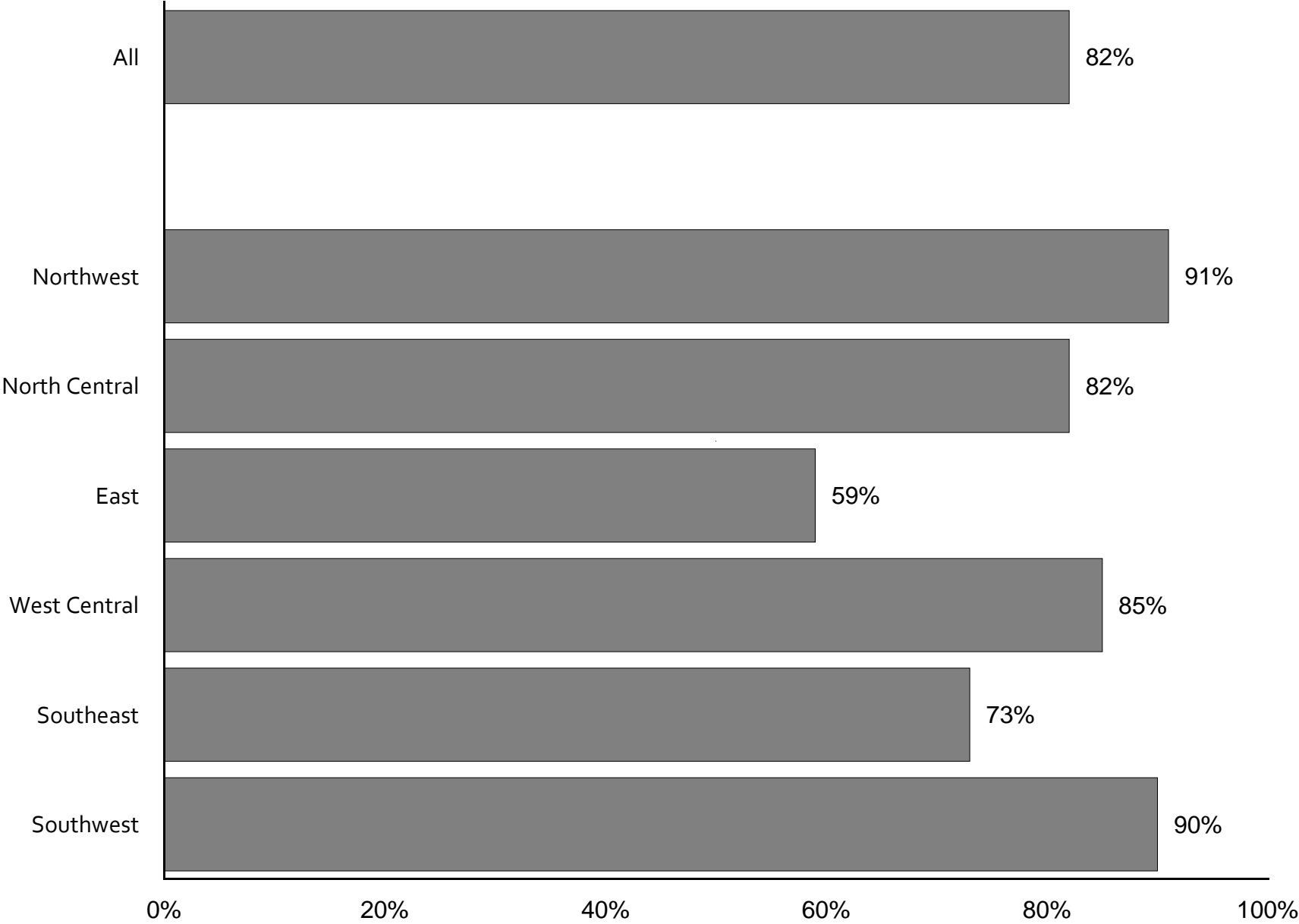

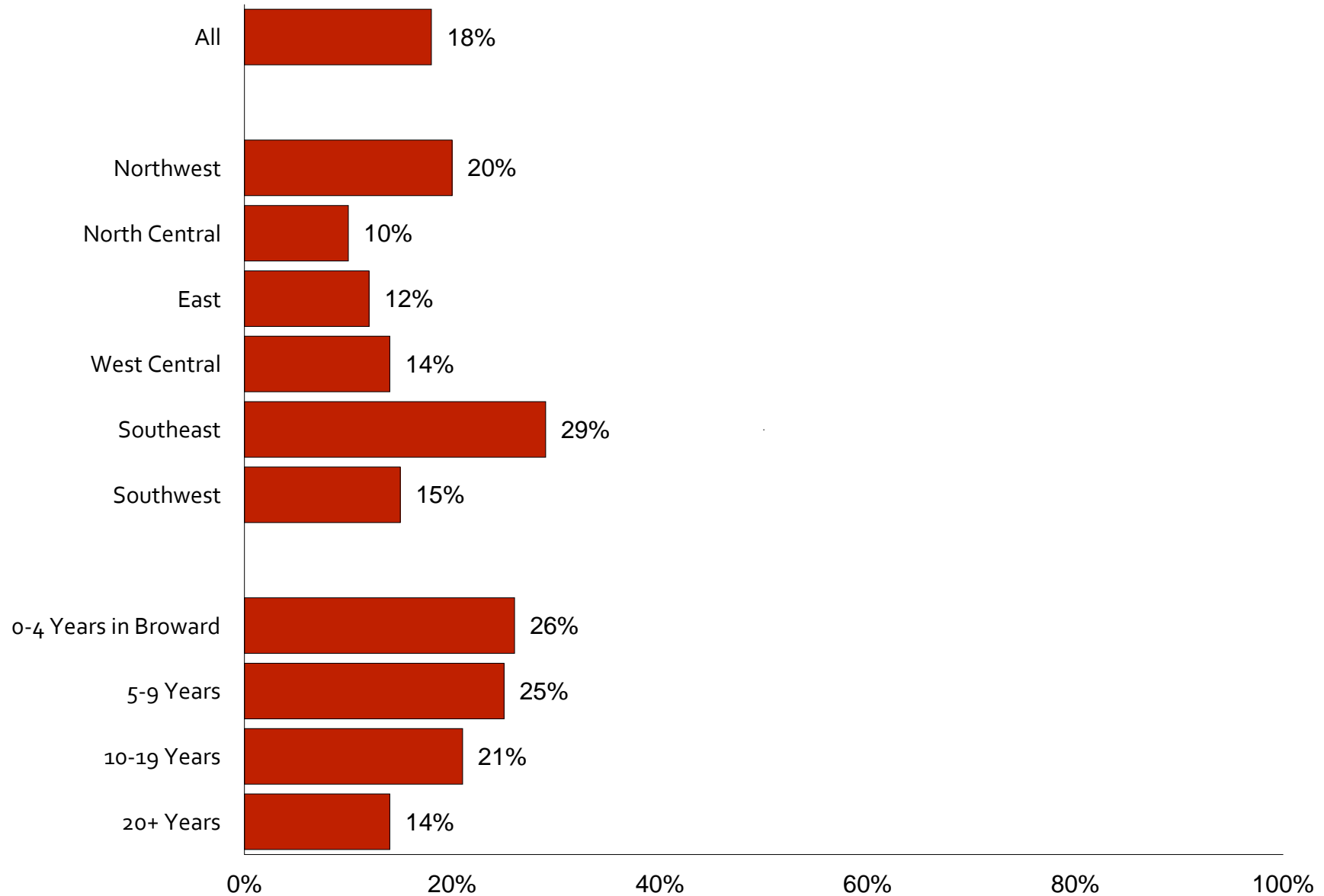
## Probability of Moving Within the Next Three Years

(Jewish Households)



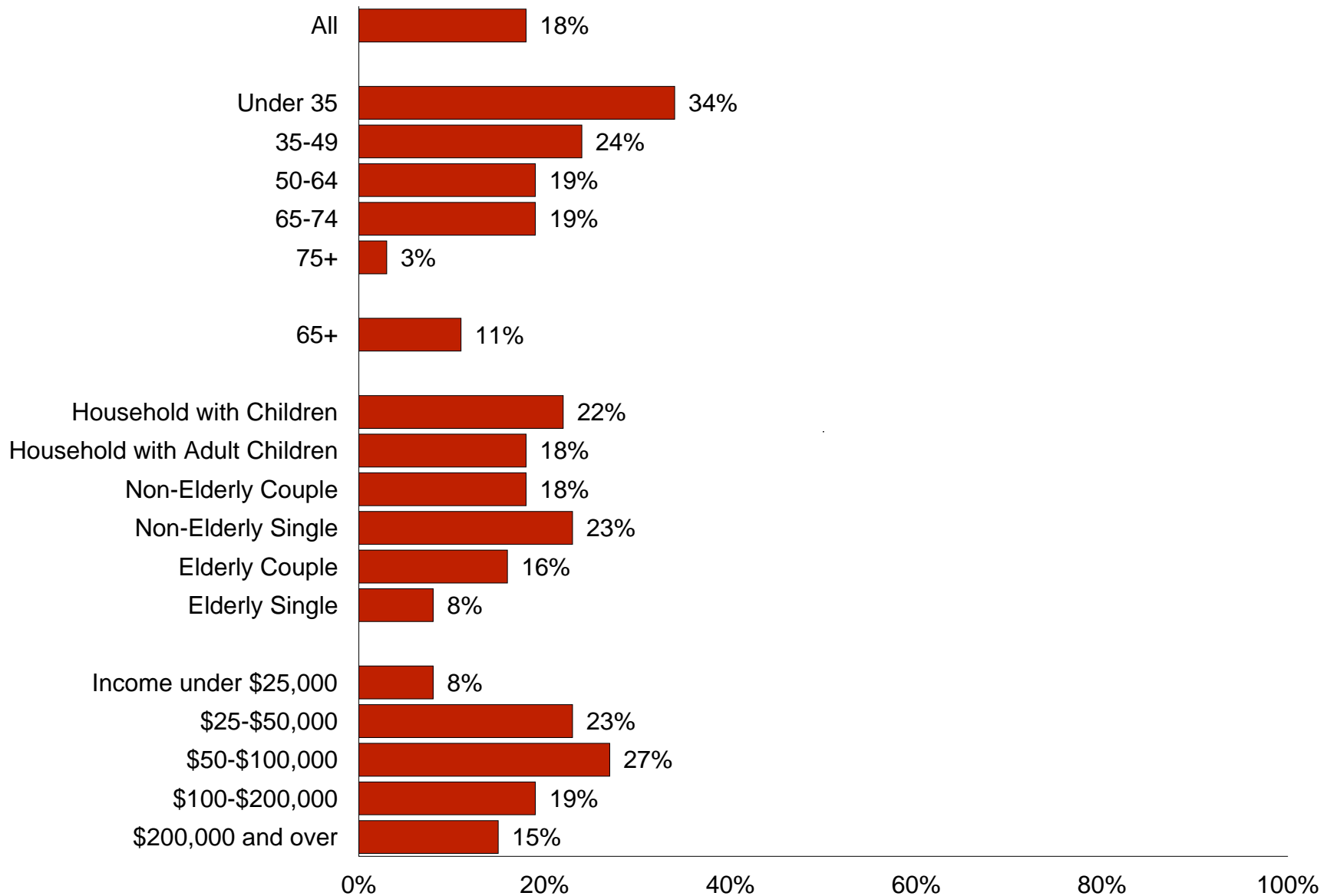

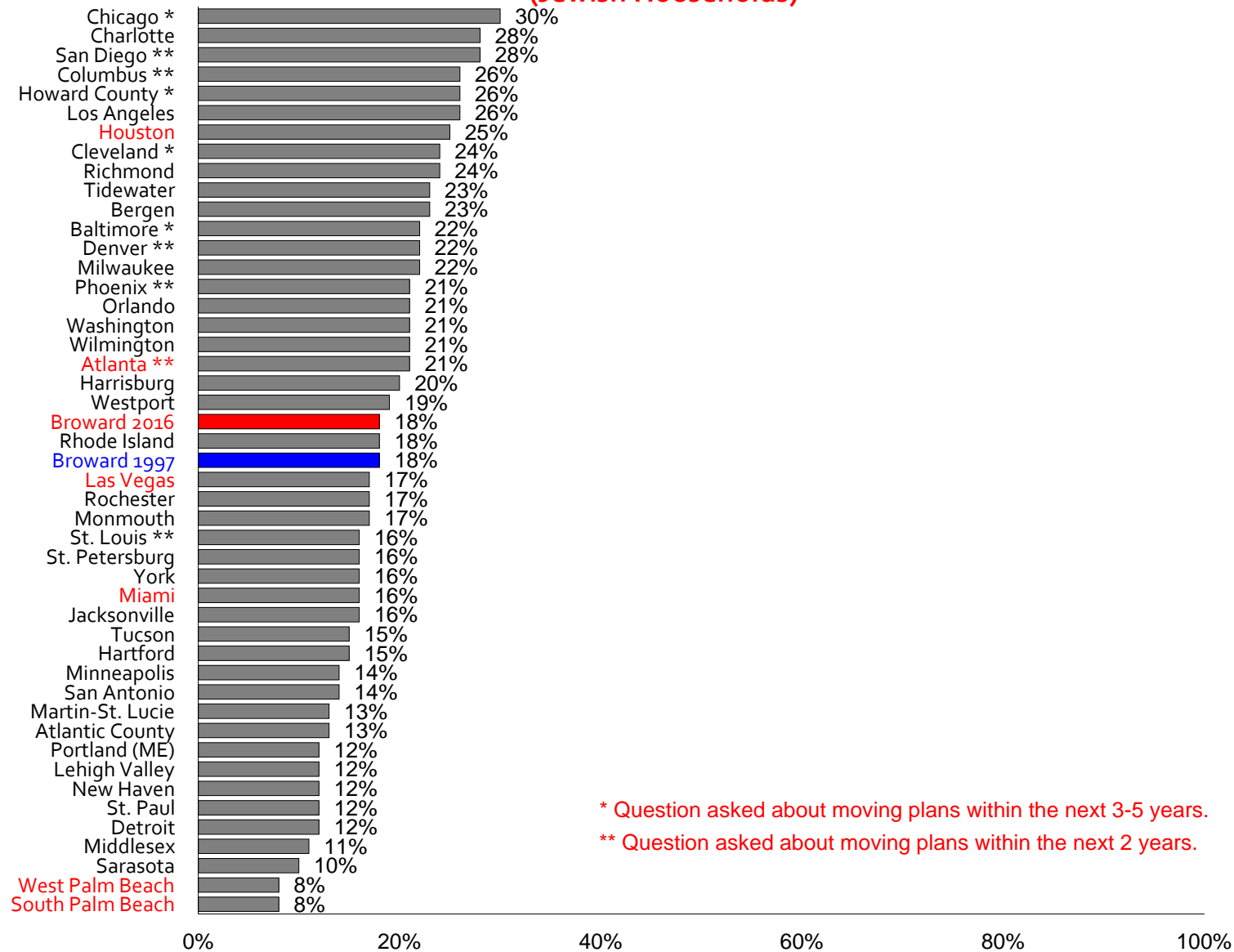

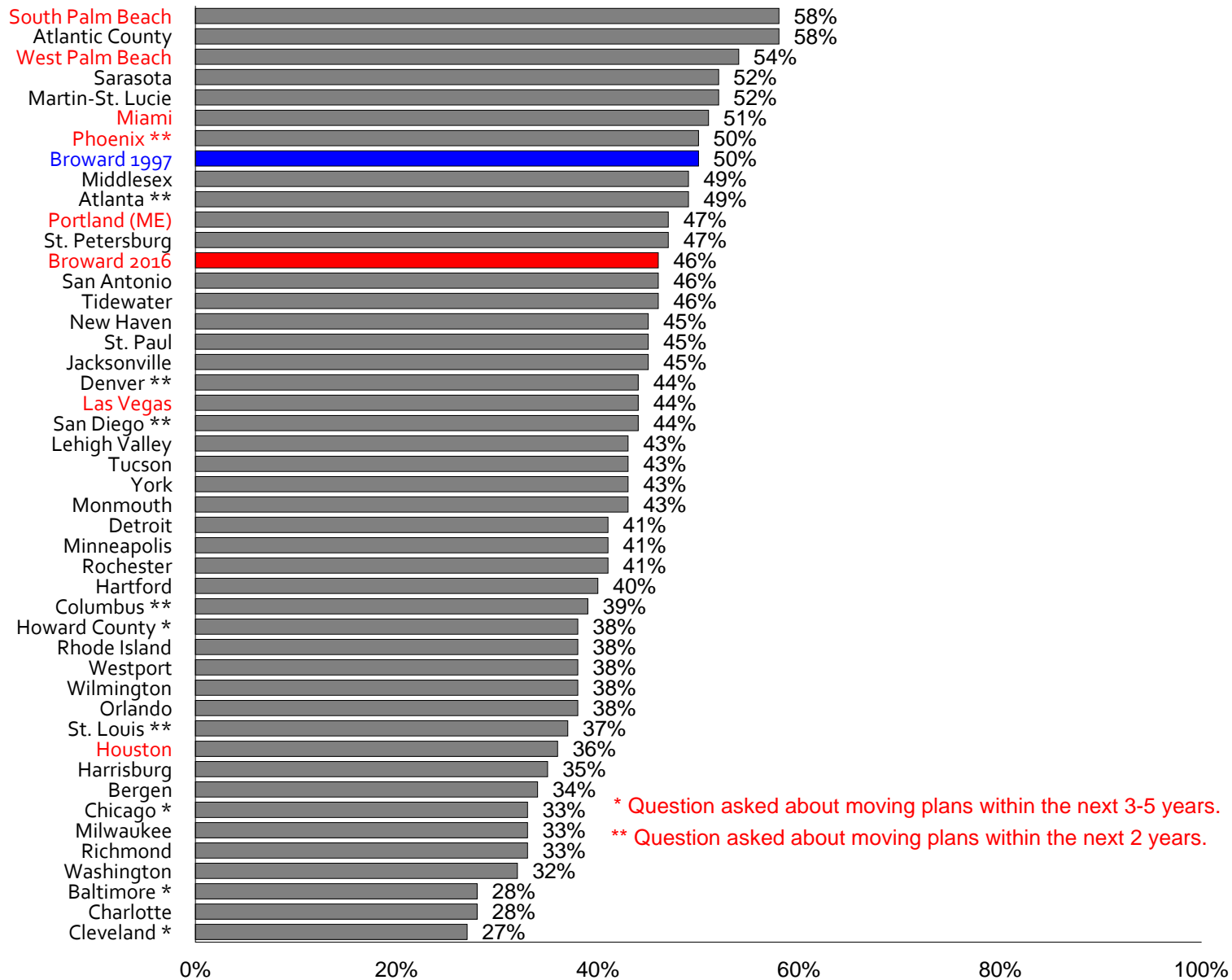

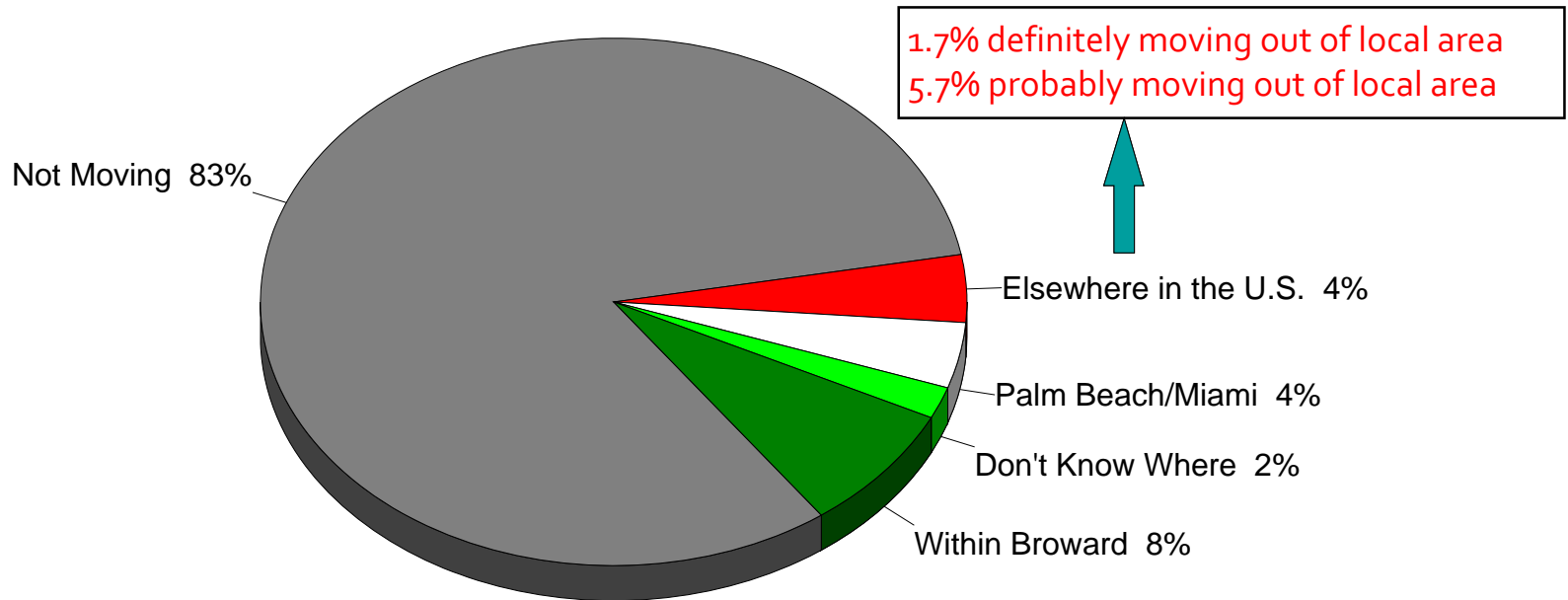
# Definitely Not Moving Within the Next Three Years

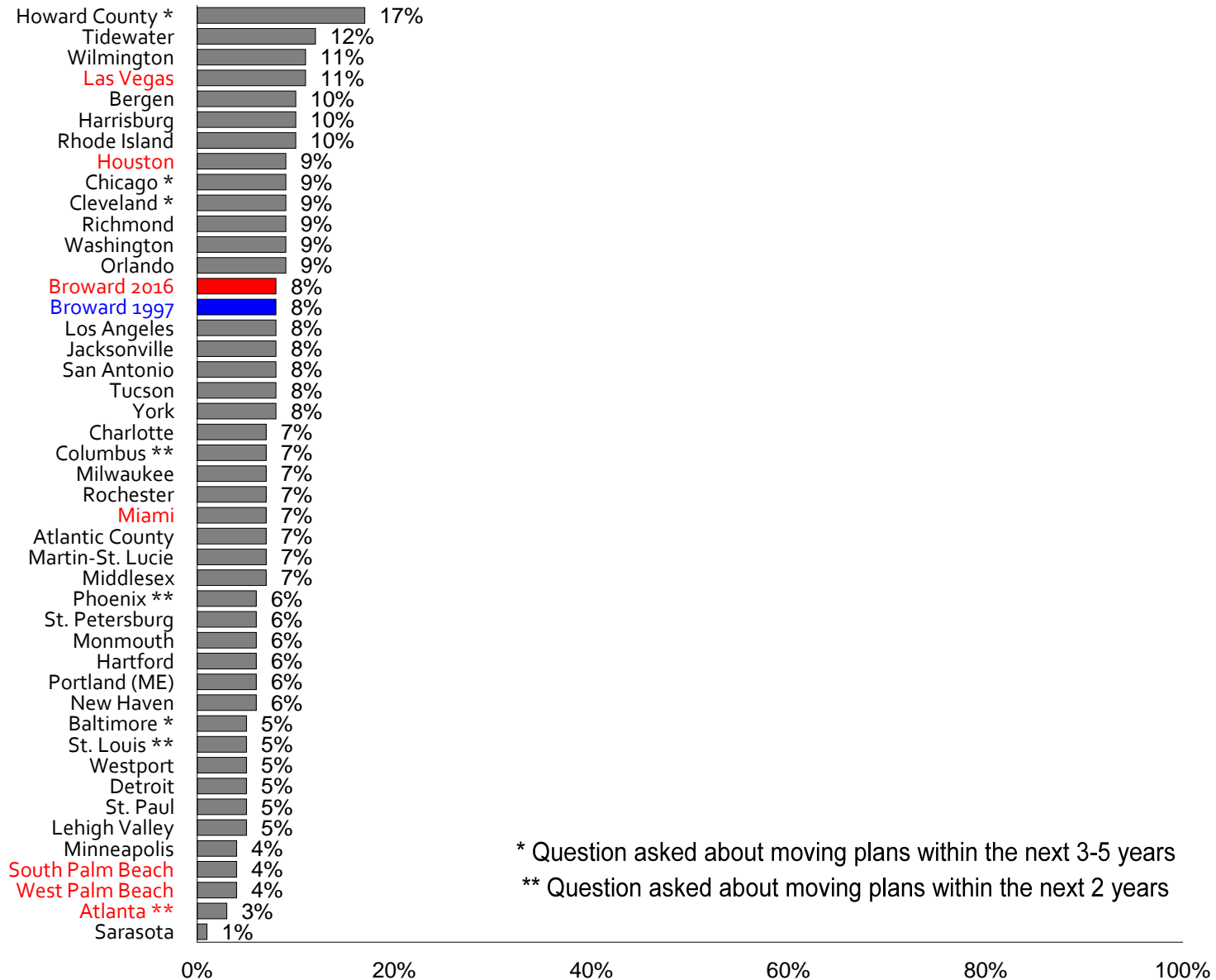


# Expected Destination for Households Who Are Moving Within the Next Three Years

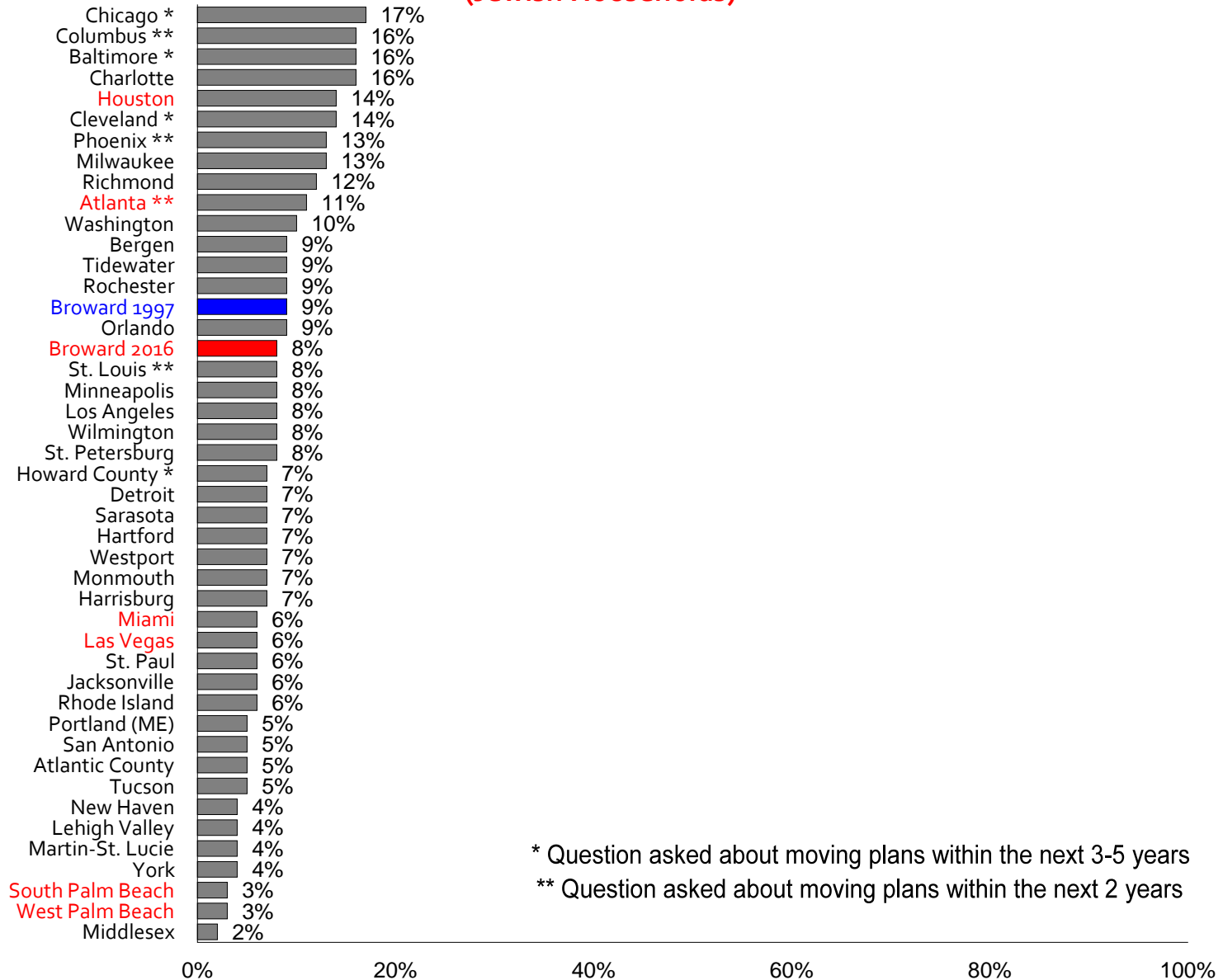
## Definitely or Probably Moving Out of Local Community Within the Next Three Years (Jewish Households)





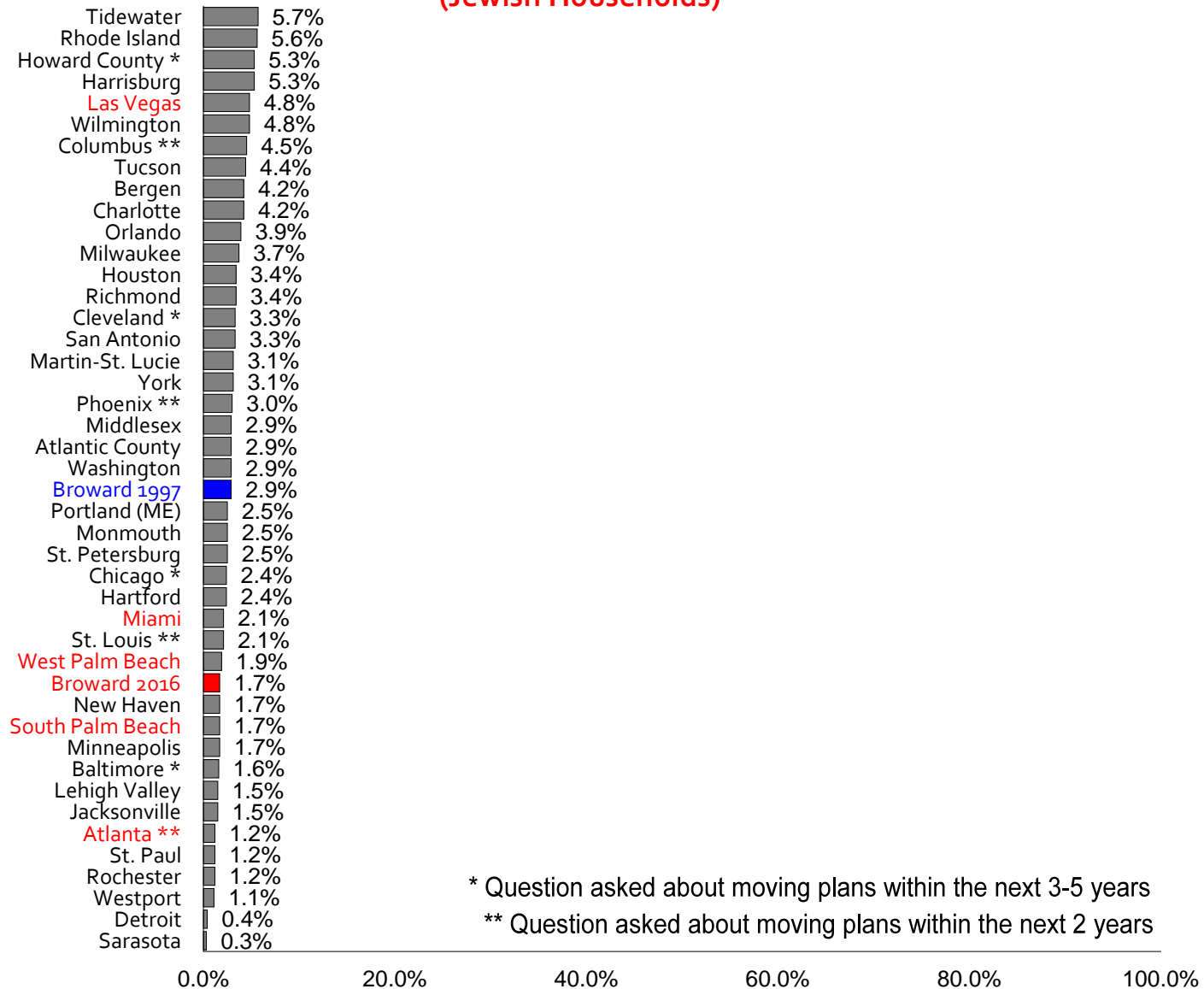

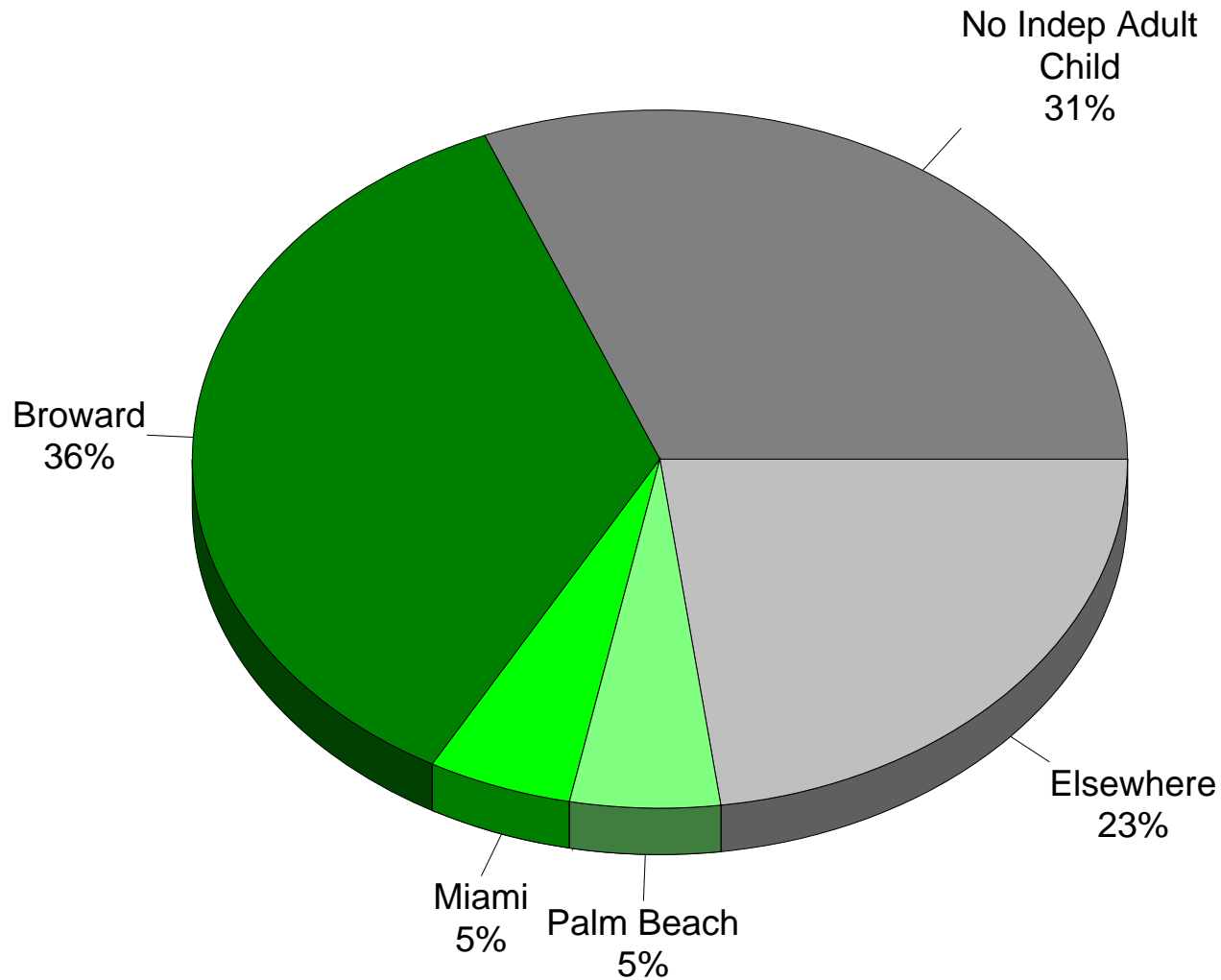


## Migration of Full-Year Households

- Average Annual In-Migration
  - 900 full-year households moved in each year during the past five years
- Projected Average Annual Out-Migration
  - 400 full-year households definitely moving out of Broward each year during the next three years
  - 1,300 full-year households probably moving out of Broward each year during the next three years
- Projected Change
  - the Jewish population should continue to decrease in the next few years as a result of migration

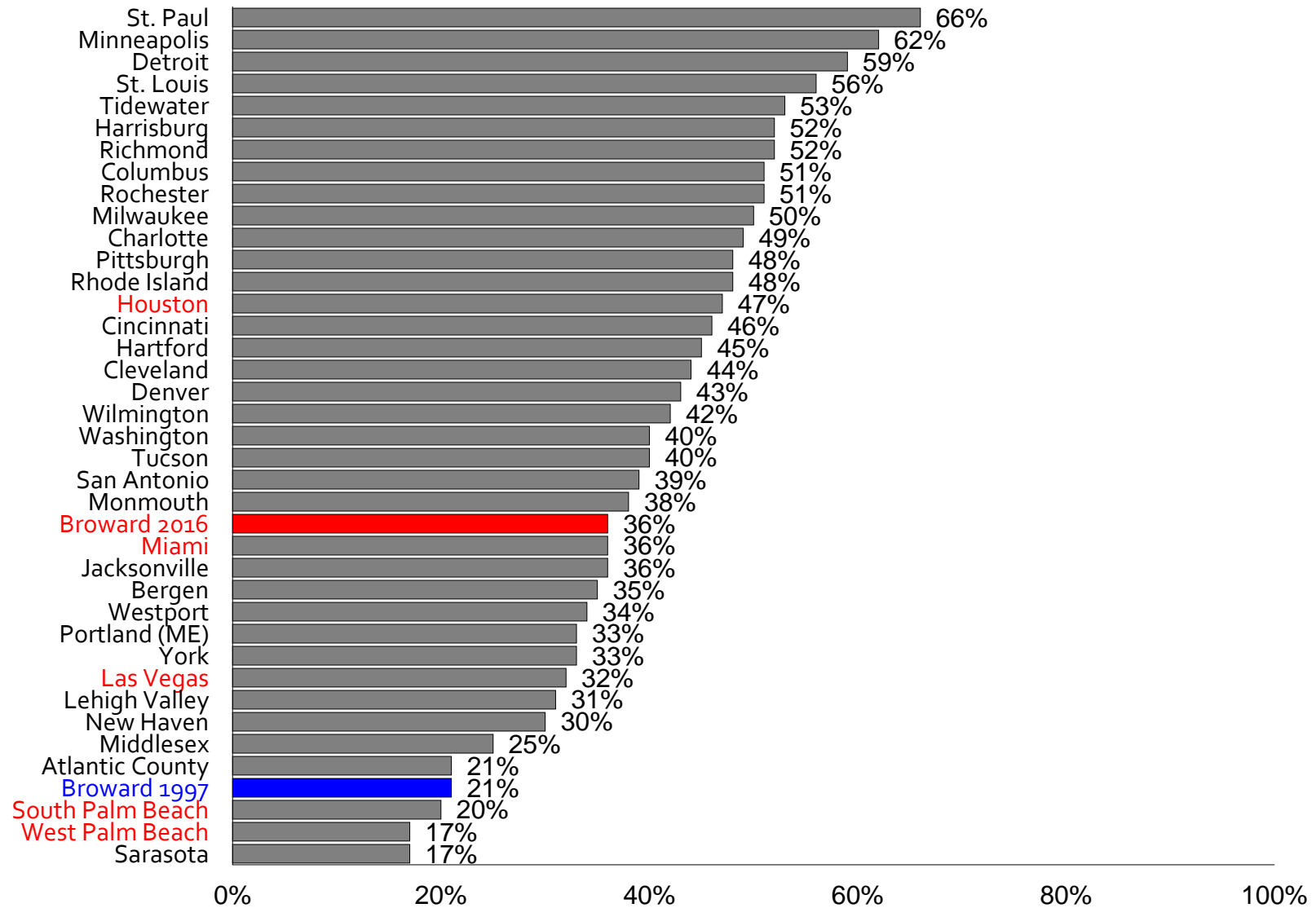
## Location of Adult Children Who Have Established Their Own Homes

(Households in Which the Respondent Is Age 50 or Over)



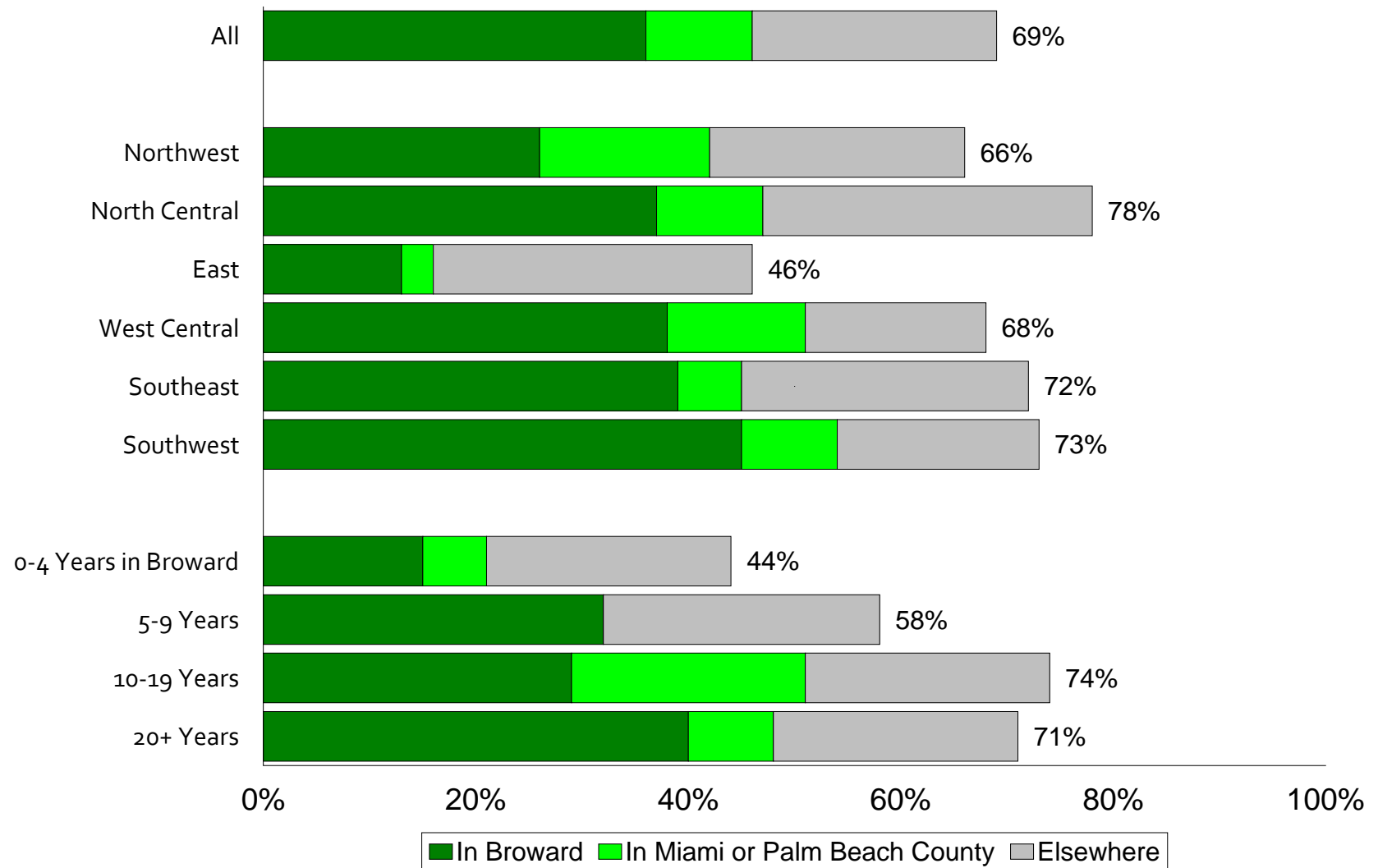

(Households in Which the Respondent Is Age 50 or Over)



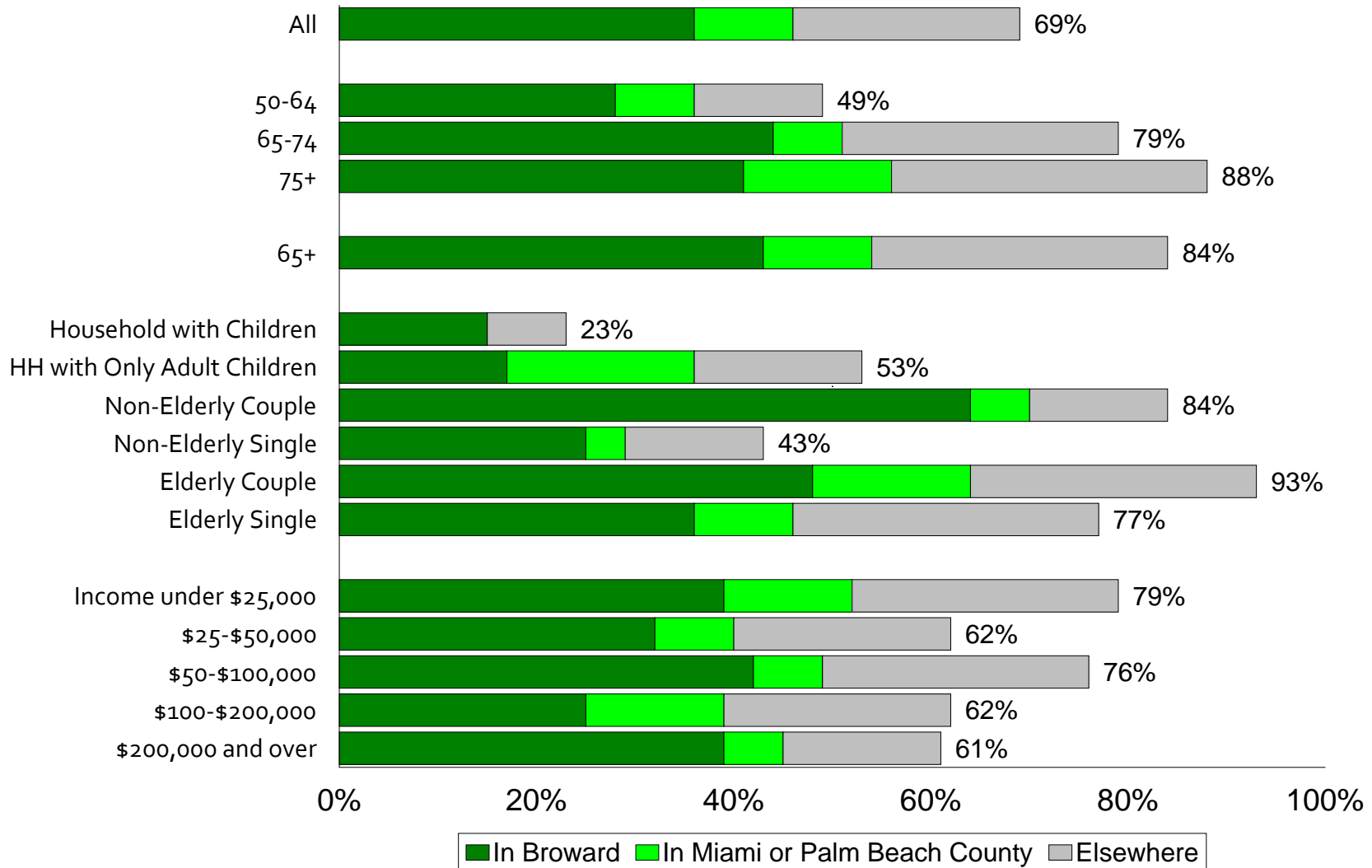
## Households with Adult Children Who Have Established Their Own Homes in Local Area
